[57] **CLAIM**

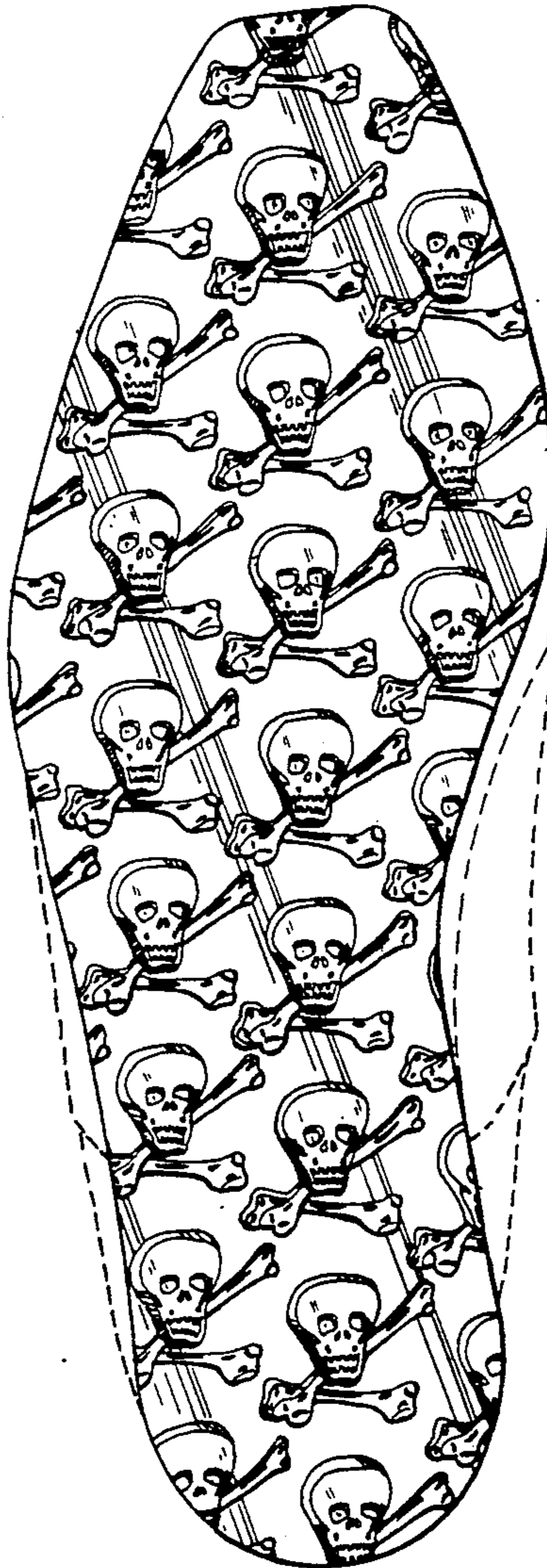
The ornamental design for a shoe sole, as shown and described.

The broken line showing of a shoe upper is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



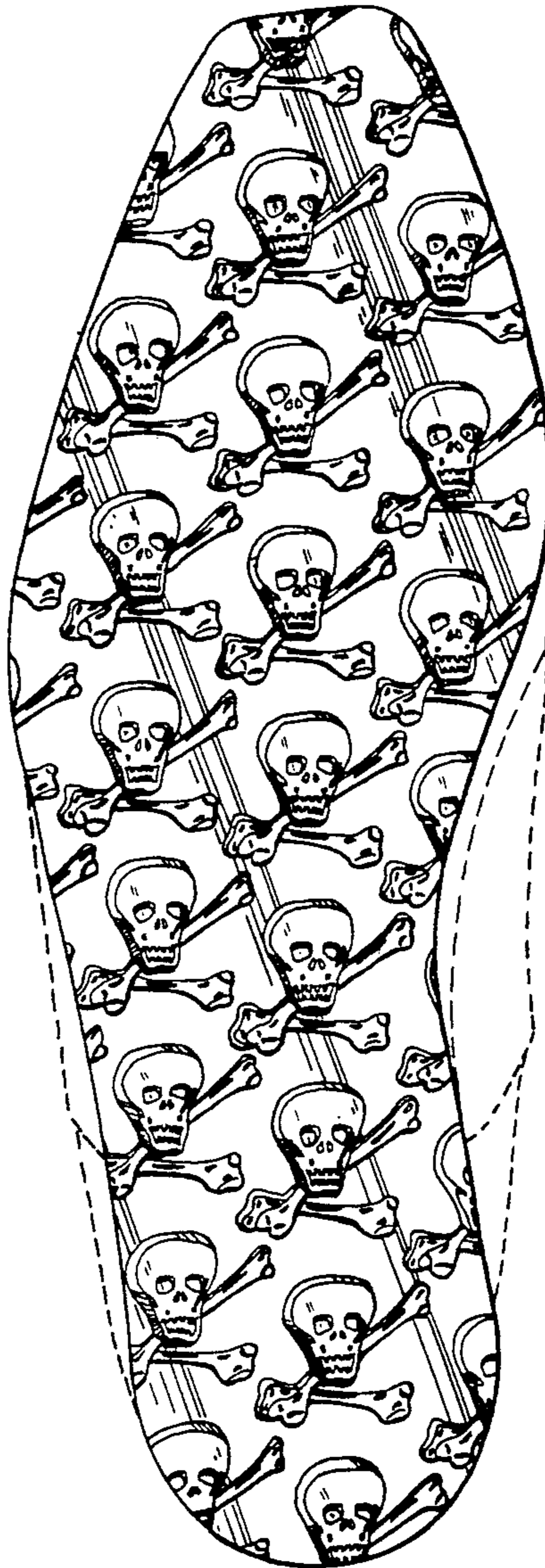

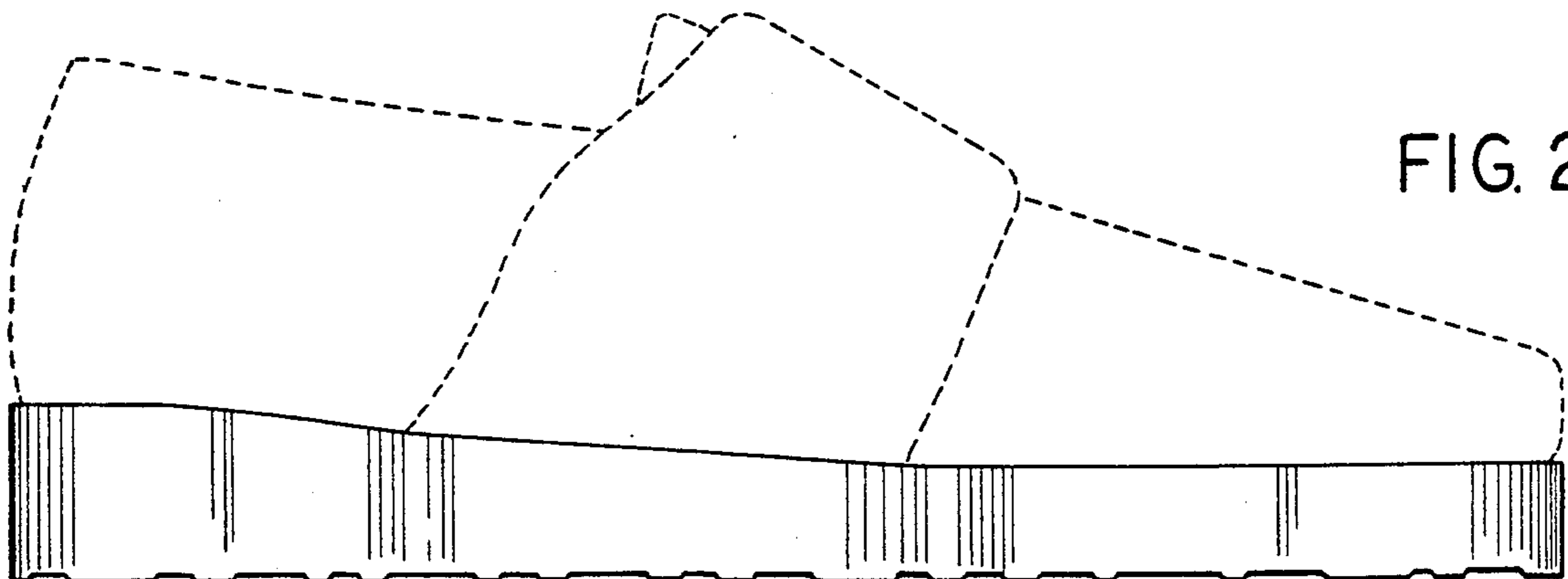
