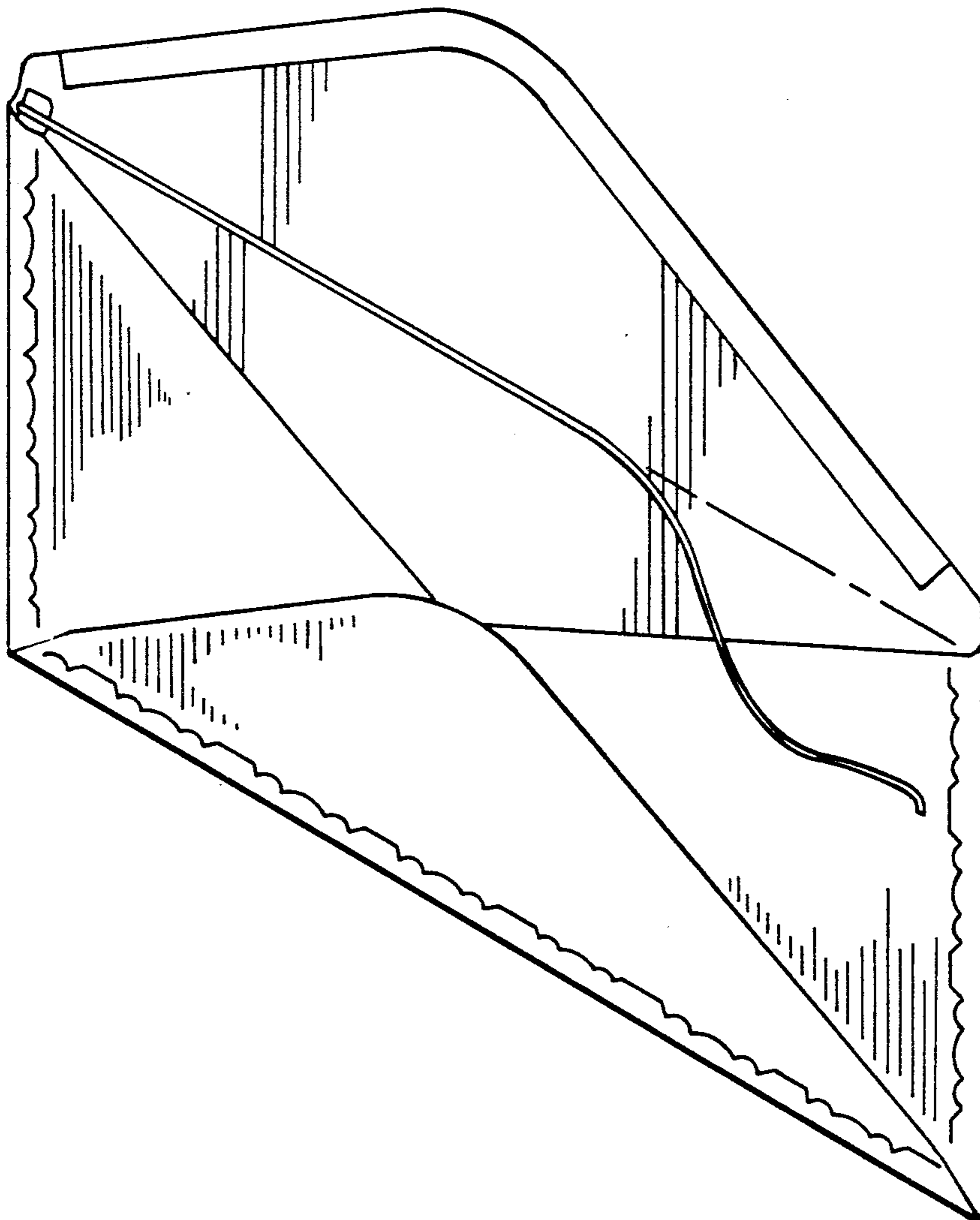

The ornamental design for an envelope, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the envelope embodying the design of the present invention;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, it being understood that the decorative element on the upper right corner is a surface design feature;
FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 4 is a left side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof;
FIG. 7 is a bottom view thereof.



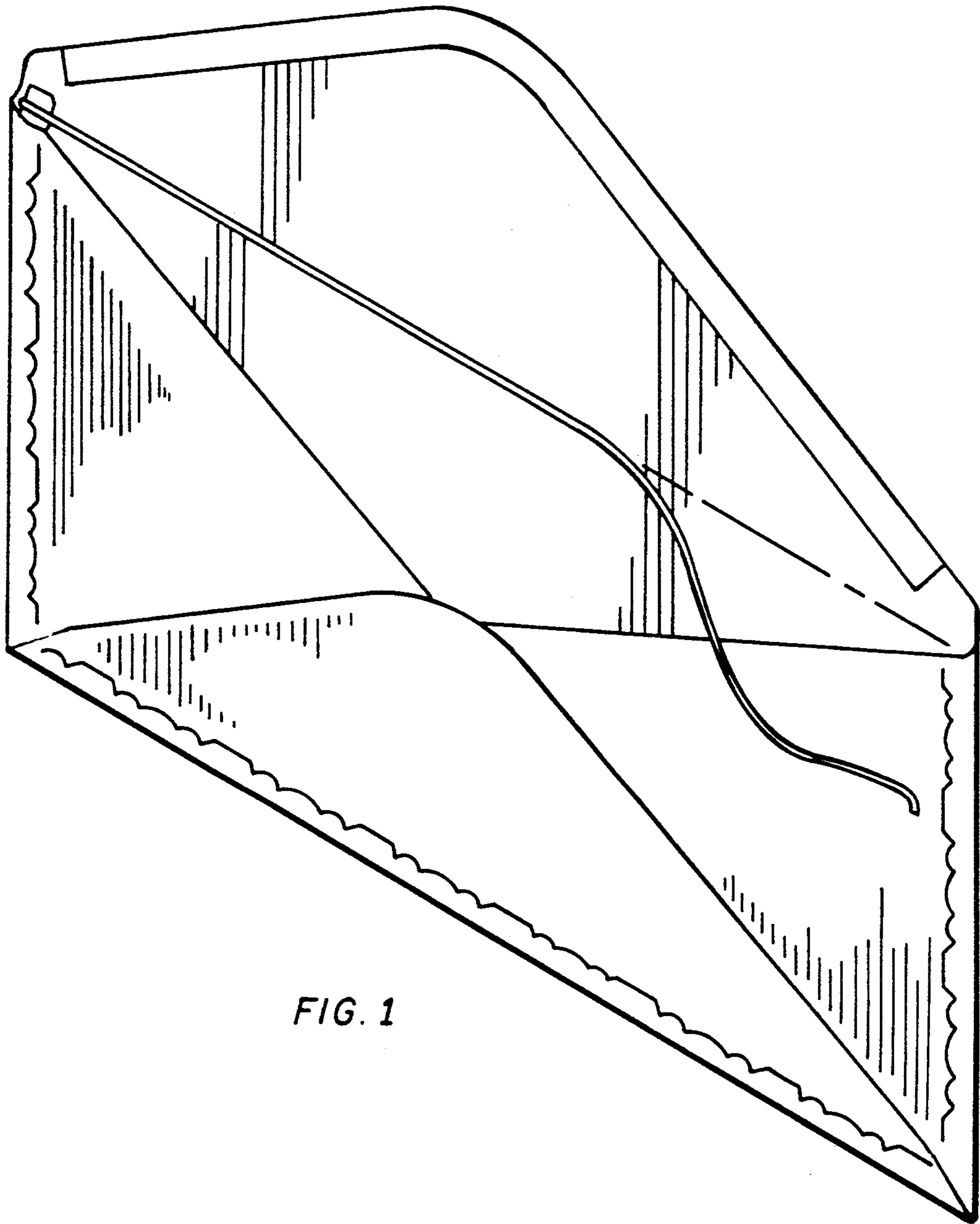

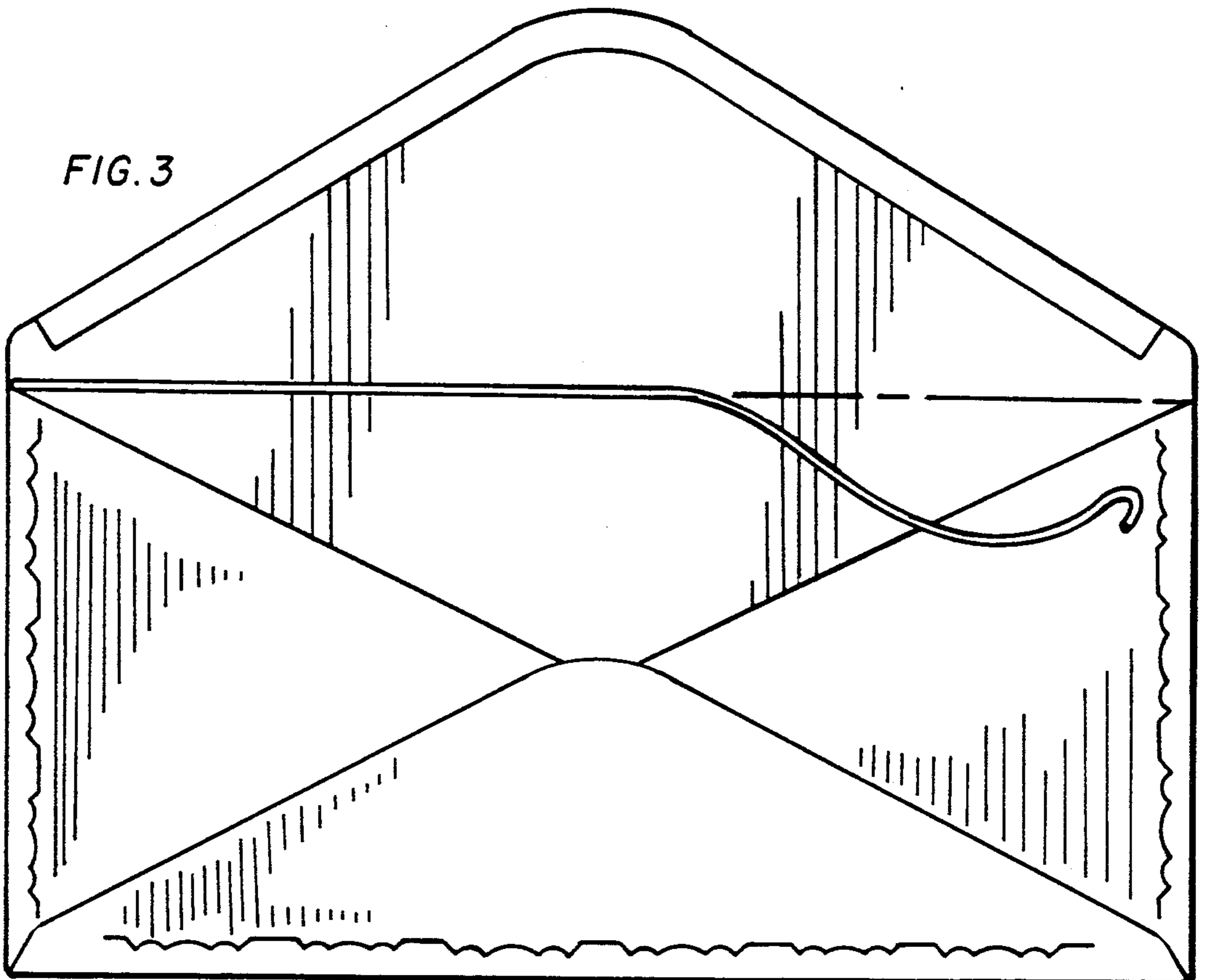
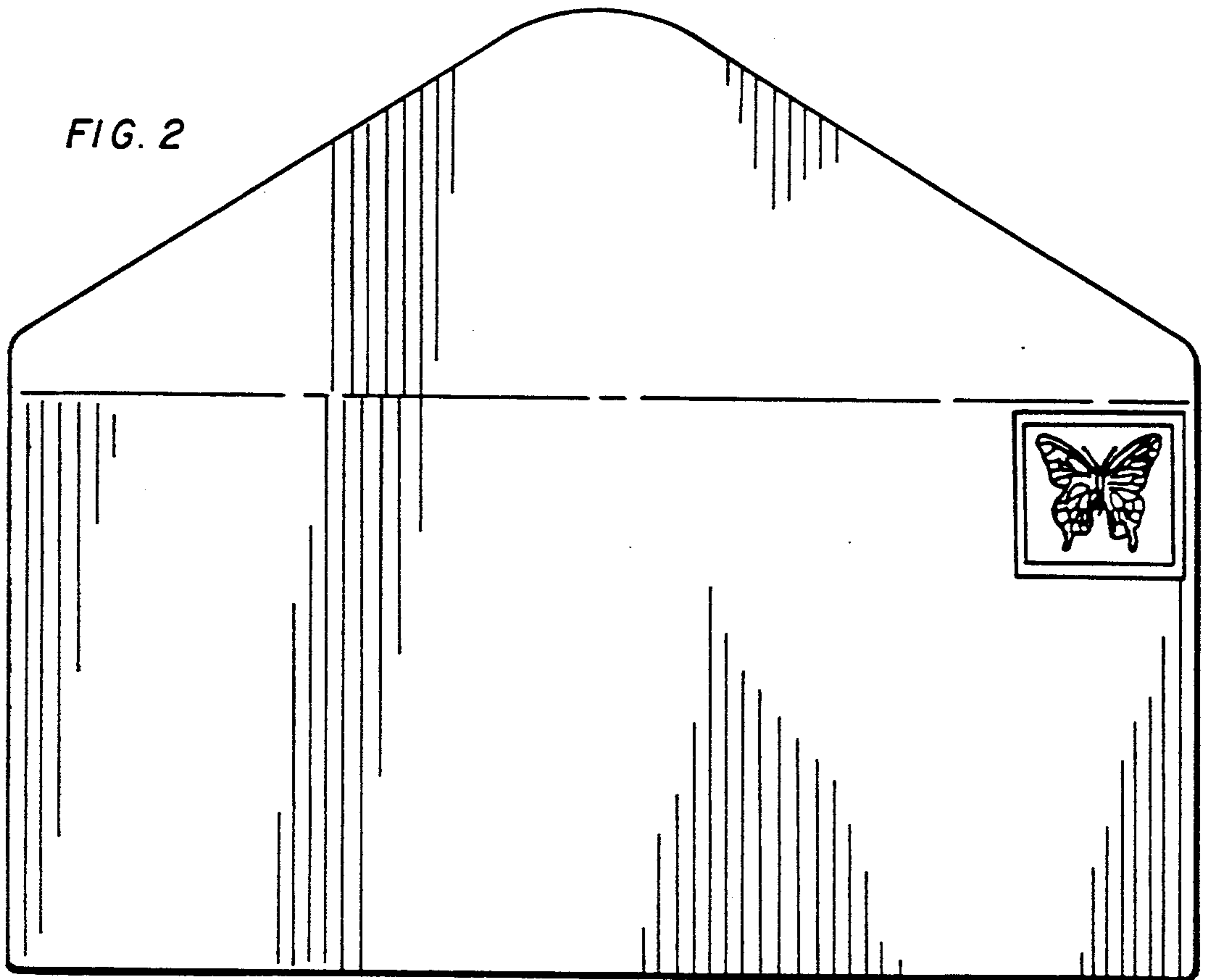
