The ornamental design for a pain reliever for the ear, as shown.

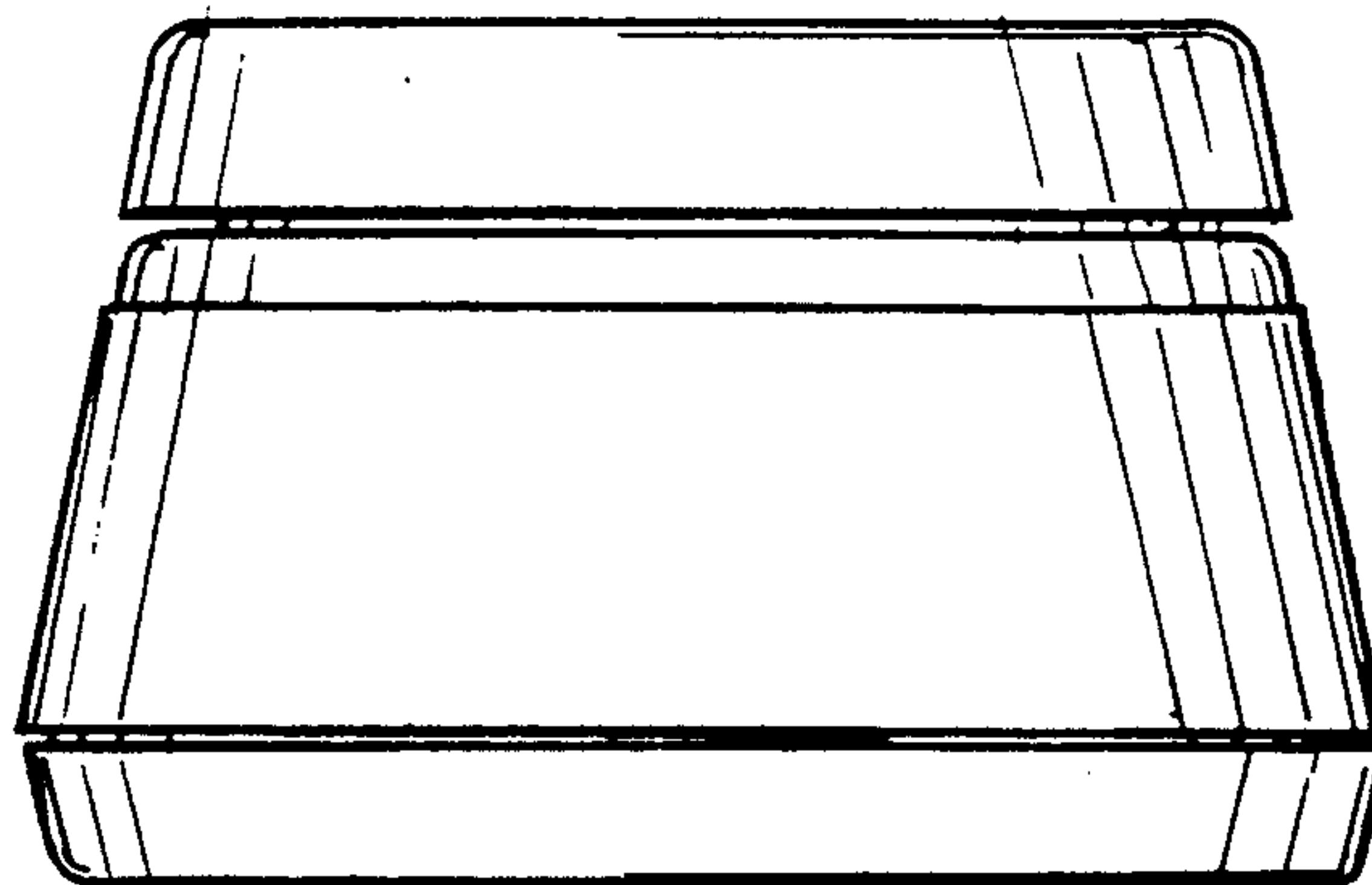
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a pain reliever for the ear, showing my new design, the rear elevational view being identical;

FIG. 2 is a left end elevational view thereof, the right end elevational view being identical;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



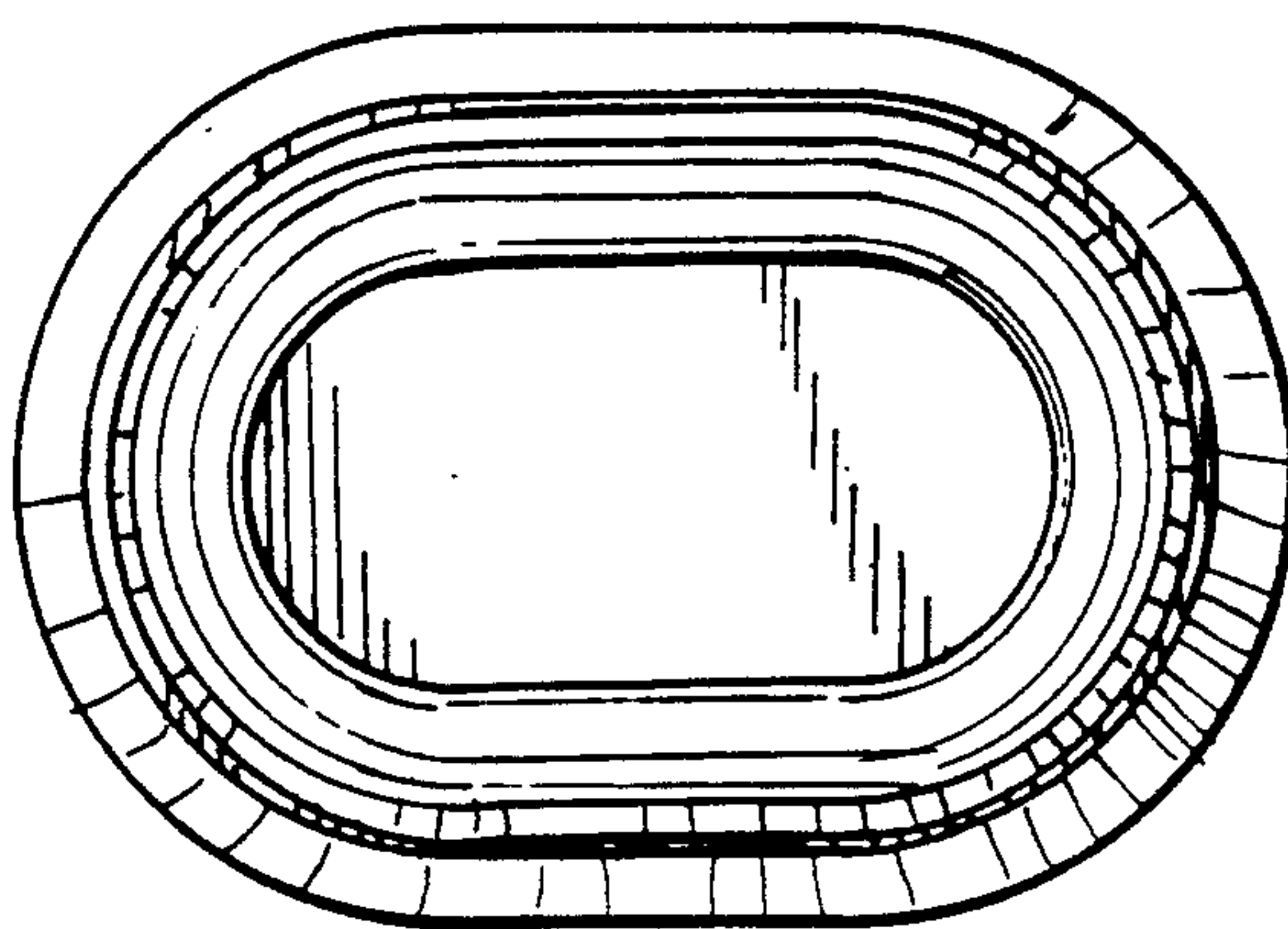

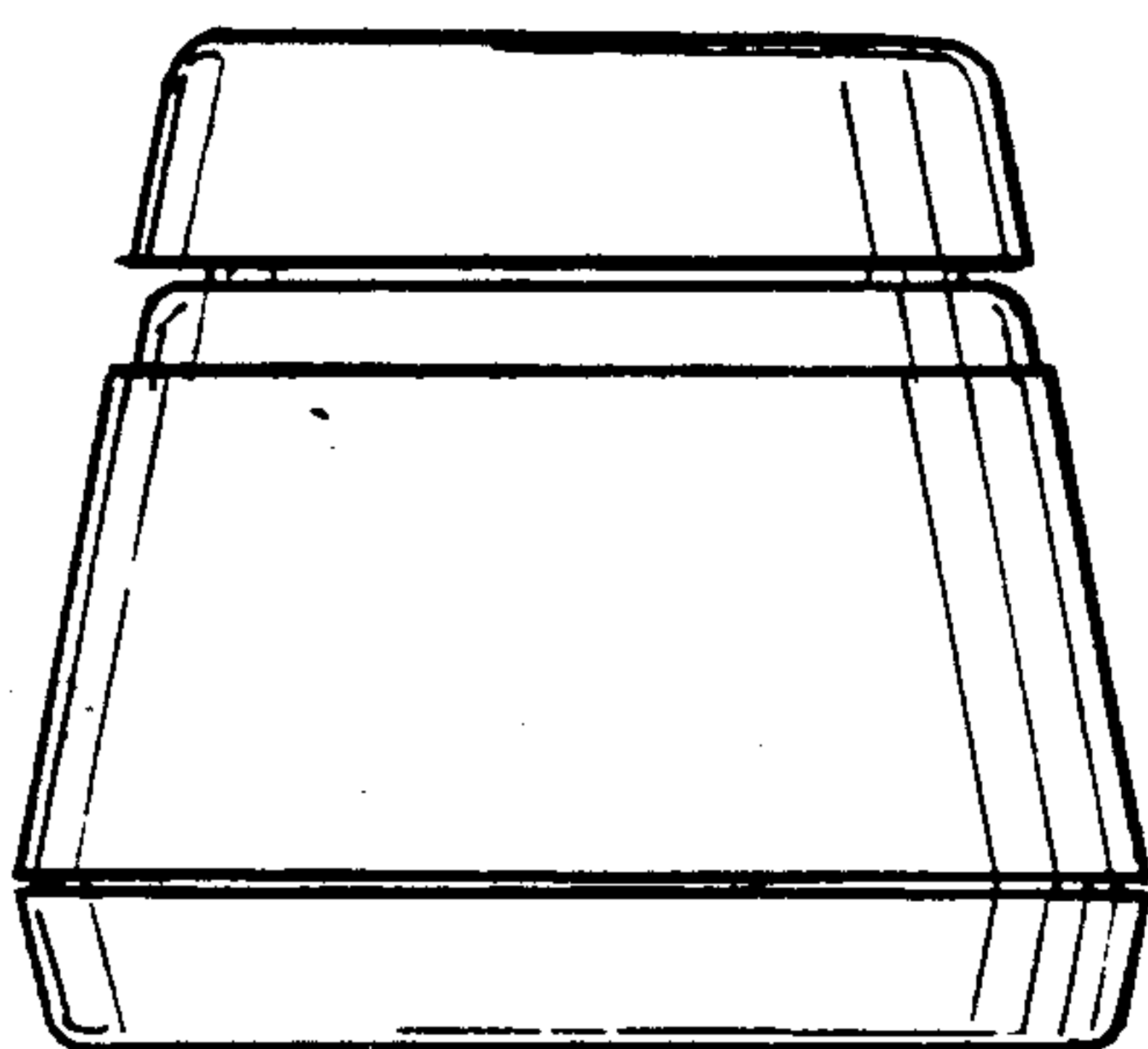

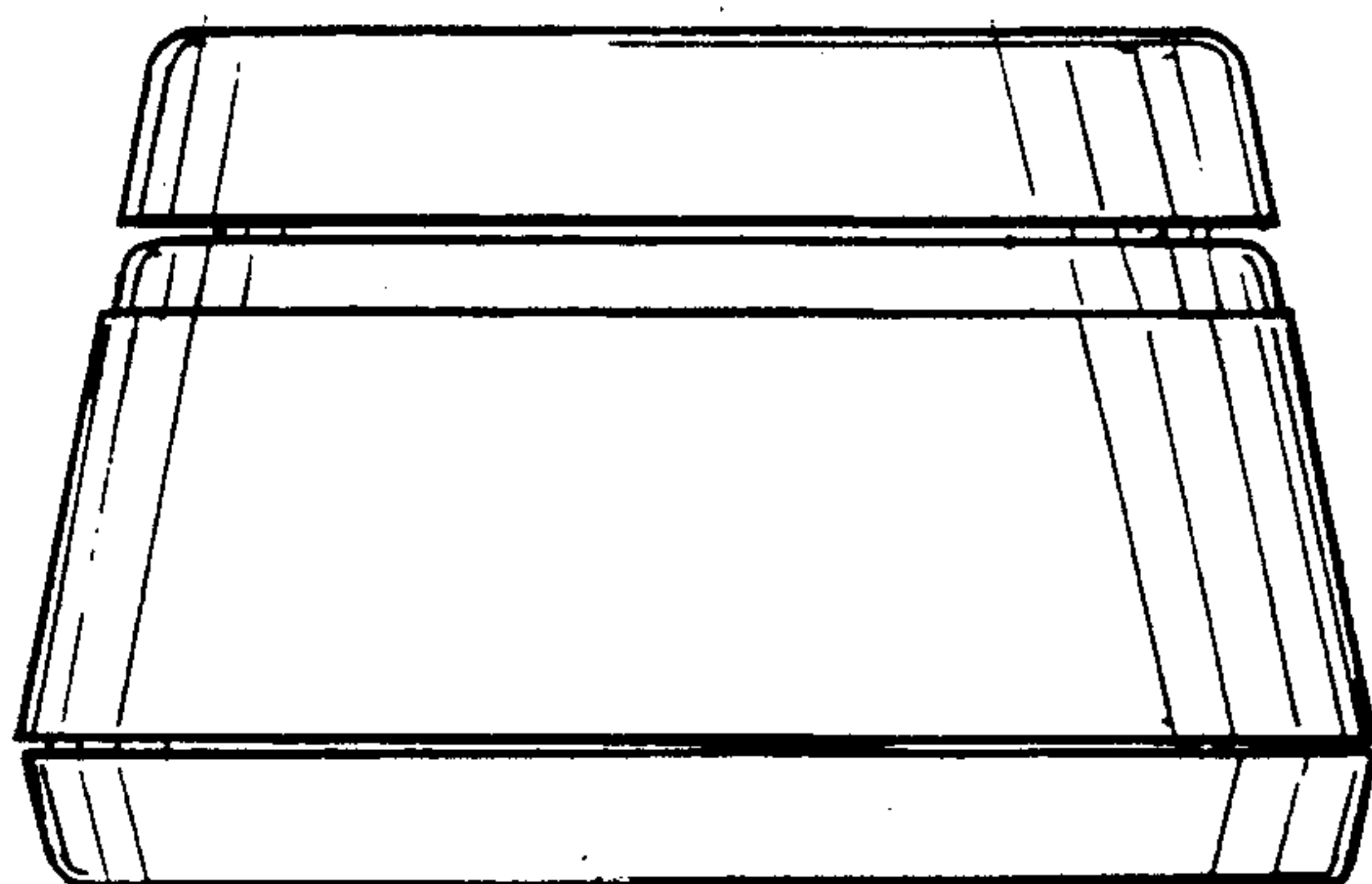

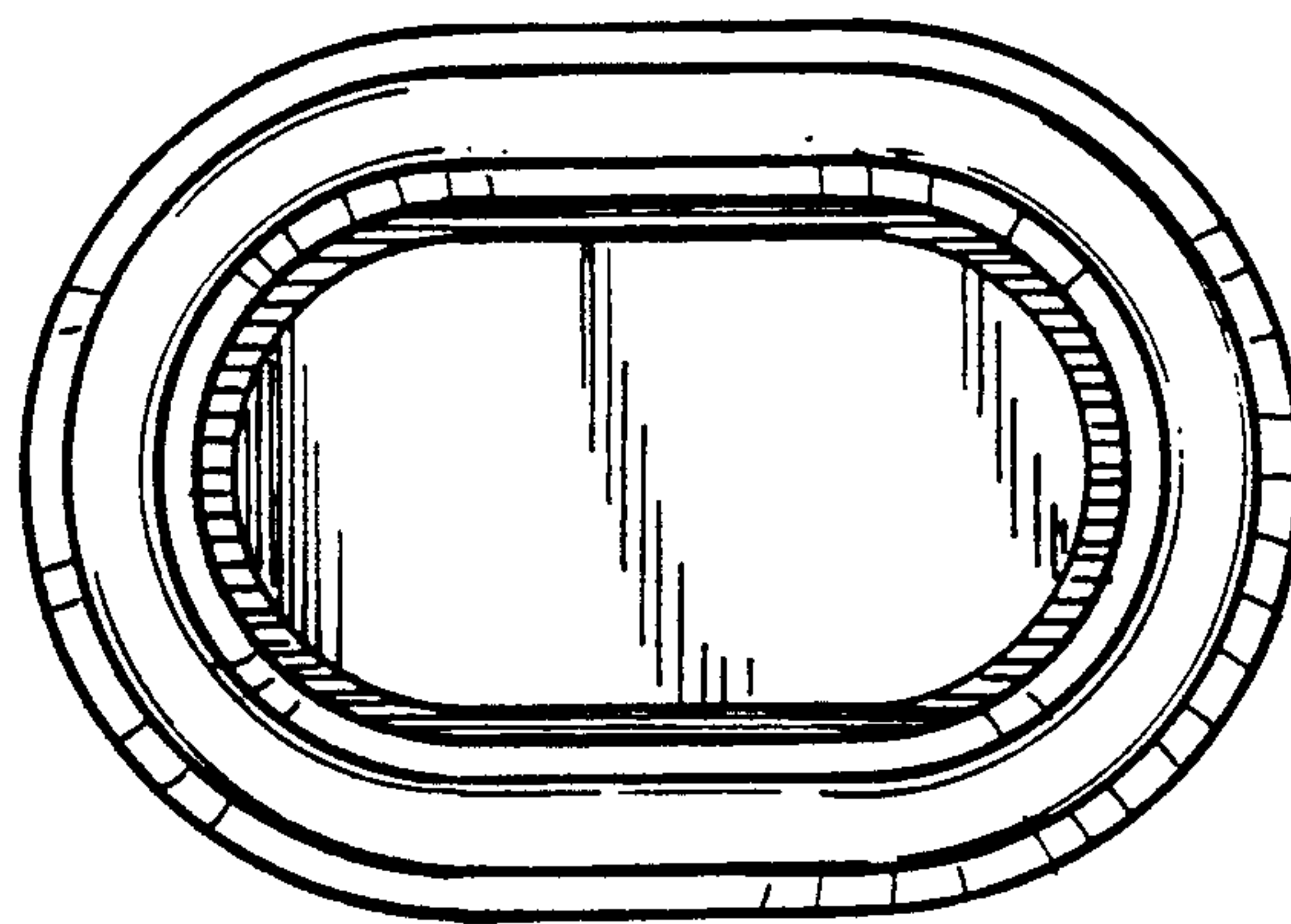
