The broken line disclosure of a head band in FIGS. 1-6 has been shown for illustrative purposes only.

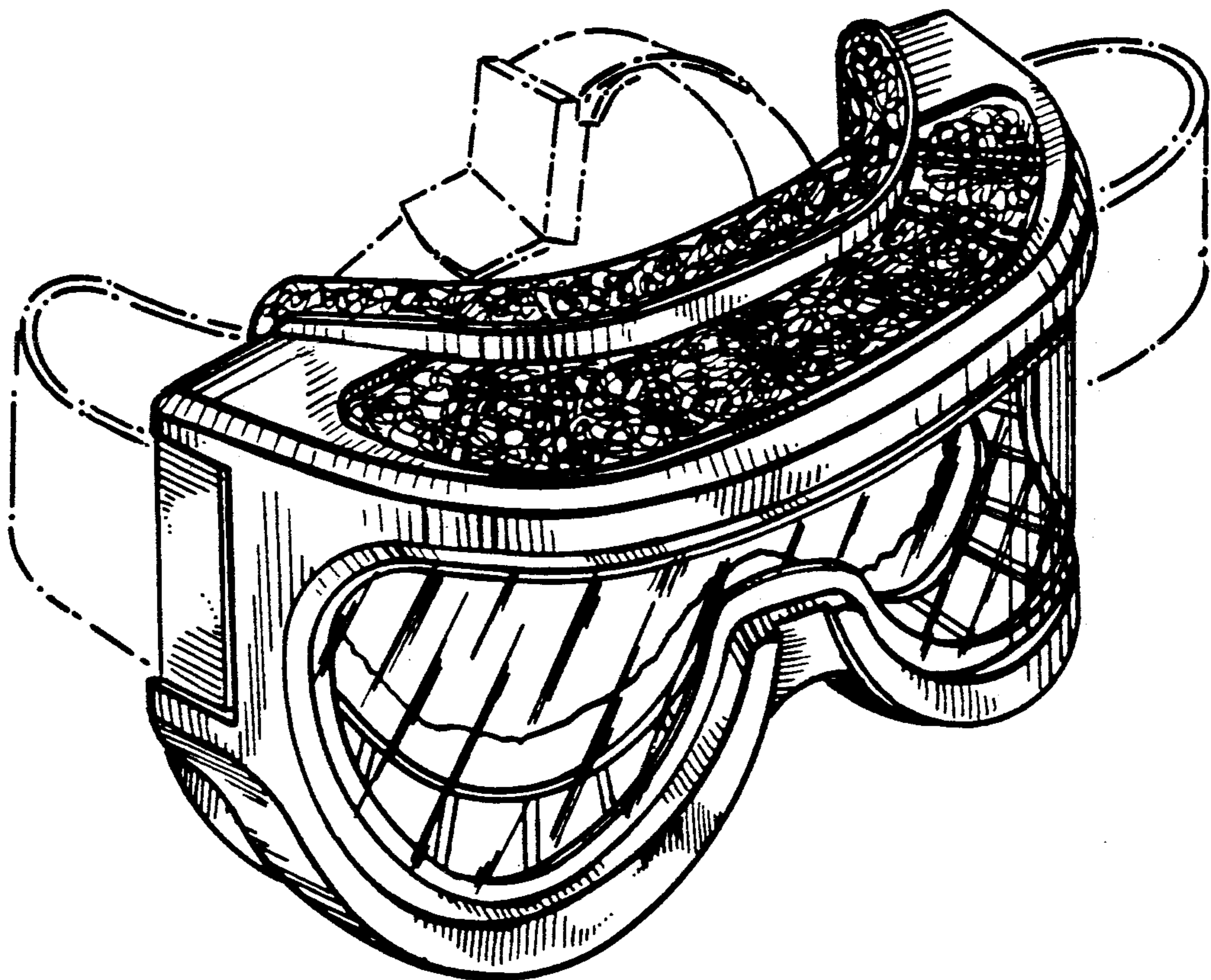

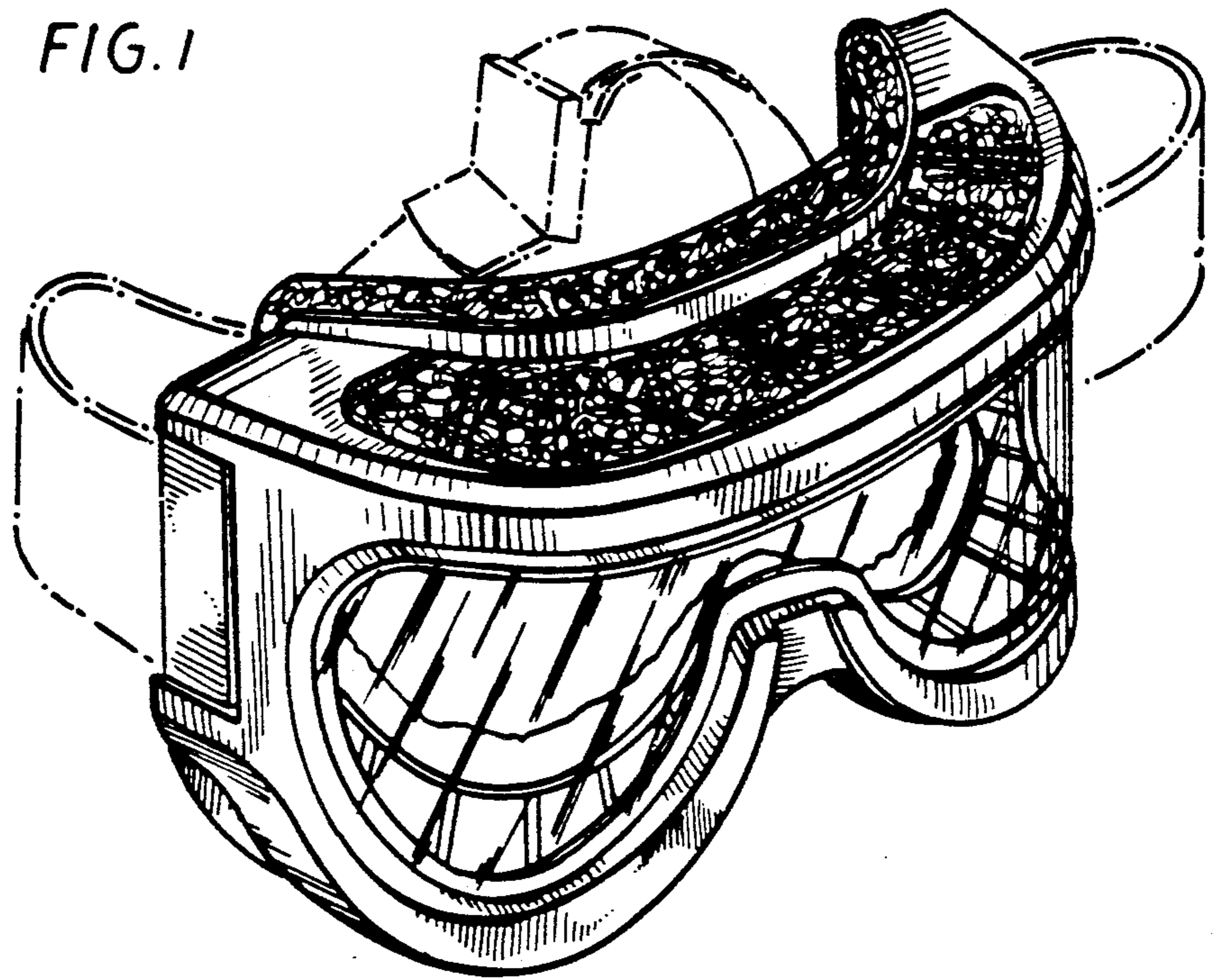

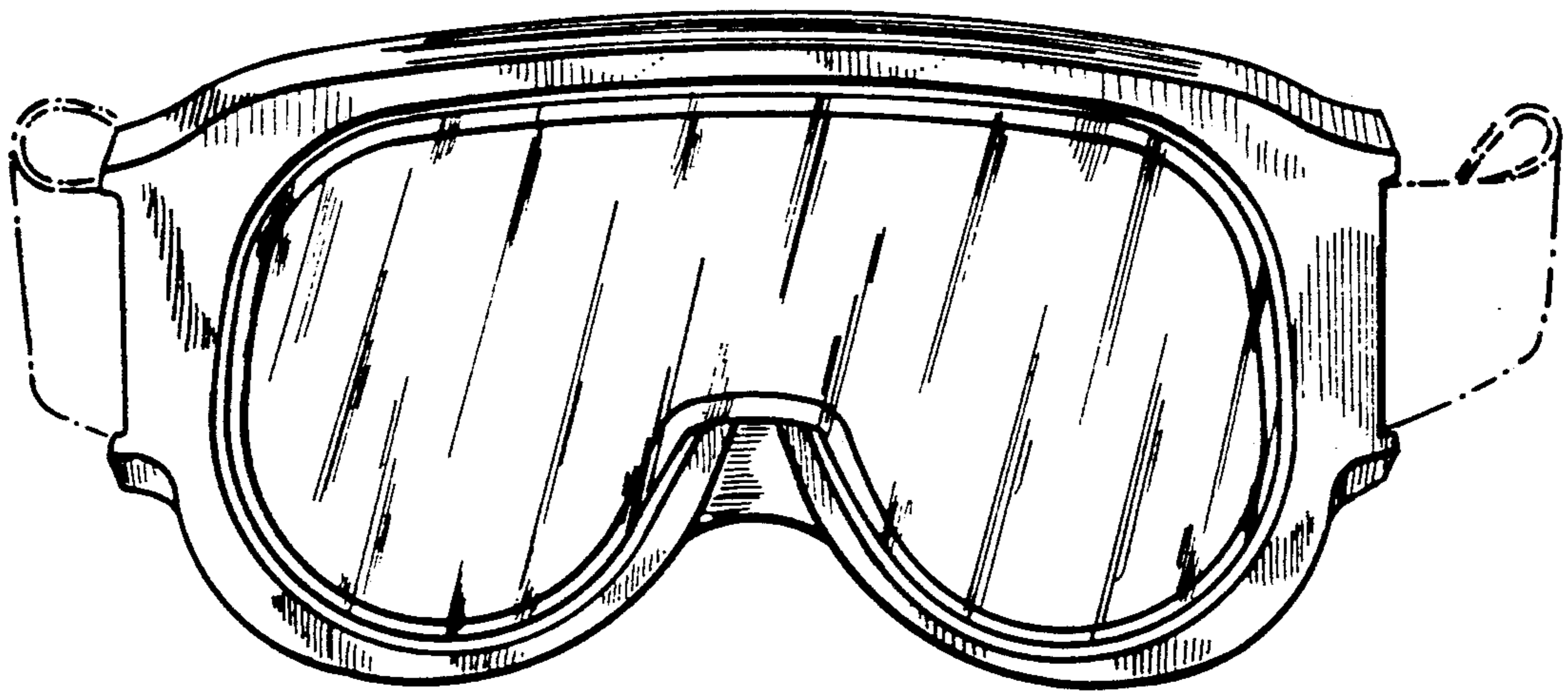

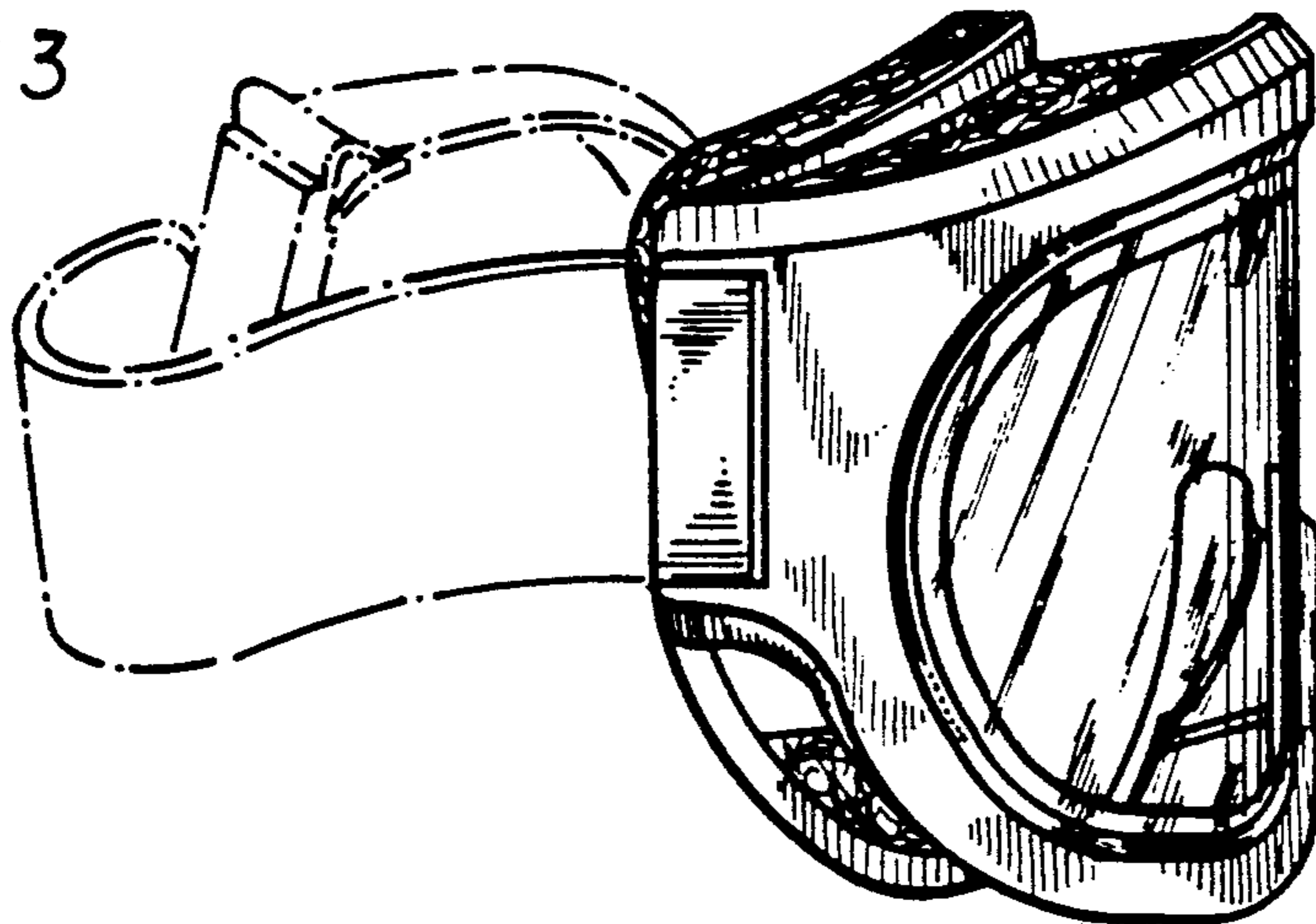

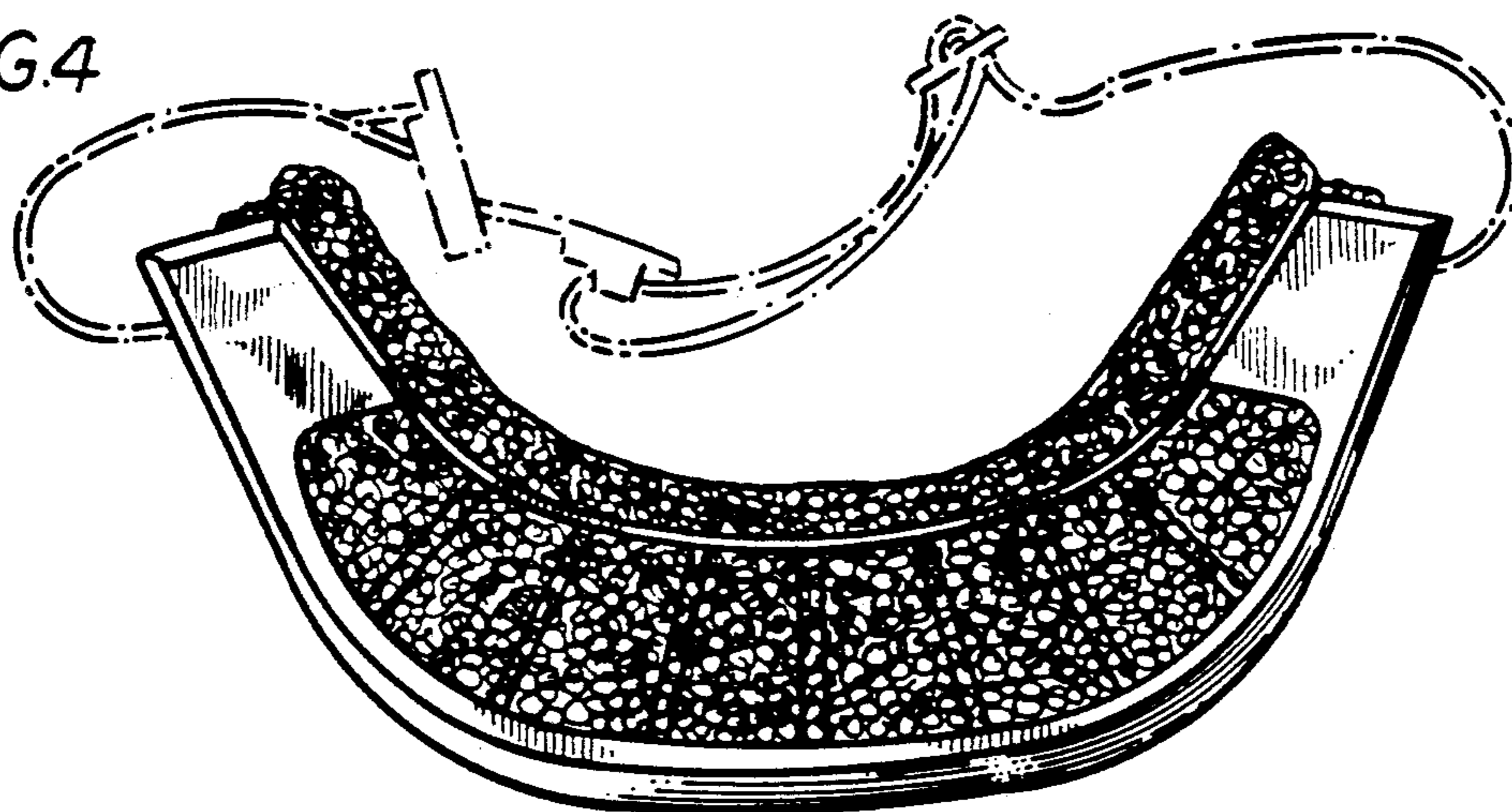

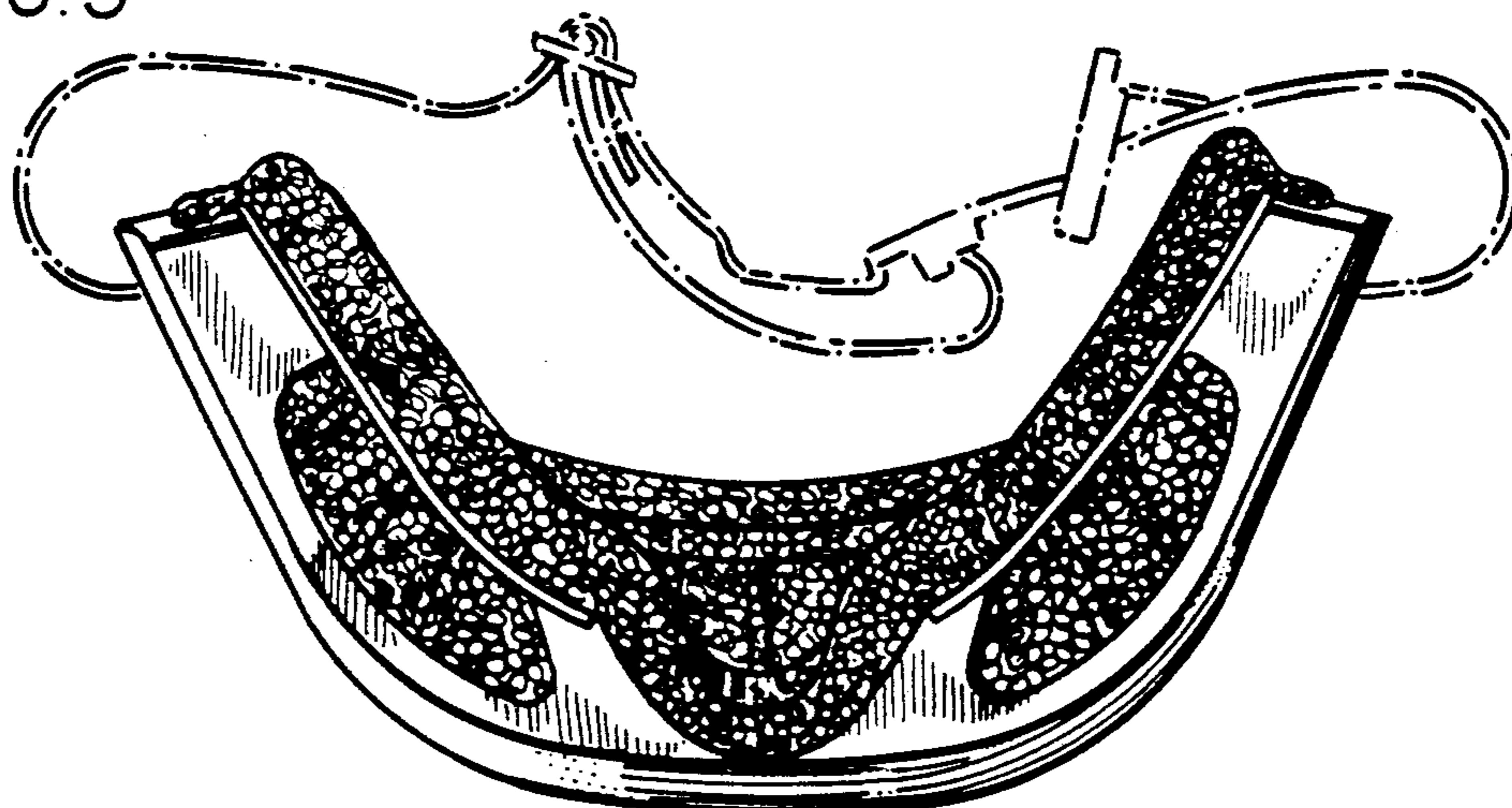
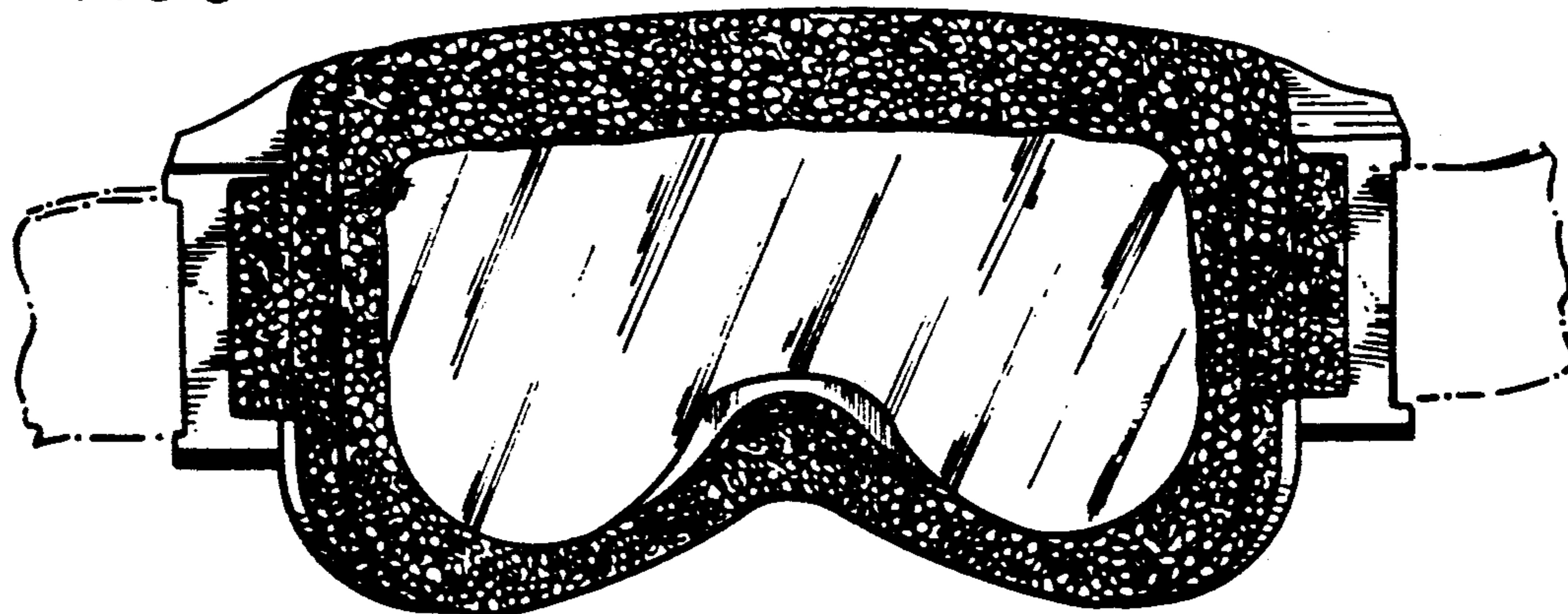
