DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a child's typewriter showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a right, front and top perspective view thereof.



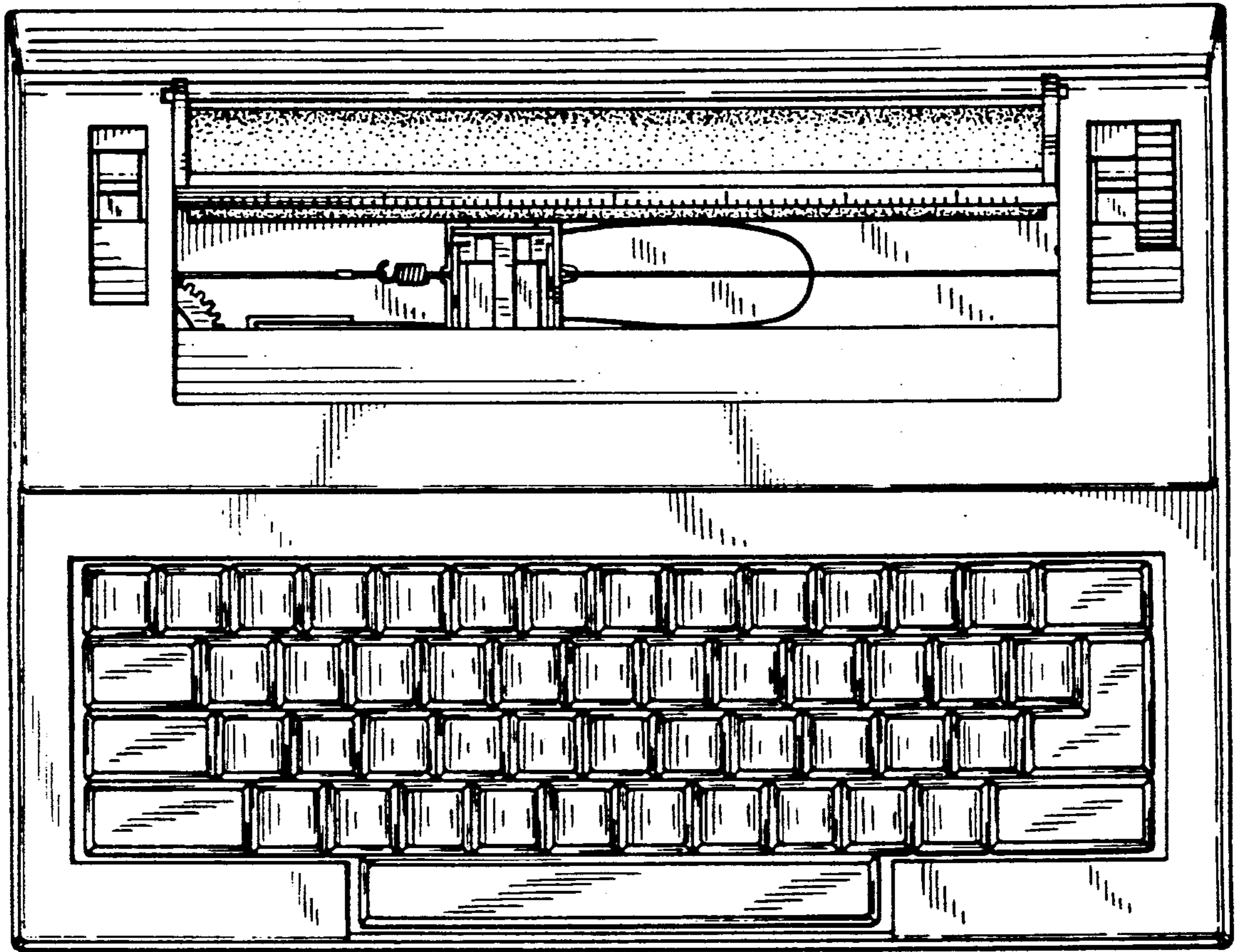

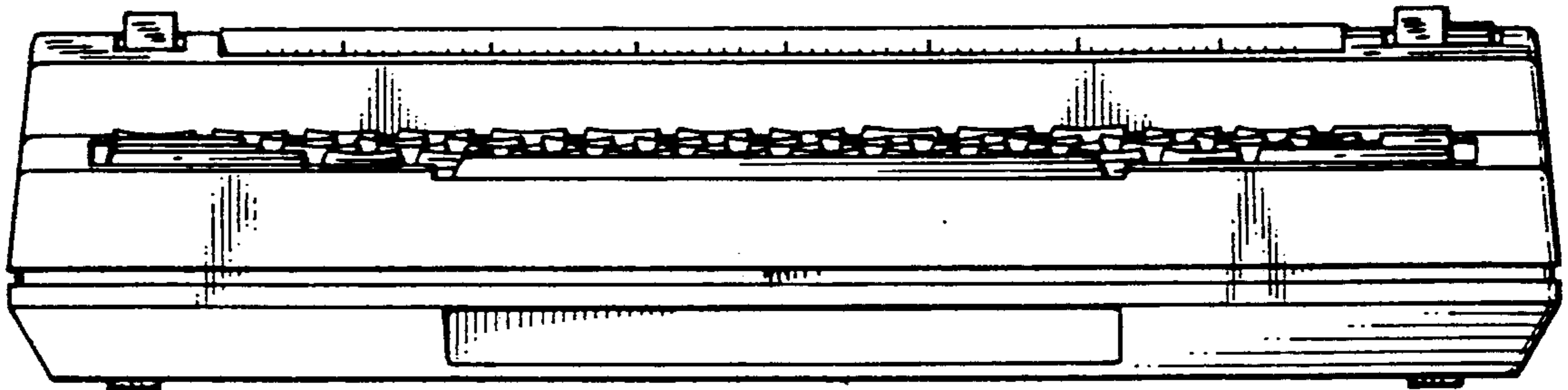

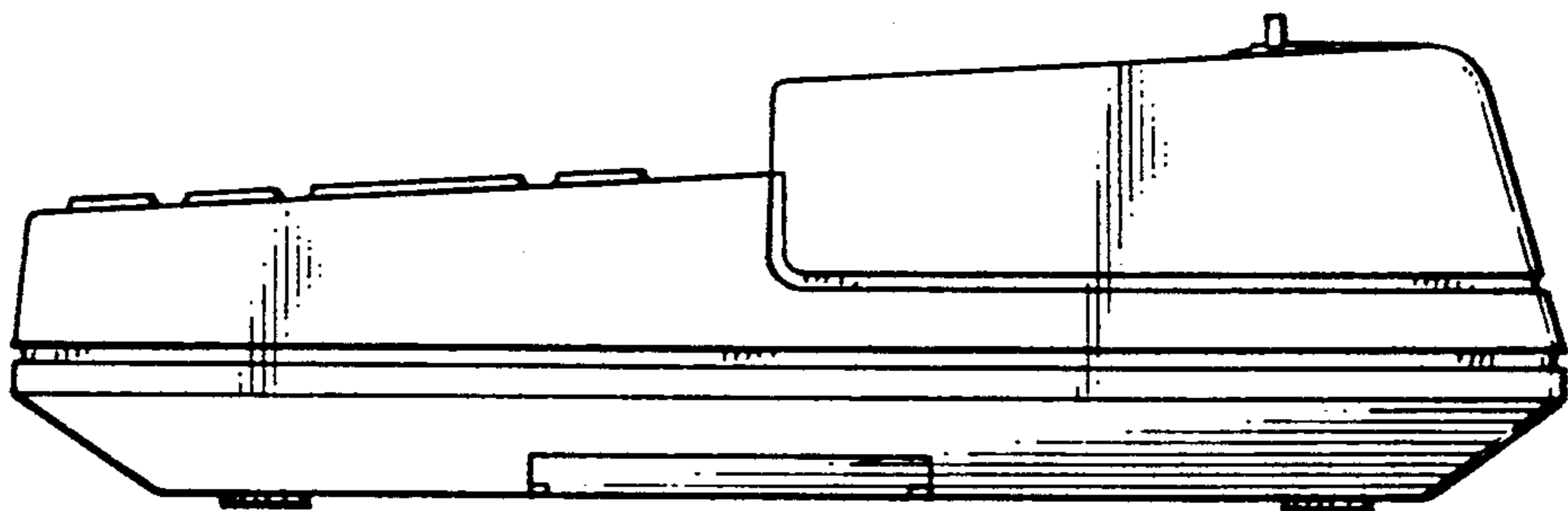

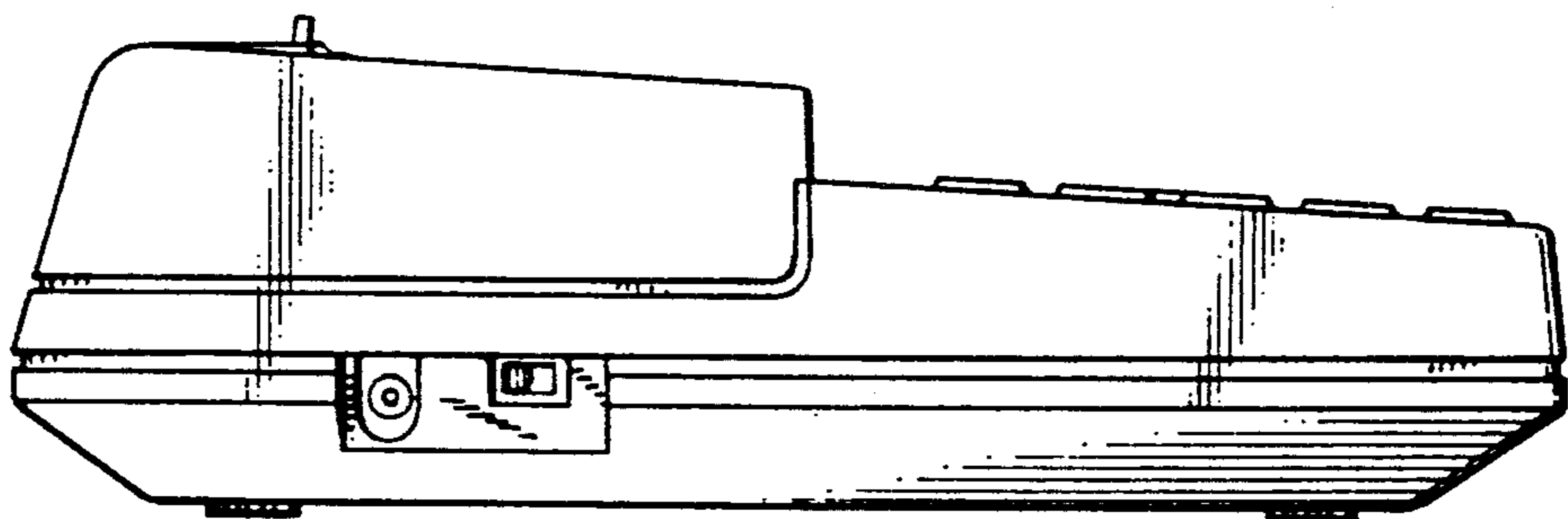

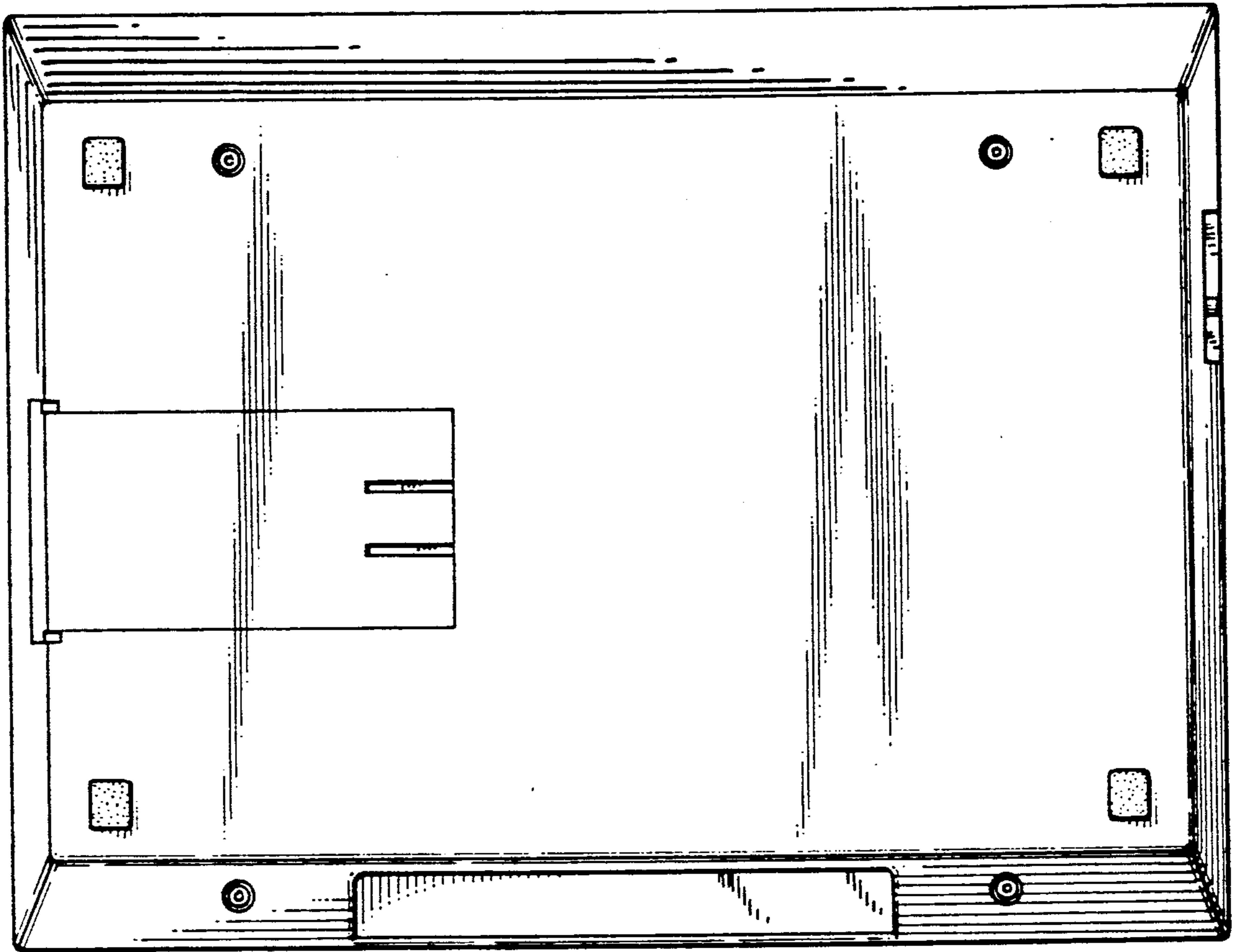

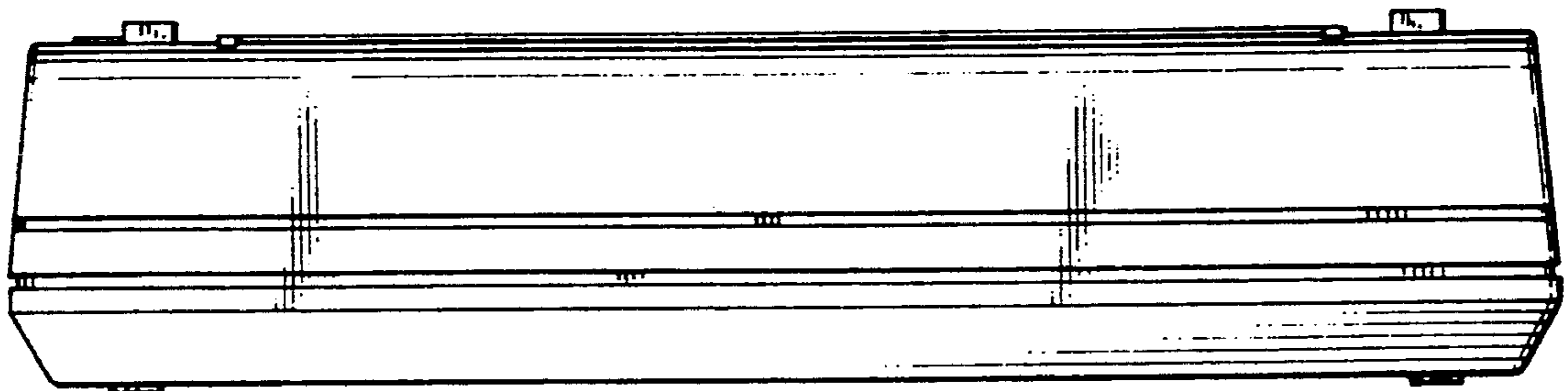
