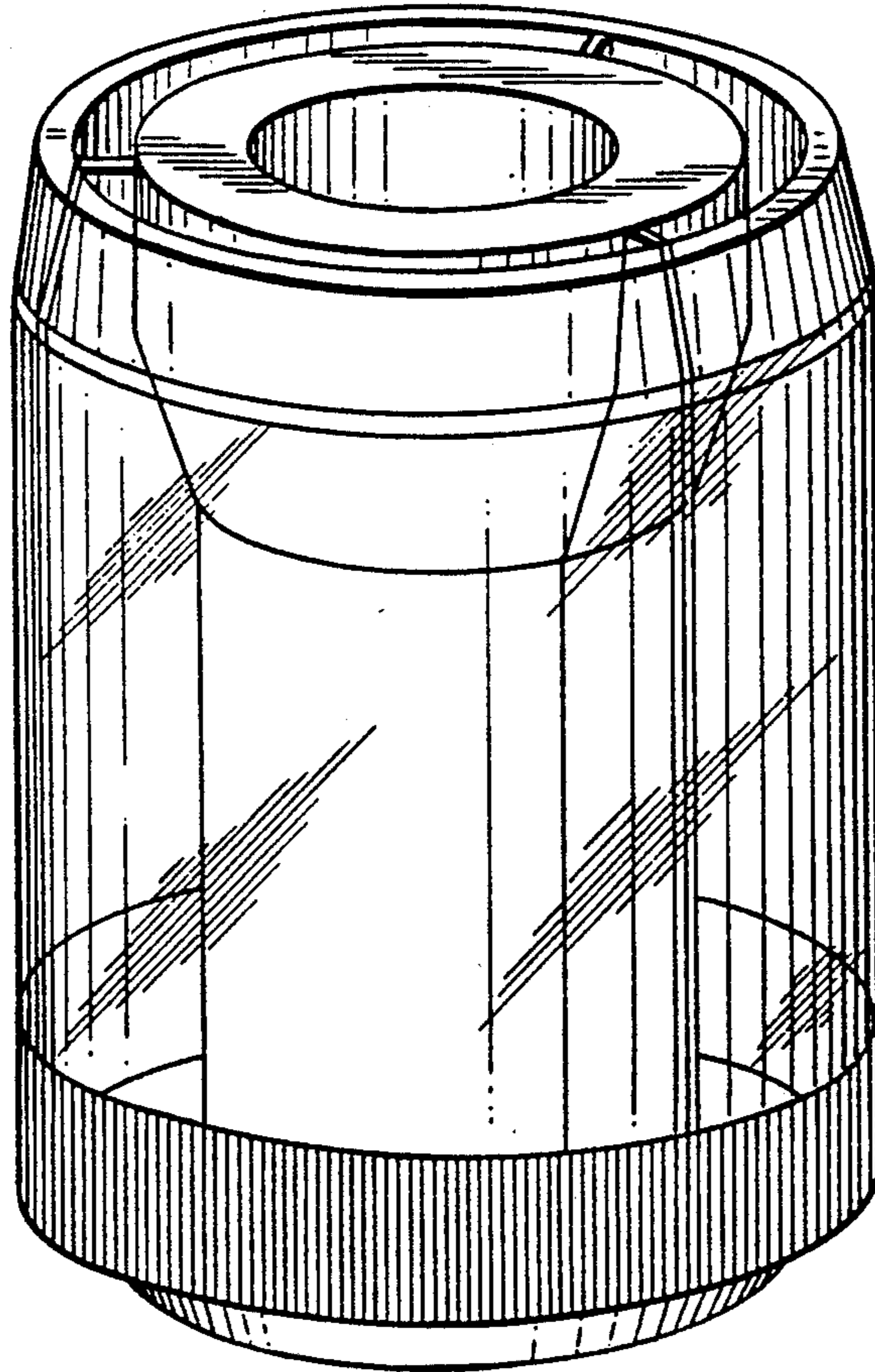

[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a container for magnetizable articles, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a container for magnetizable articles showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a top plan view;
FIG. 3 is a perspective view of my design, the paper-clips depicted by means of broken lines being shown for illustrative purposes only and forming no part of the claimed design;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view; and
FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



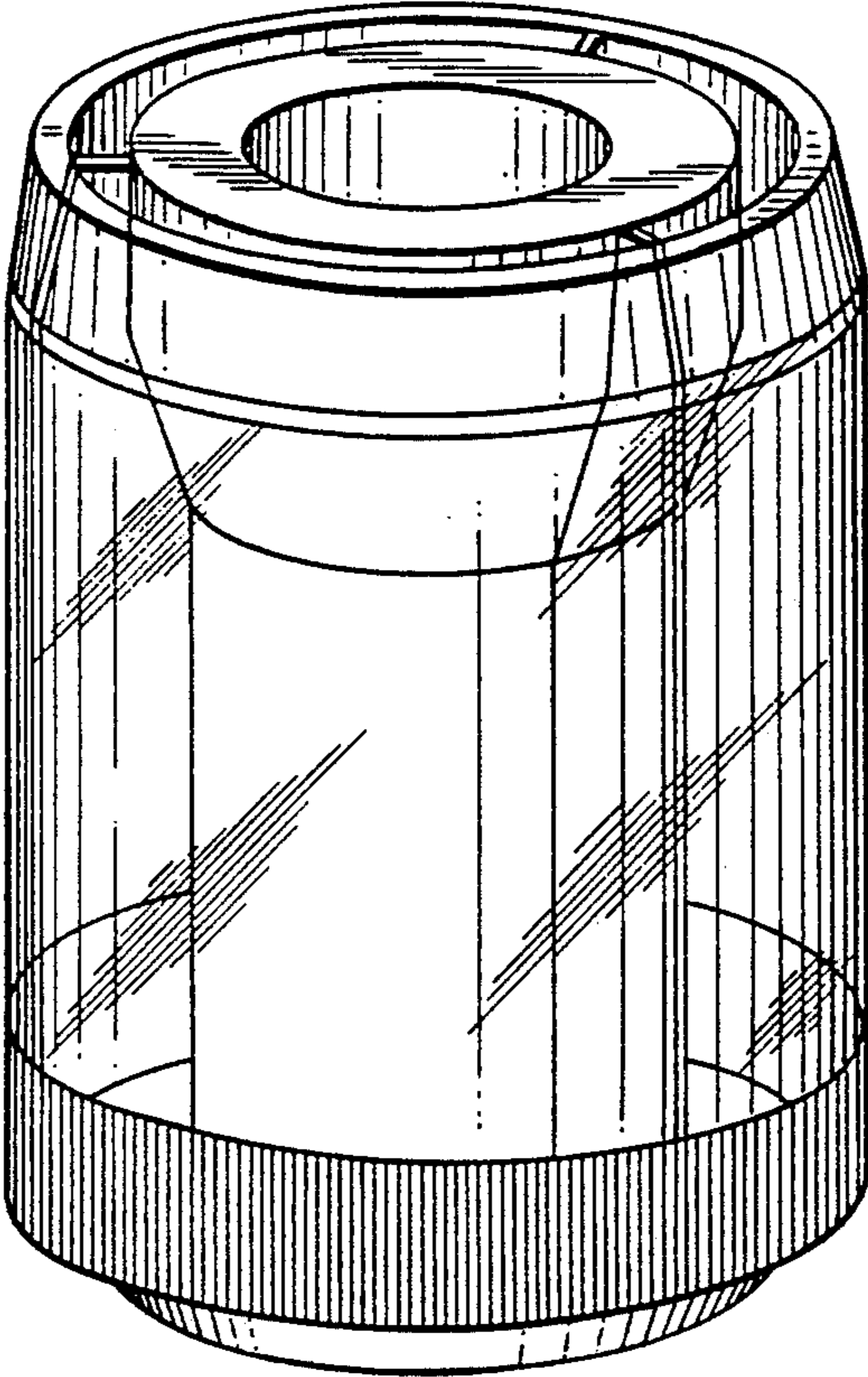

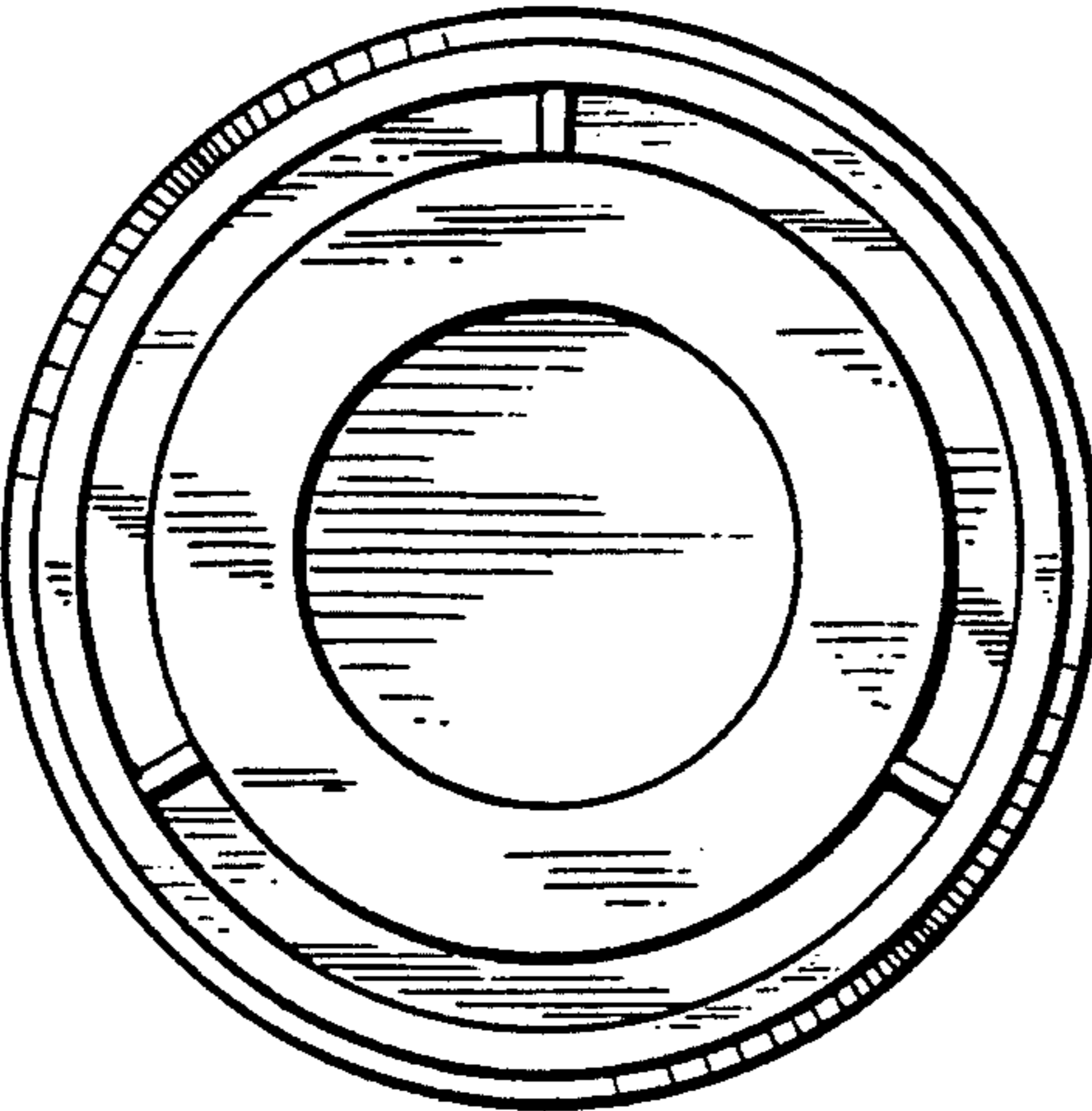

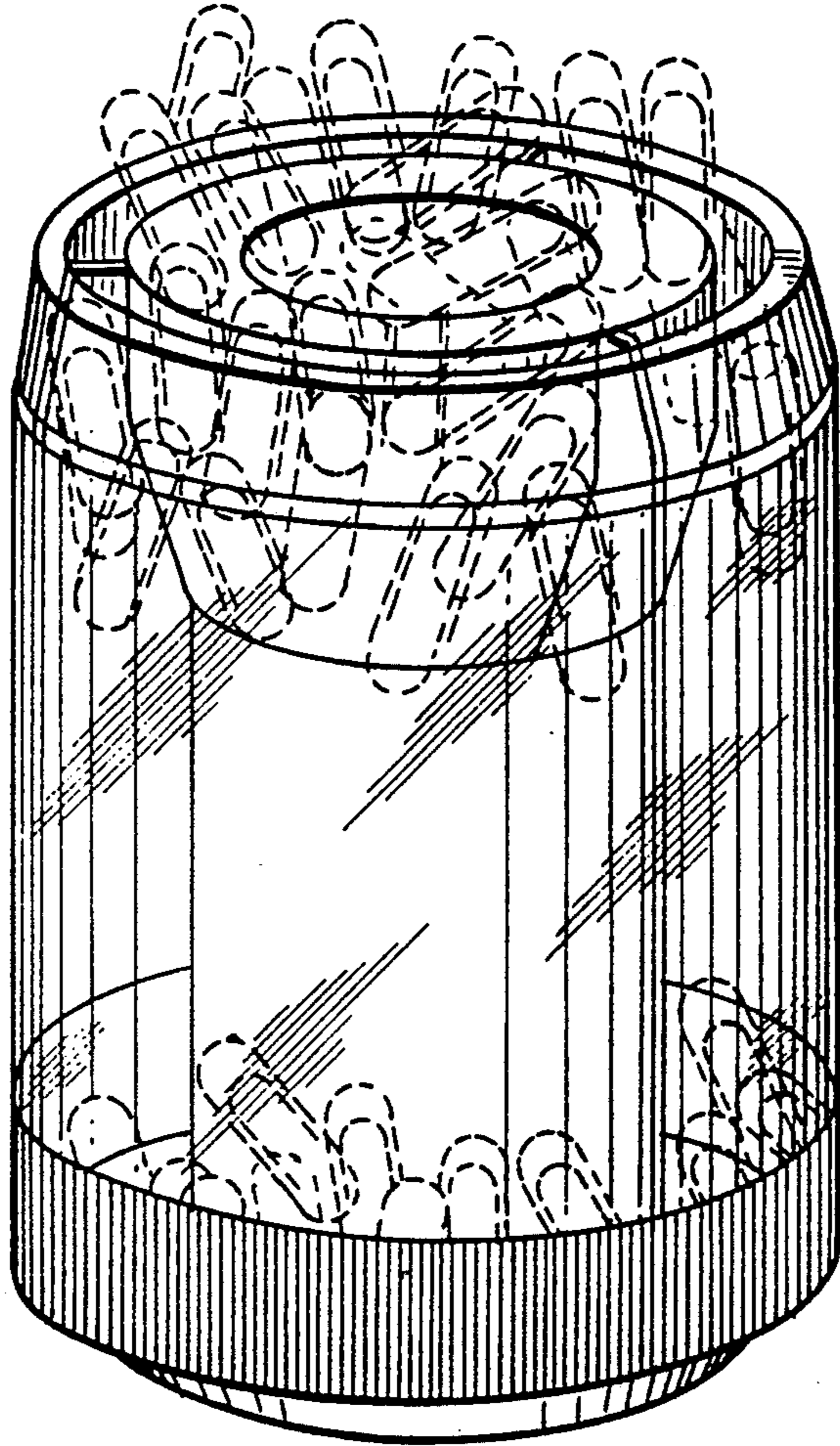

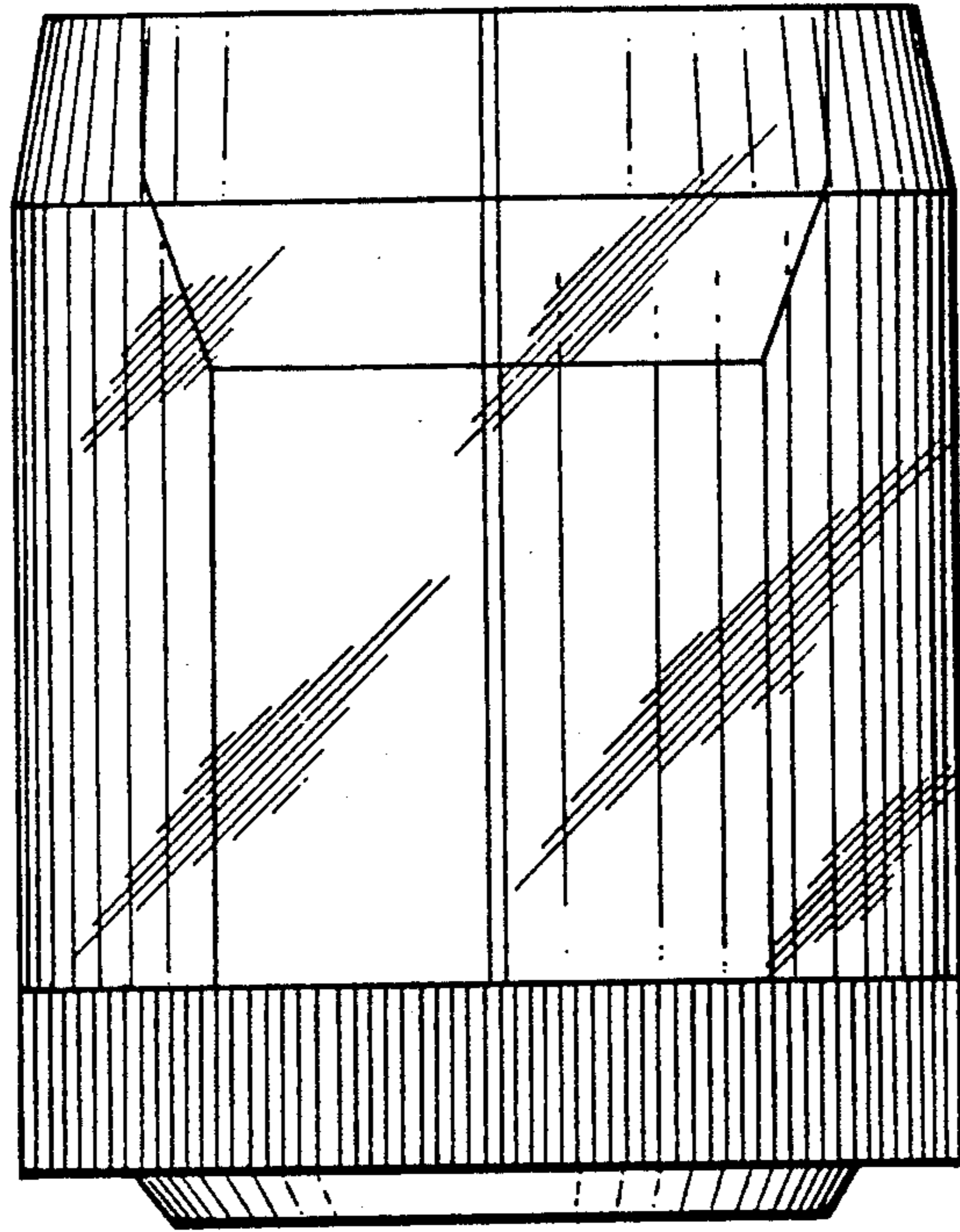

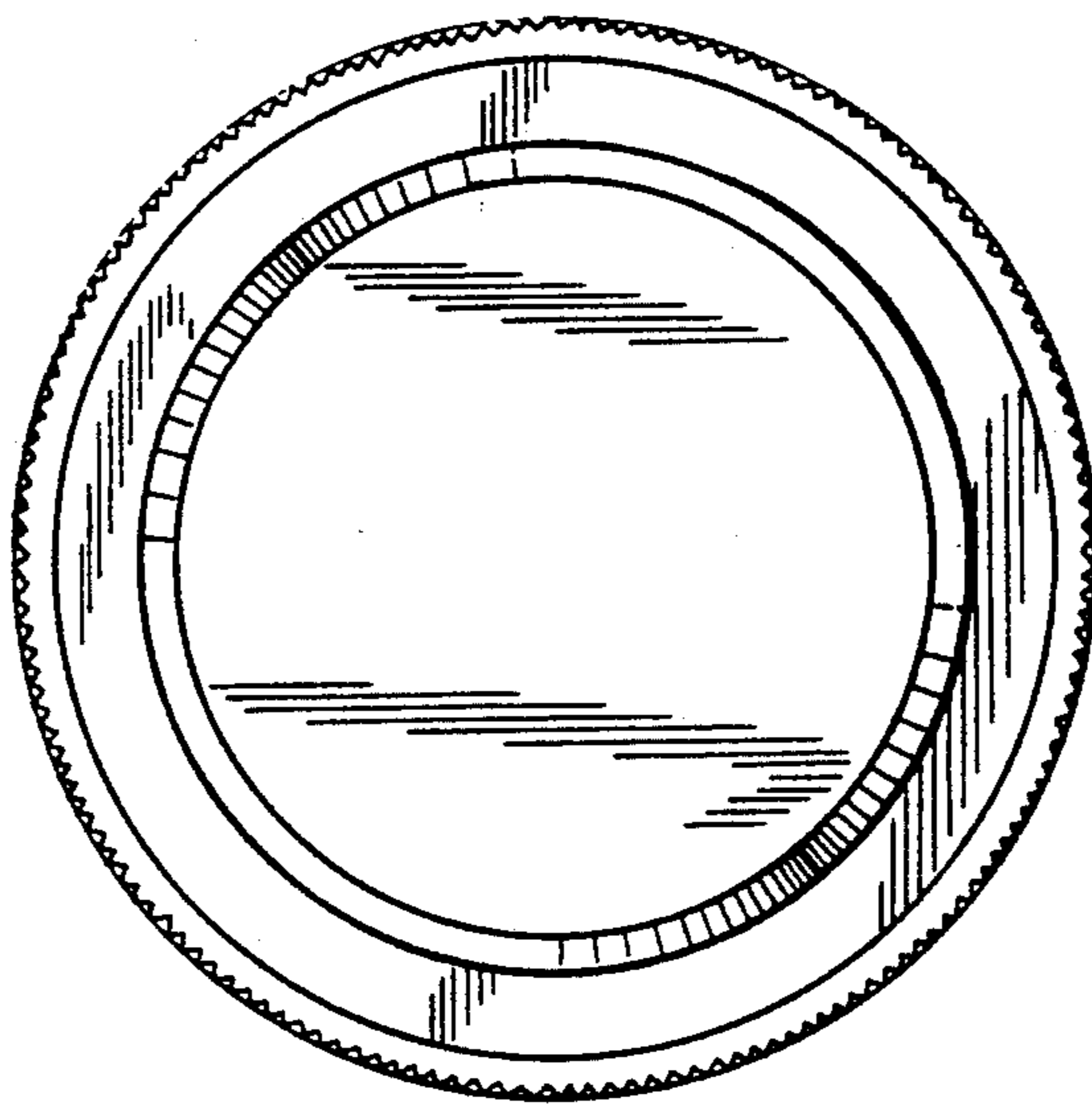
