FIG. 6 is a perspective view thereof on a reduced scale, it being understood that the broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design.

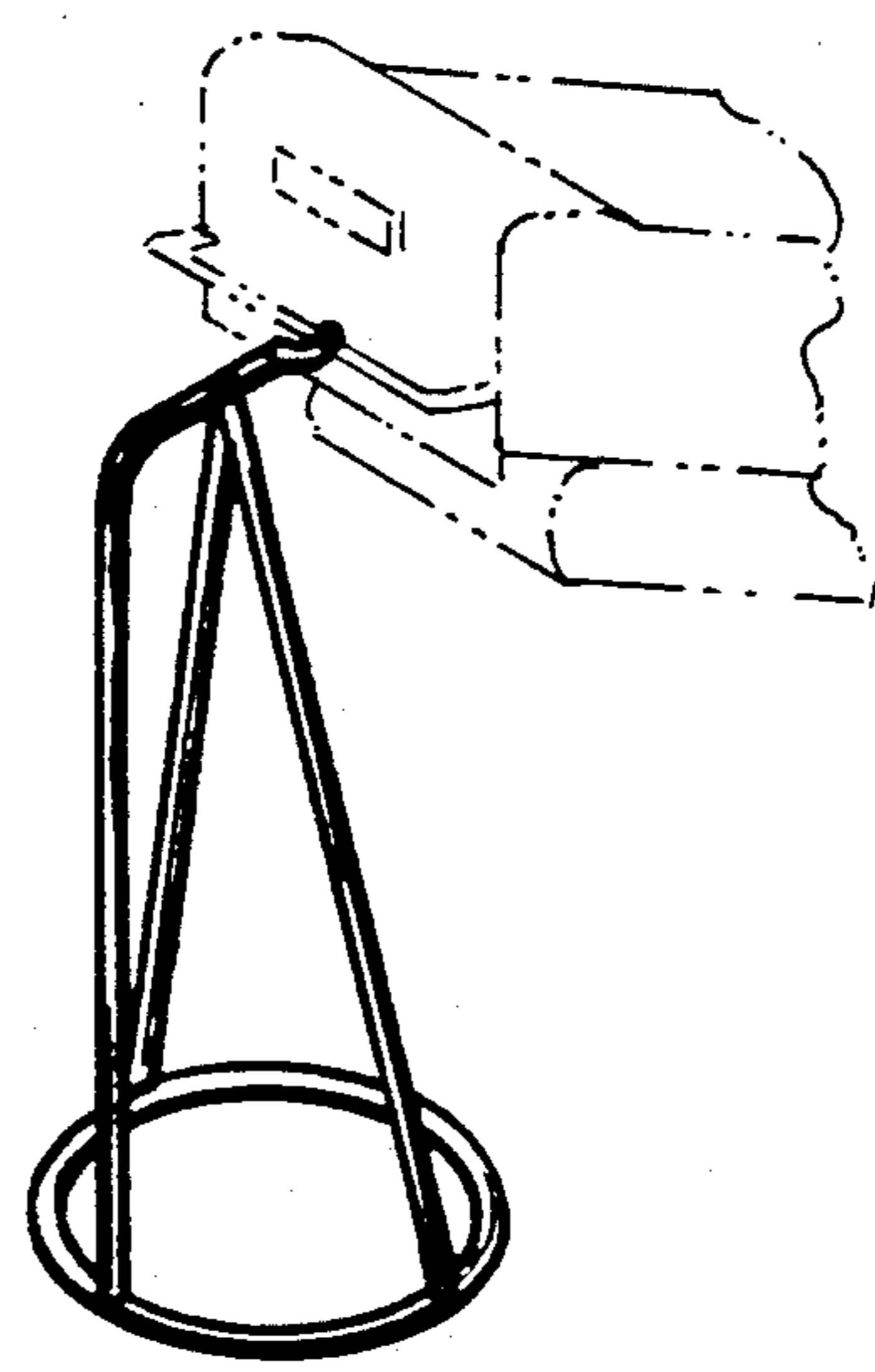

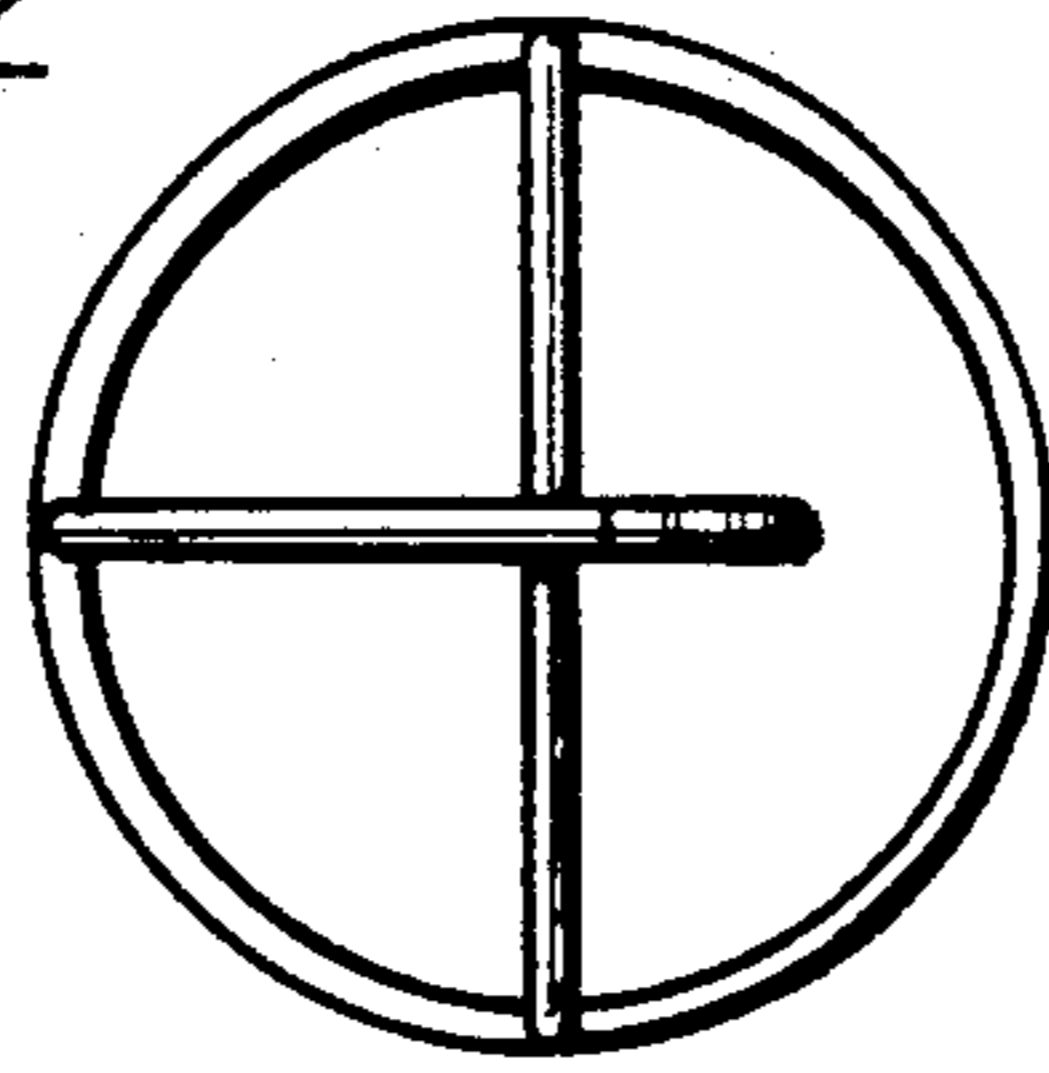

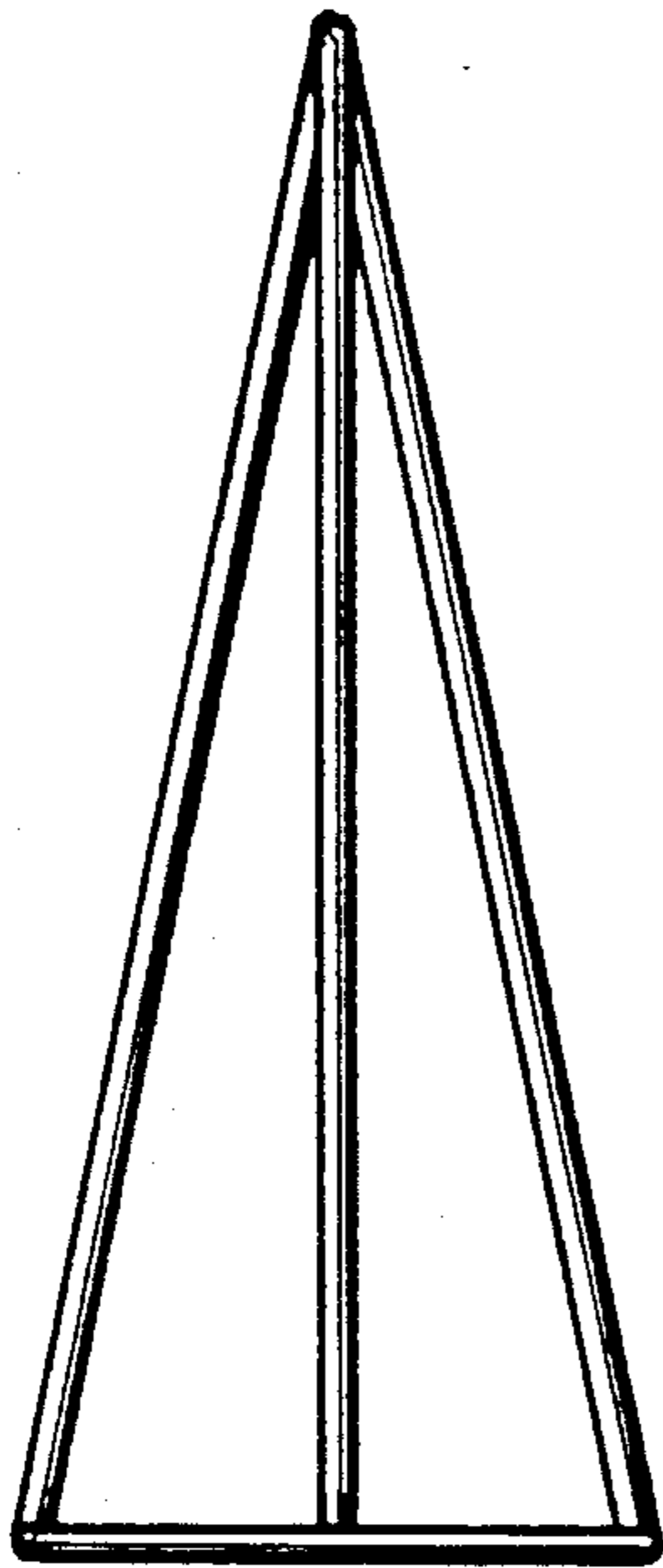

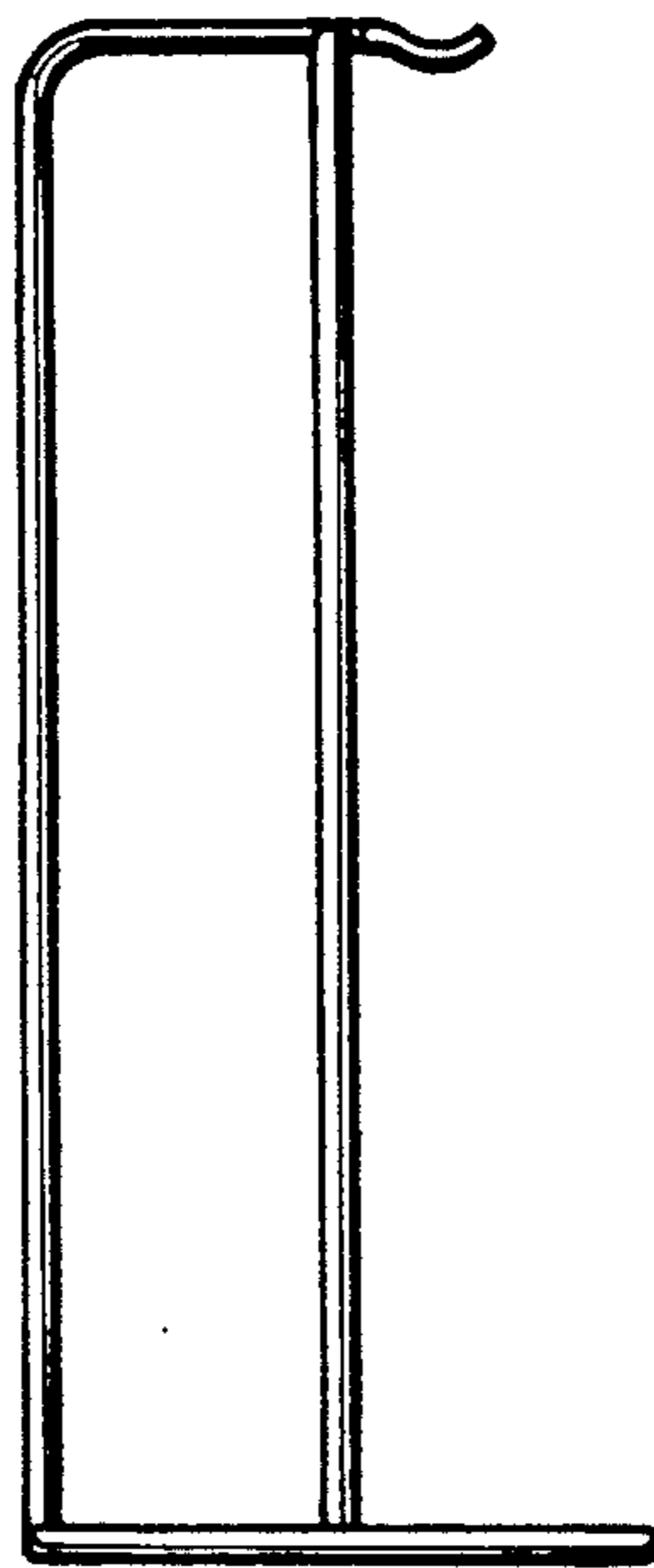

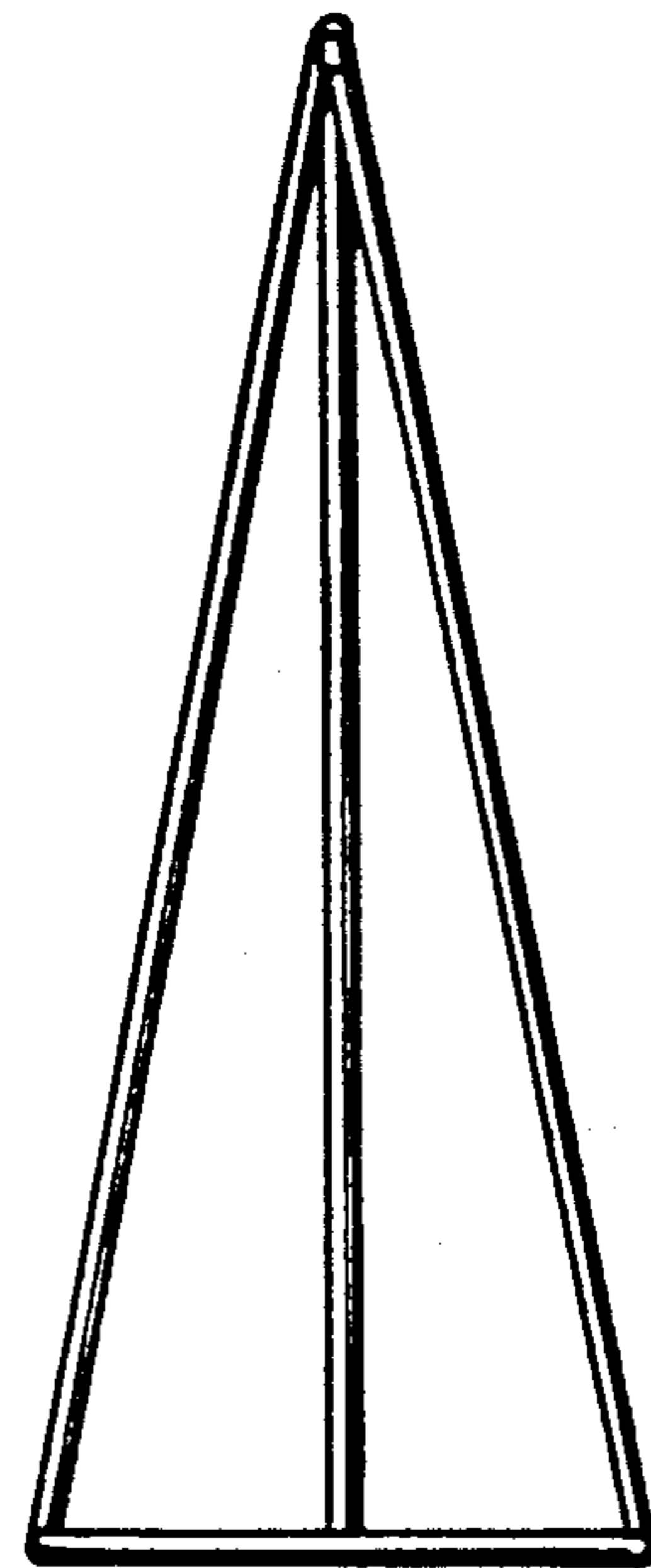

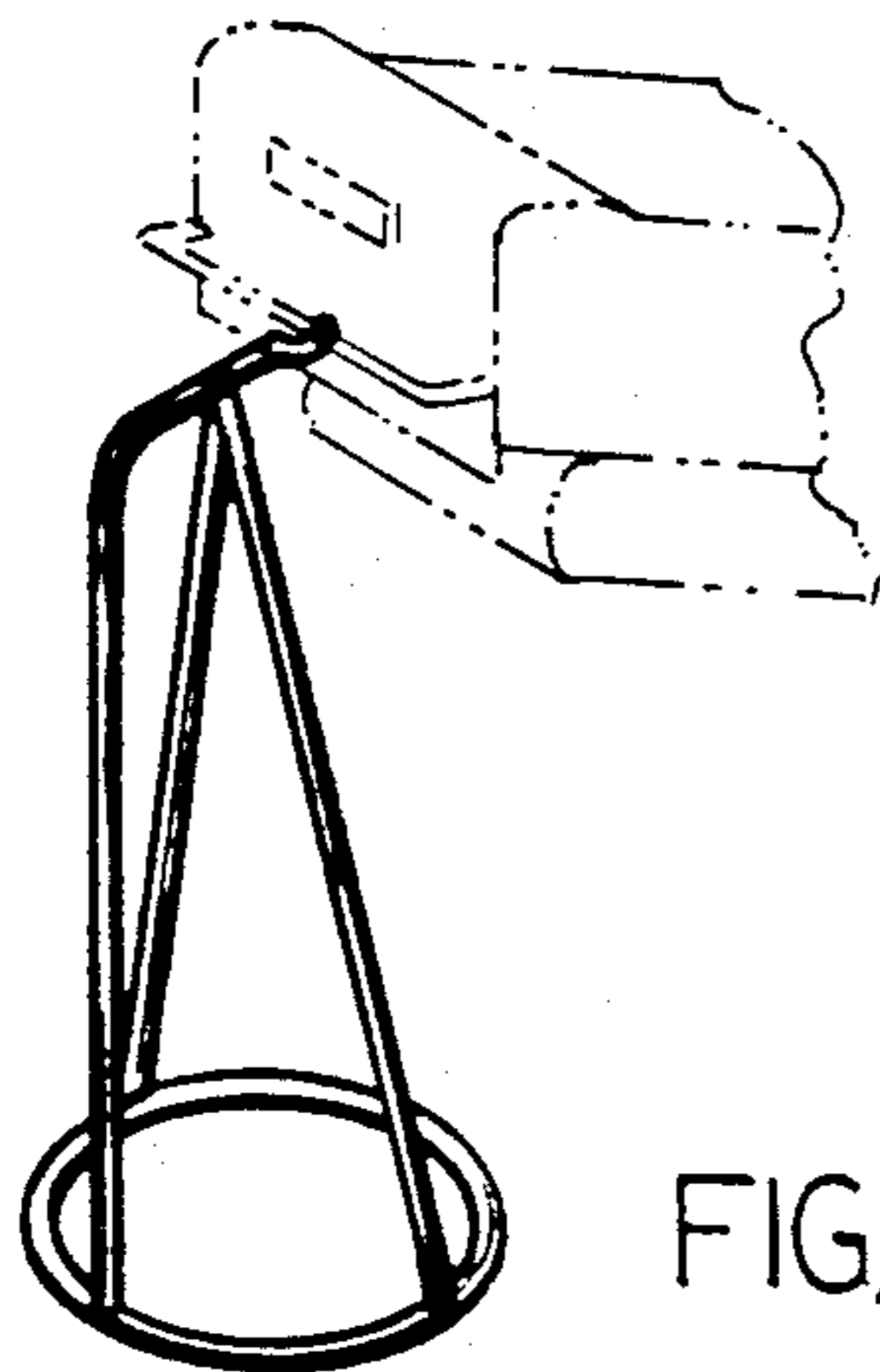
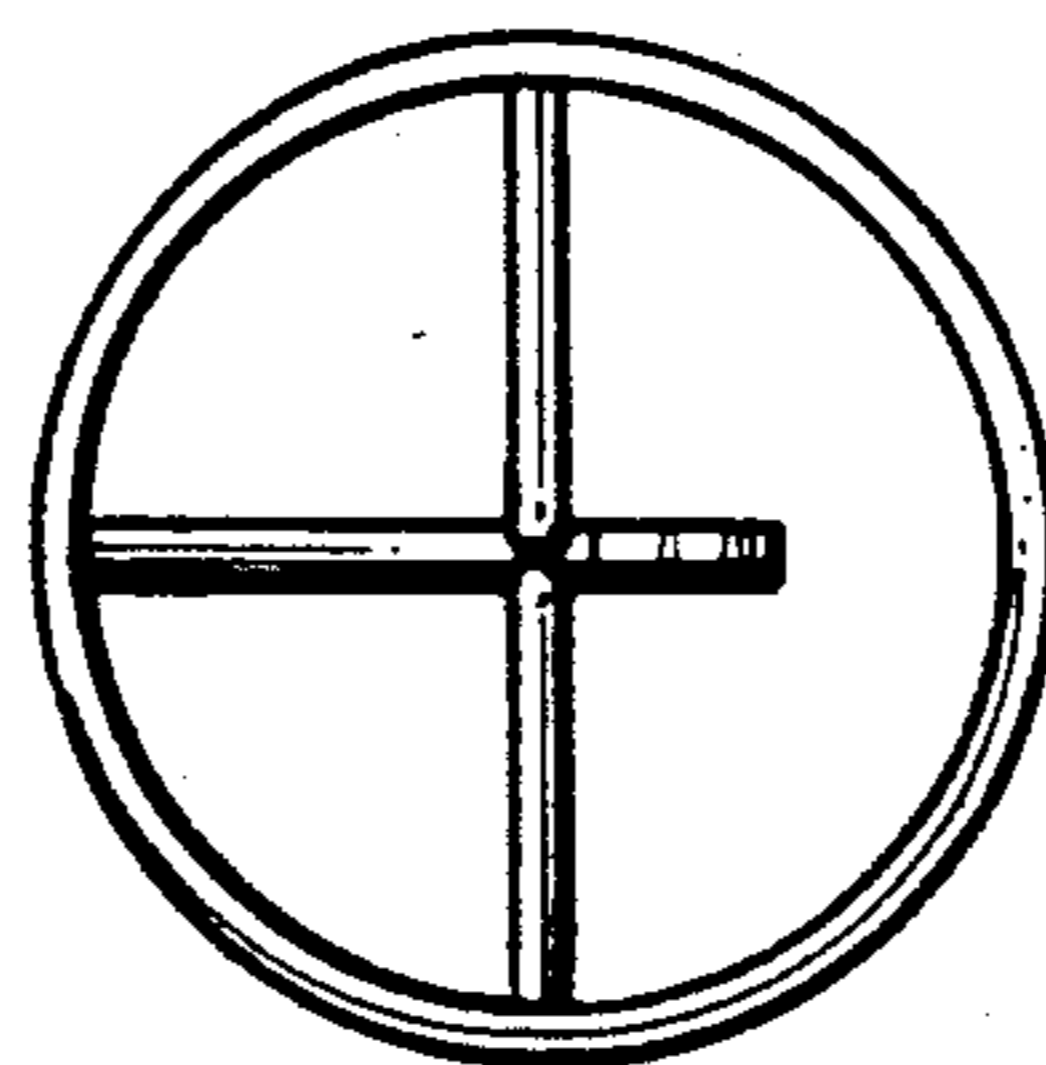
