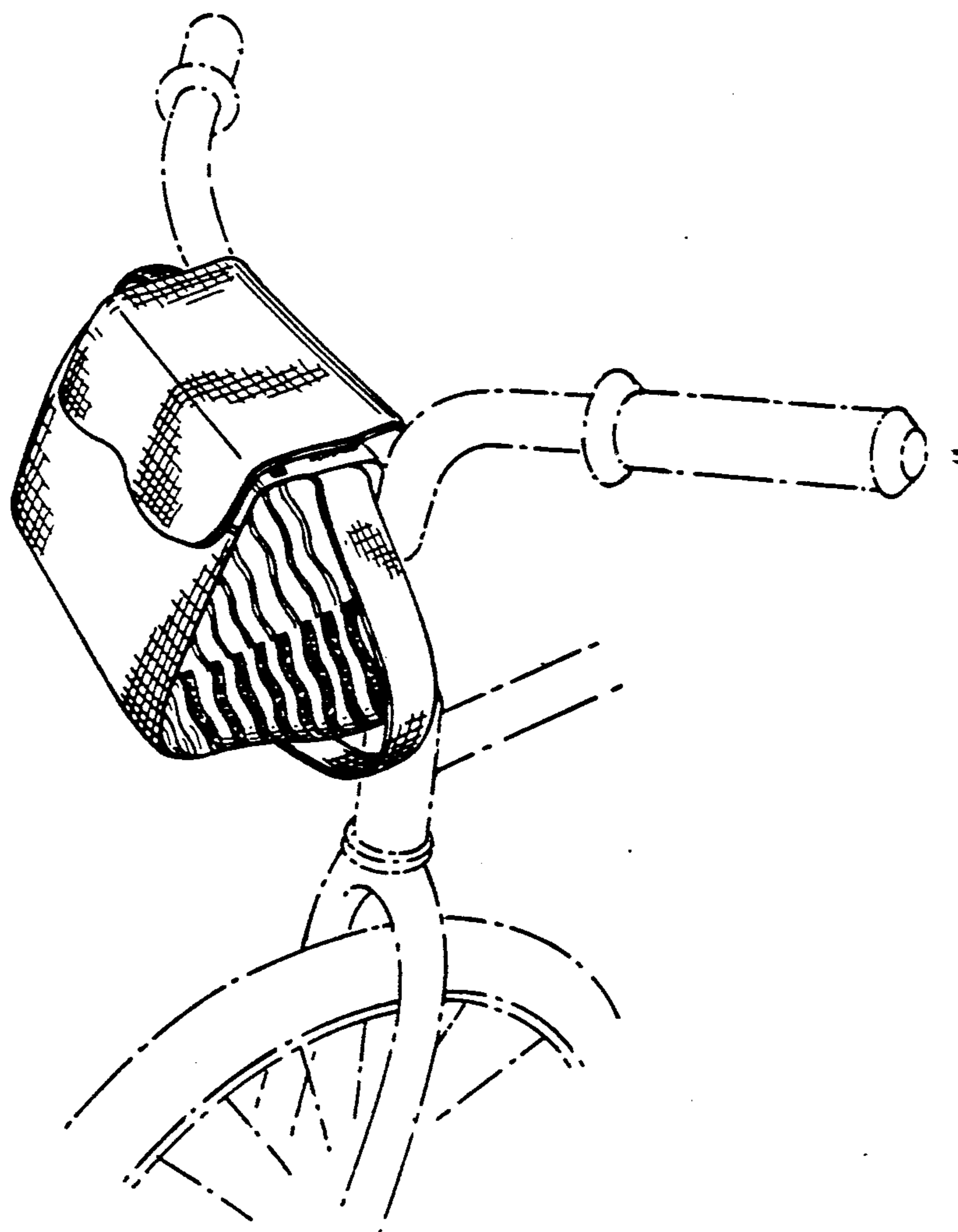

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a handlebar-mountable handbag, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a handlebar-mountable handbag showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof with the strap broken away;
FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof with the strap broken away;
FIG. 4 is a right-side elevational view thereof with the strap broken away;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a perspective view thereof mounted on bicycle handlebars, the broken lines showing of part of a bicycle is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



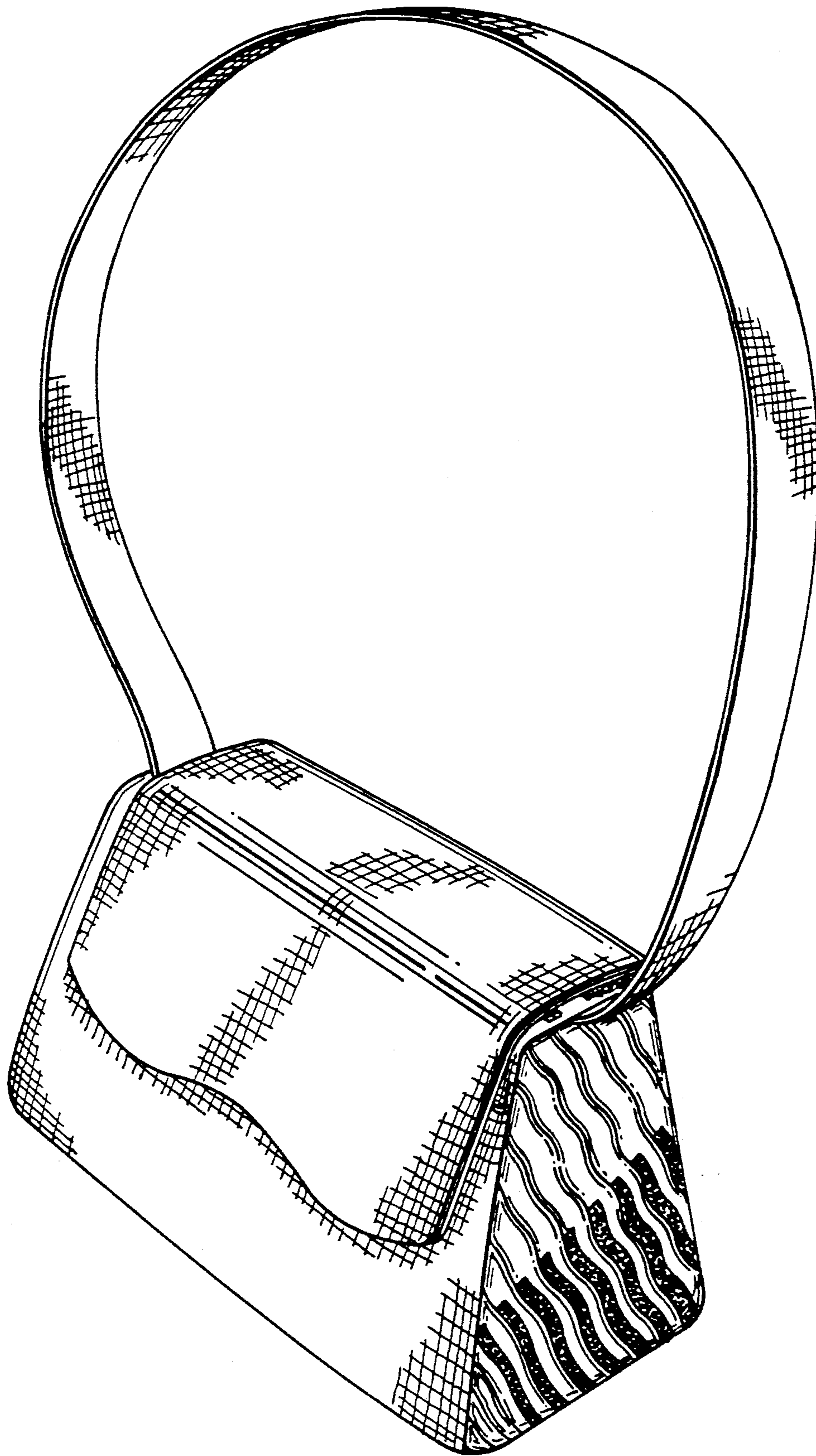

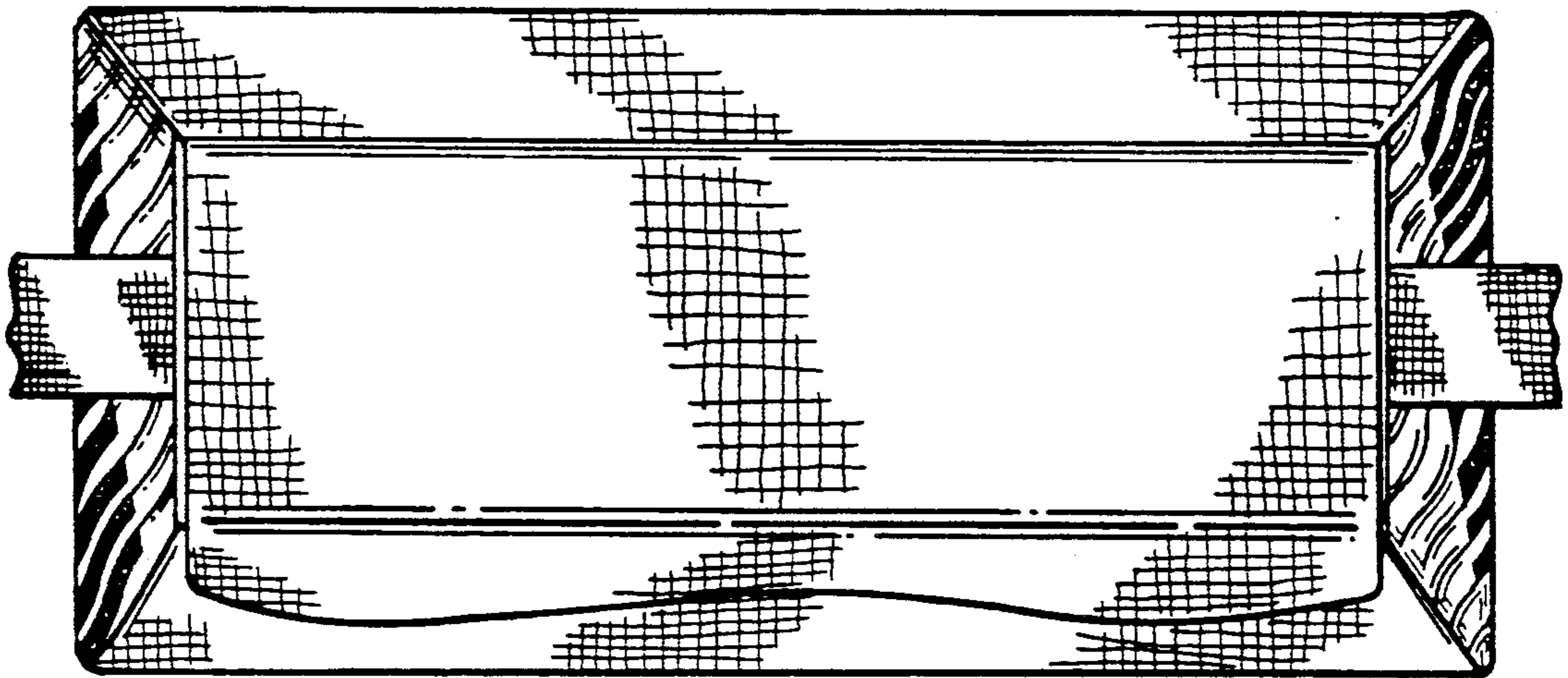

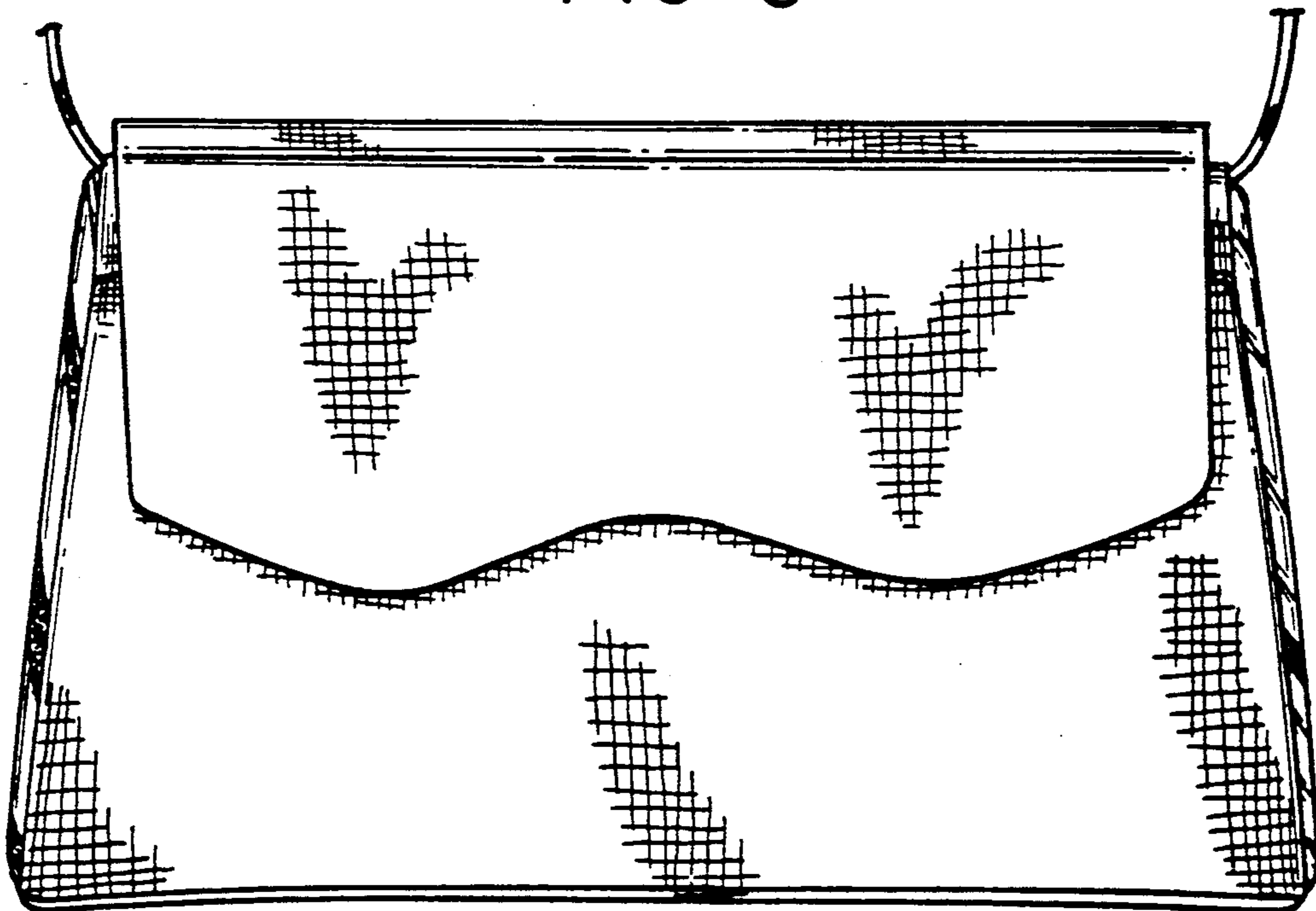

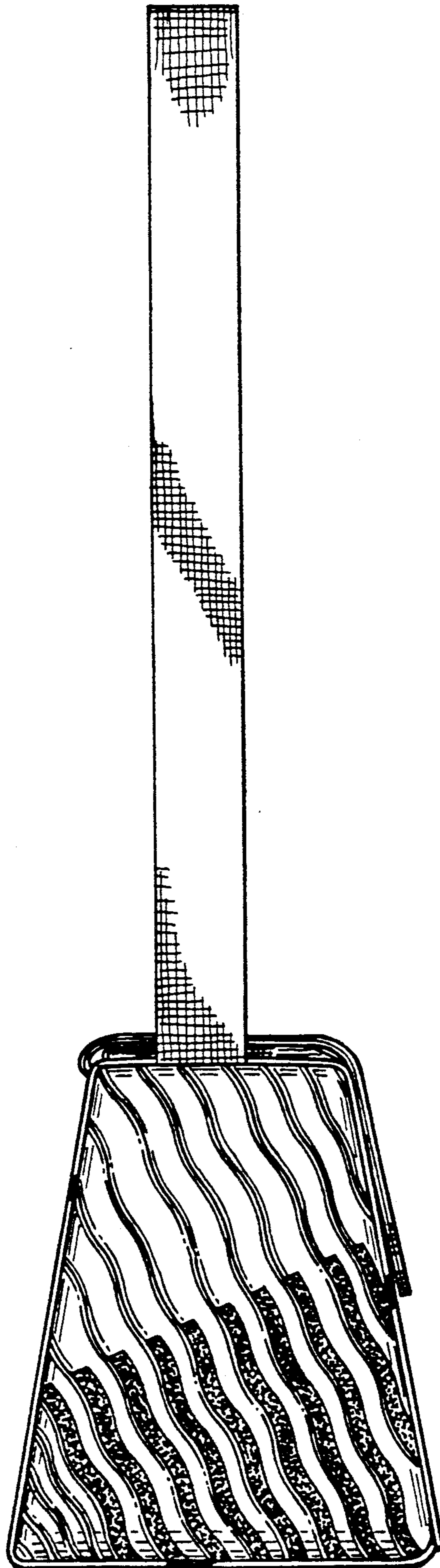

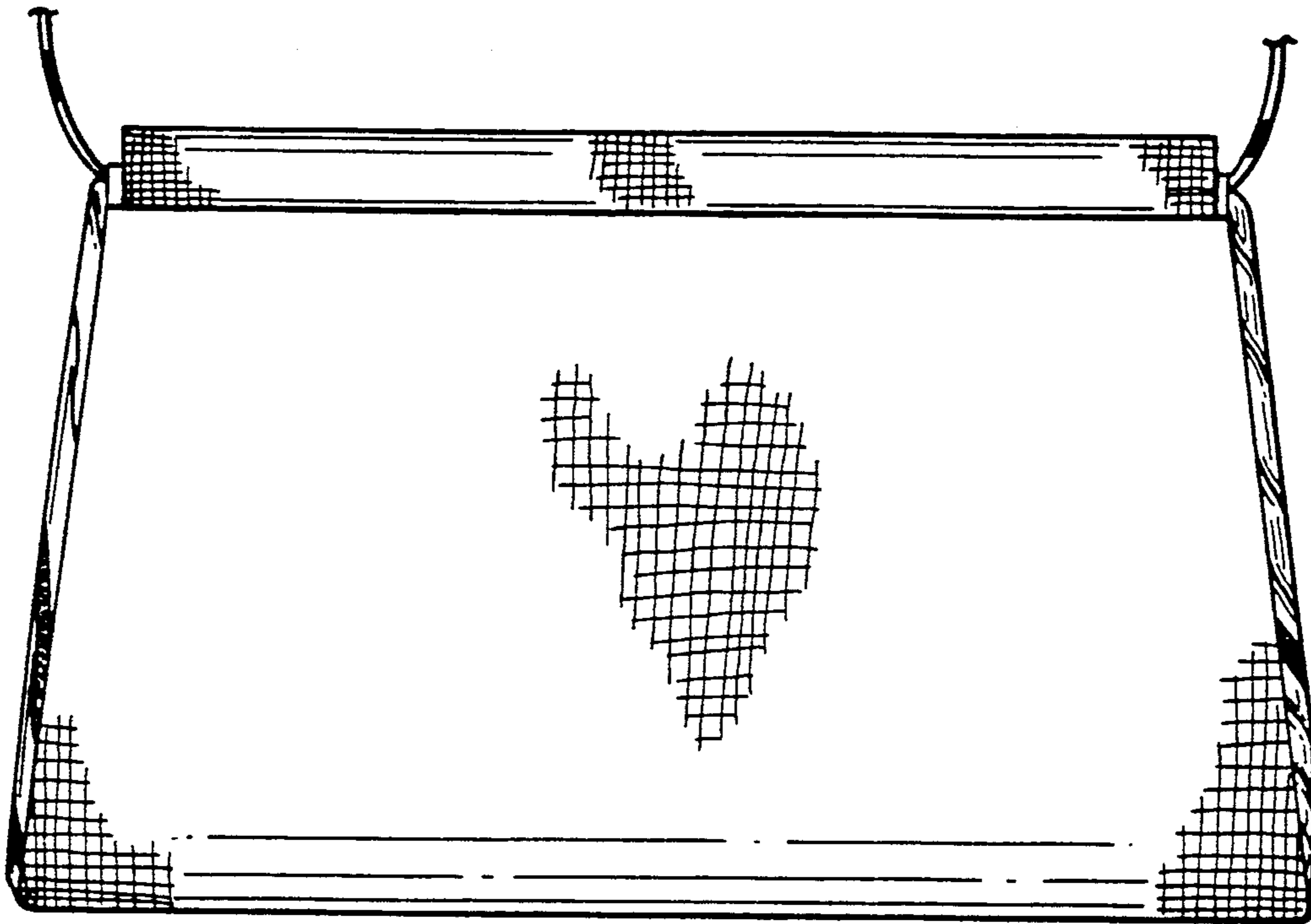

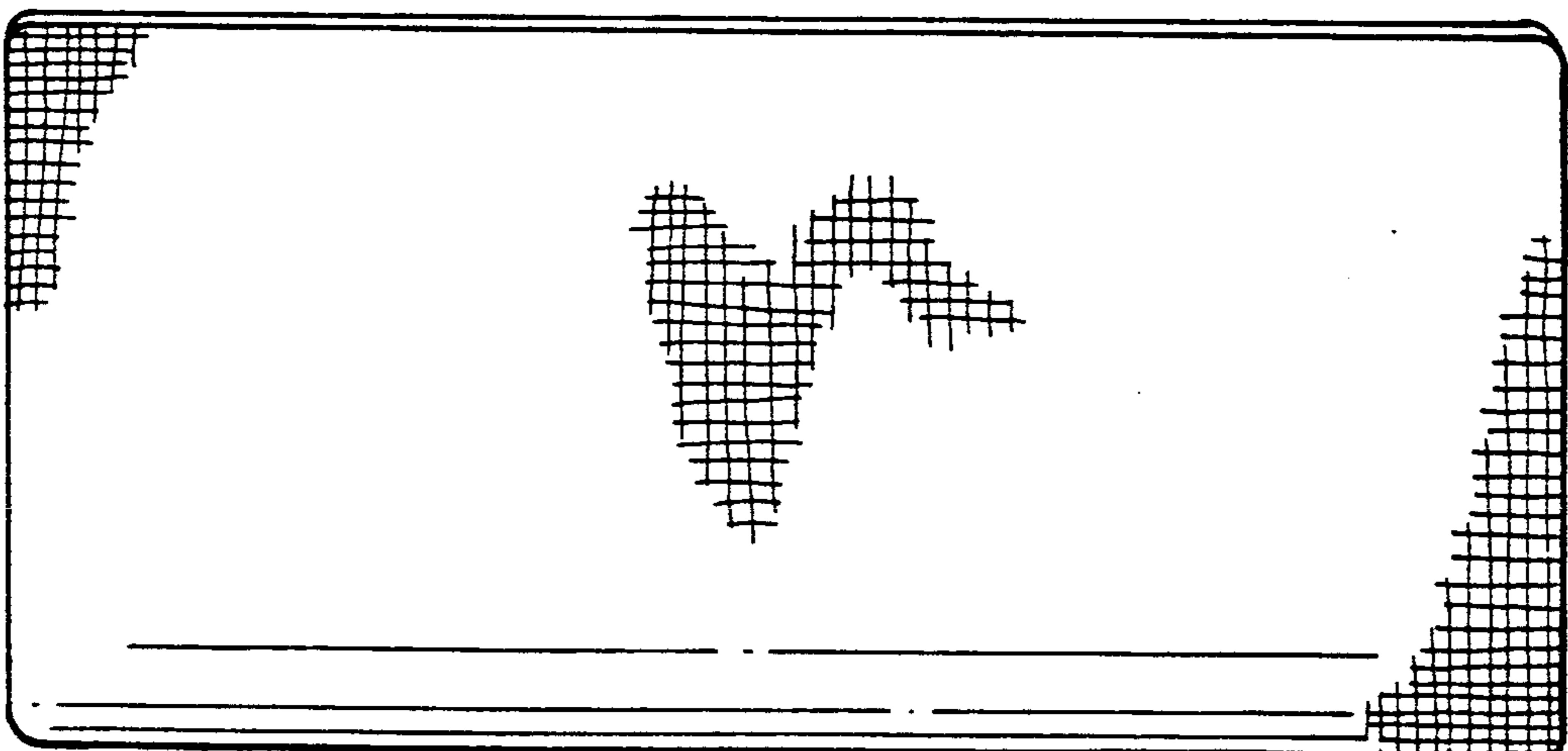
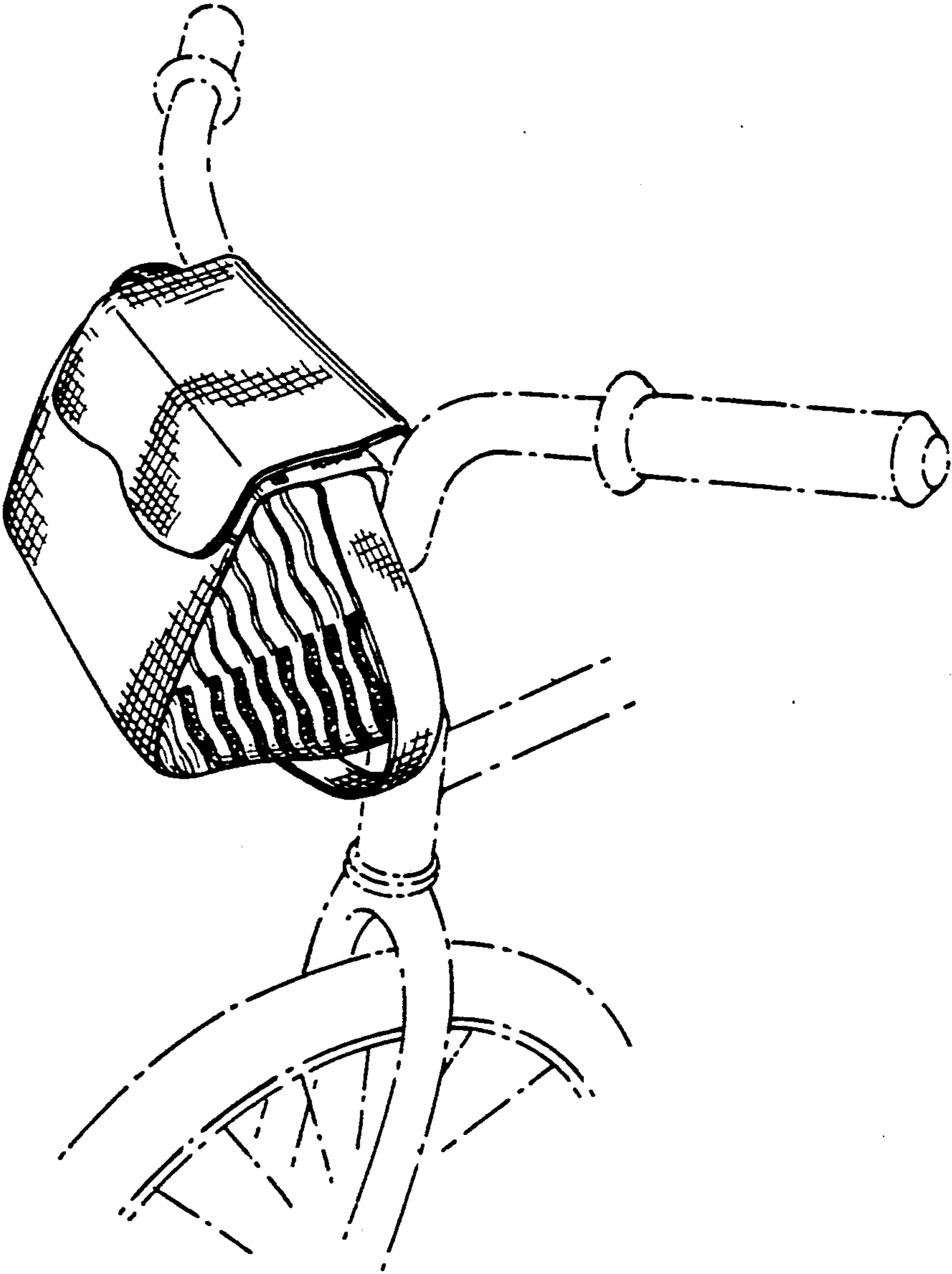
