The ornamental design for a trash can holder, as shown and described.

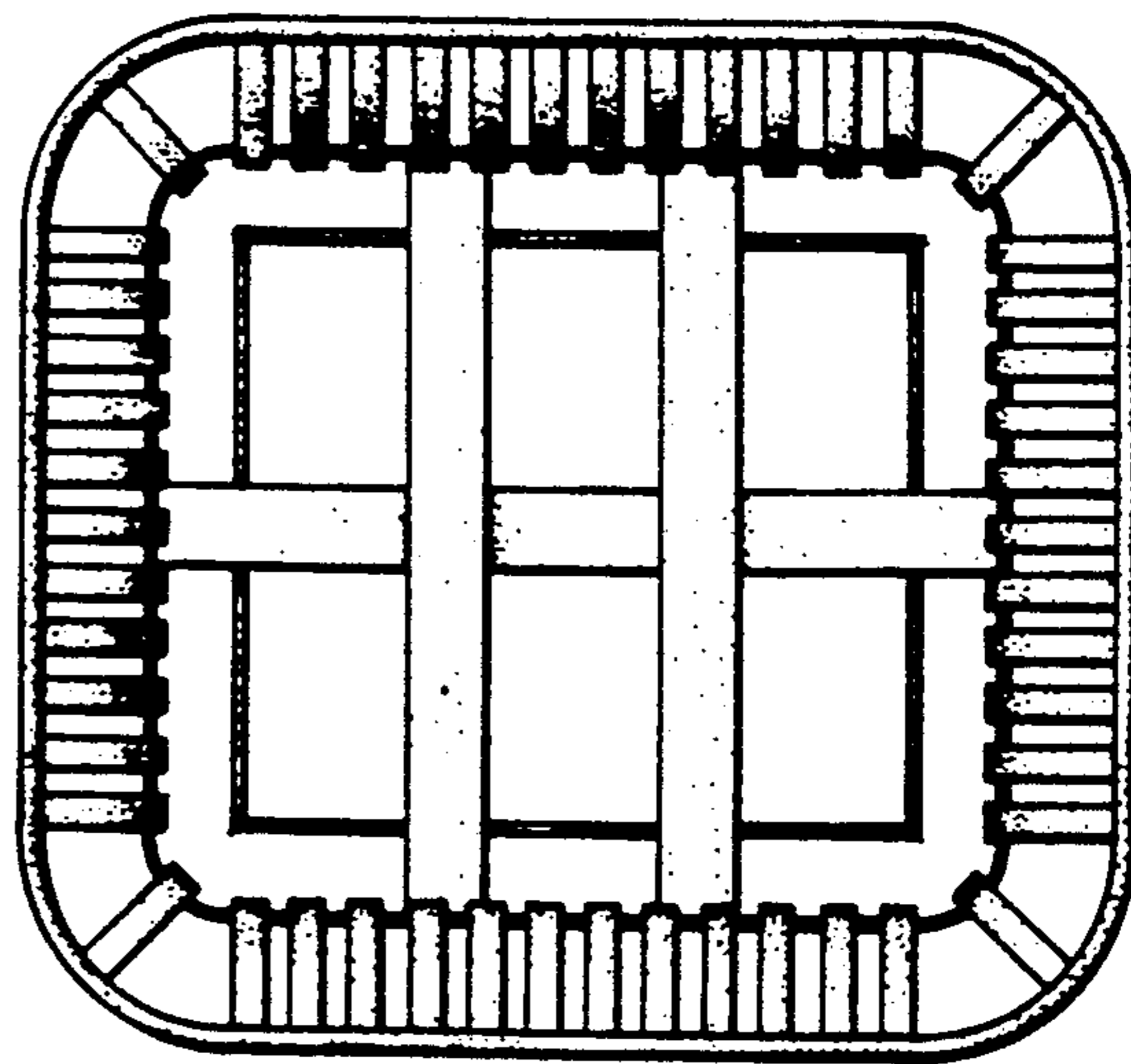
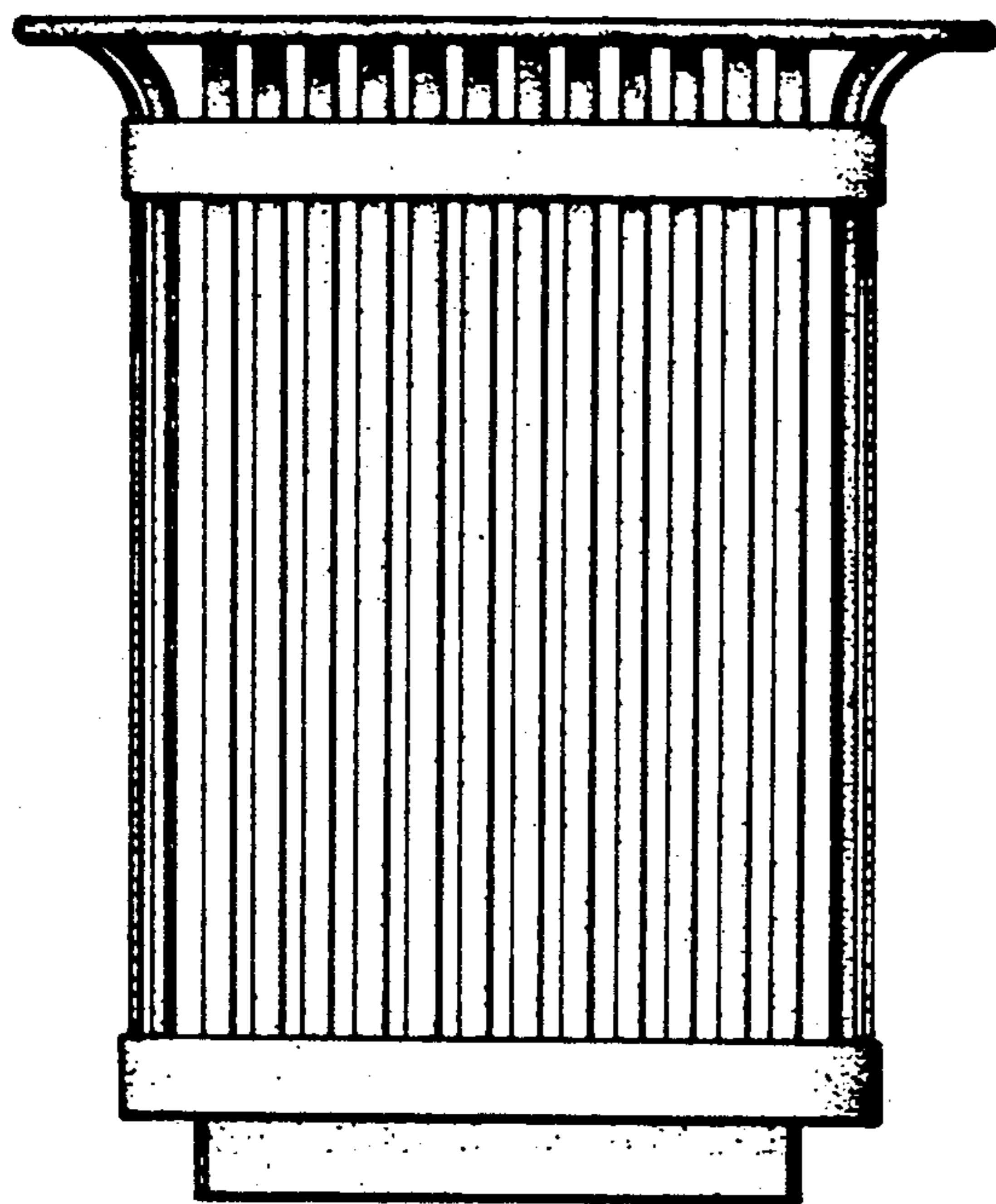
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a trash can holder showing my new design, the rear view being a mirror image of that shown;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side being a mirror image of that shown;

FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof; and

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.



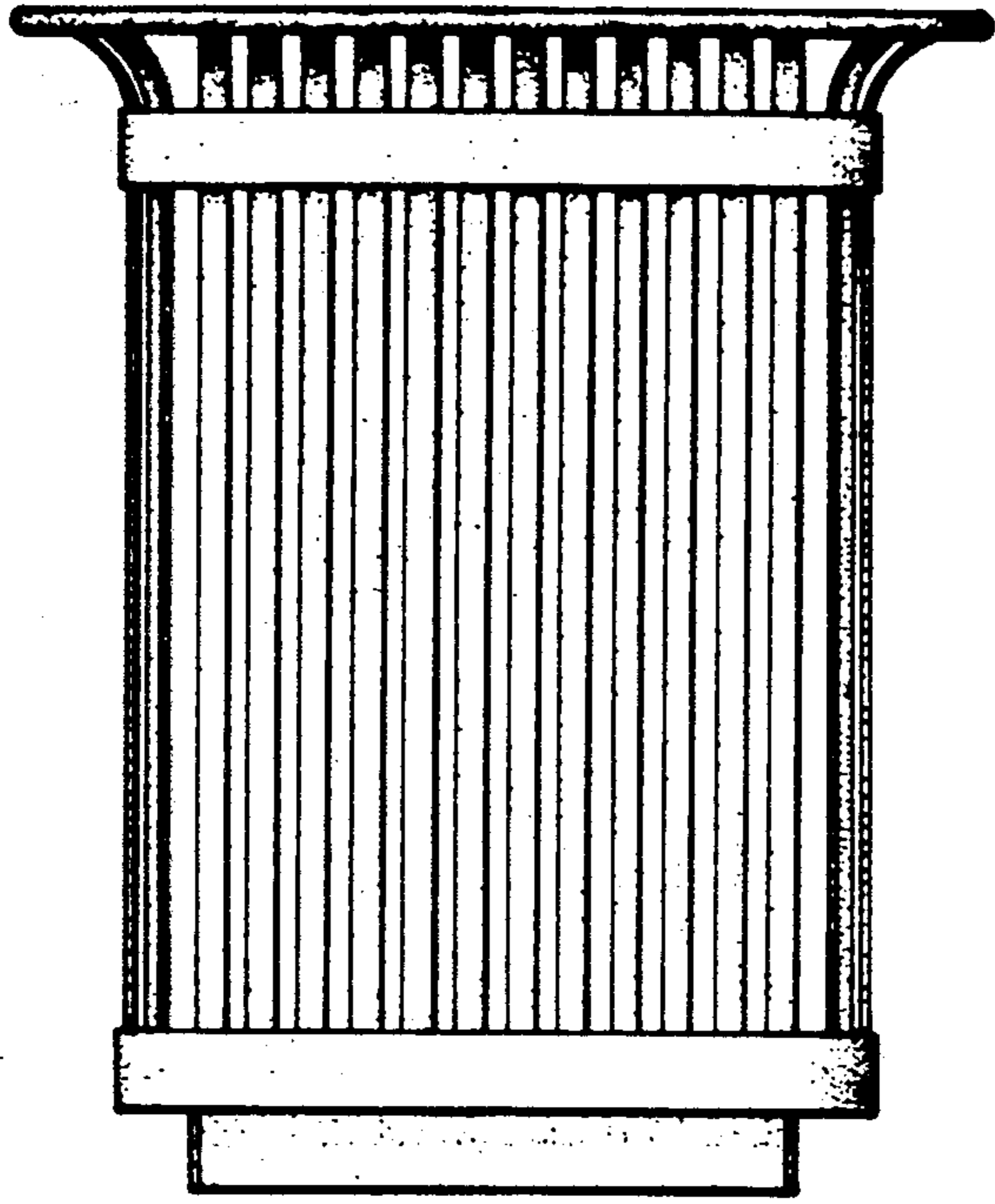

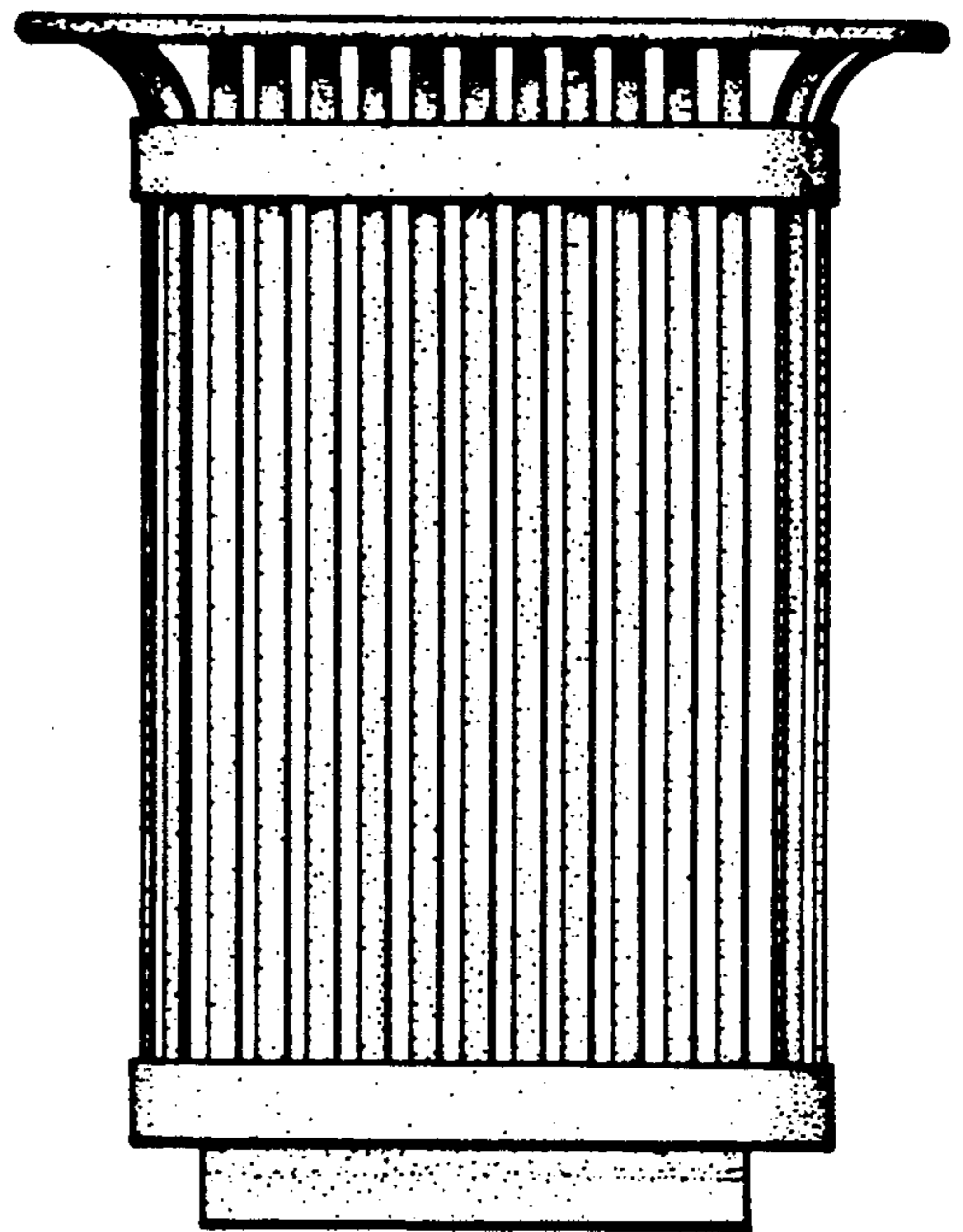

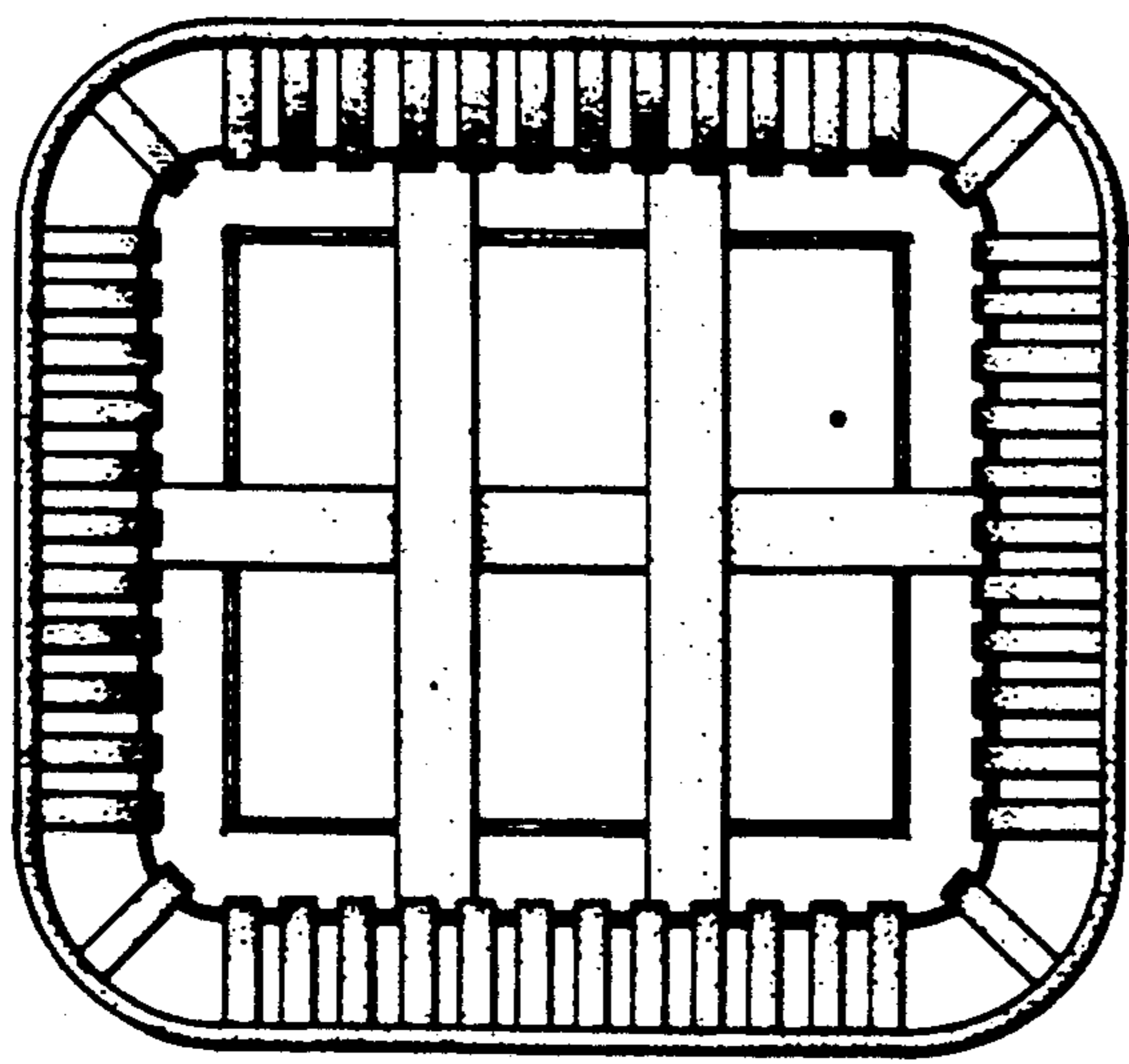

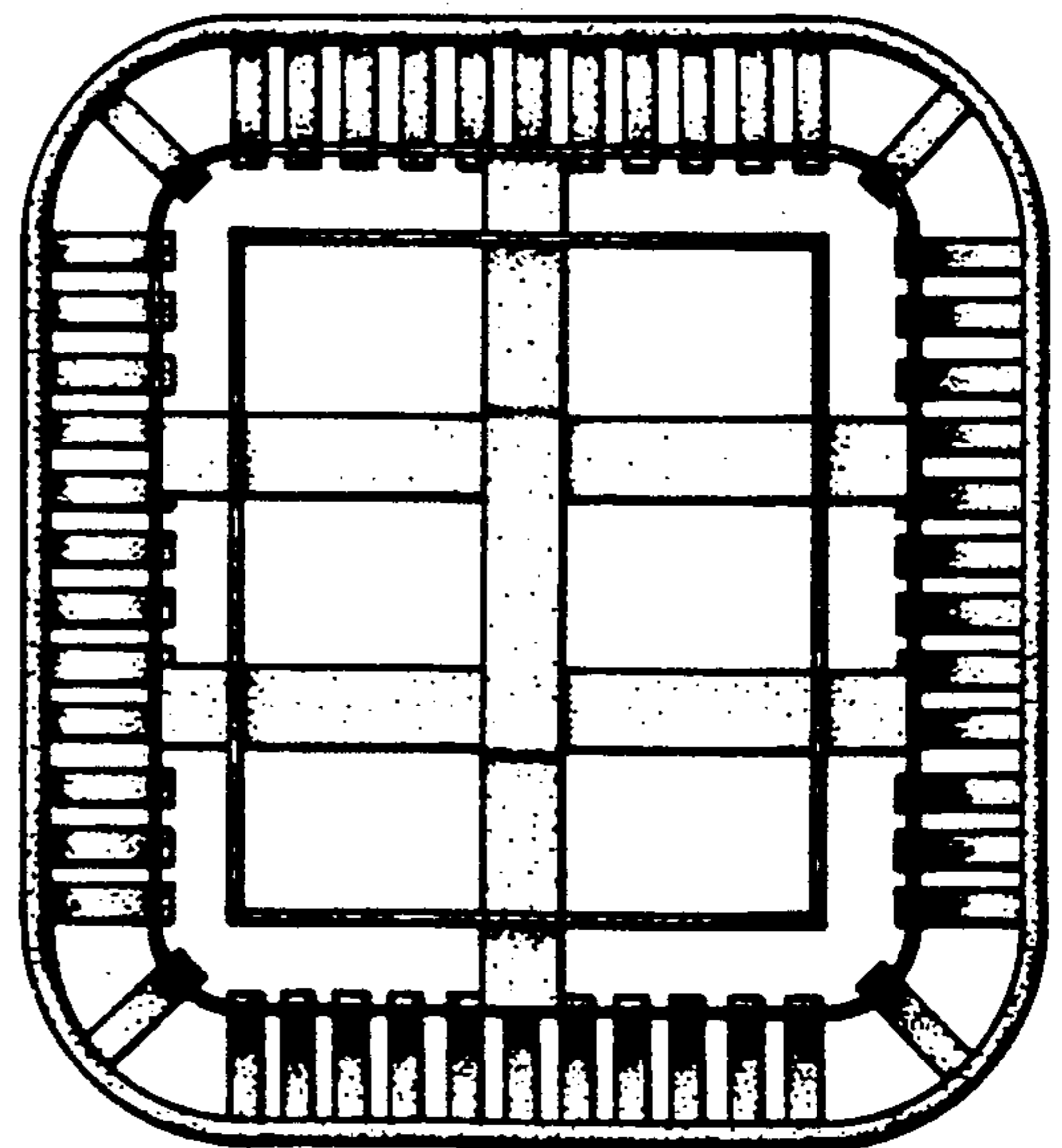
