FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a portable work light or the like showing my new design;

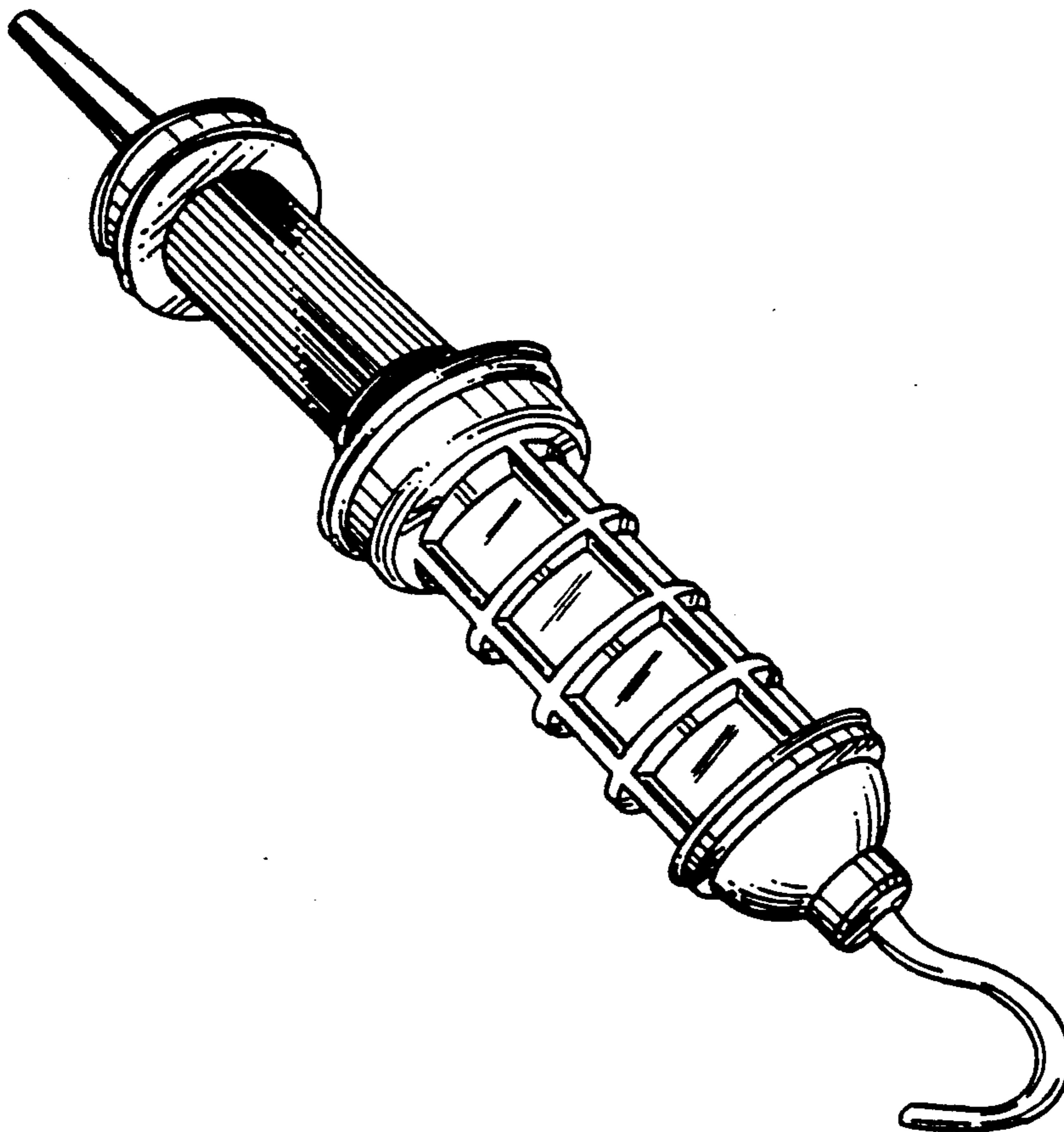
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof.



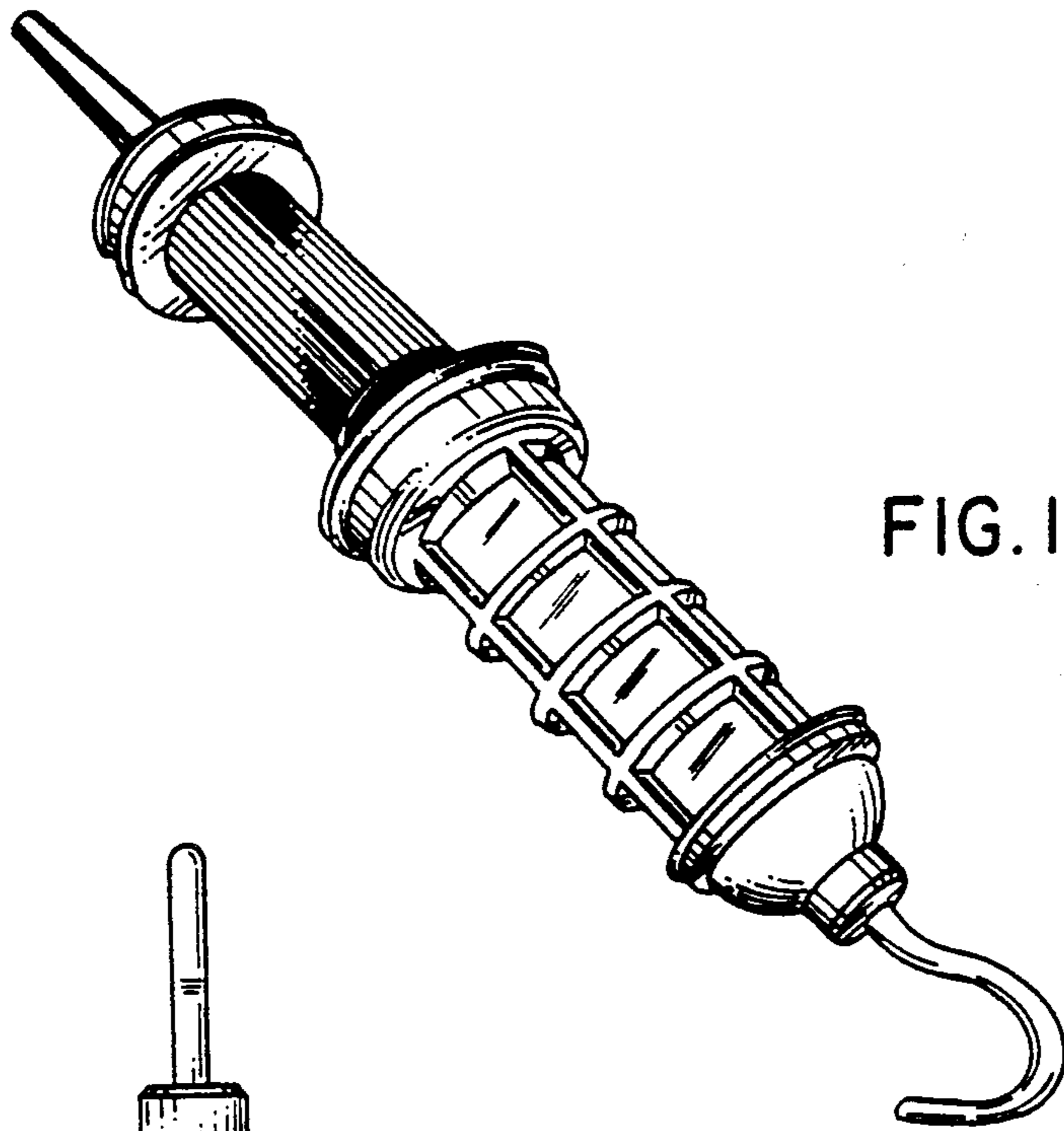

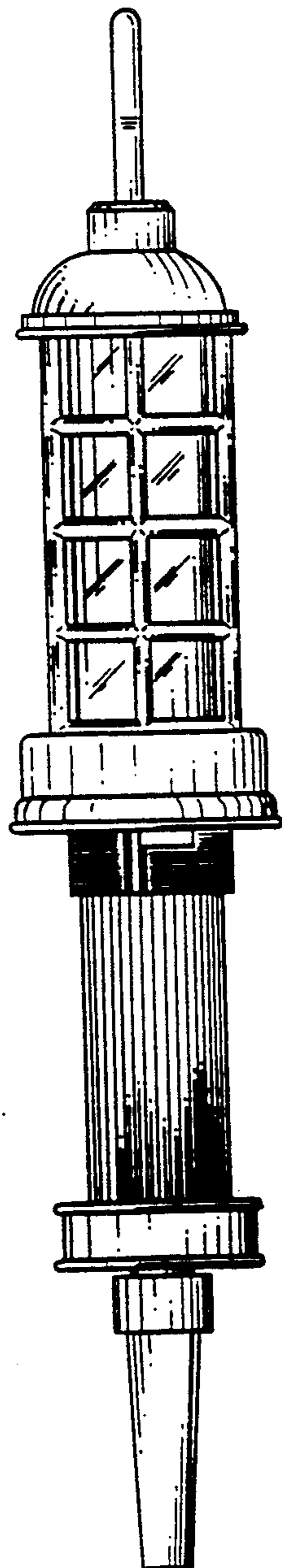

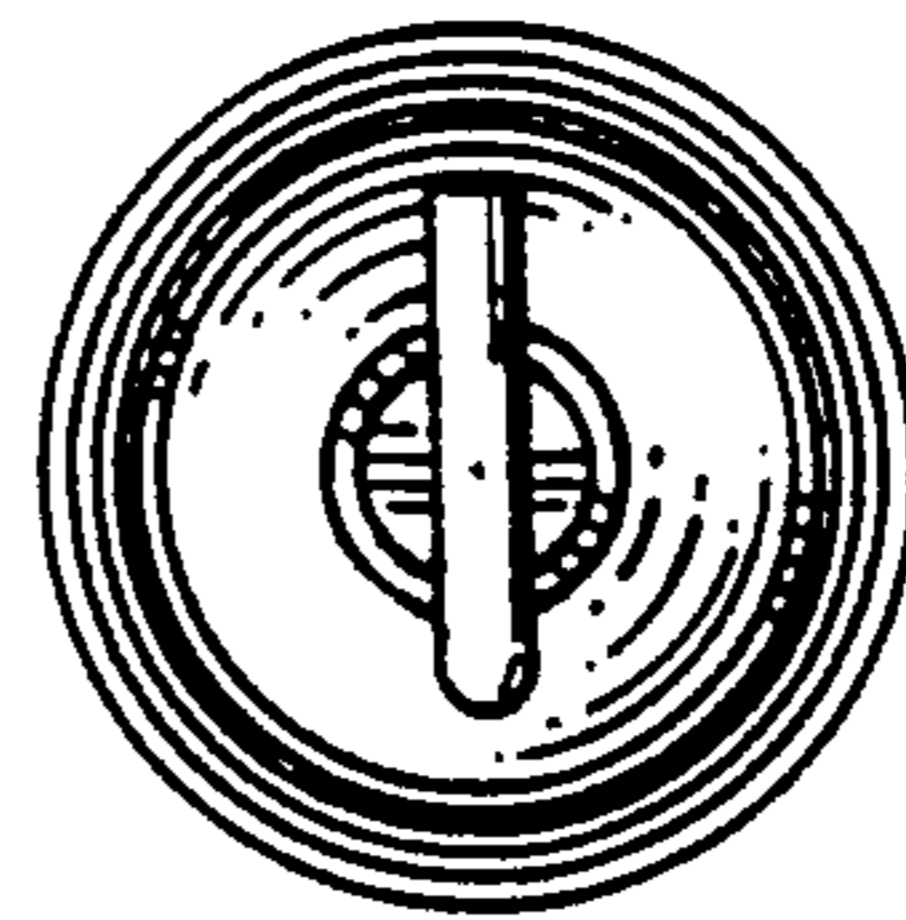

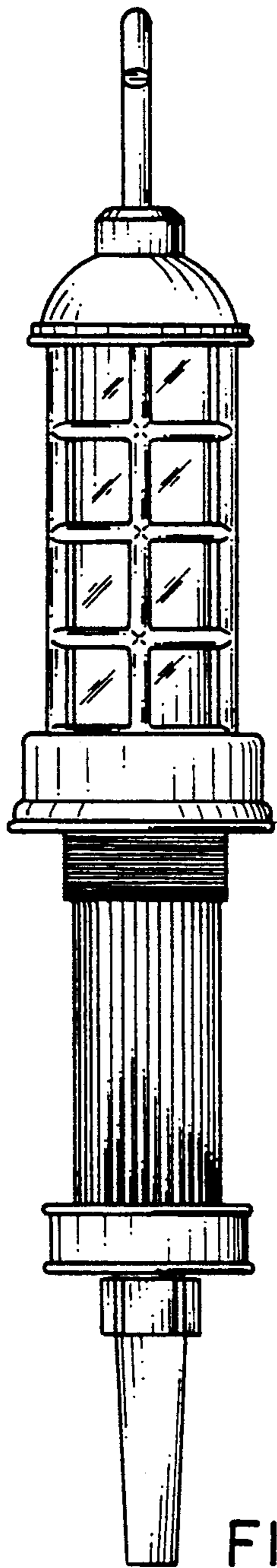

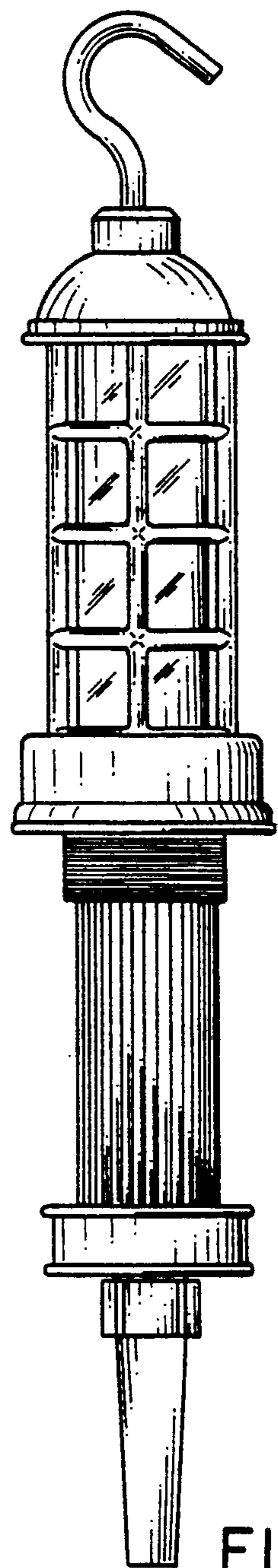

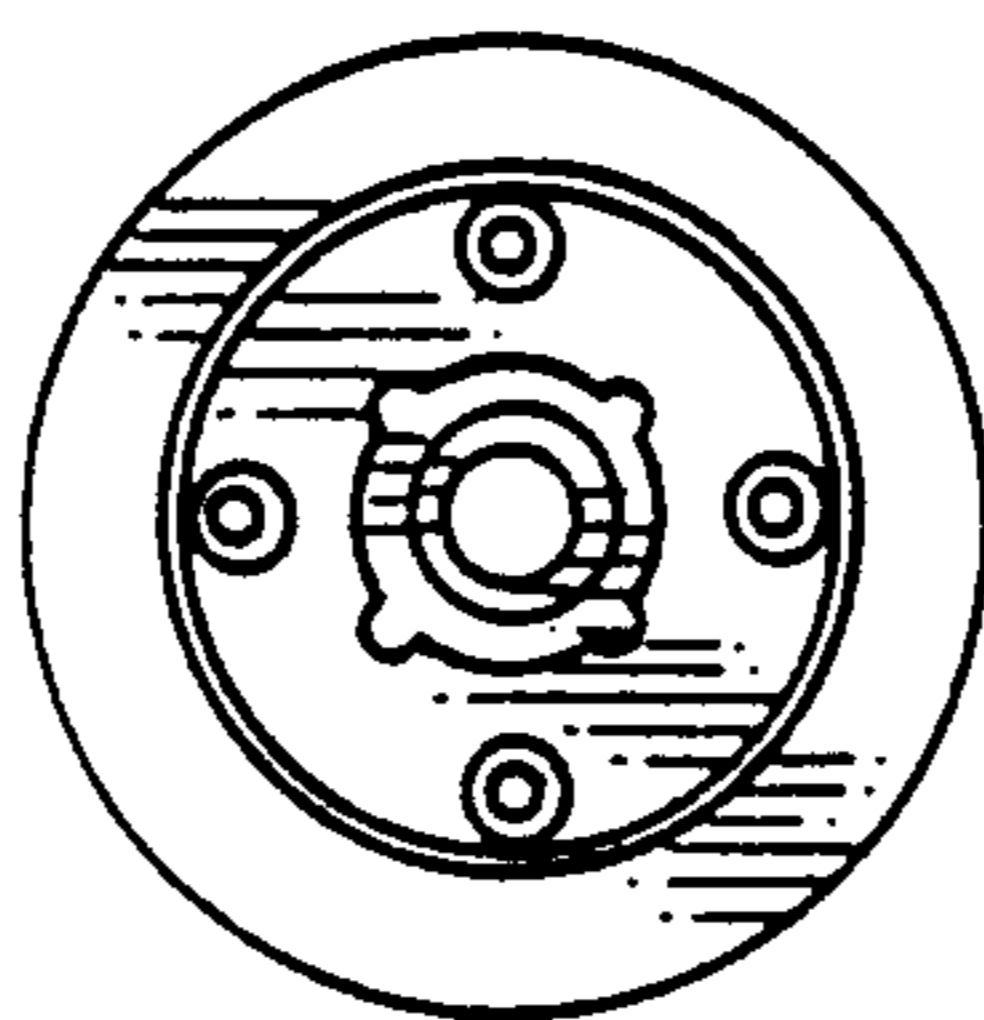
