## **DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;


FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view of an element of a shoe showing a modified form of my new design;


FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof;


FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view thereof; and


FIG. 9 is a front elevational view thereof.

The broken line showing of a shoe midsole is for environmental purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.




















