[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combination chip and card holder and scorer therefor or similar article, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combination chip and card holder and scorer therefor or similar article, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear view being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof.

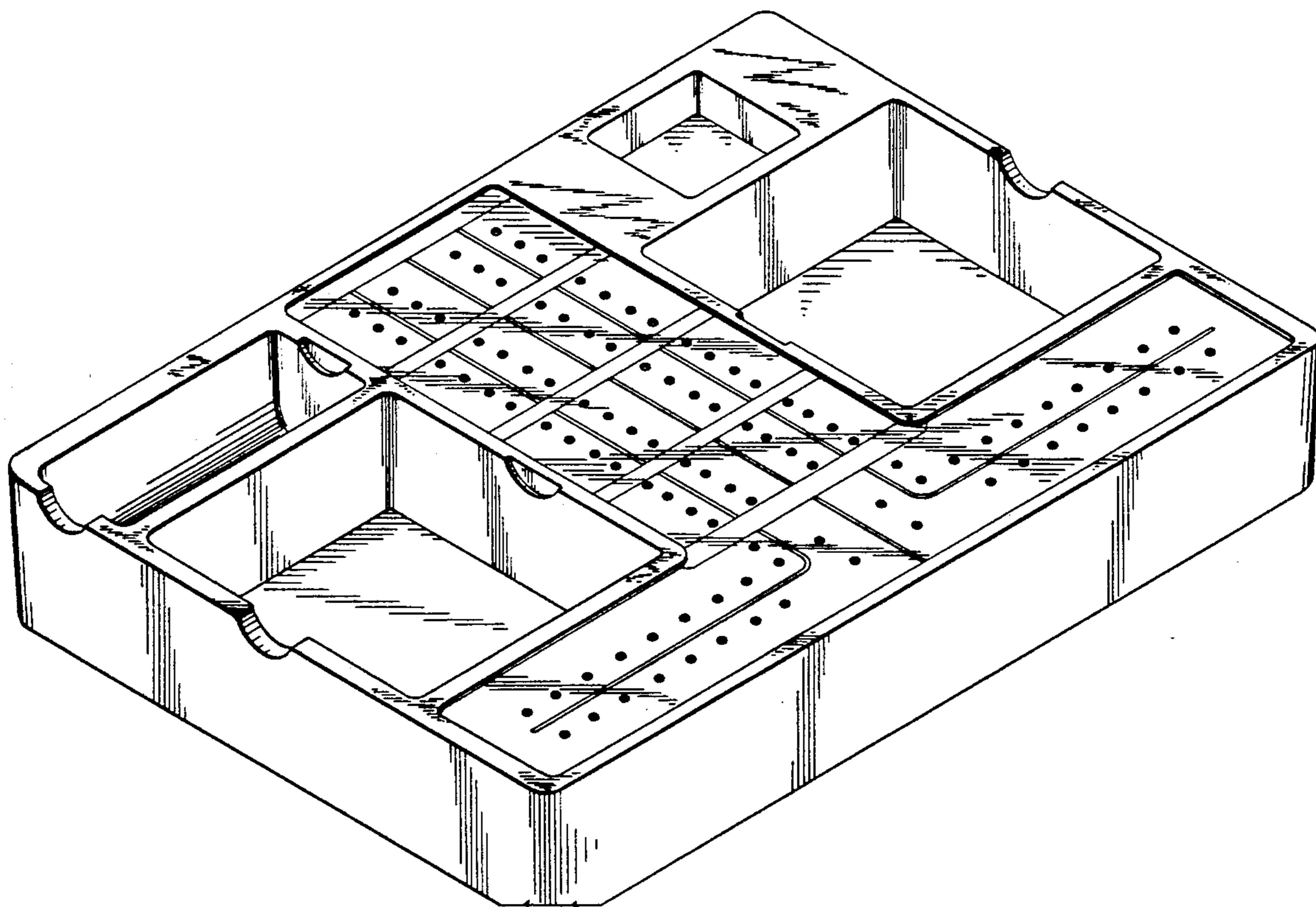

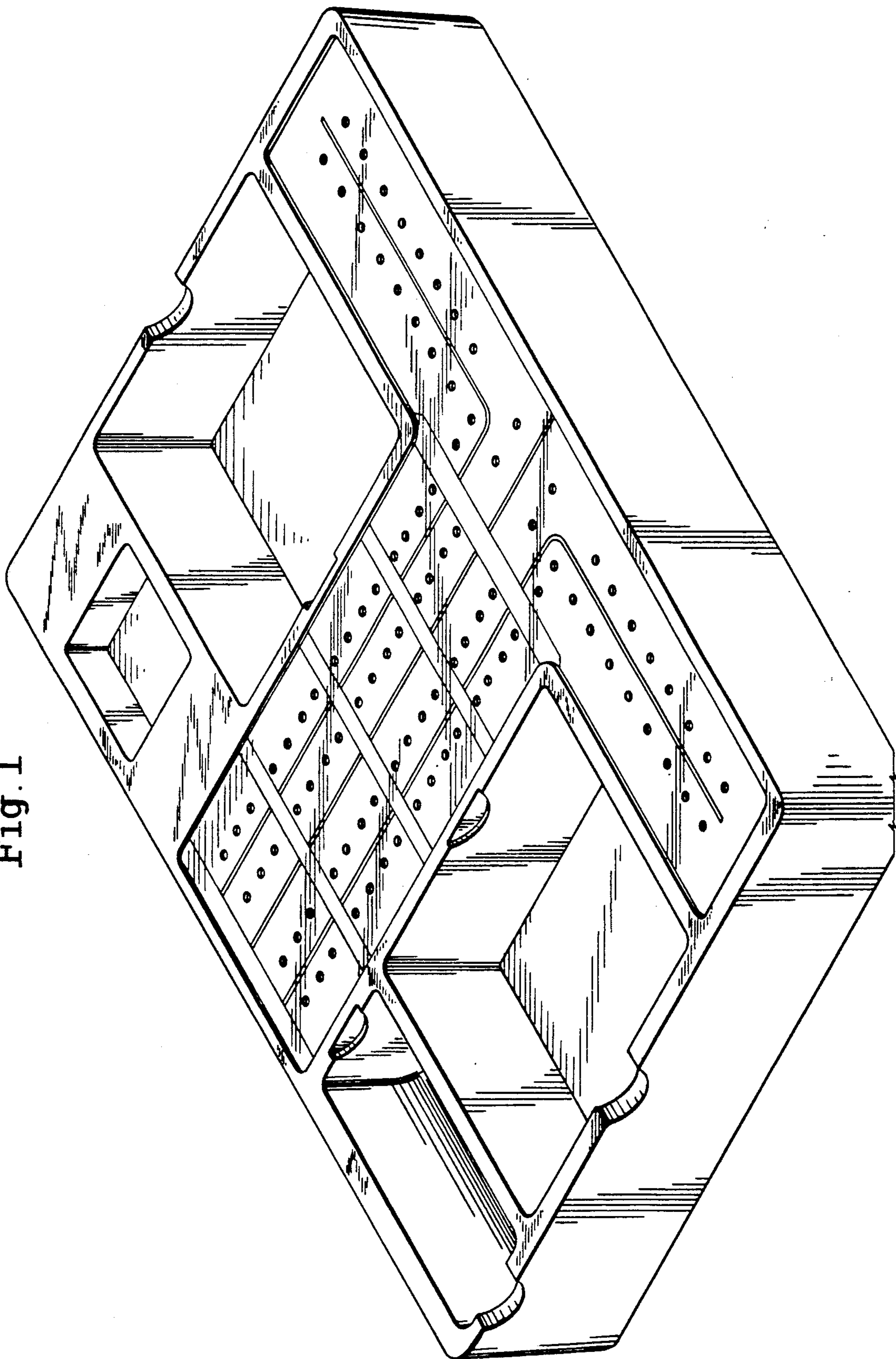

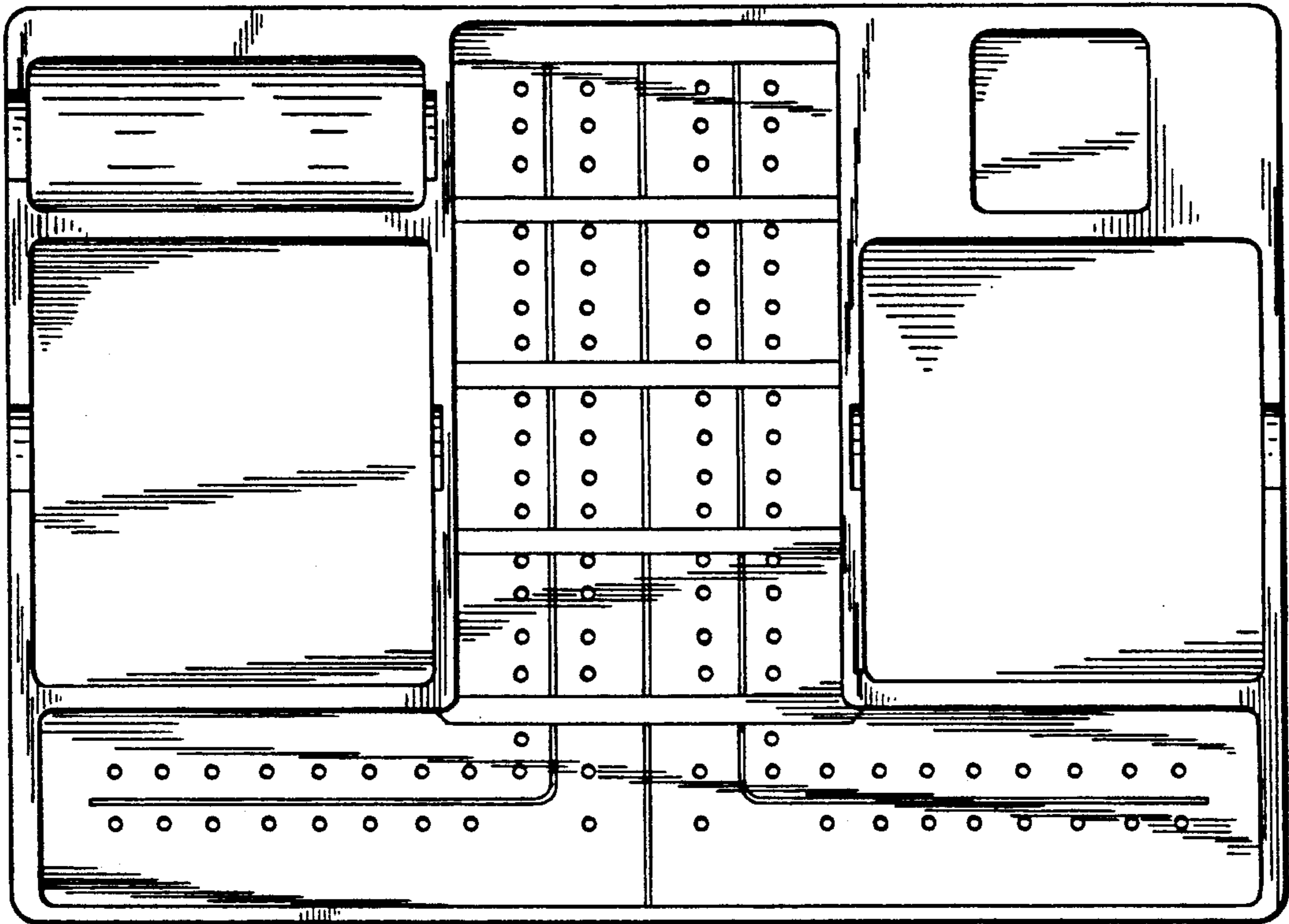

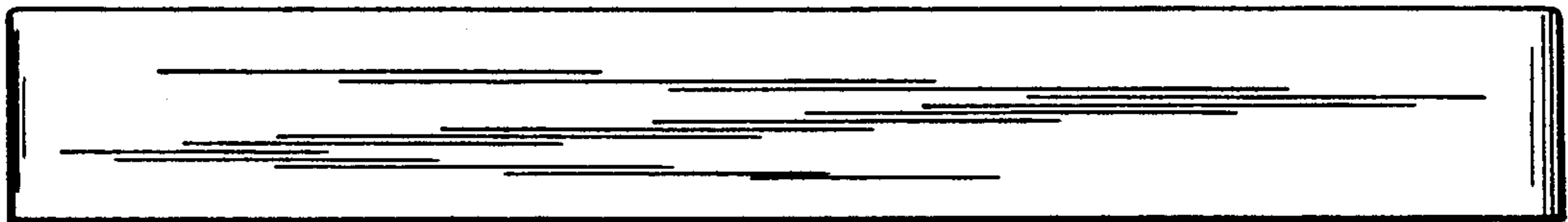

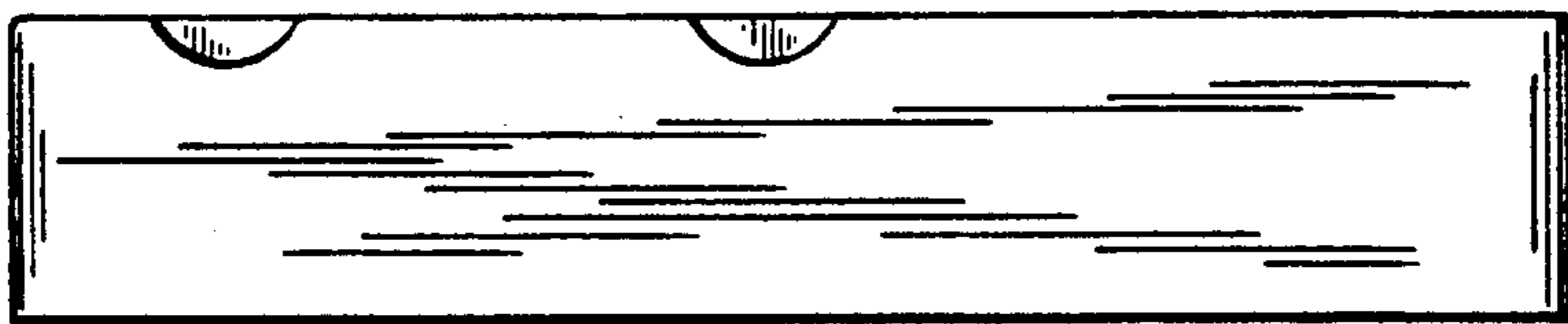
