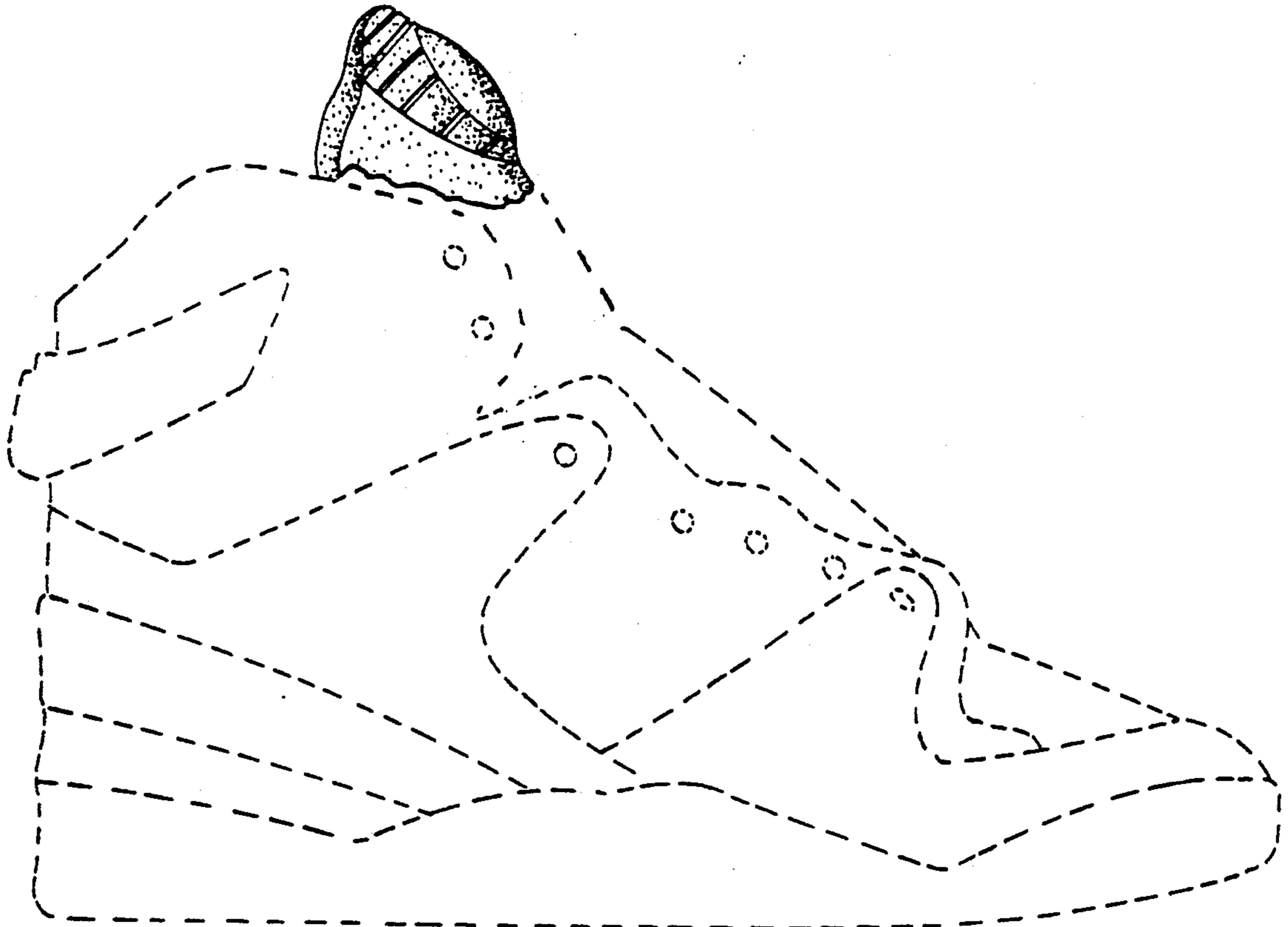
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for an element of a shoe upper, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an element of a shoe upper showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.

The broken line showing of the shoe in the FIGS. is environmental only and forms no part of the claimed design.



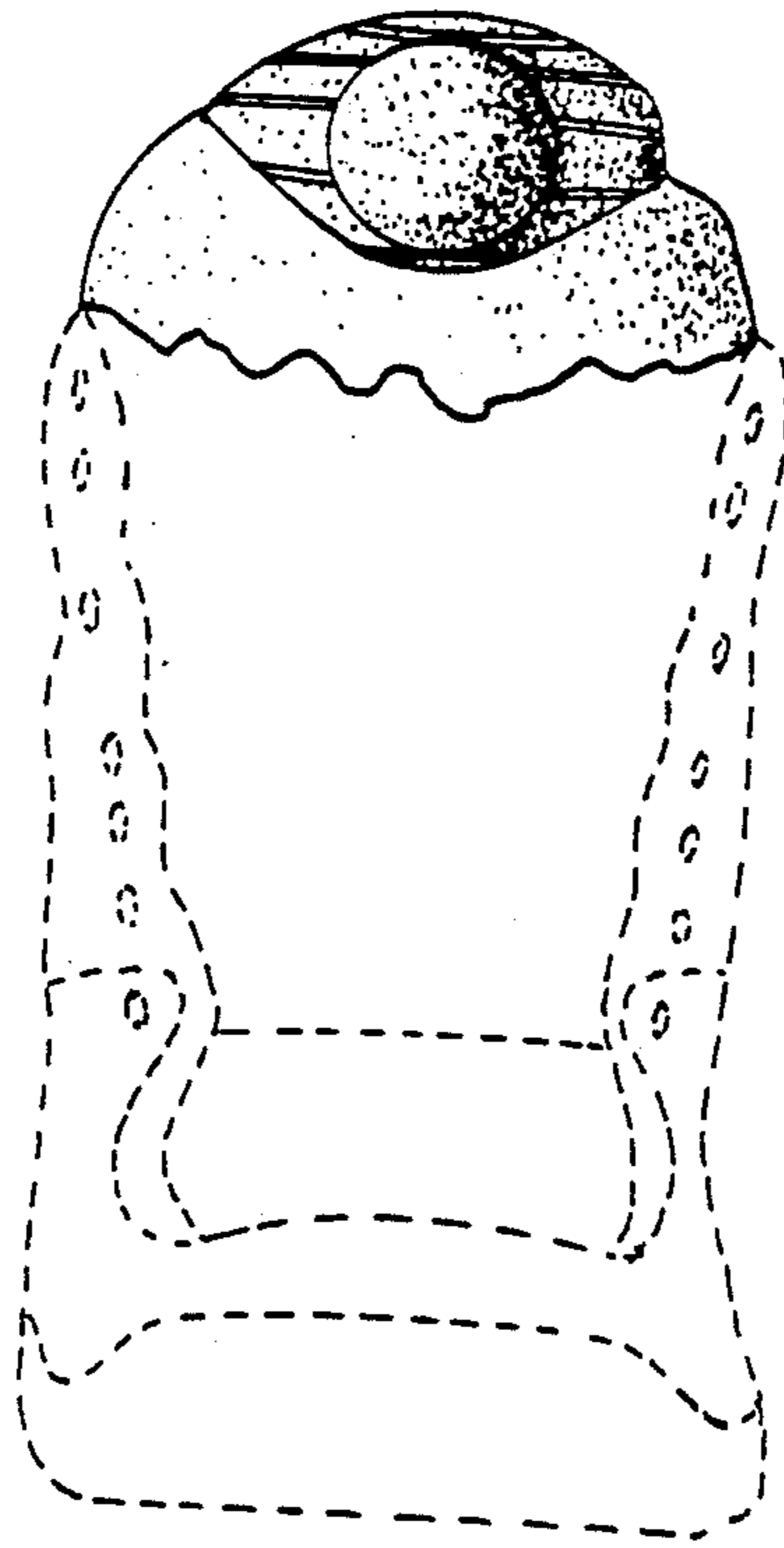

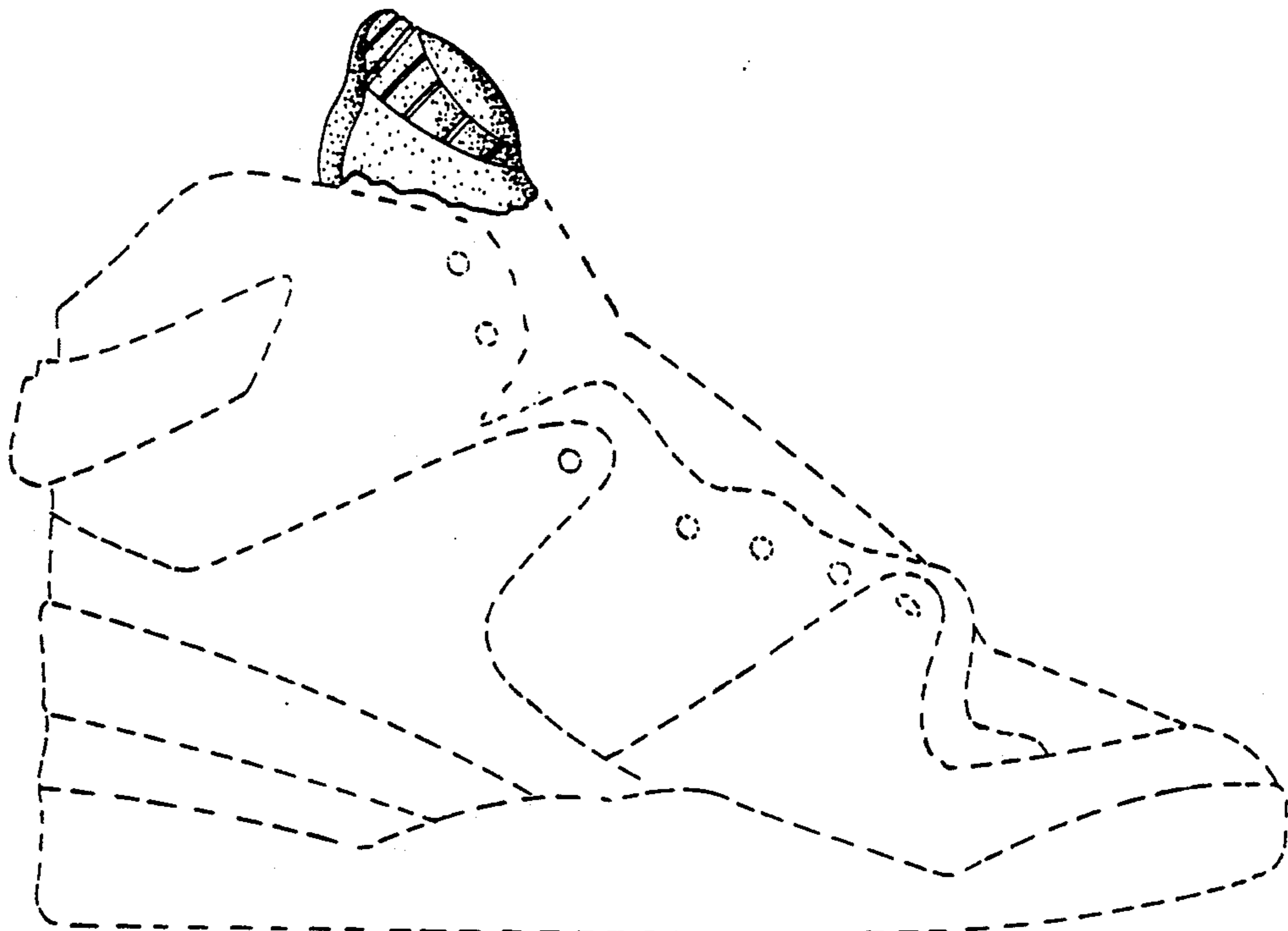

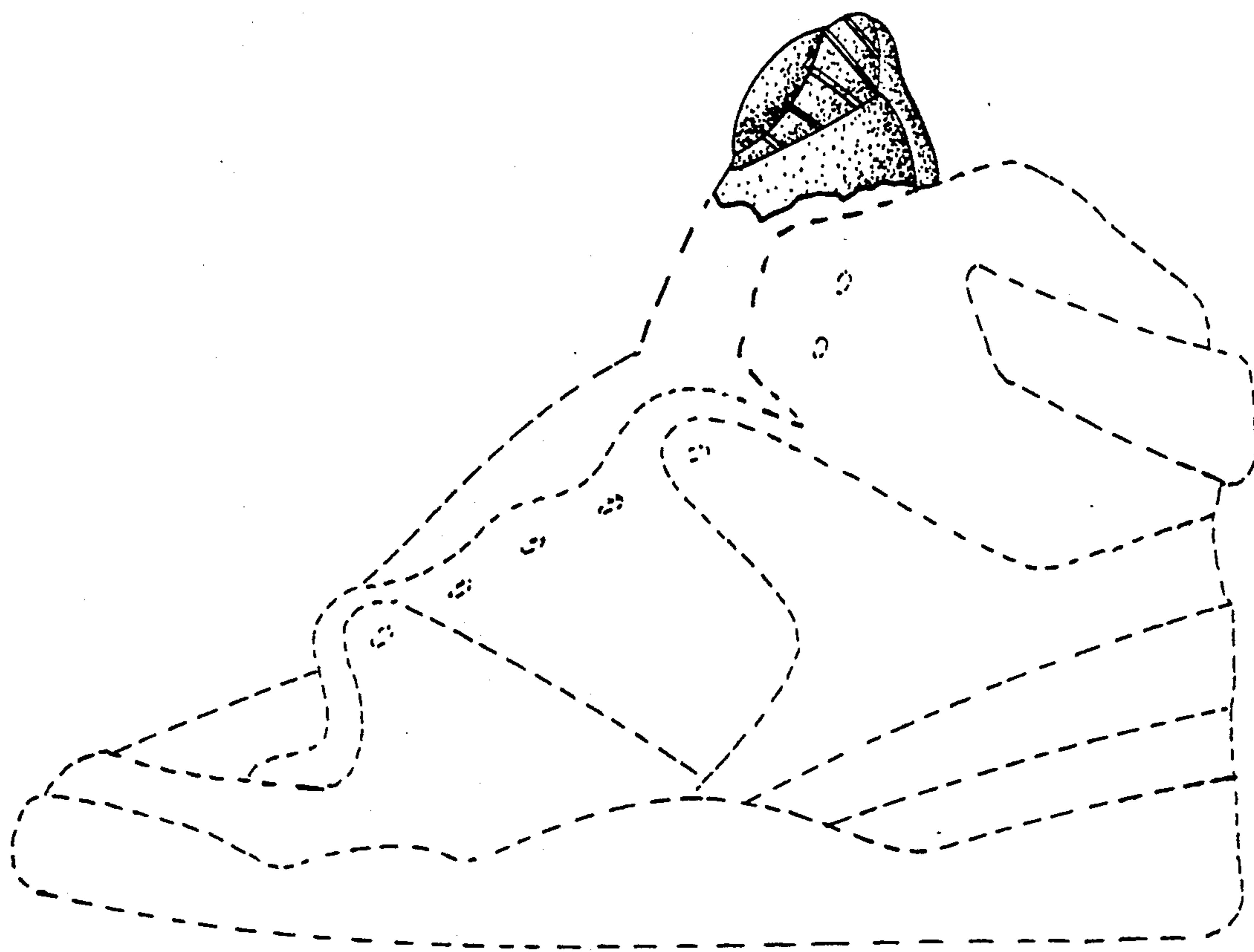

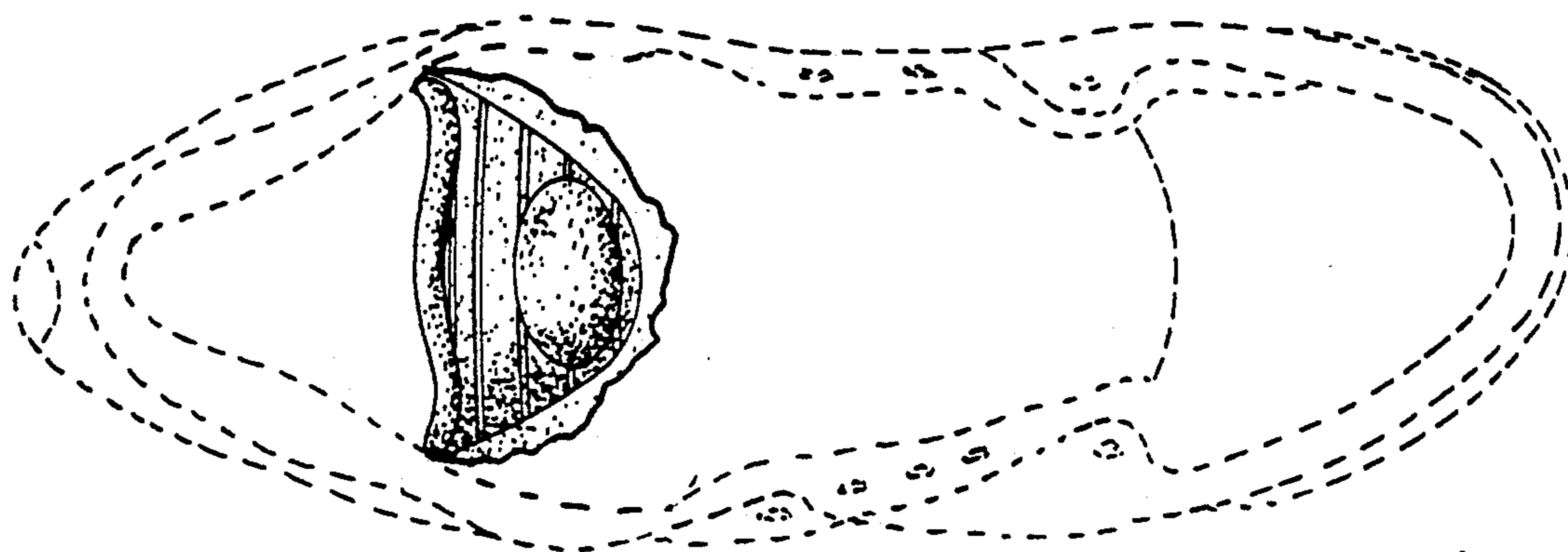

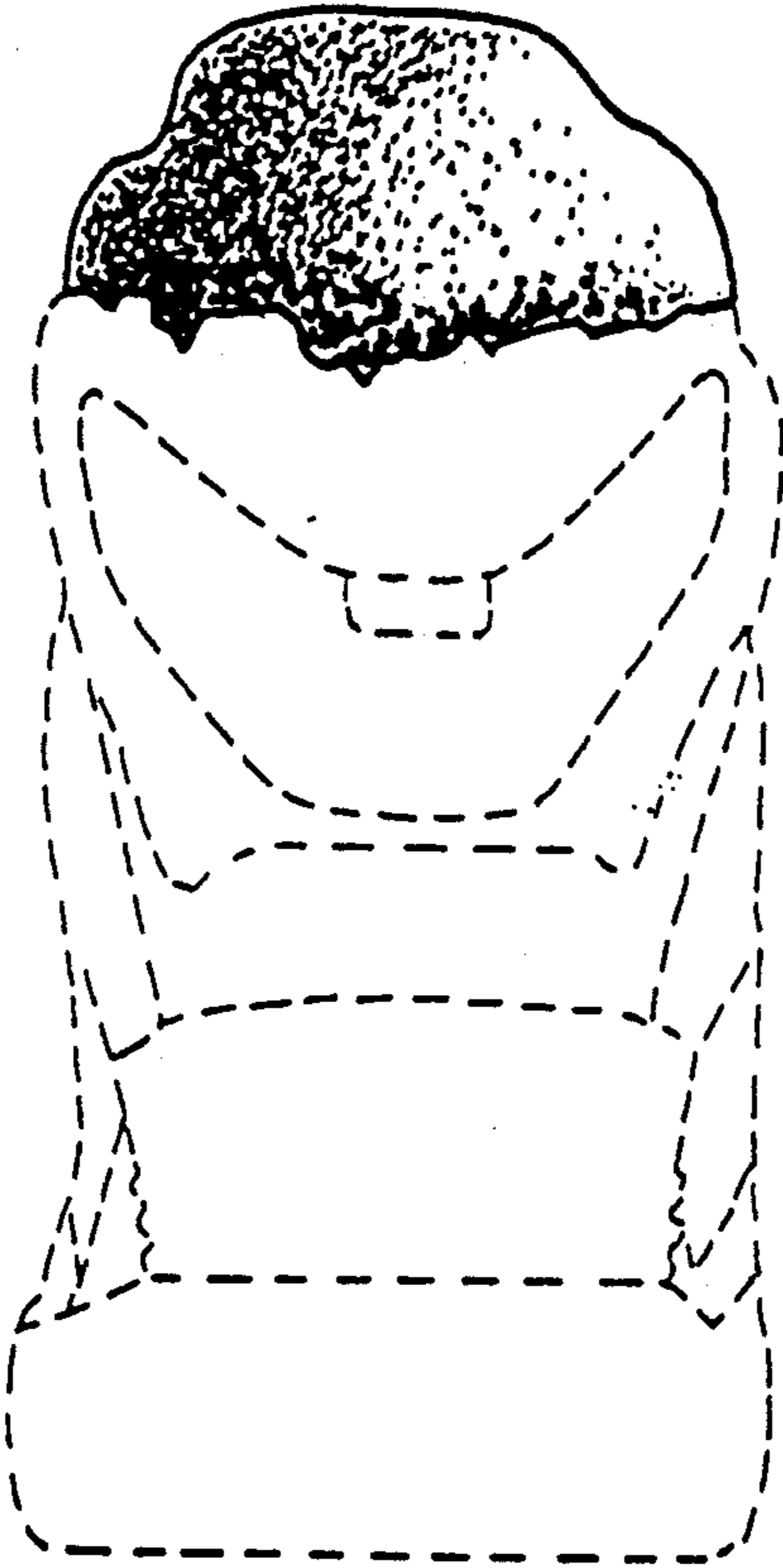
