**DESCRIPTION**

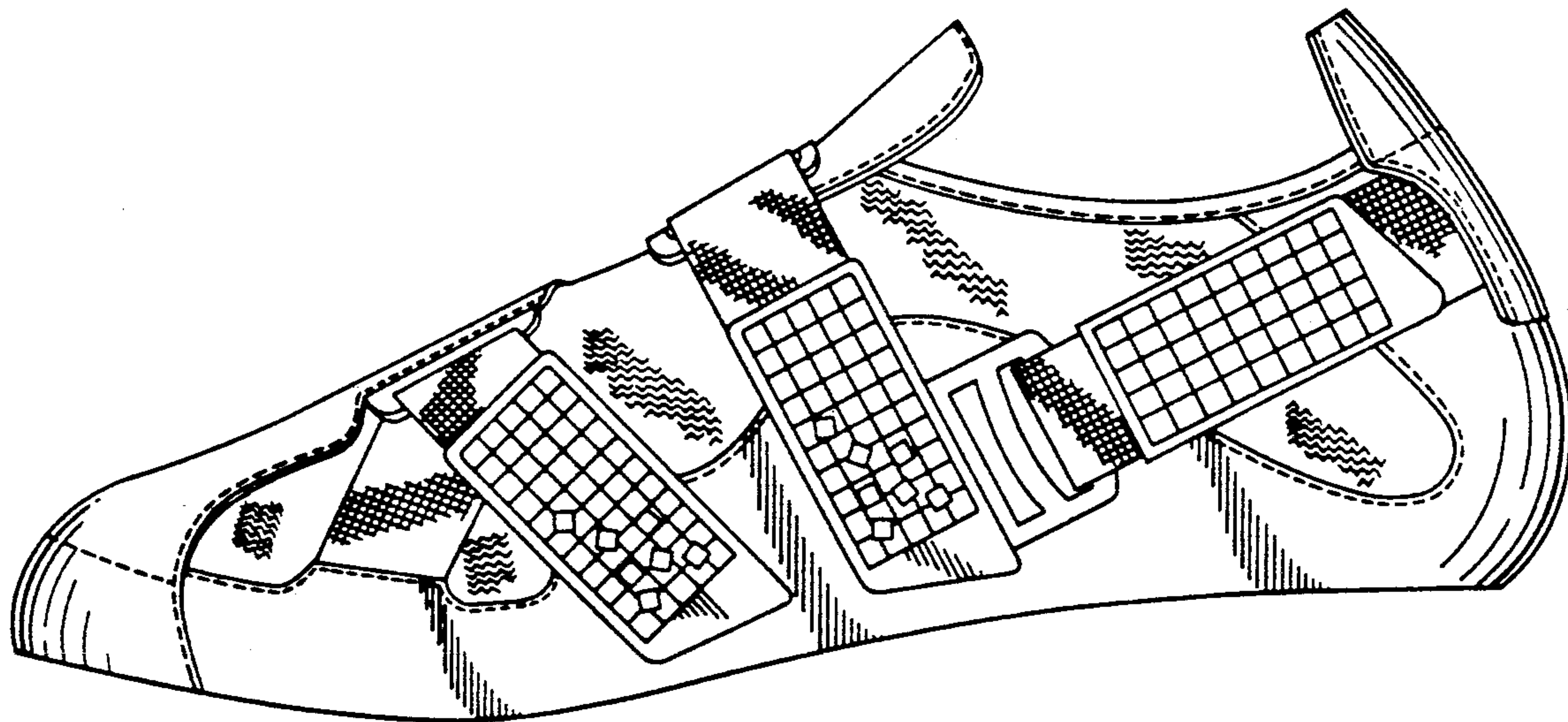
FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of one side of an upper for bicycle shoe showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the other side of the upper for bicycle shoe shown in FIG. 1;

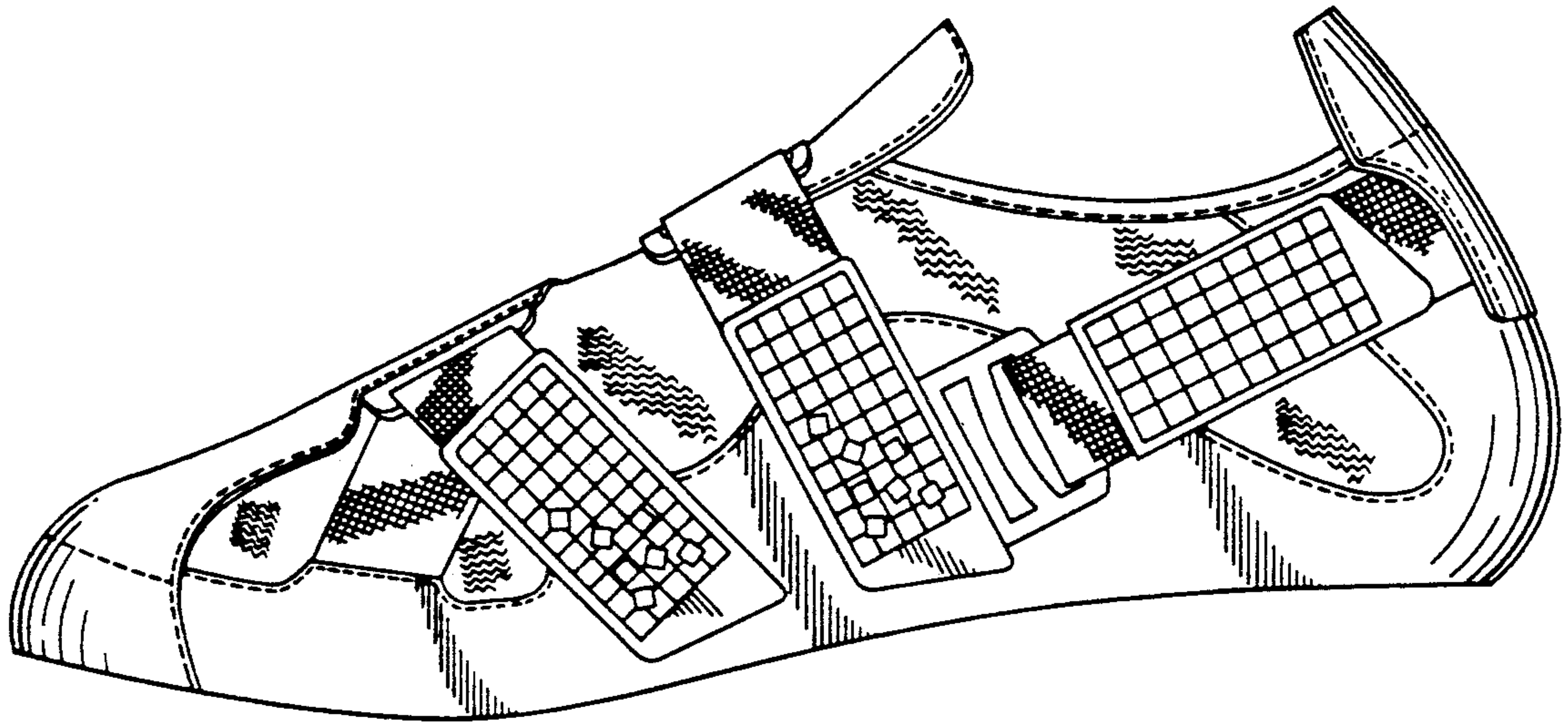
FIG. 3 is a top plan view of the upper for bicycle shoe shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the upper for bicycle shoe shown in FIG. 1; and

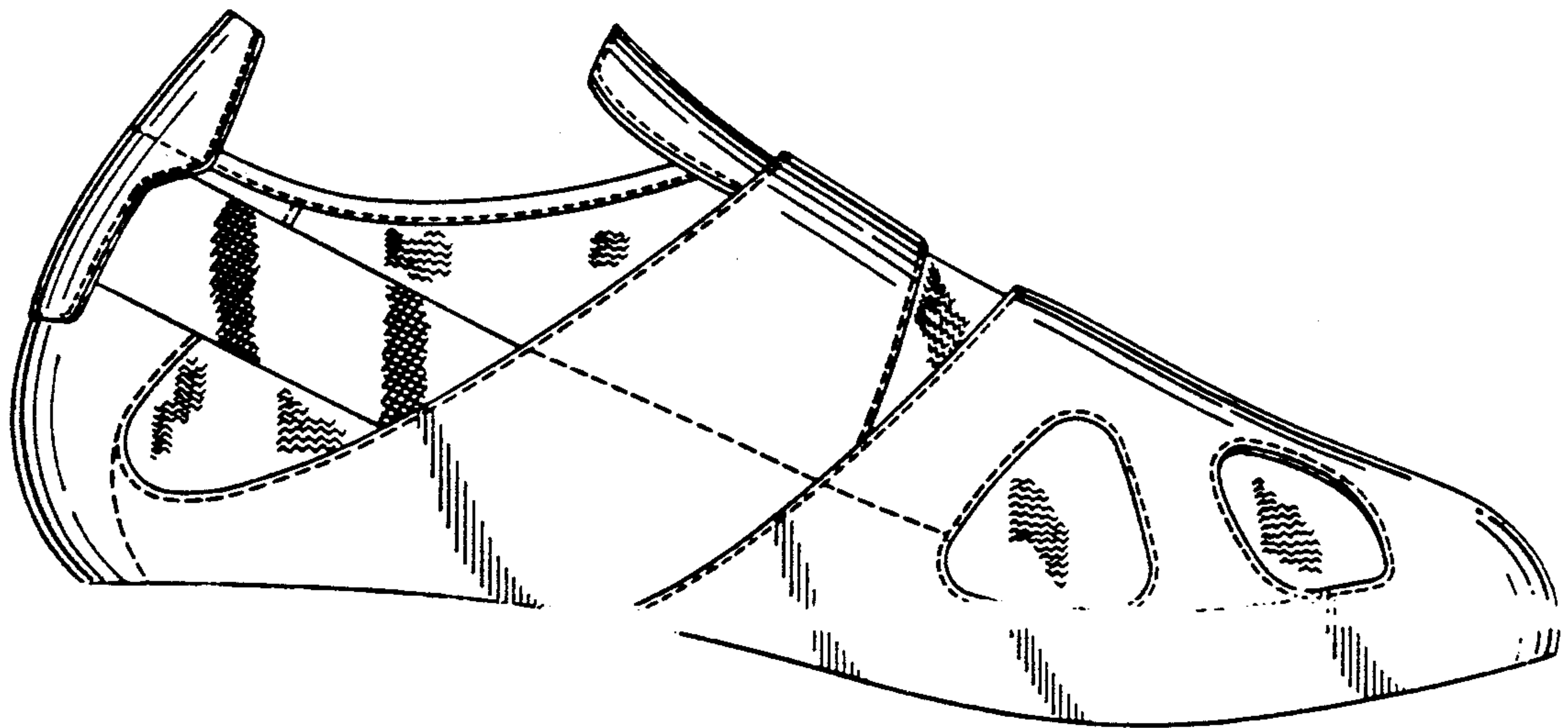
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of the upper for bicycle shoe shown in FIG. 1.



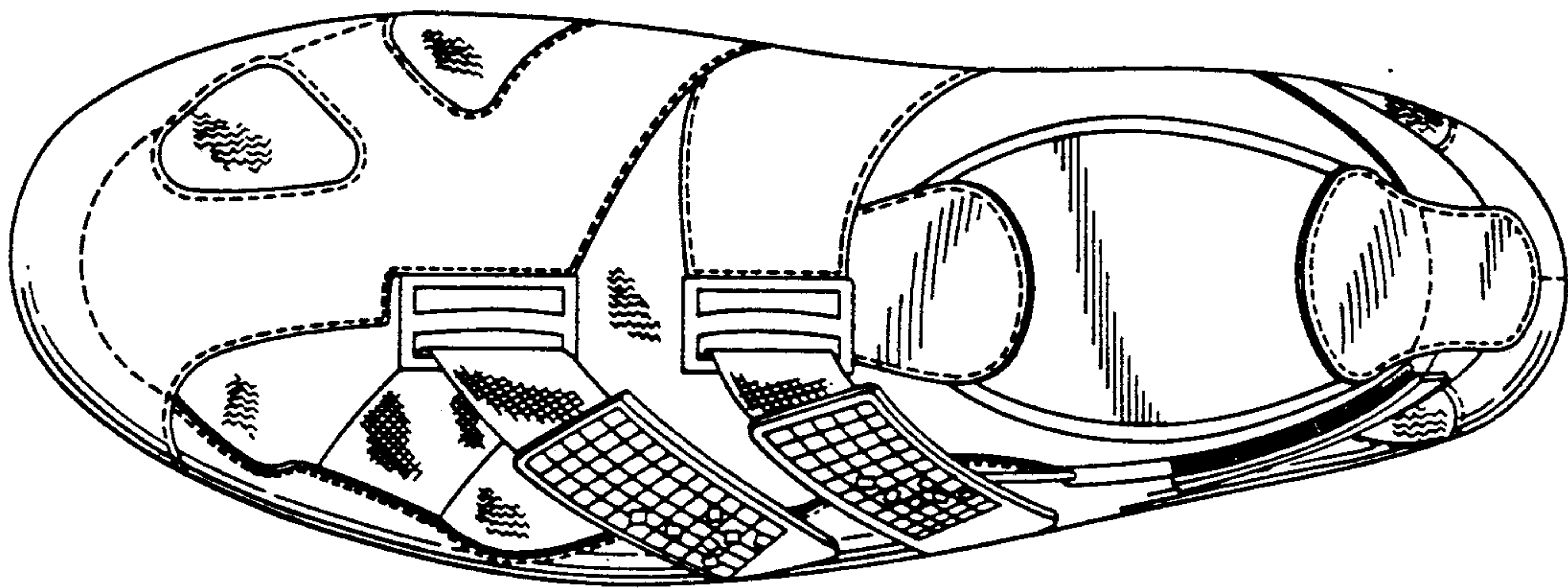

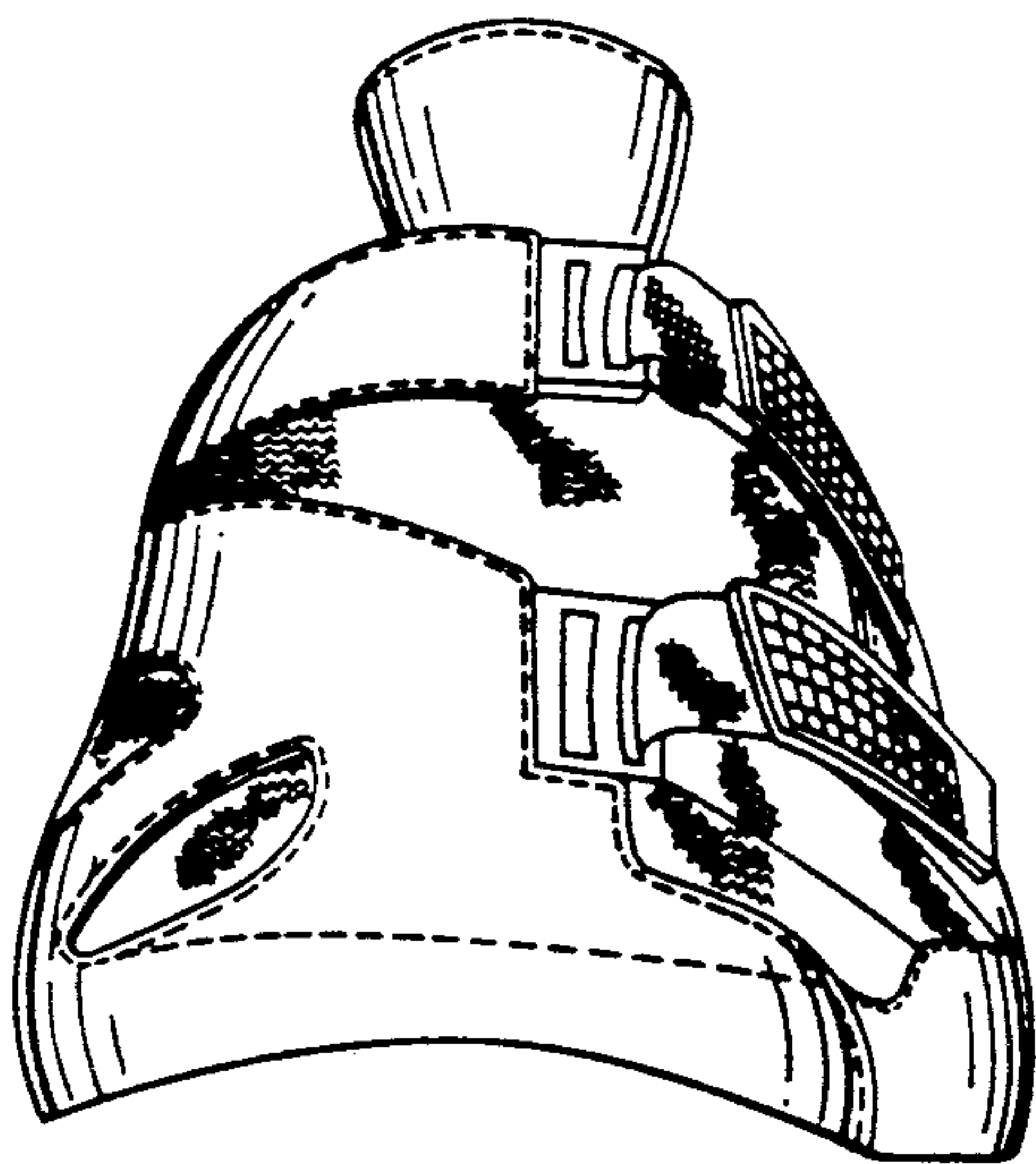
