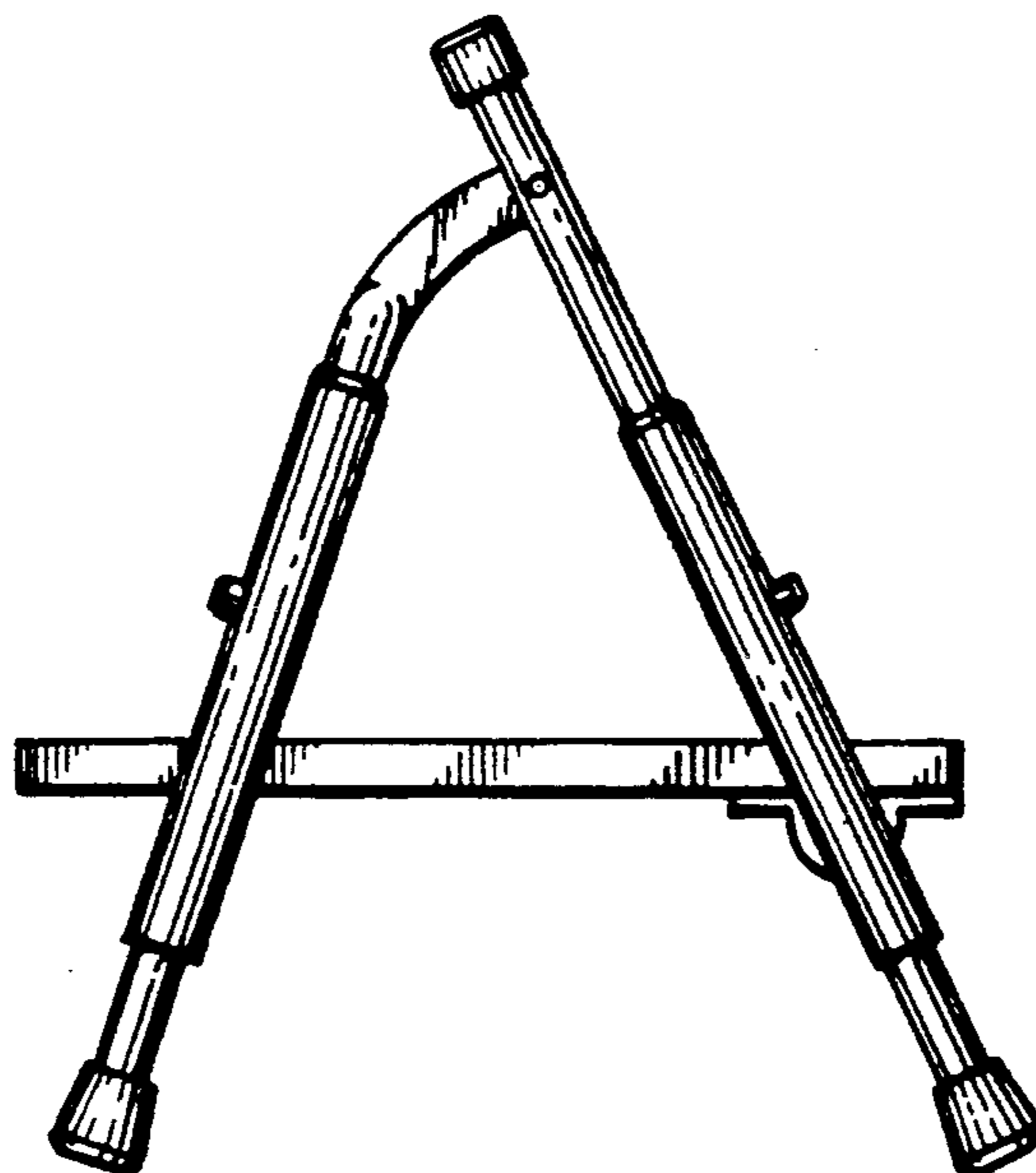

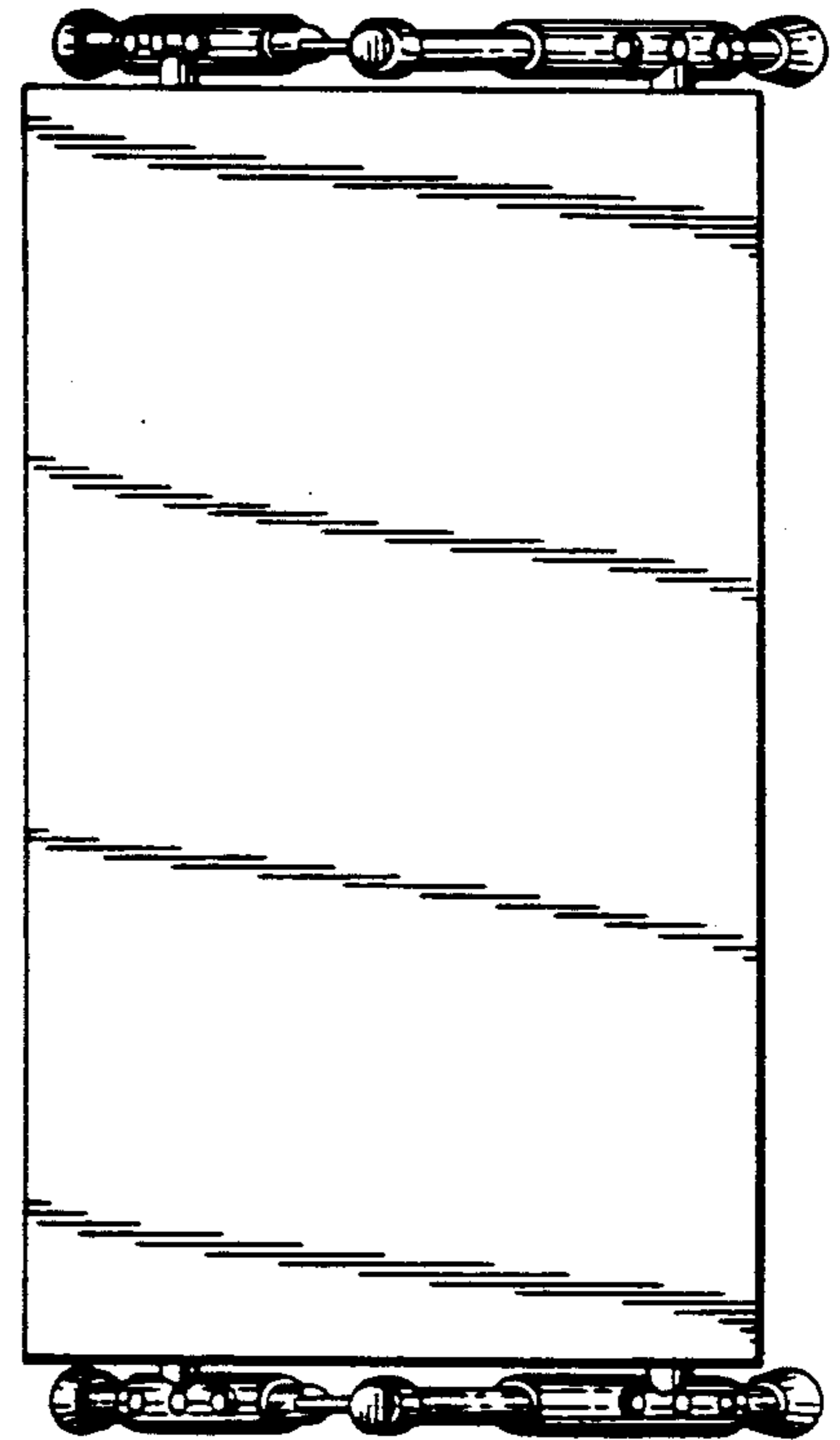
The ornamental design for a climbing exerciser, as shown and described.

**DESCRIPTION**

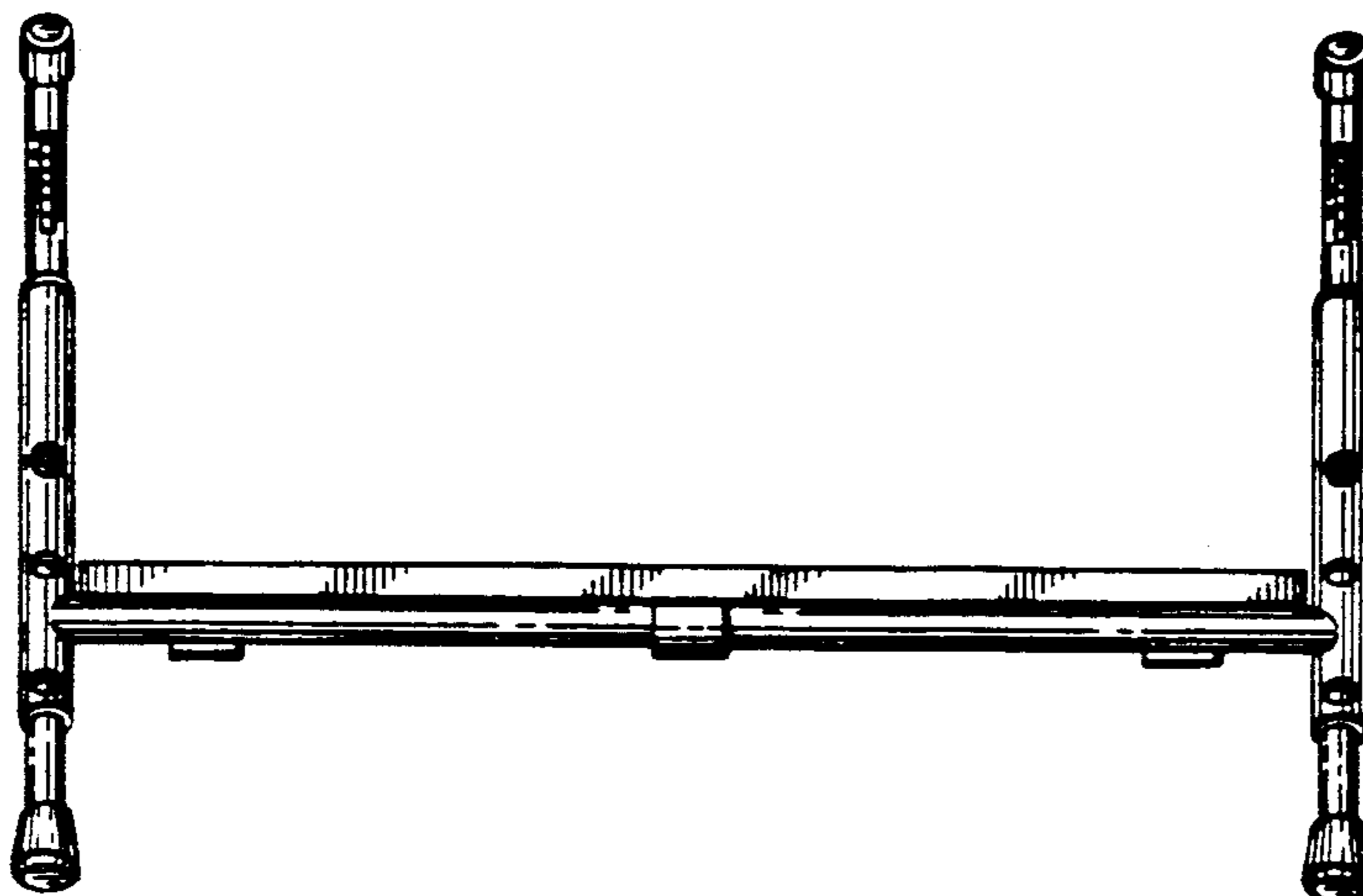
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a climbing exerciser showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



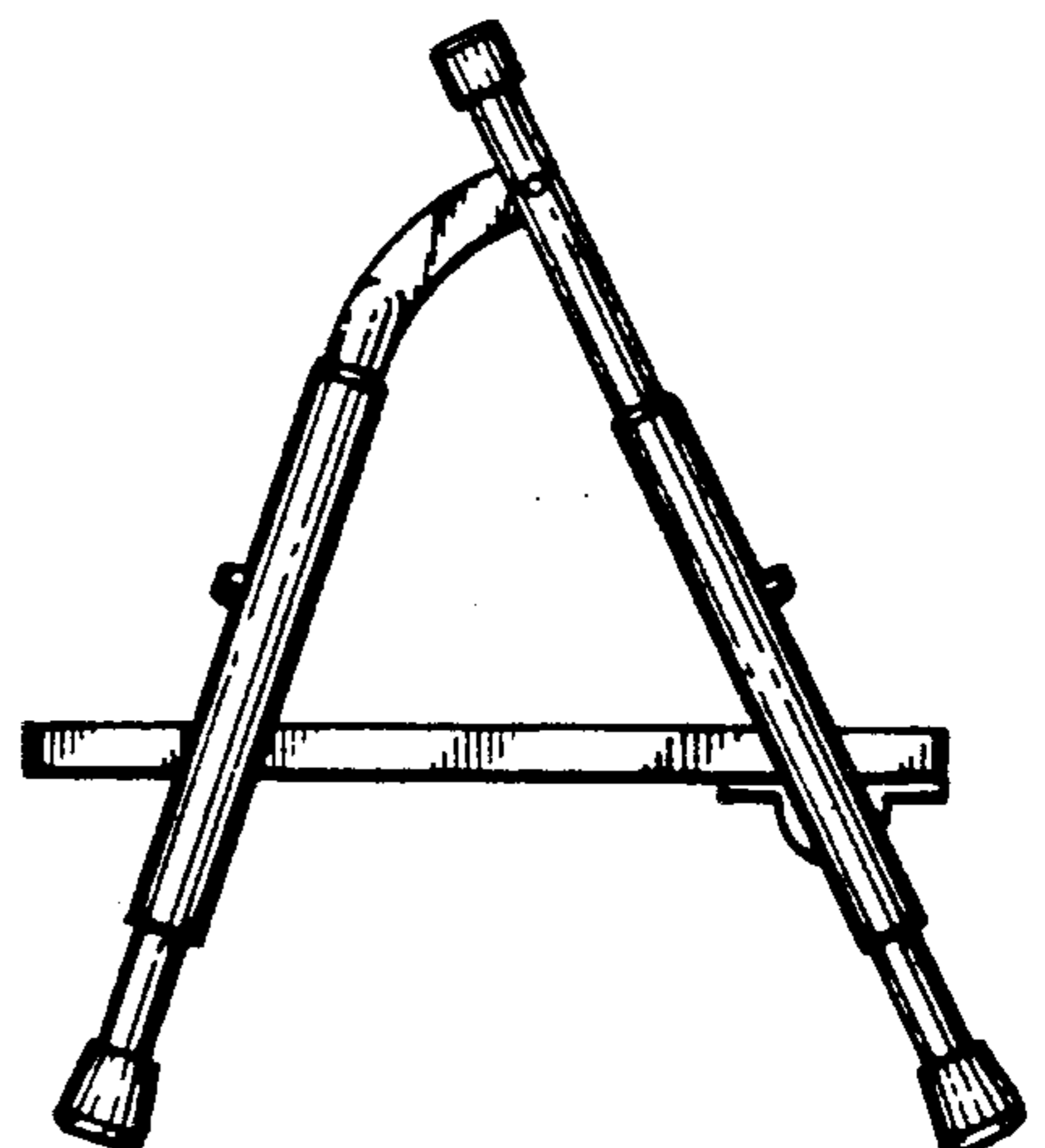

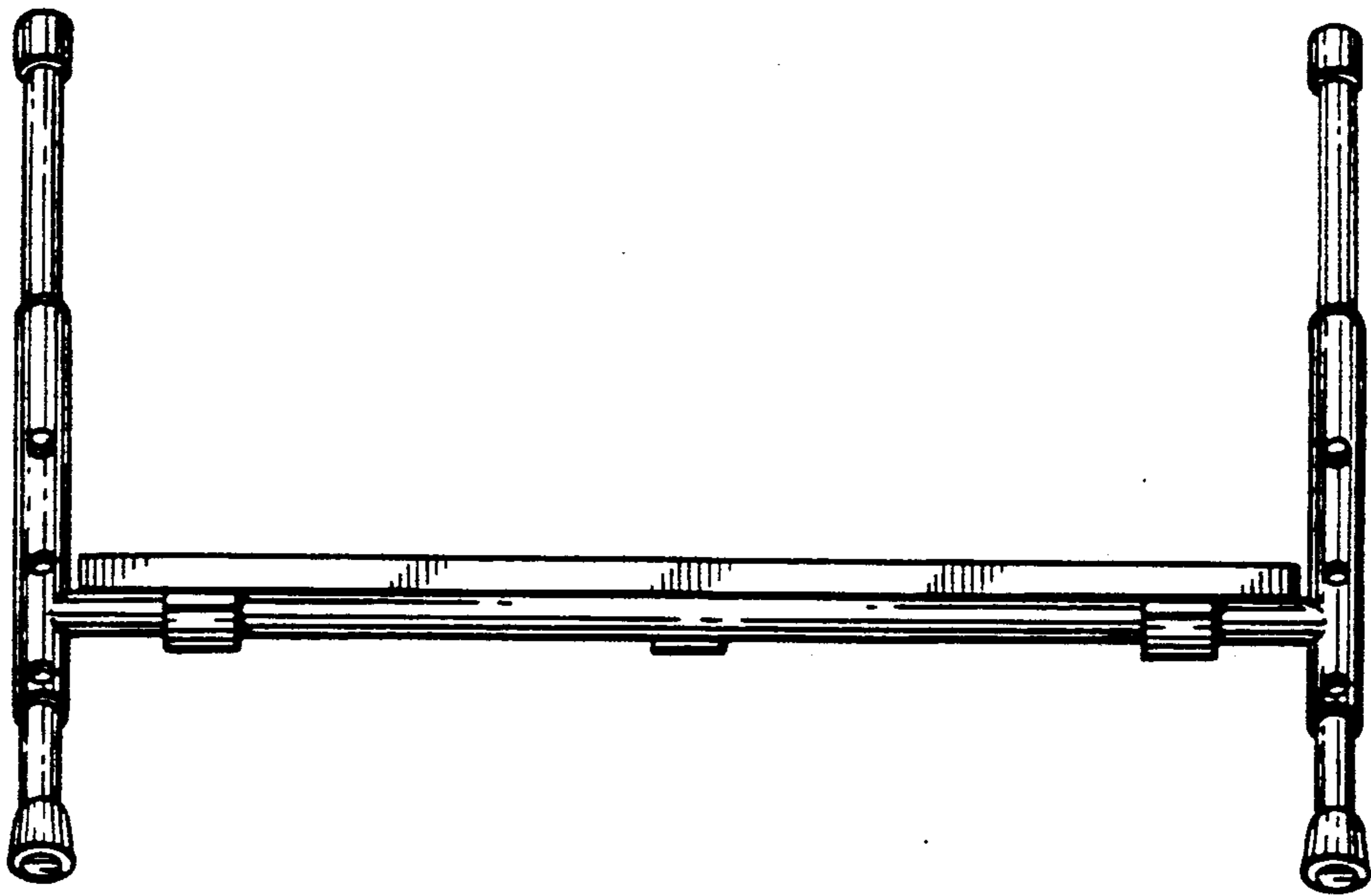
