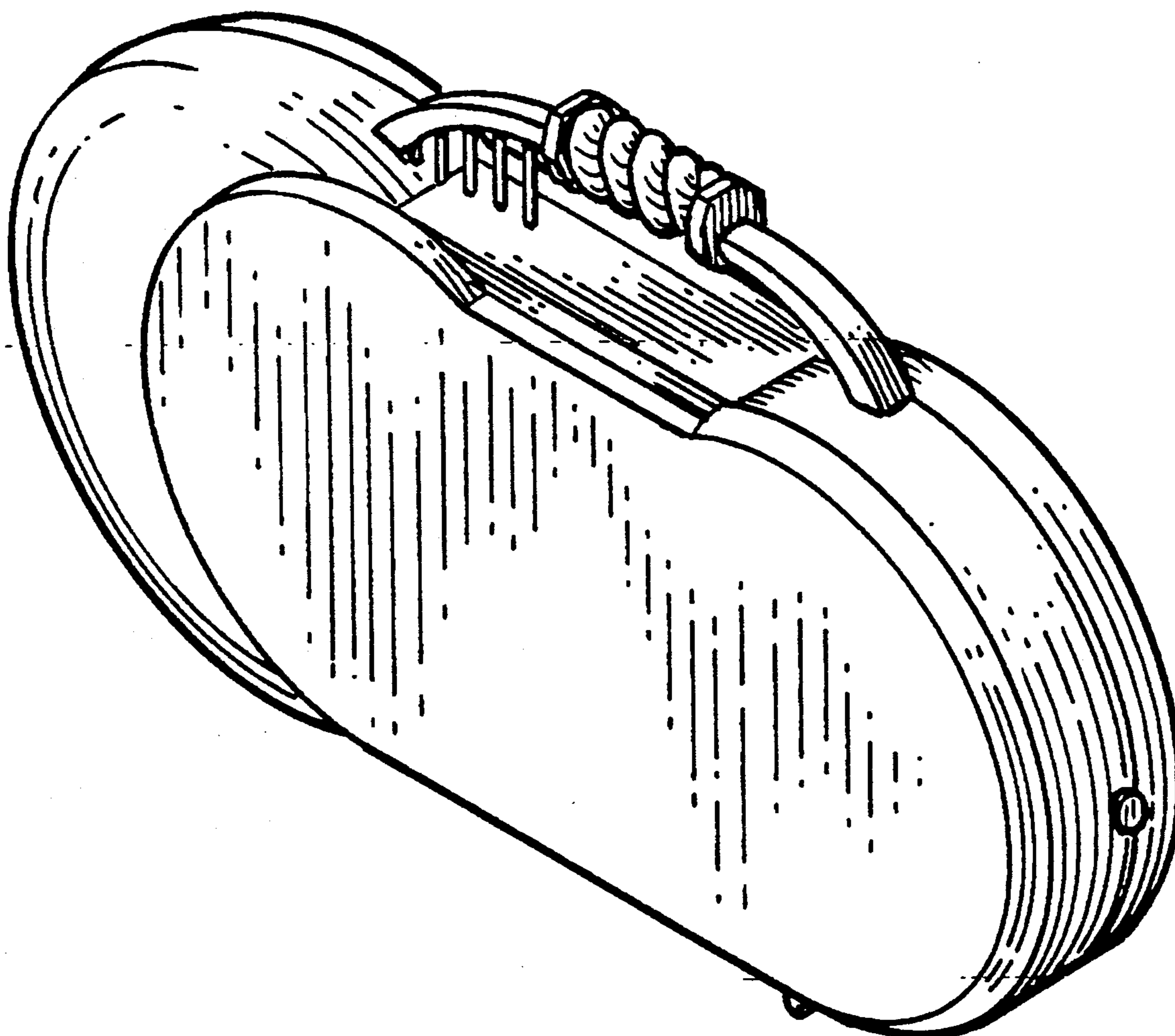

The ornamental design for a tennis travel case, as shown.

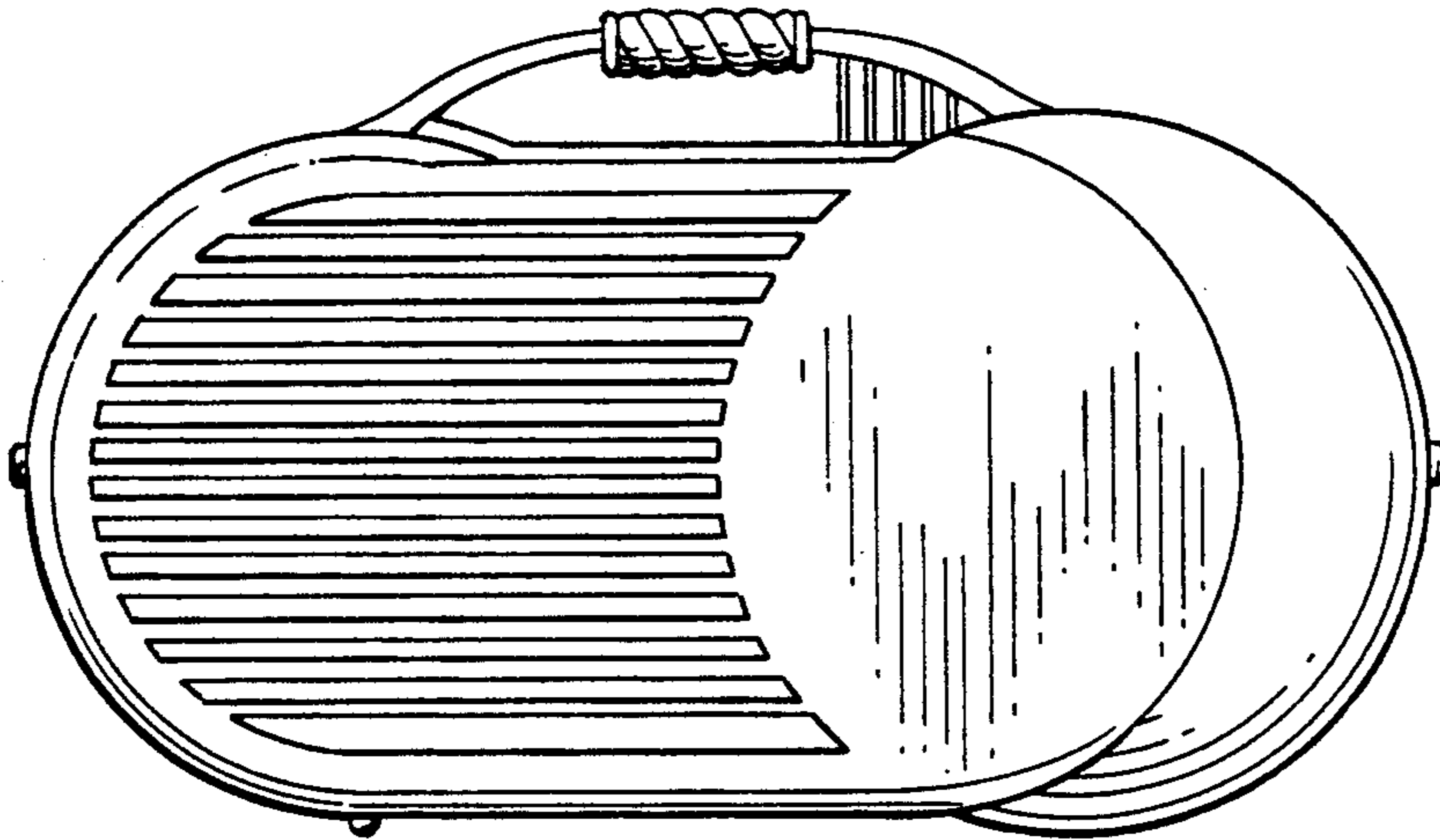
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 7 is a rear left side perspective view thereof.

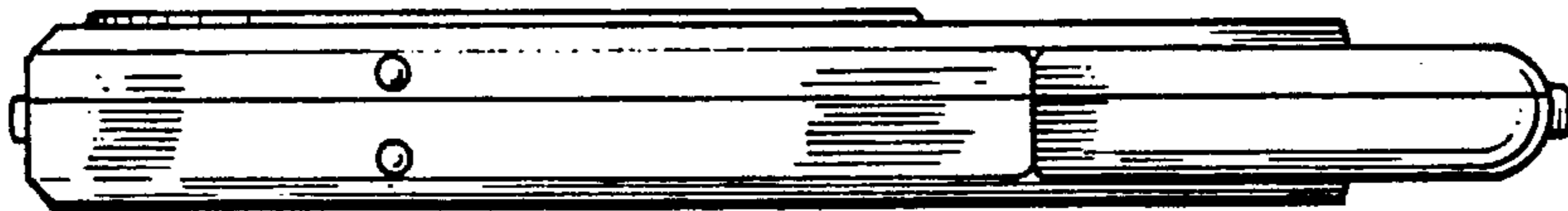




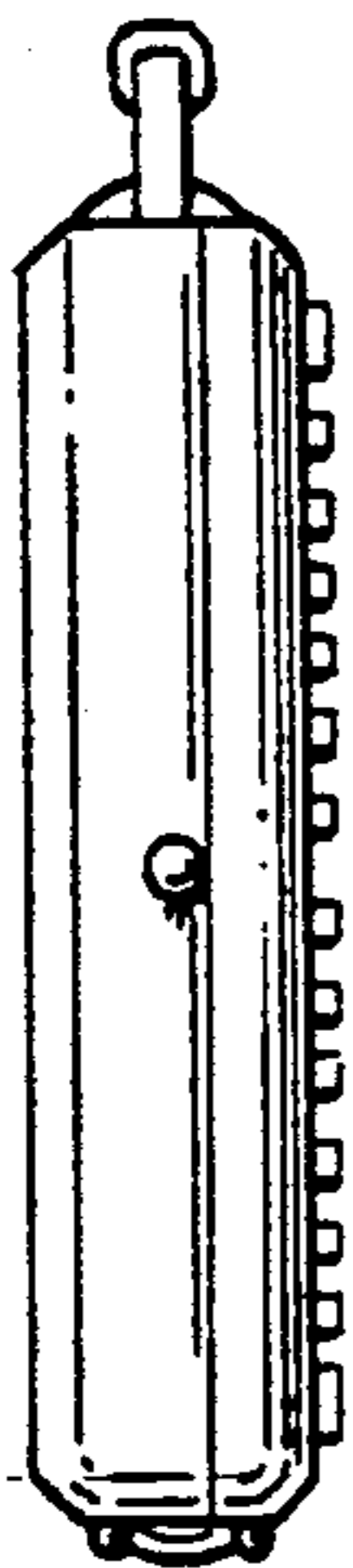

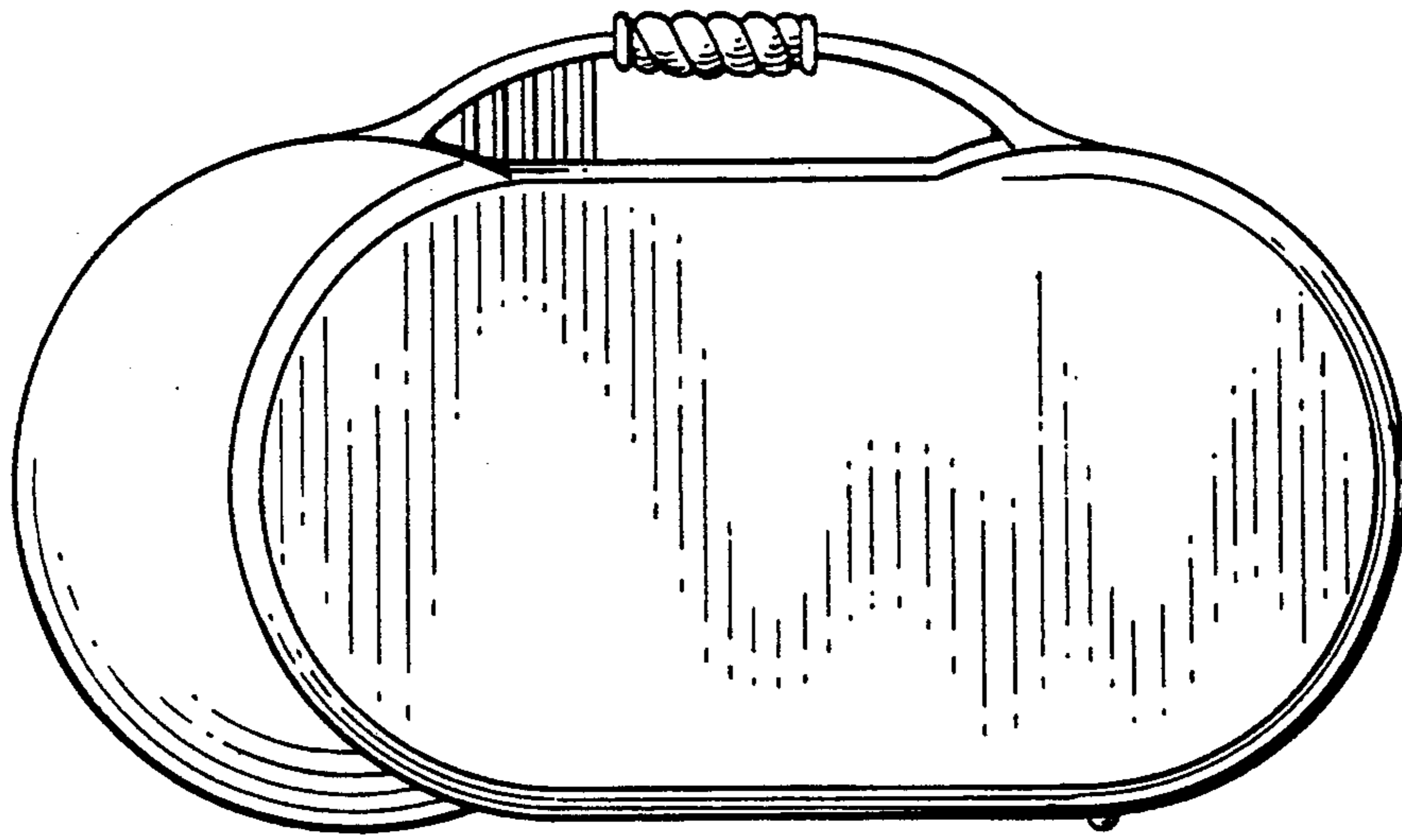

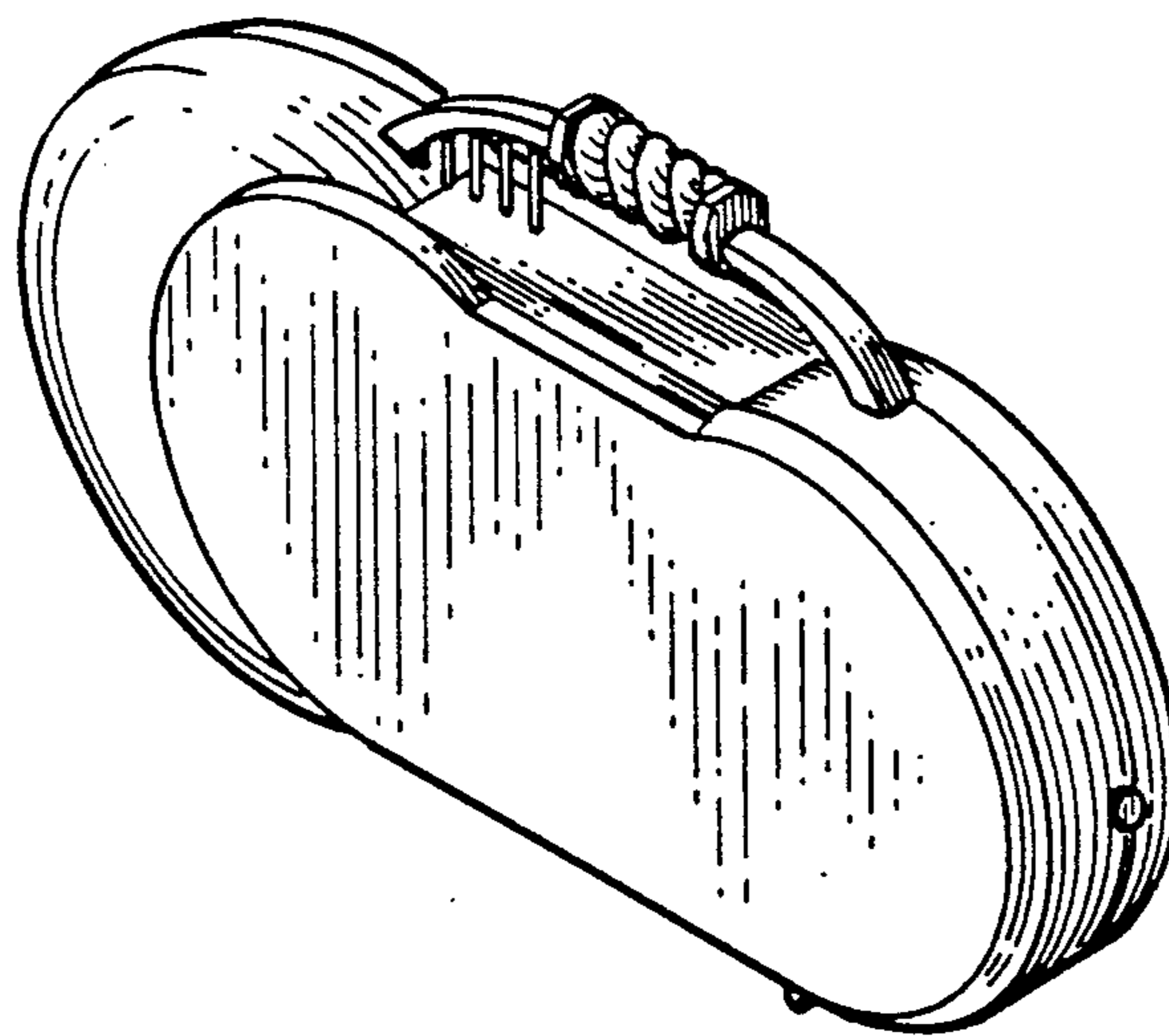
