DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view showing our new design, with the bottom plan view being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 2 is an end view of one end thereof; FIG. 3 is a side elevation view of one side thereof; FIG. 4 is a side elevation view of the opposite side thereof; and FIG. 5 is an end view of an opposite end thereof.

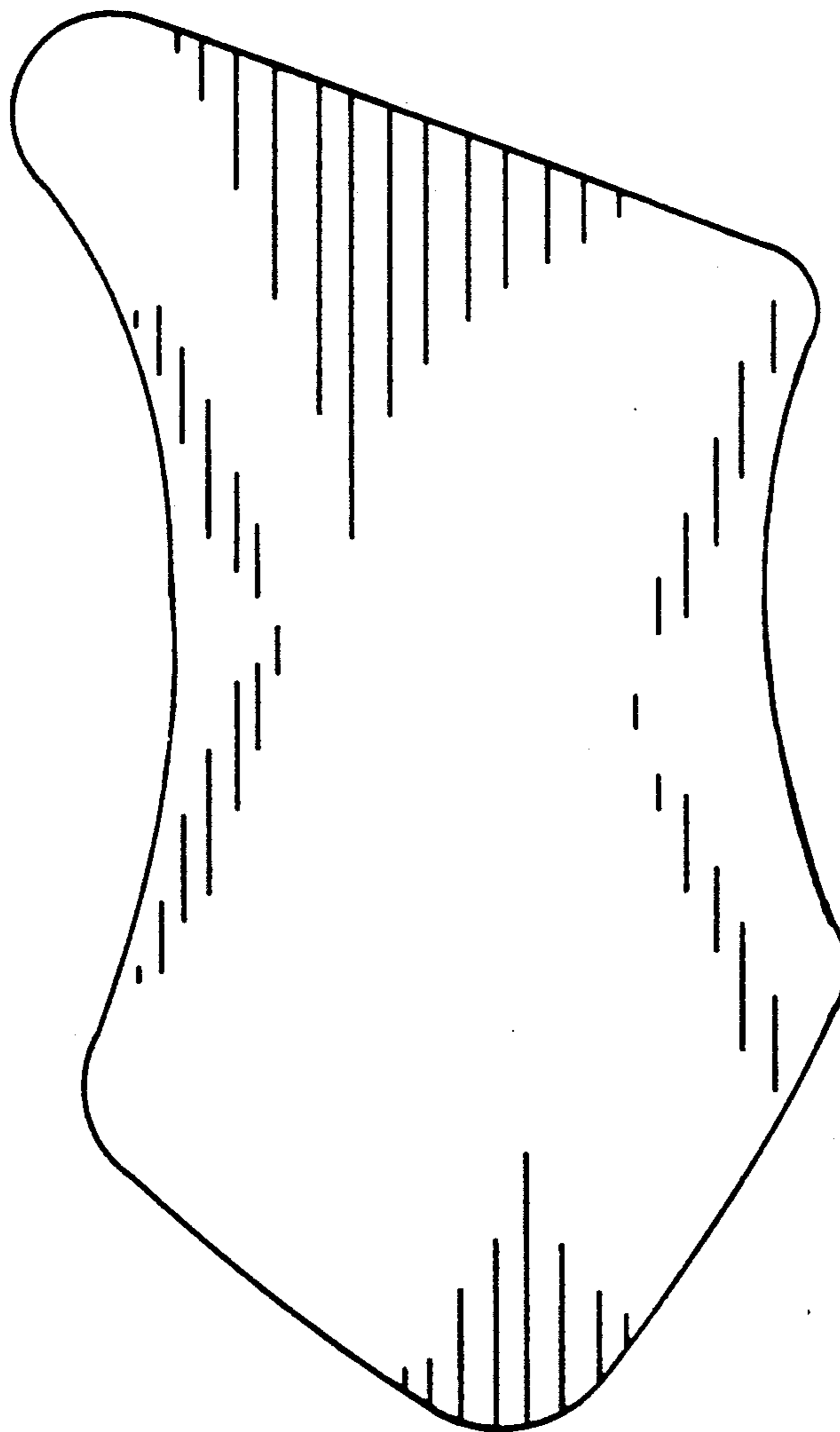

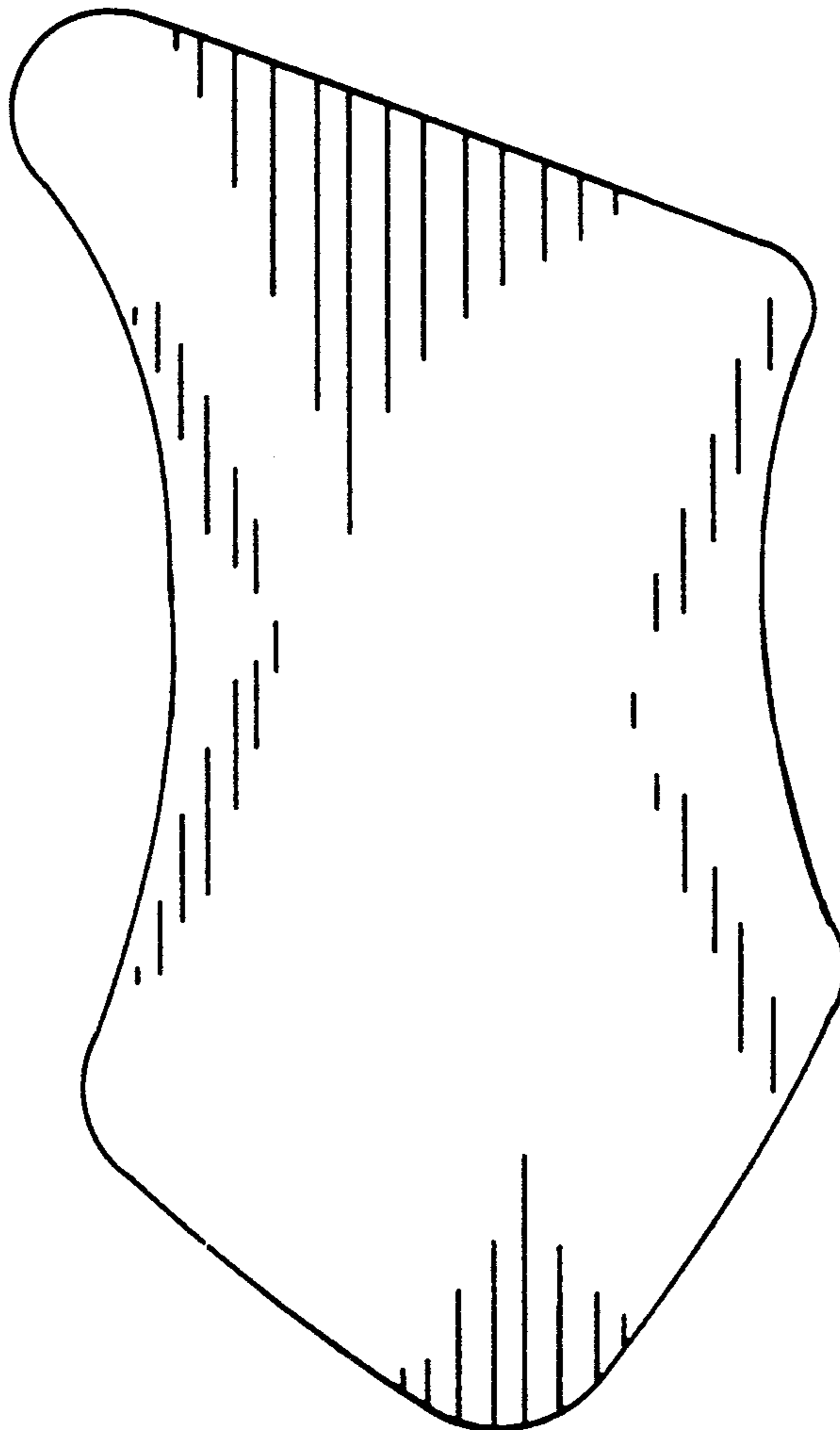
