FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; and

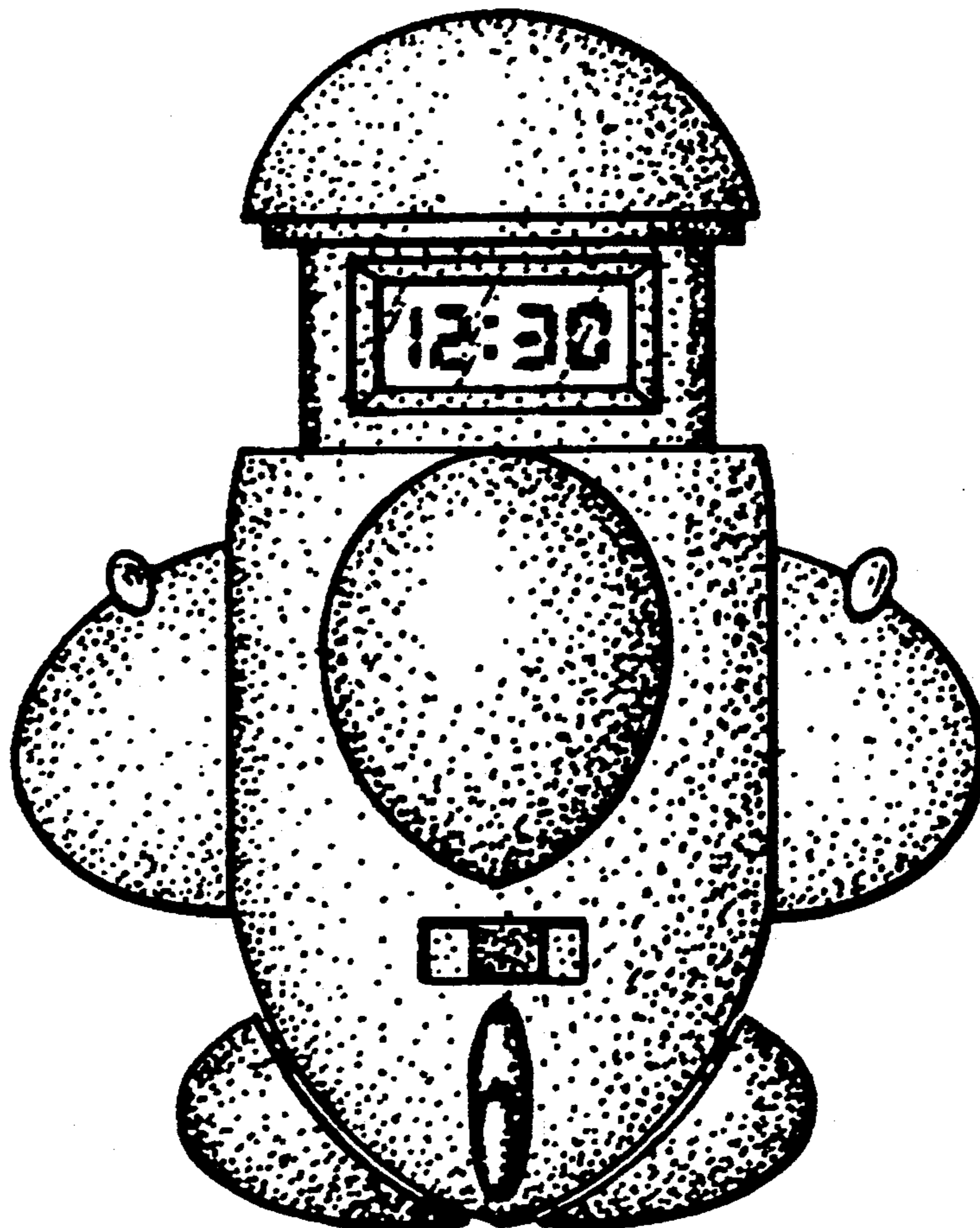
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof with the time readout in an open position.

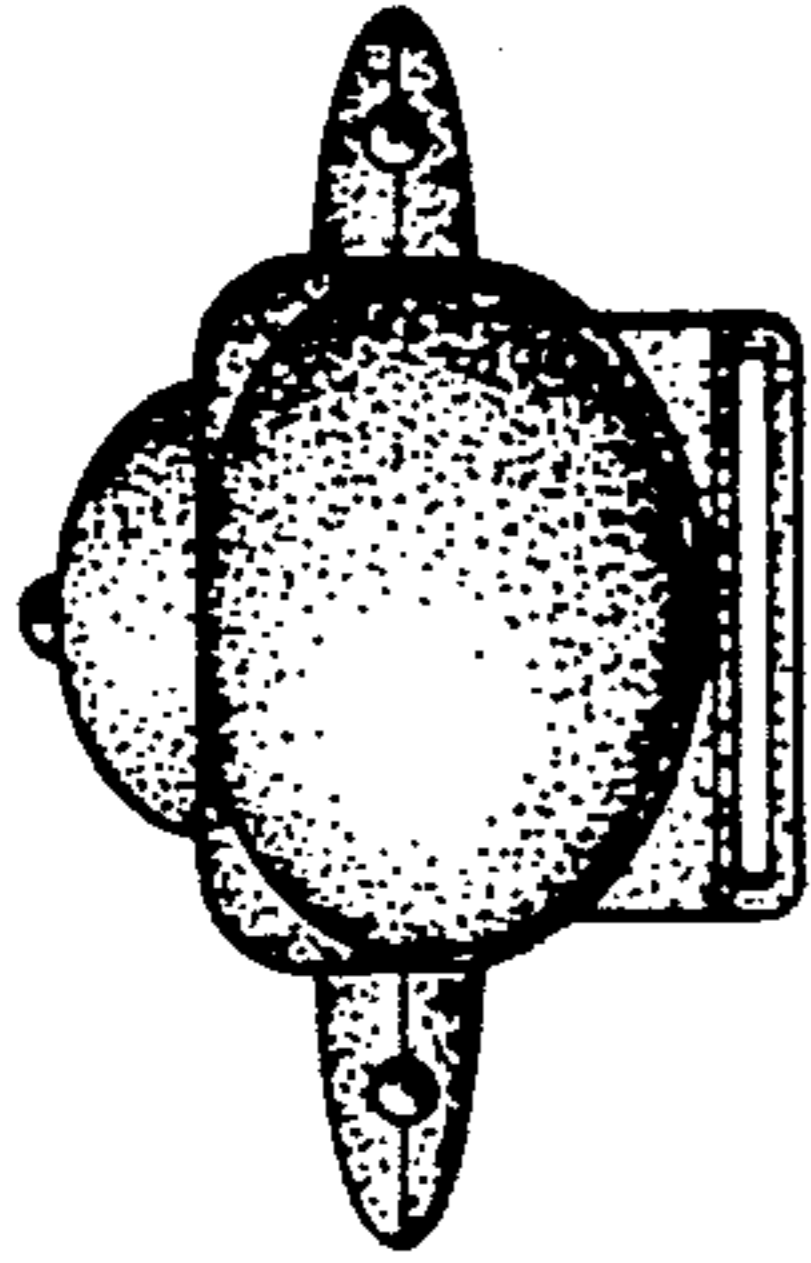

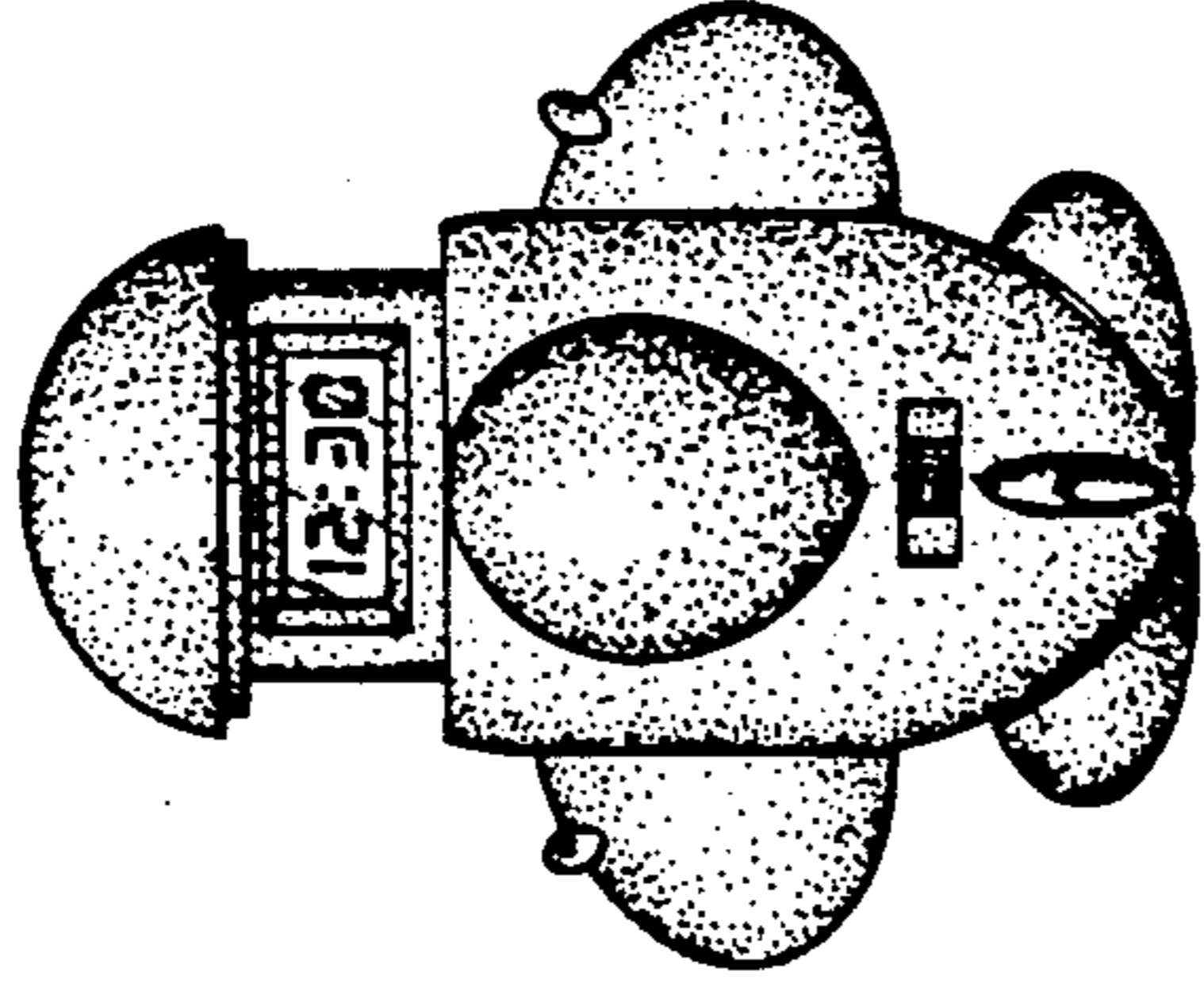

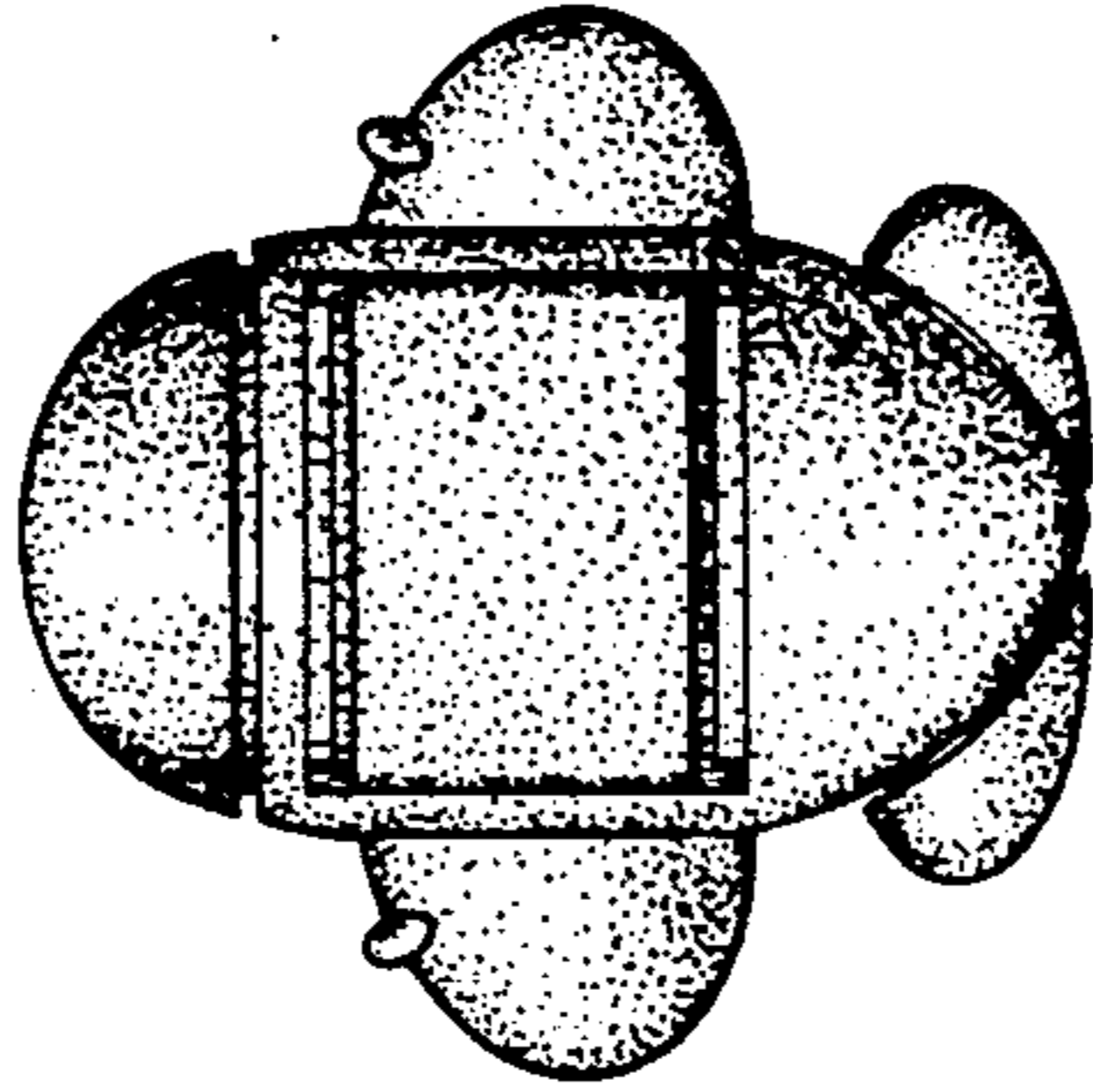

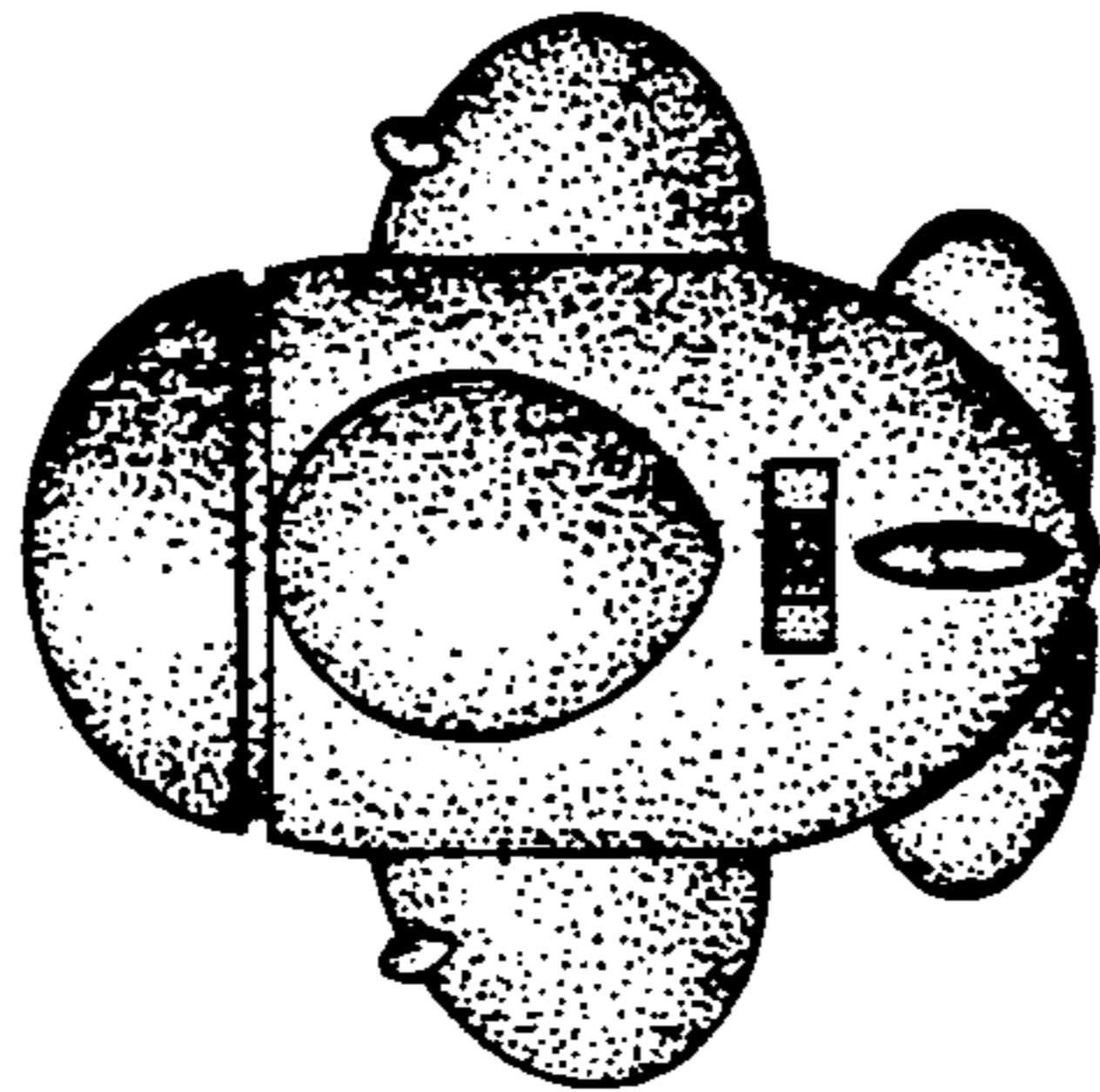

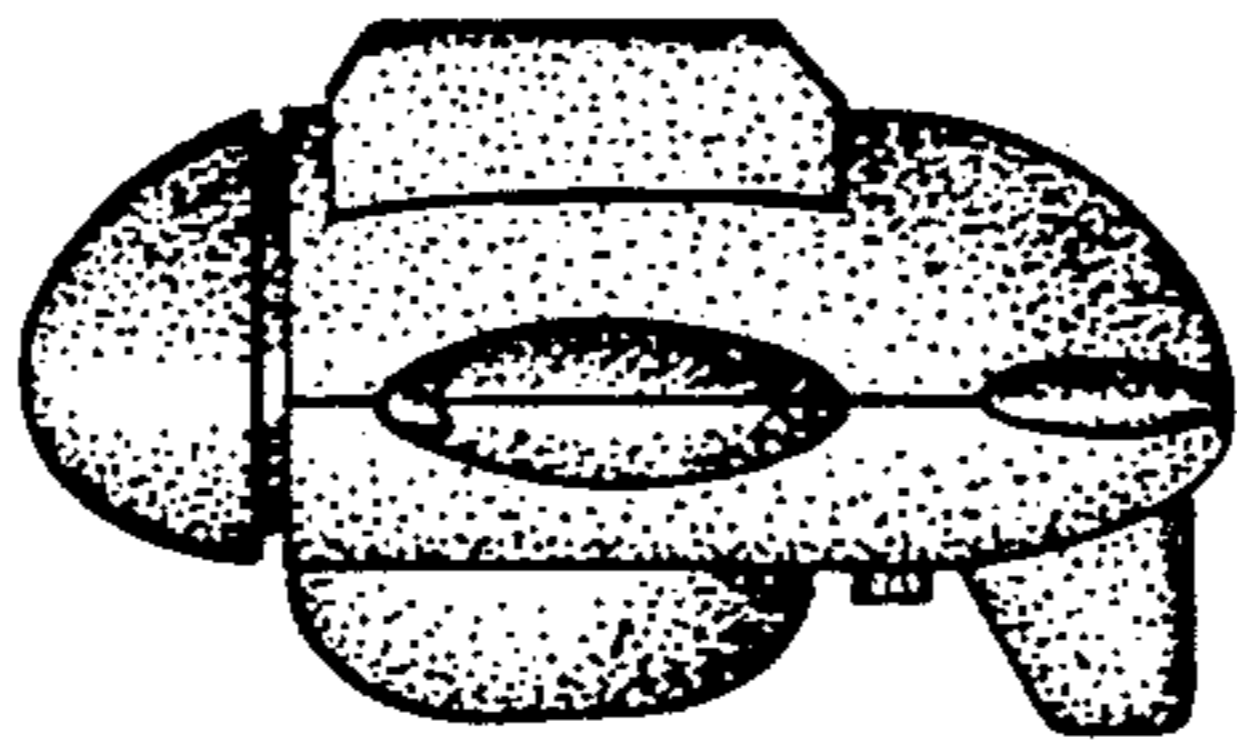

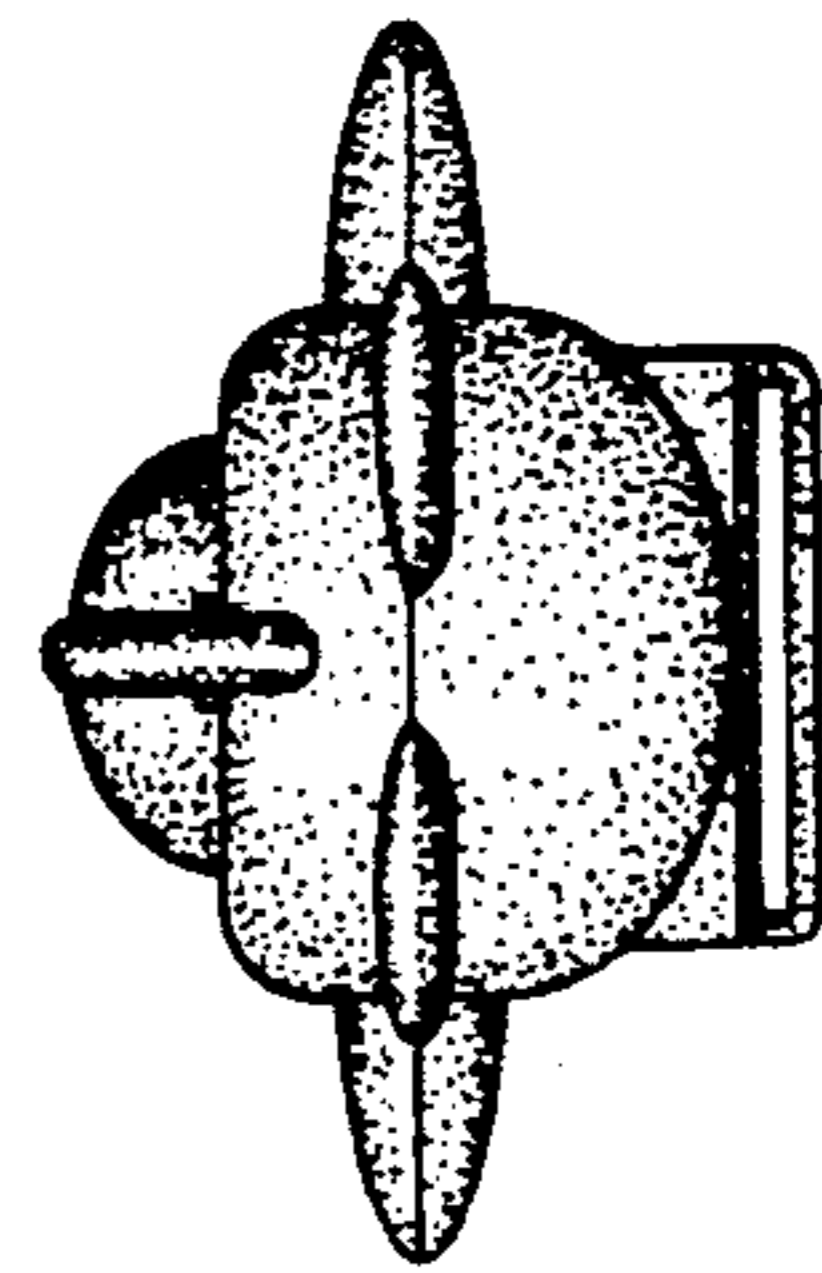
