The ornamental design for a shoe upper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an elevational view of one side of a shoe upper showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is an elevational view of the other side of the shoe upper shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is an elevational view of the front of the shoe upper shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the rear of the shoe upper shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the shoe upper shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 6 is an elevational view of one side of a shoe upper showing second embodiment of my new design;
 FIG. 7 is an elevational view of the other side of the shoe upper shown in FIG. 6;
 FIG. 8 is an elevational view of the front of the shoe upper shown in FIG. 6;
 FIG. 9 is an elevational view of the rear of the shoe upper shown in FIG. 6; and
 FIG. 10 is a top plan view of the shoe upper shown in FIG. 6.

The broken line showing the sole in FIGS. 1-4 and FIGS. 6-9 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

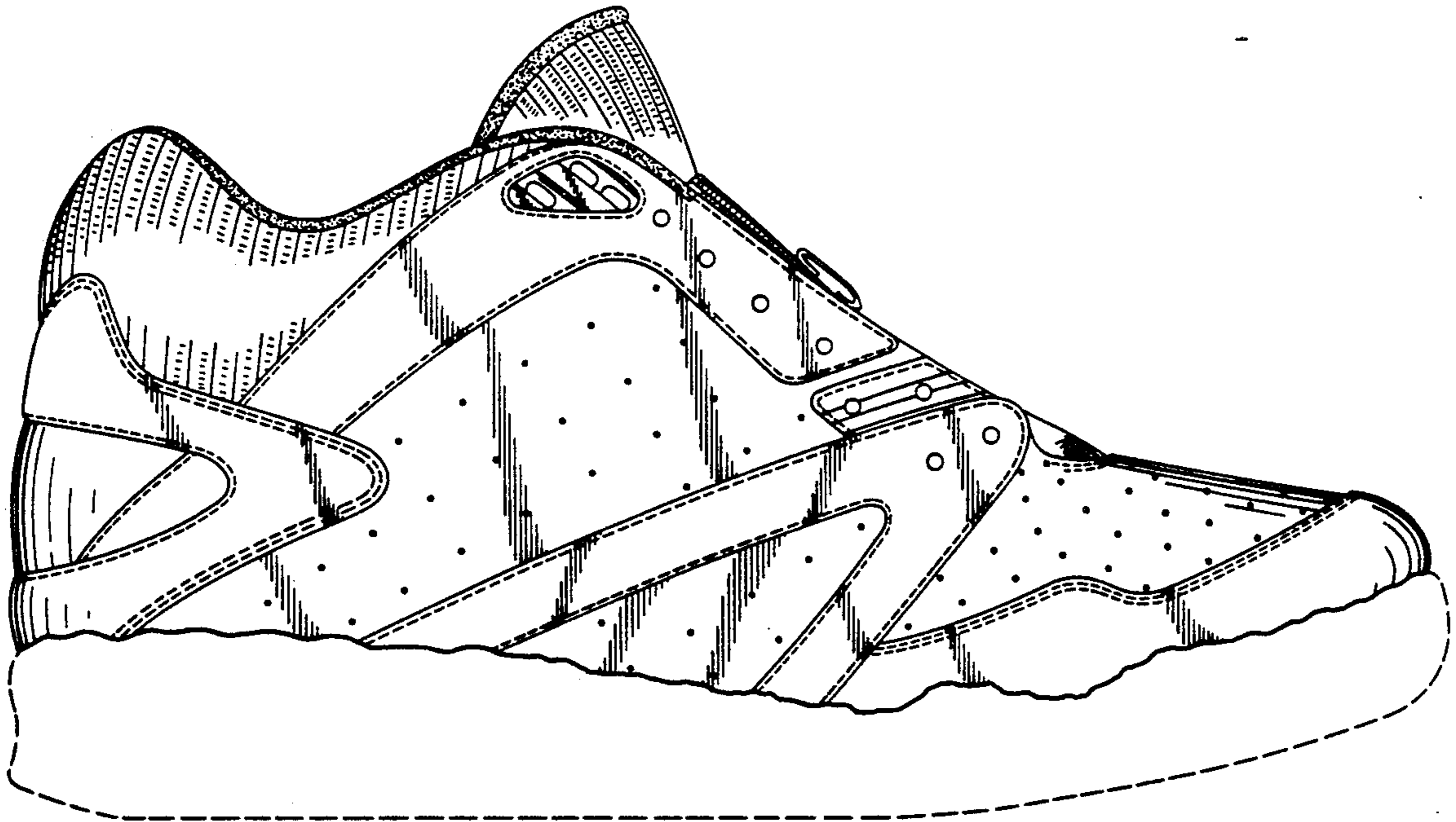
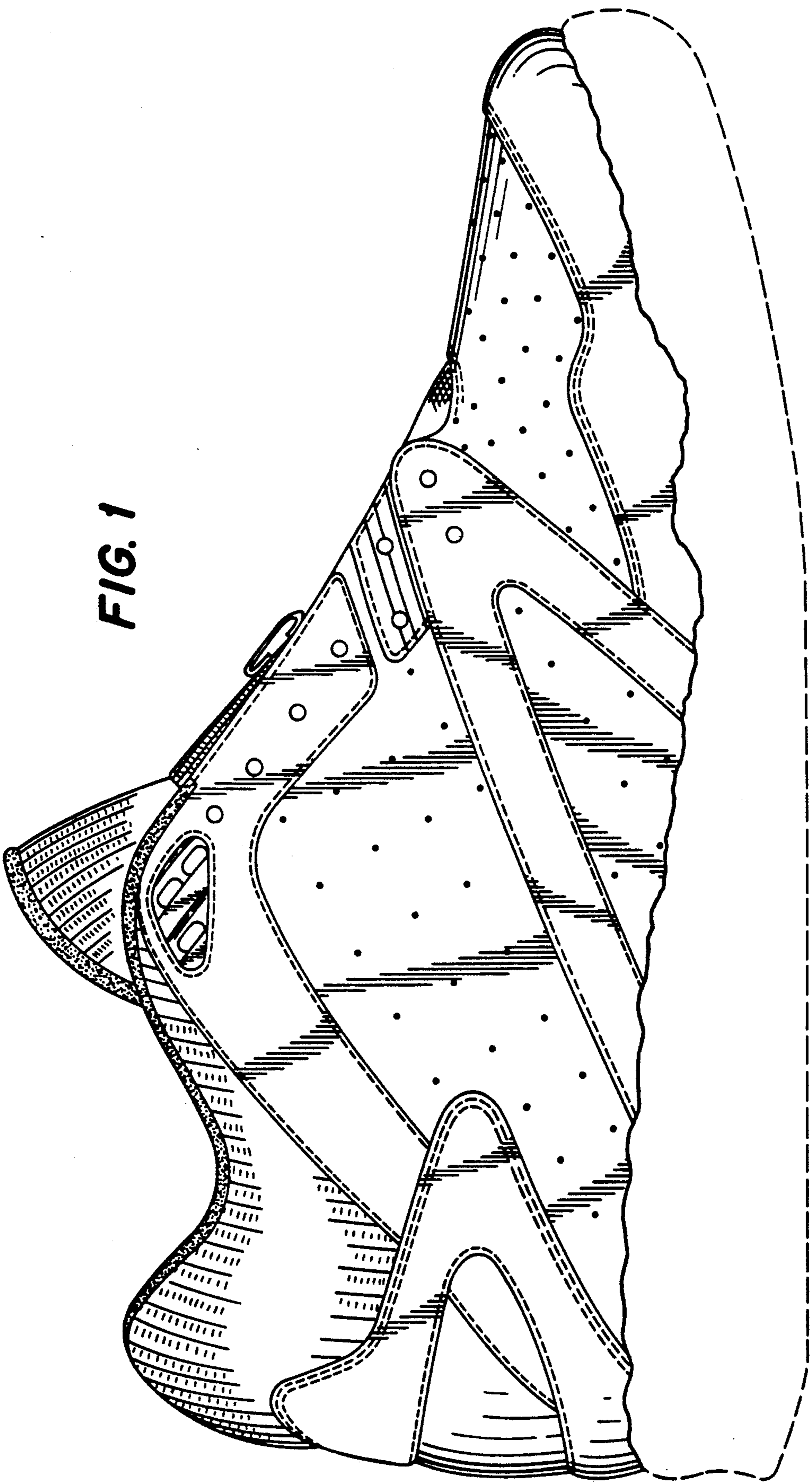

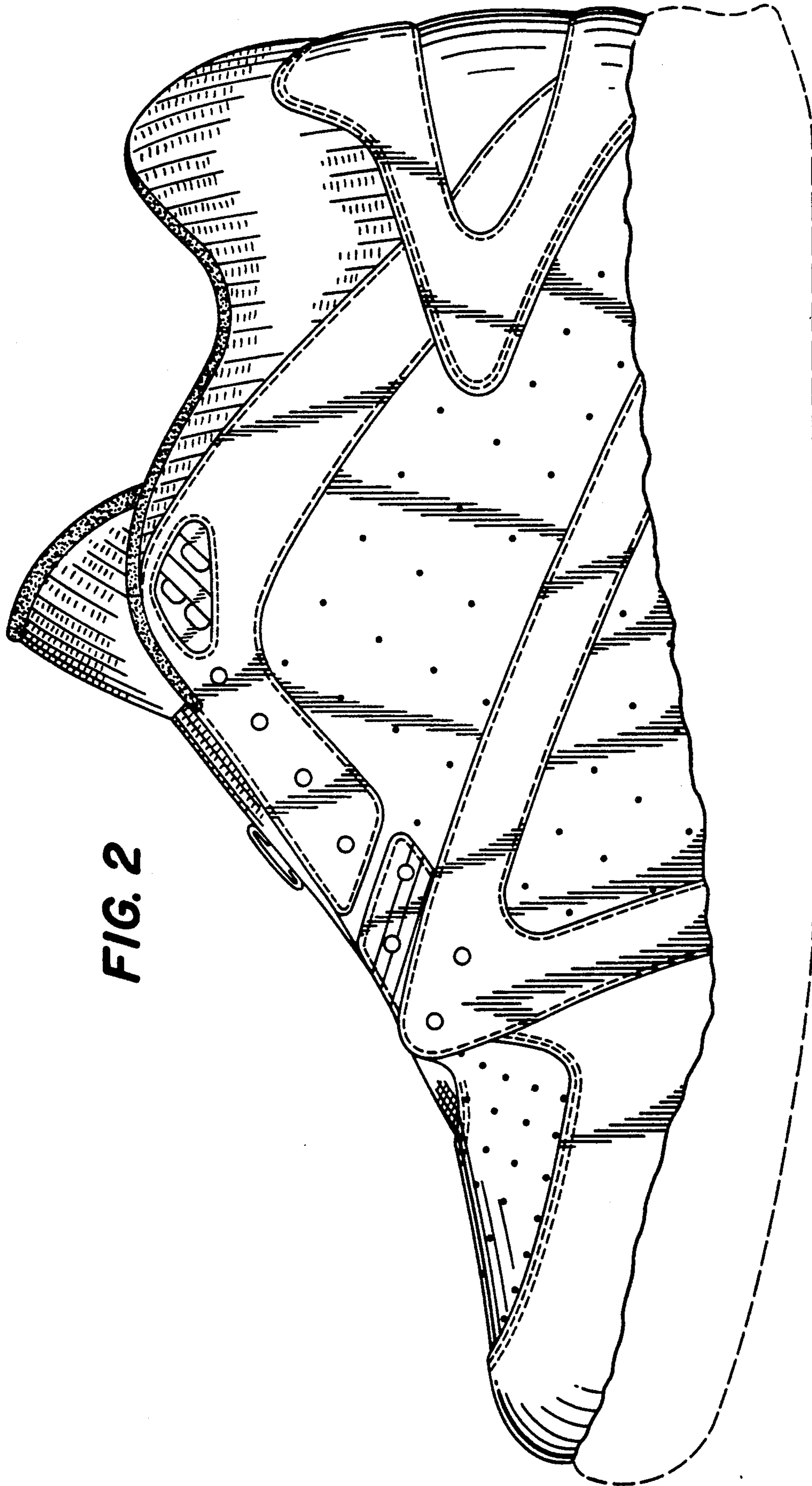

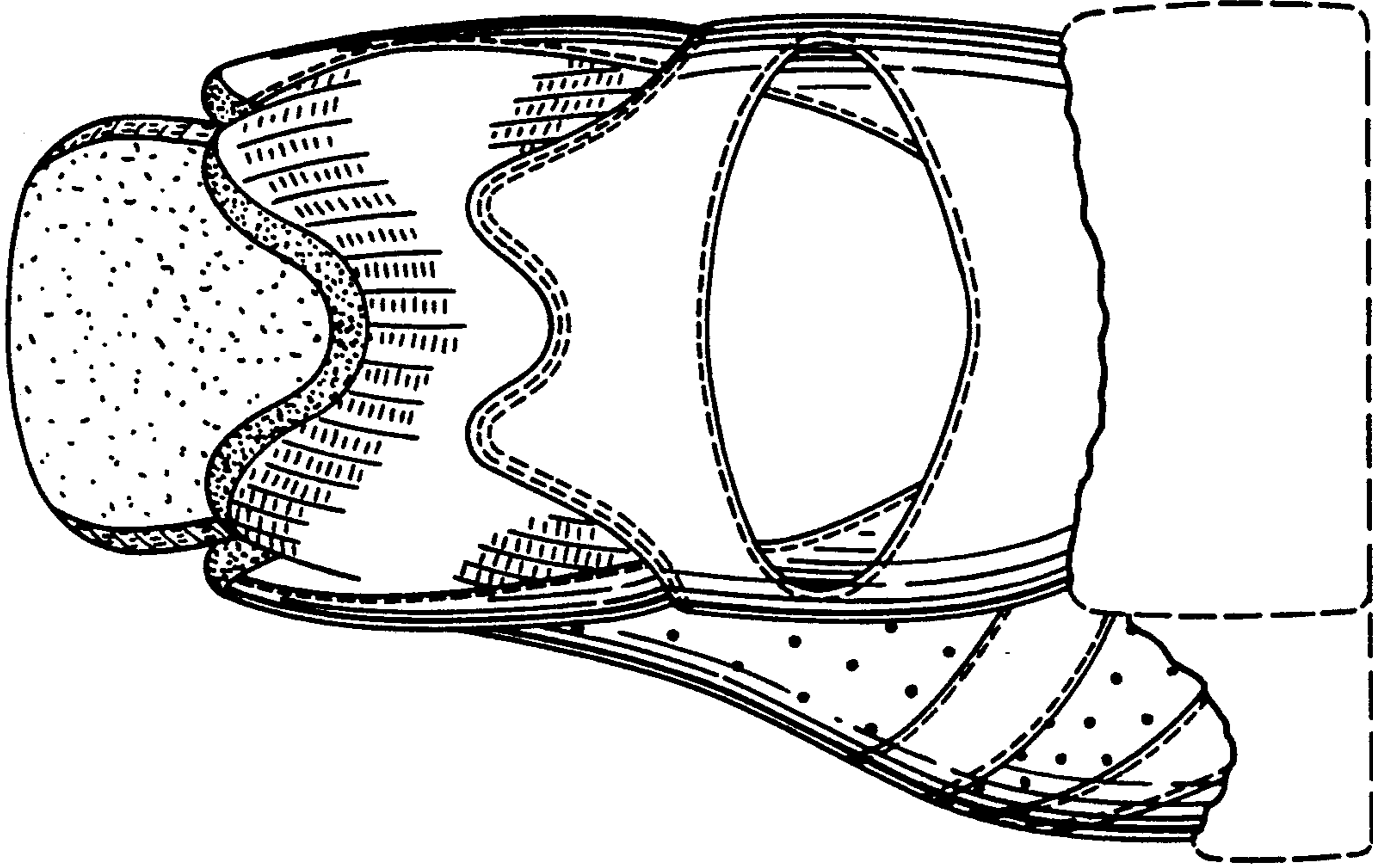

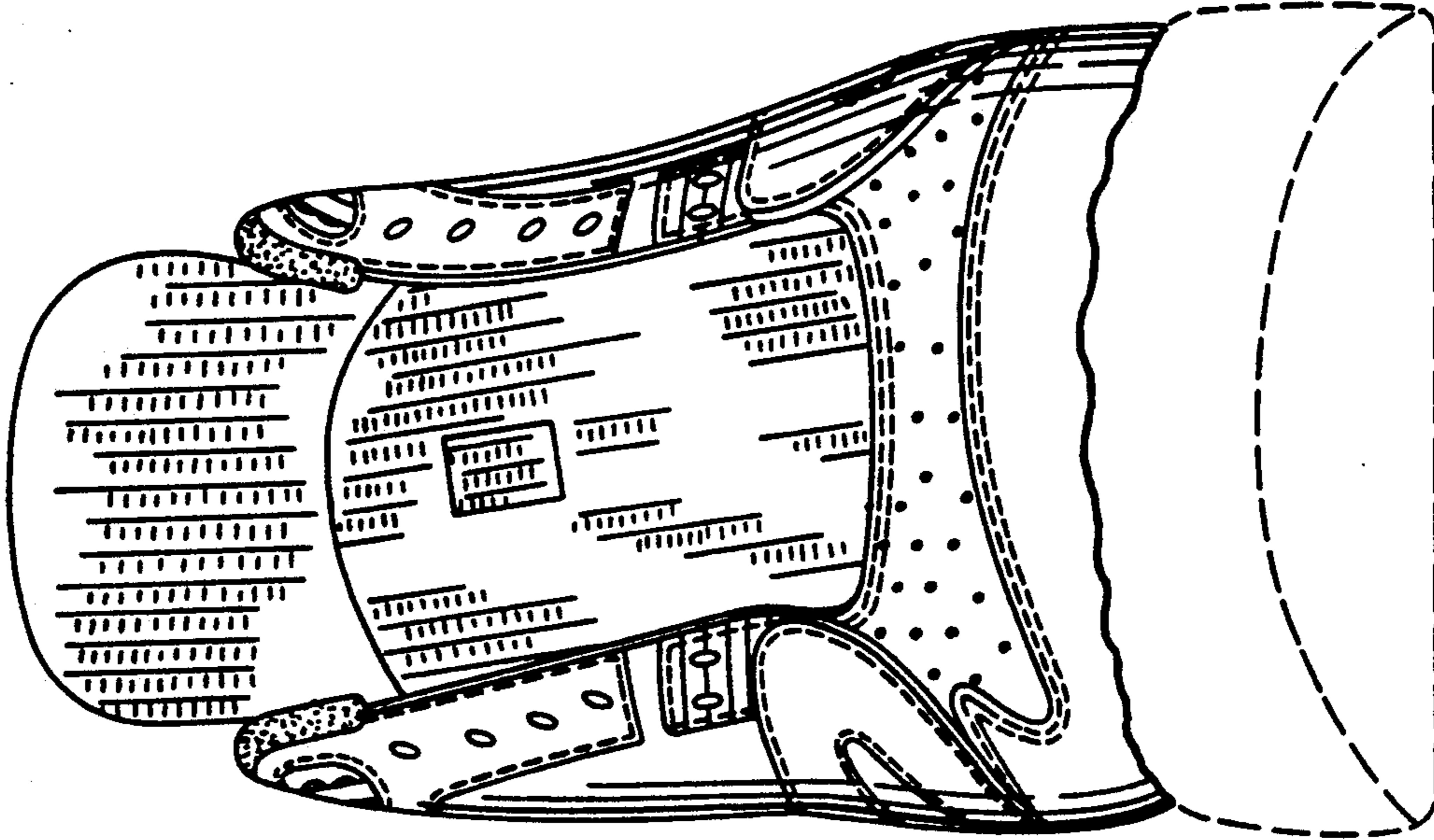

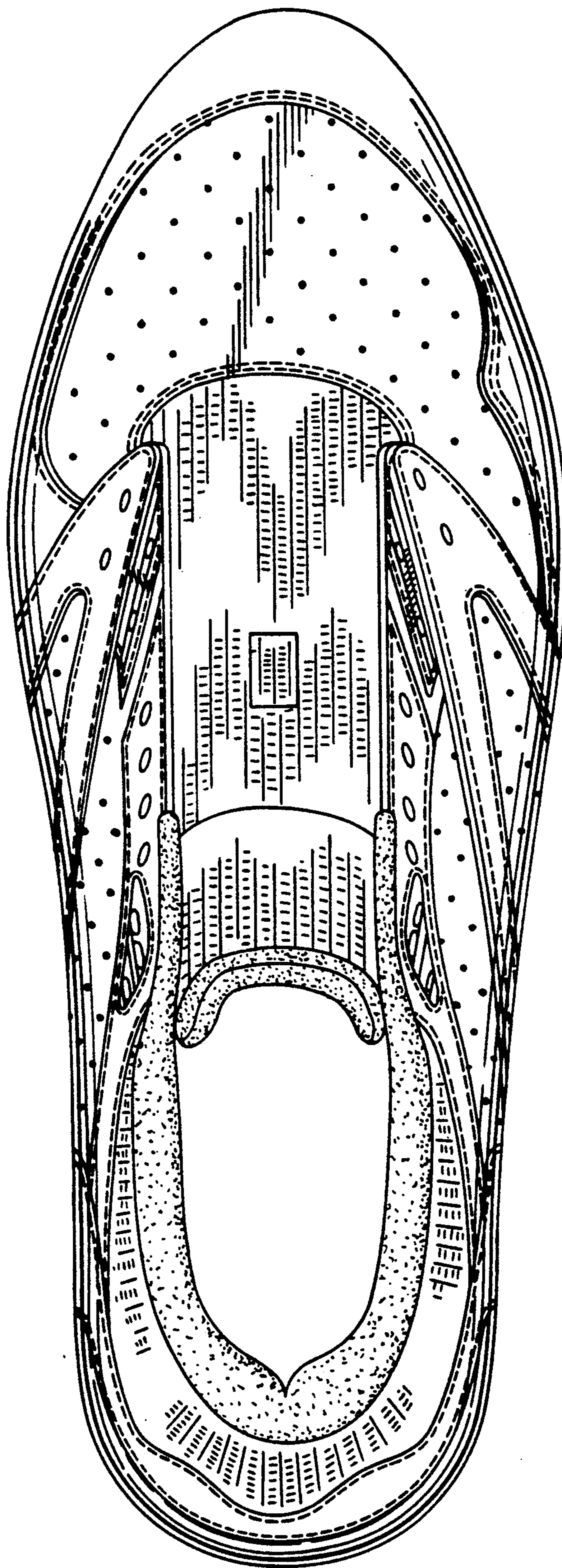
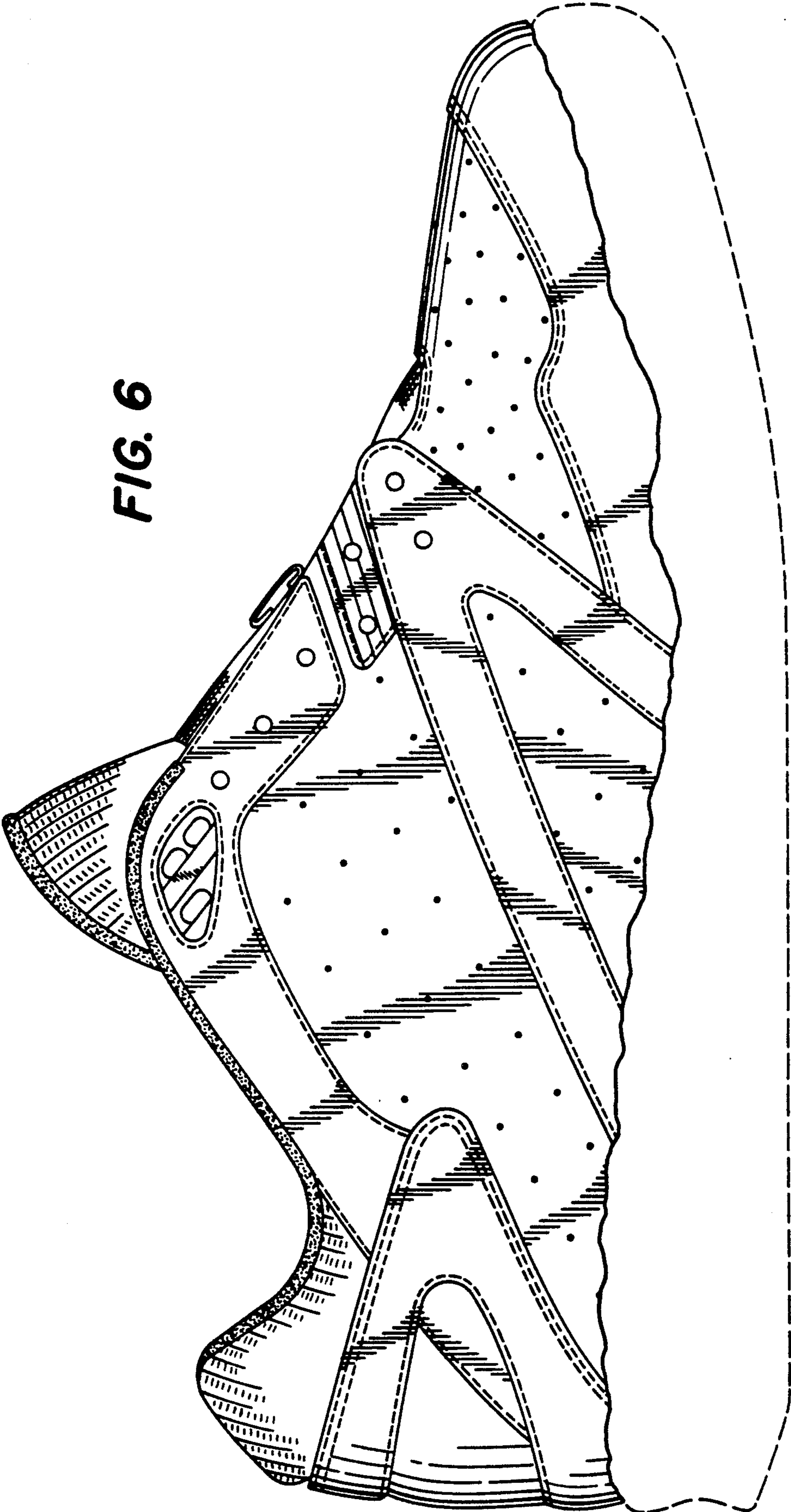

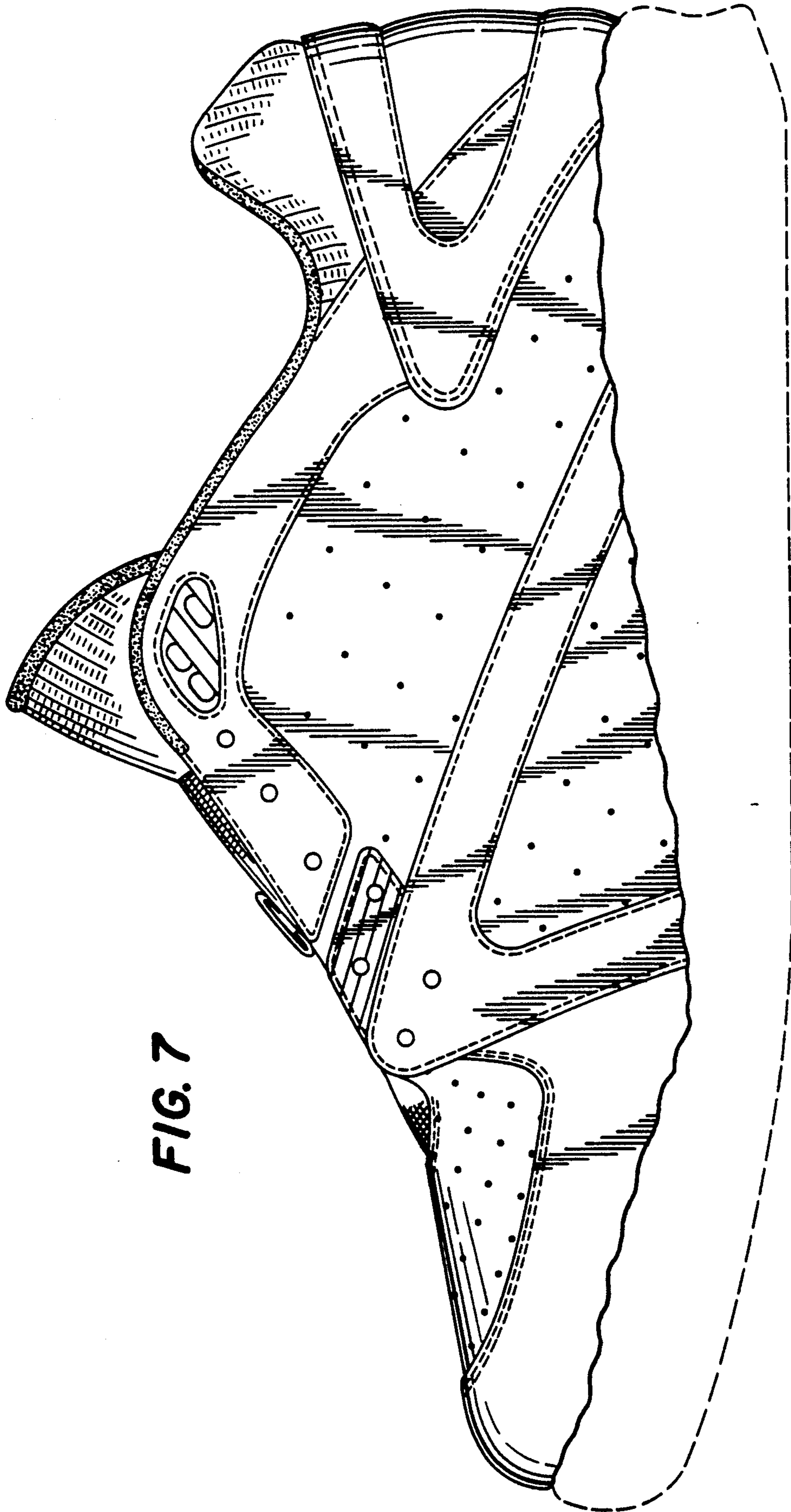

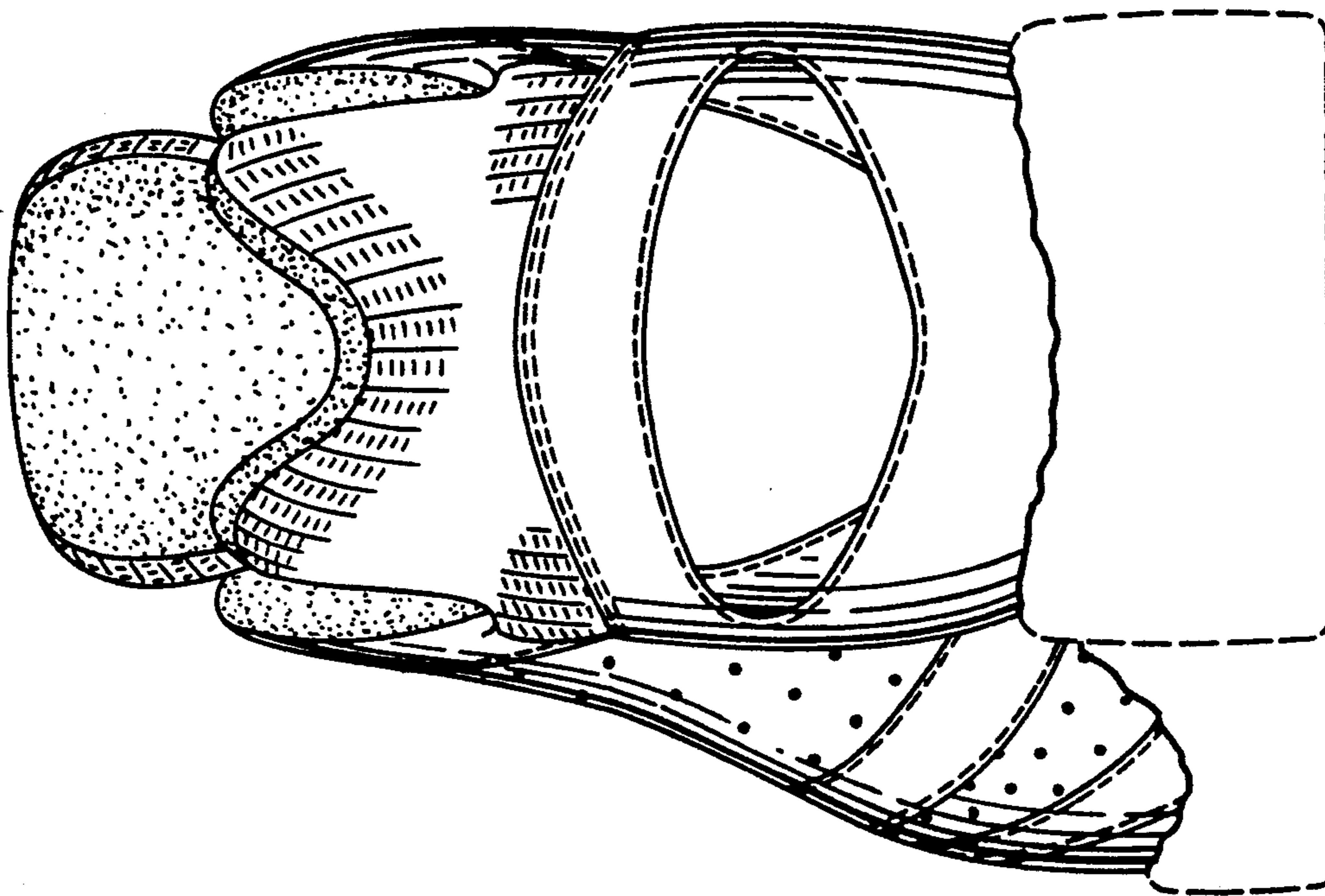

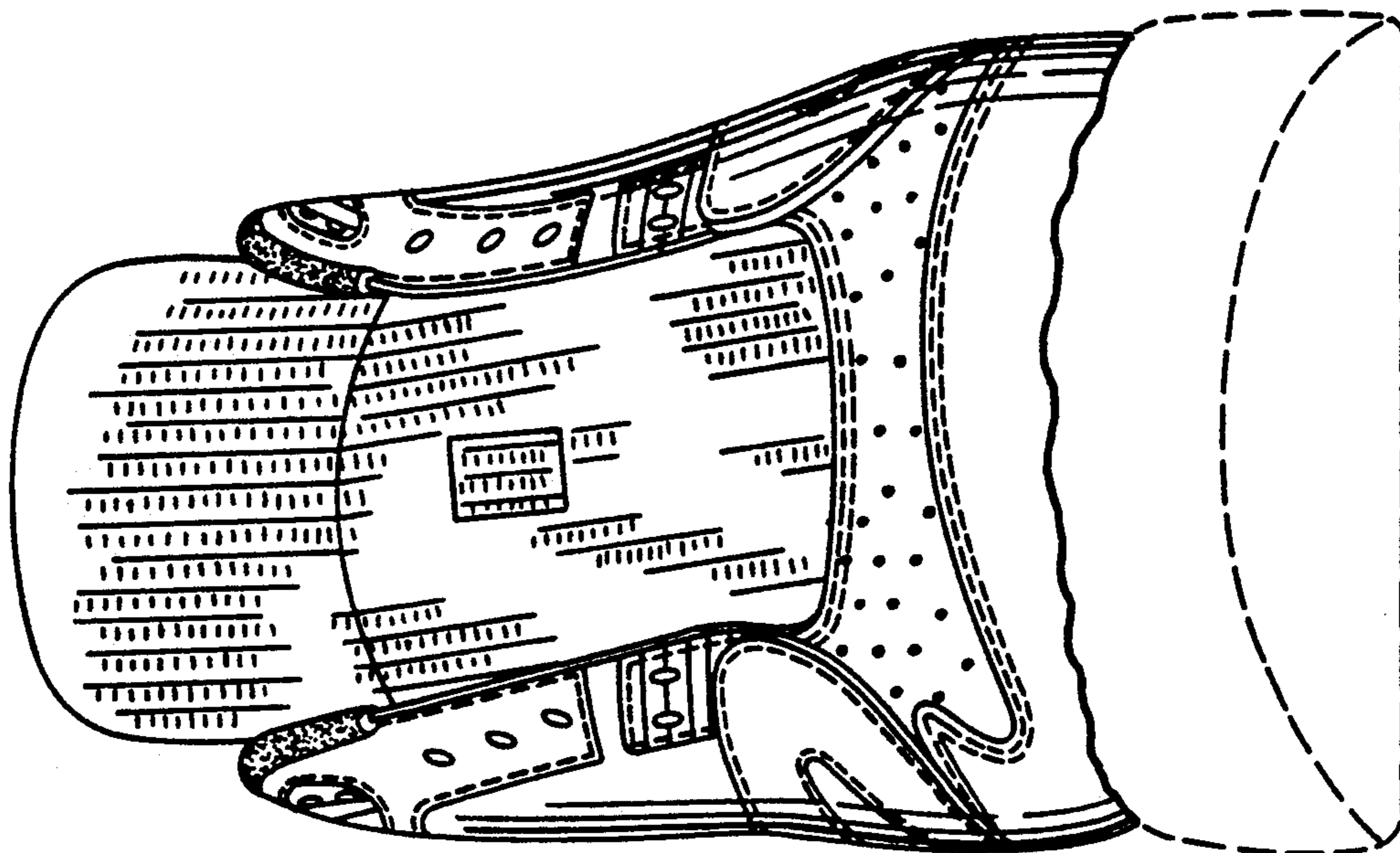
