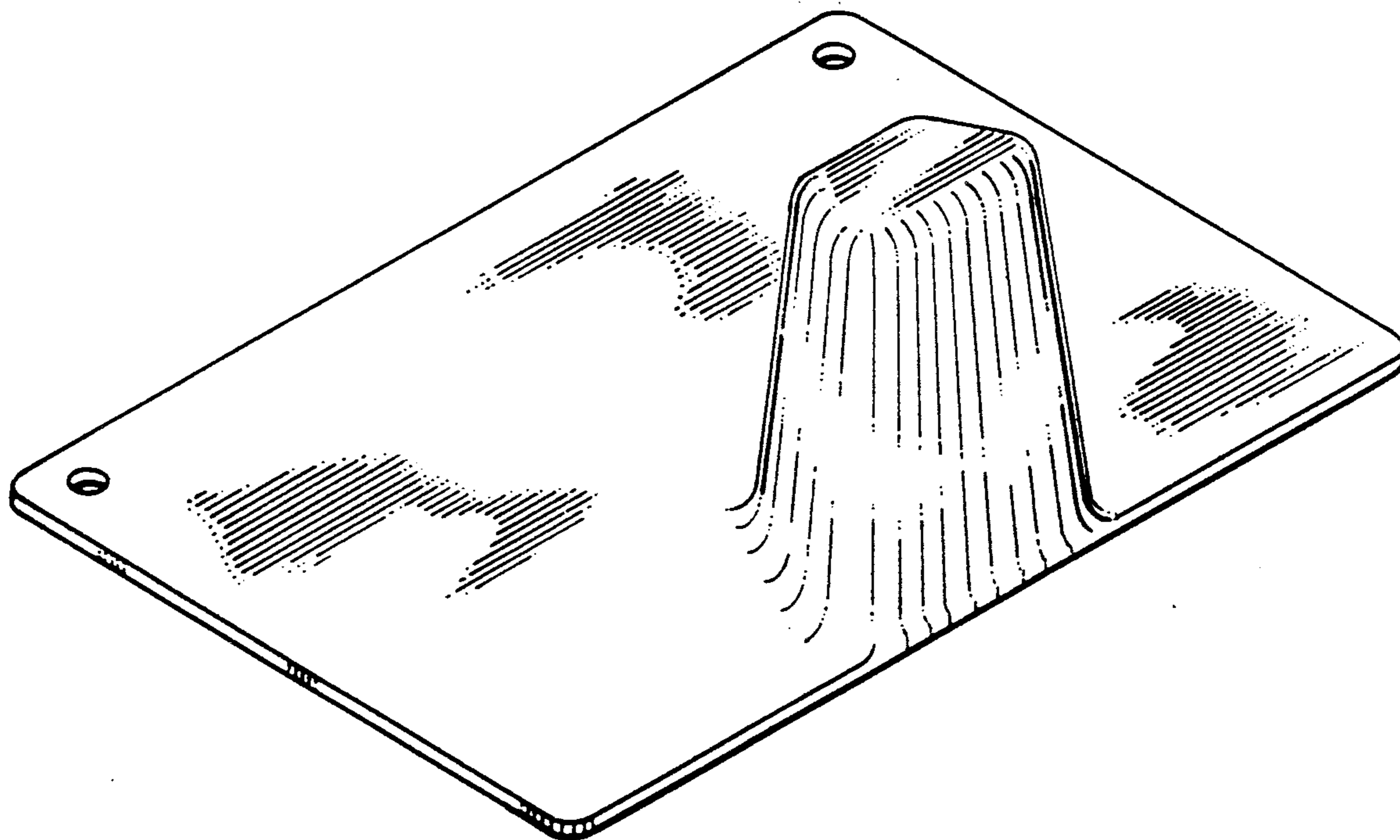

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a chair insert for restraining a child, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front and top perspective view of a chair insert for restraining a child showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view; FIG. 3 is a front elevational view; FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view the opposite side being a mirror image; and FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



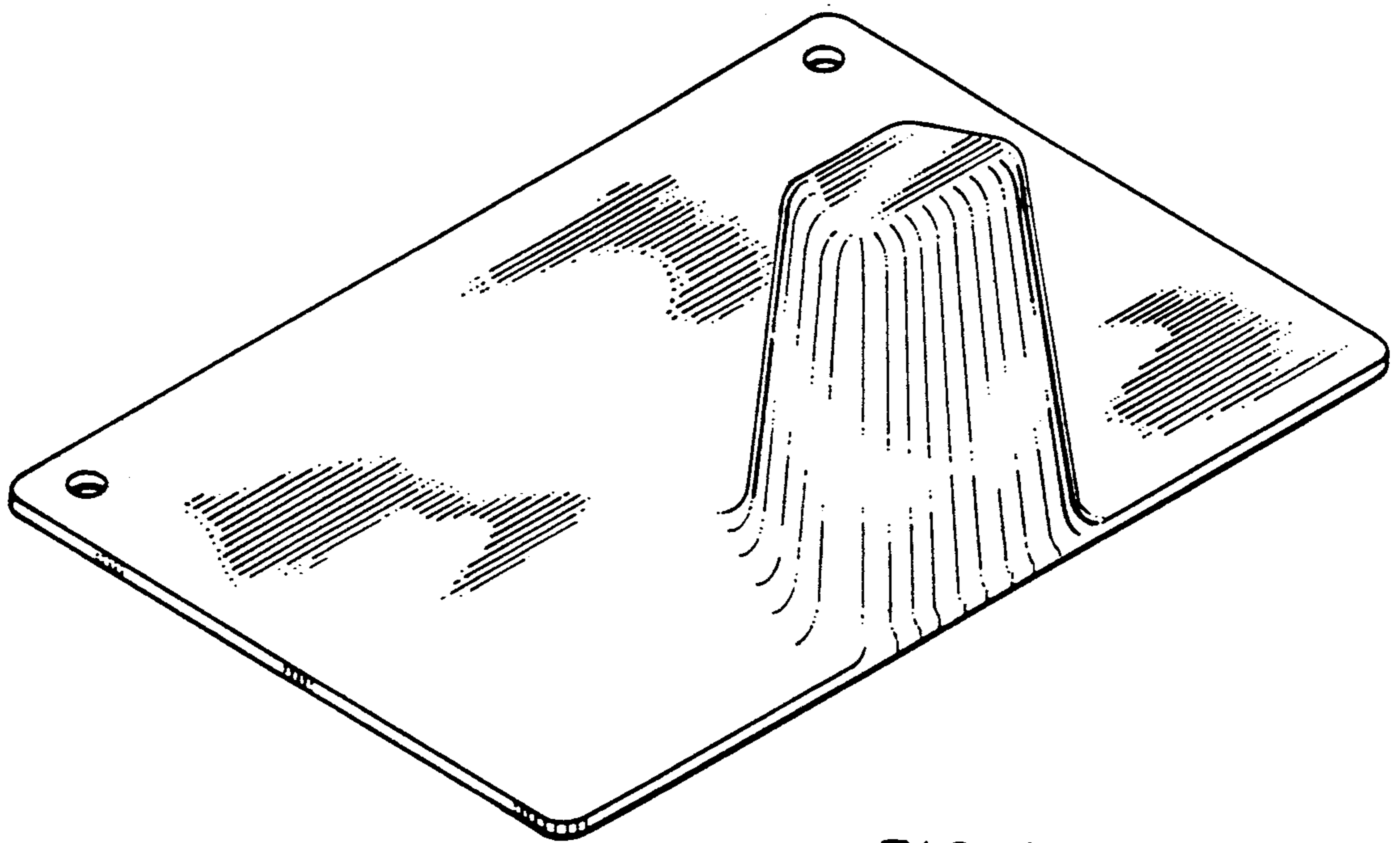

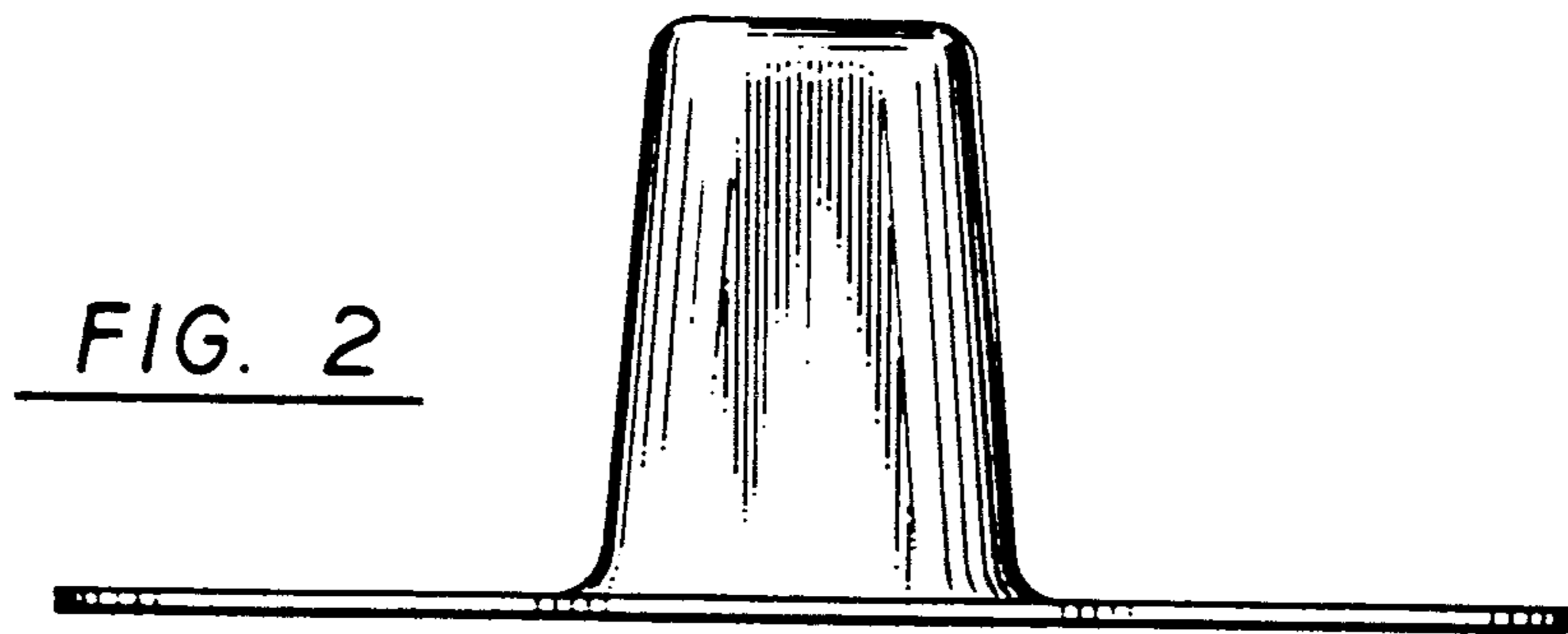

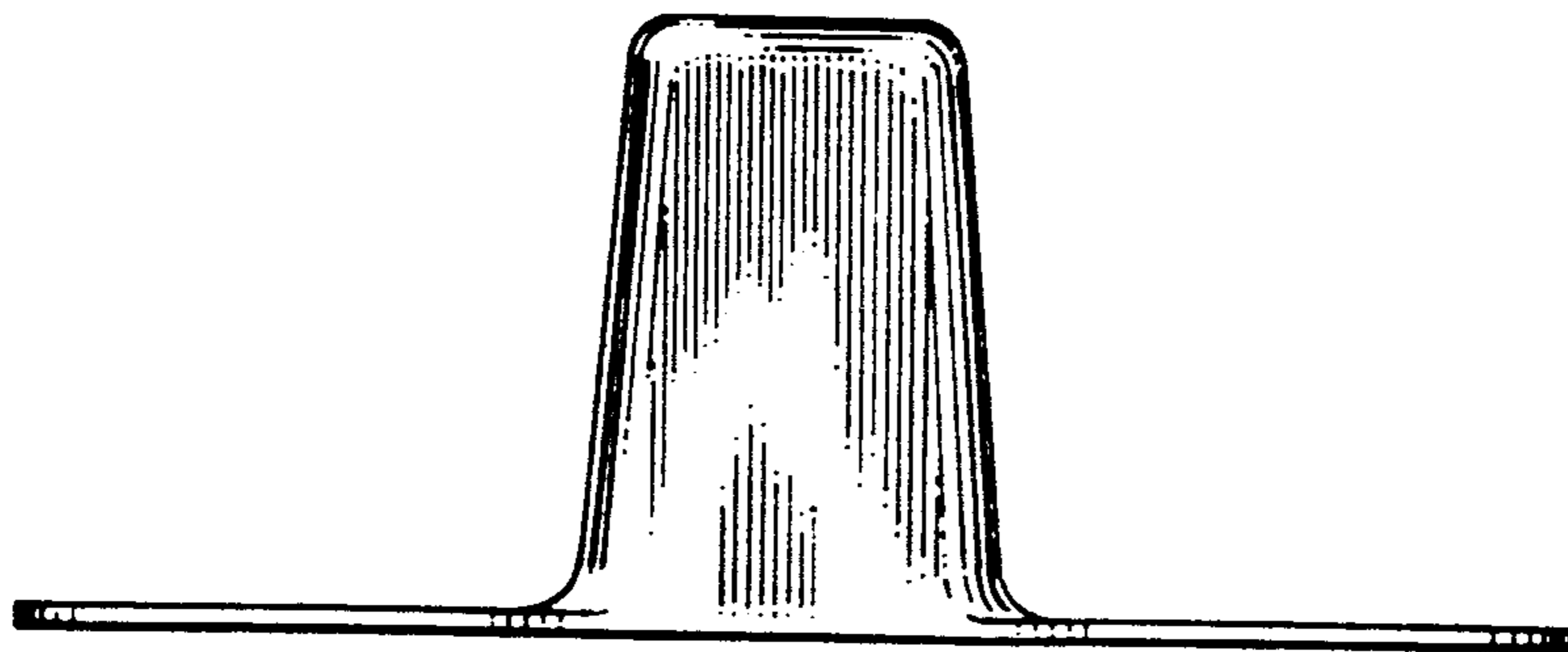

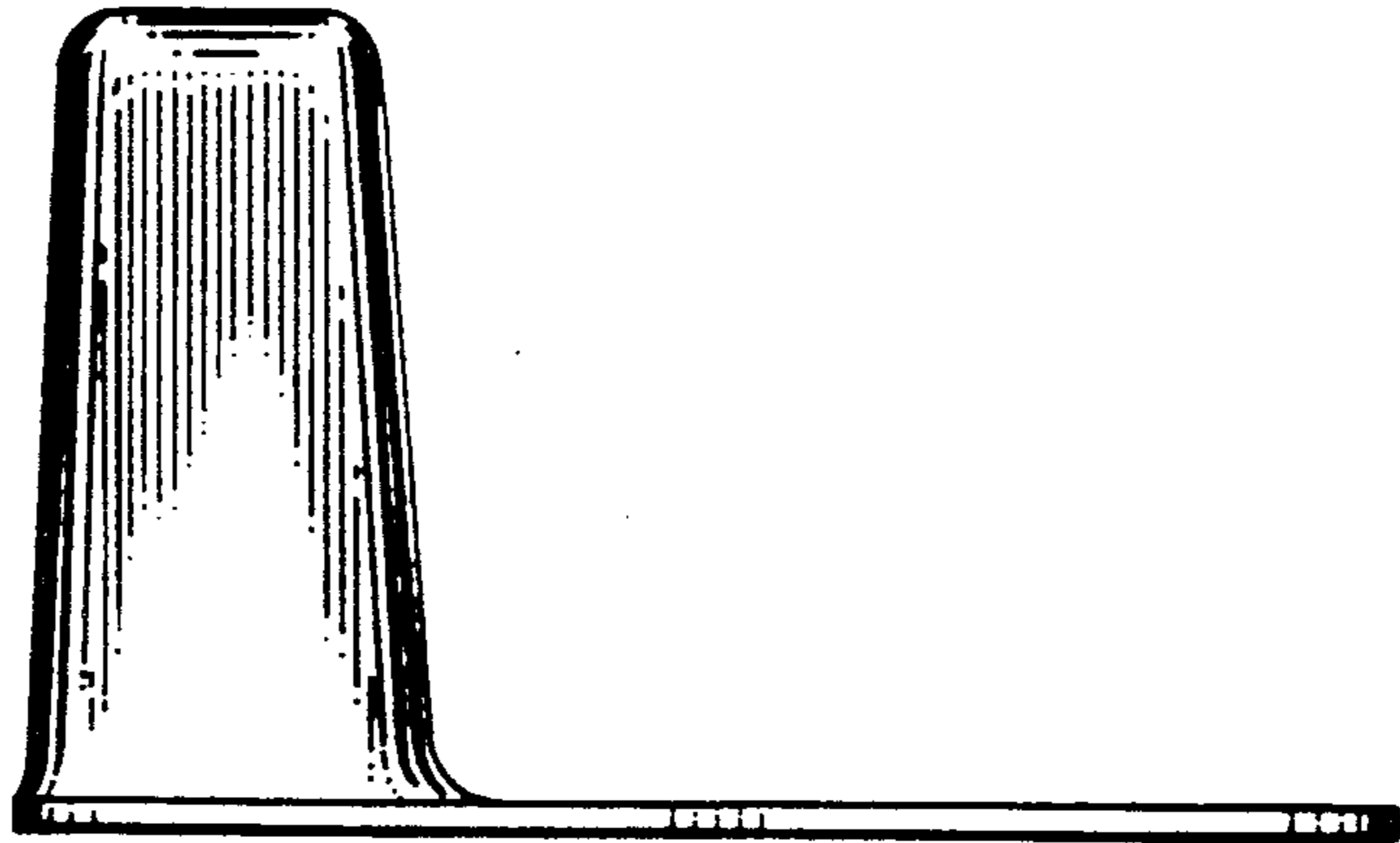

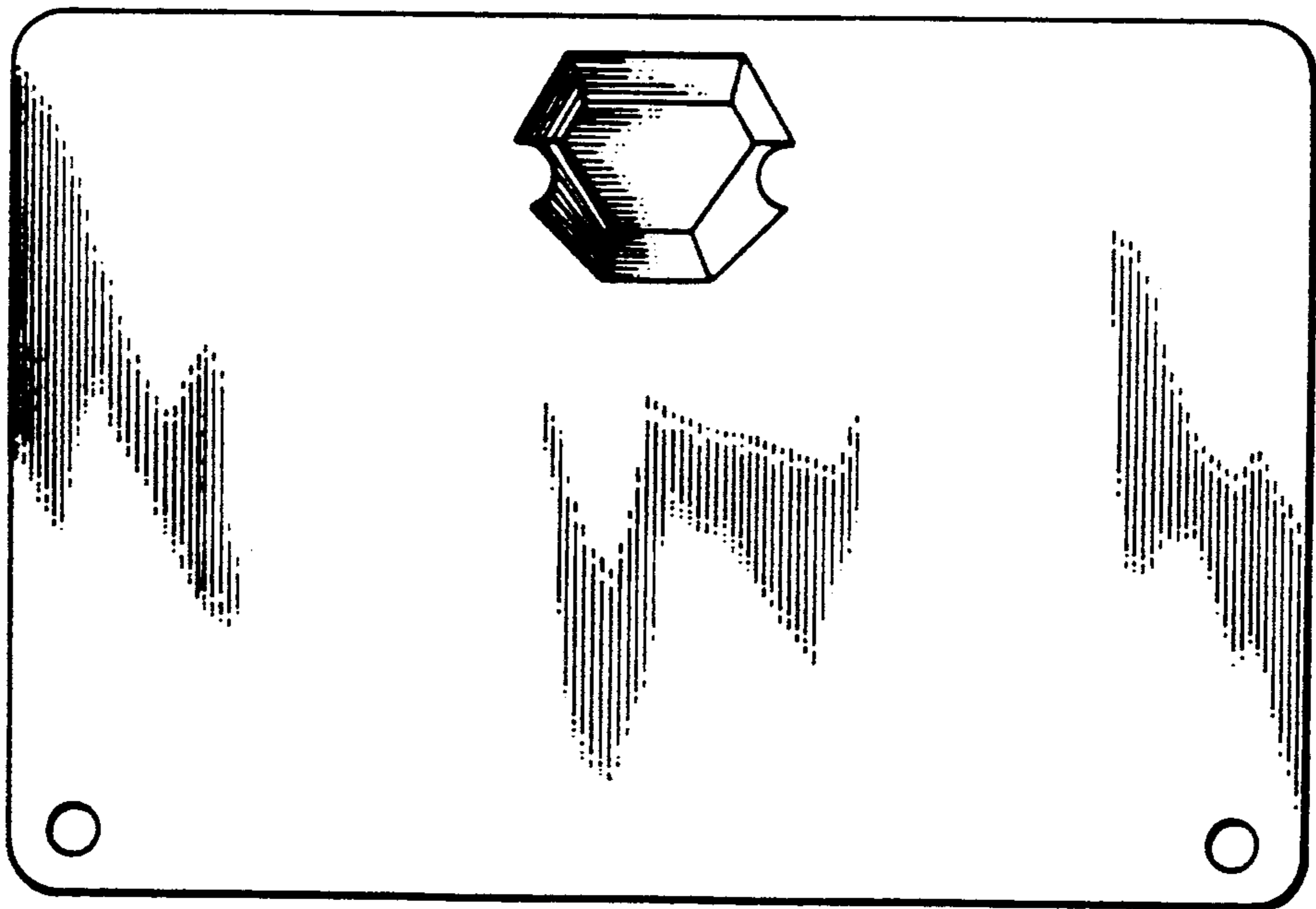
