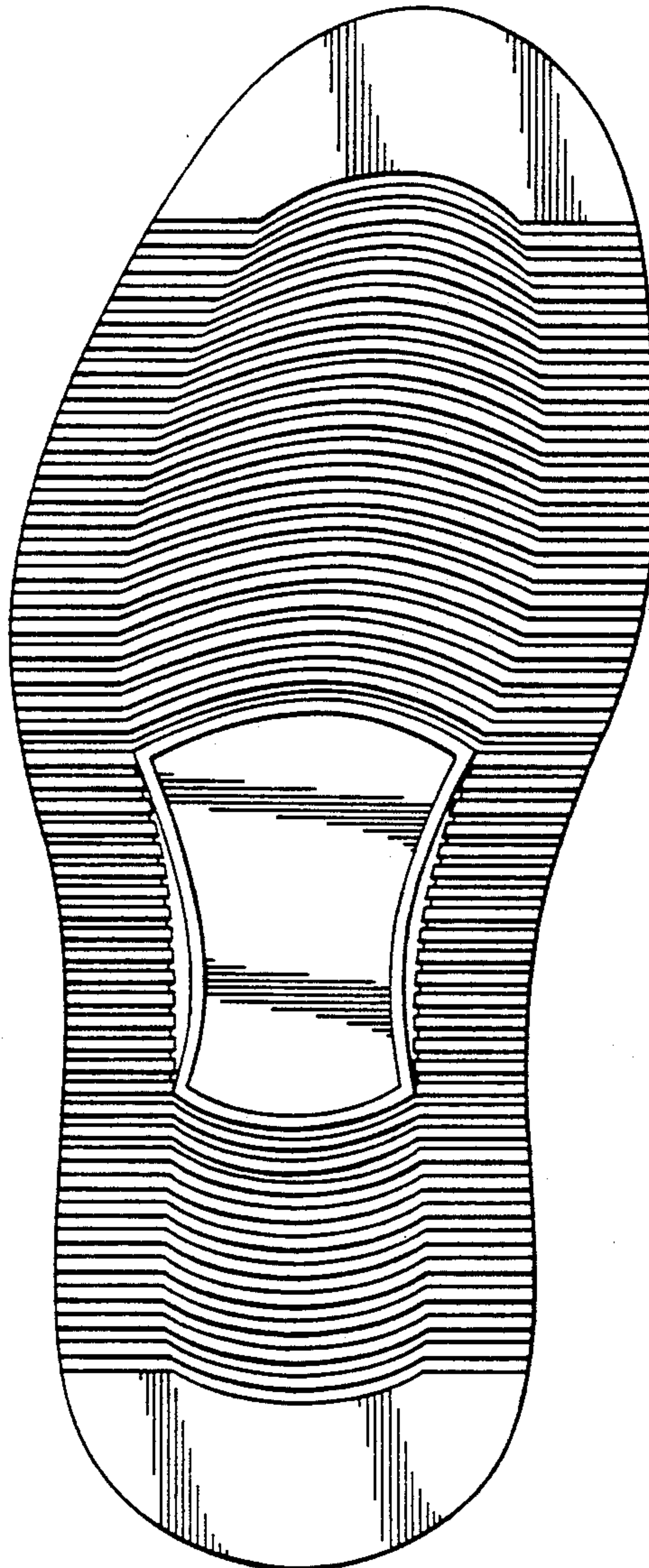

FIG. 4 is a rear side elevational view thereof.



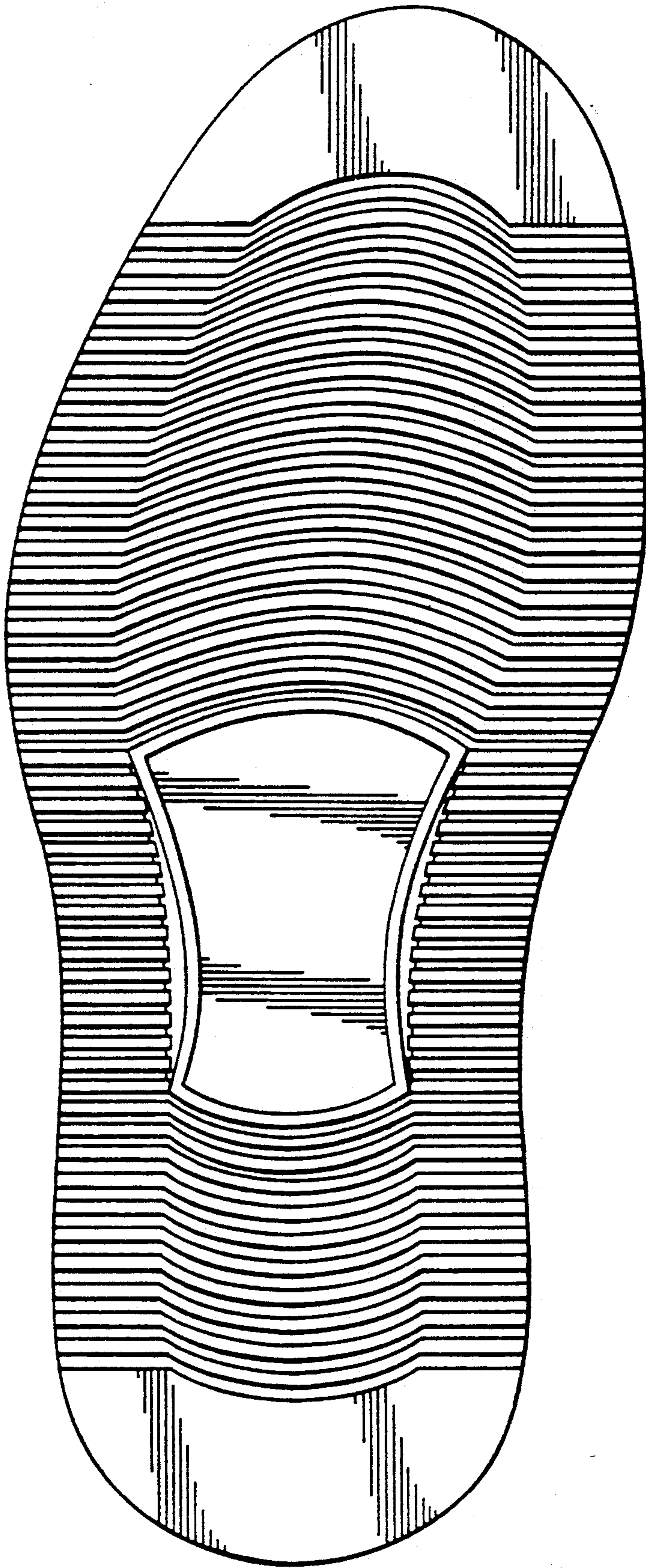

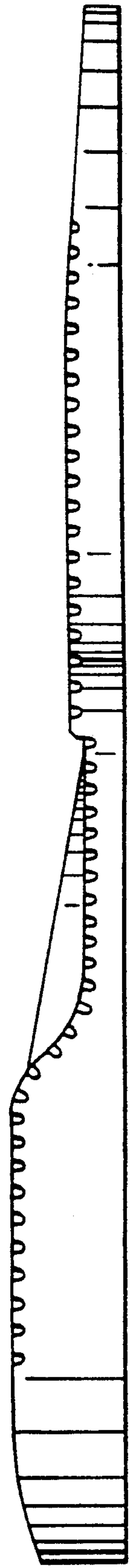

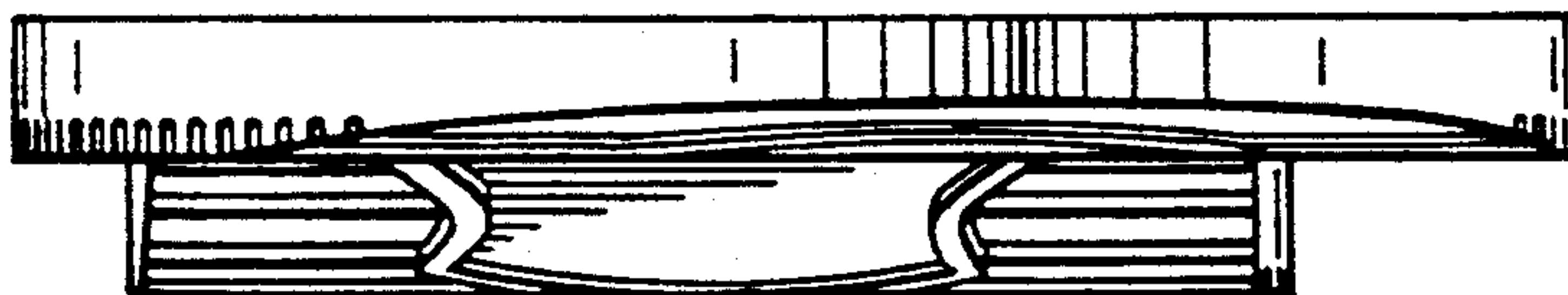
