The novel design for tamper evident, resealable bag, as described and shown in the drawings.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a tamper evident, resealable bag showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a front perspective view shown with the tear strip portion partially removed for clarity of illustration;
FIG. 3 is a front perspective view, in an open position shown with the tear strip portion removed for clarity of illustration;
FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view thereof; and
FIG. 5 is a top rear perspective view thereof.

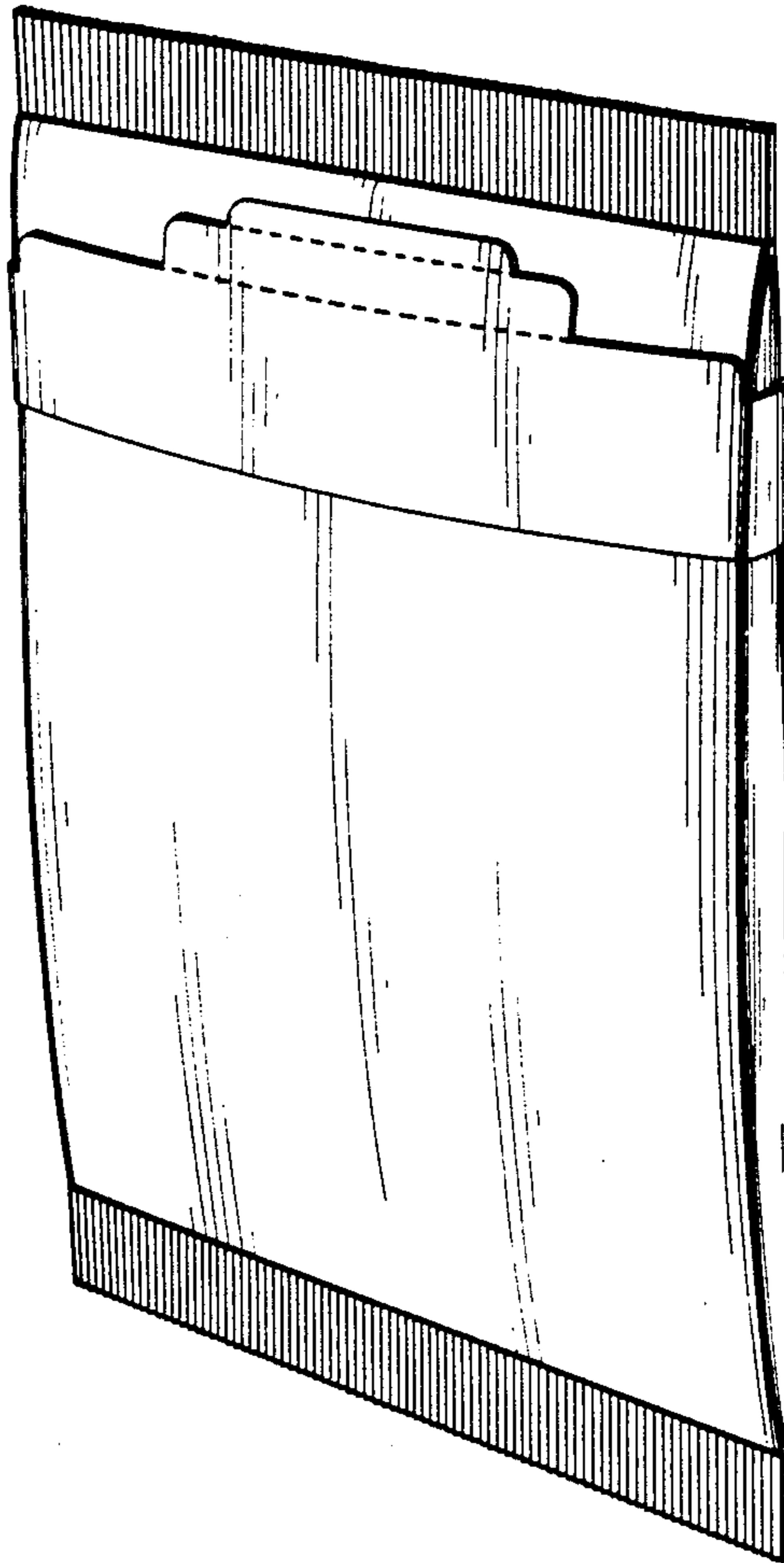

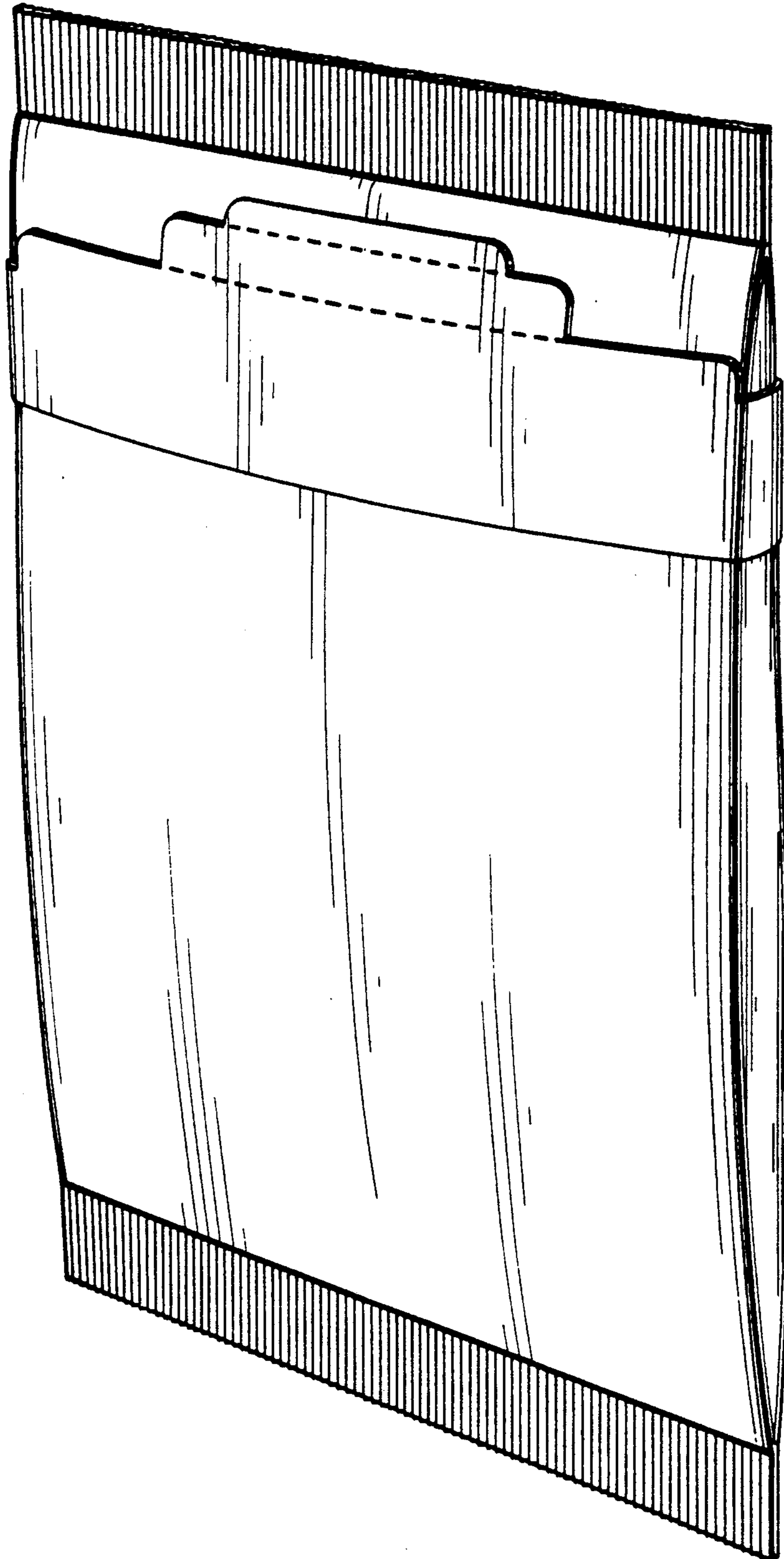

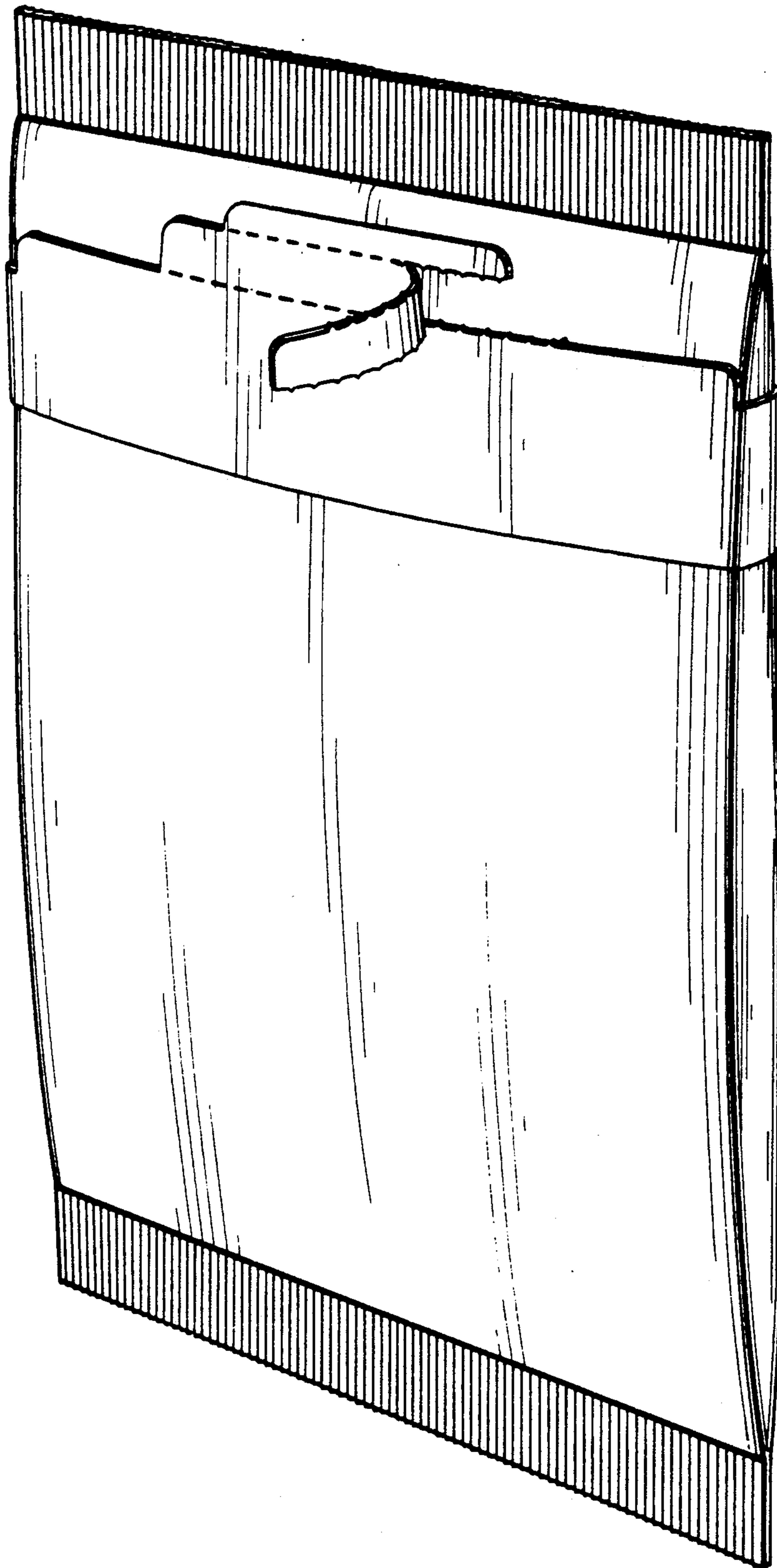

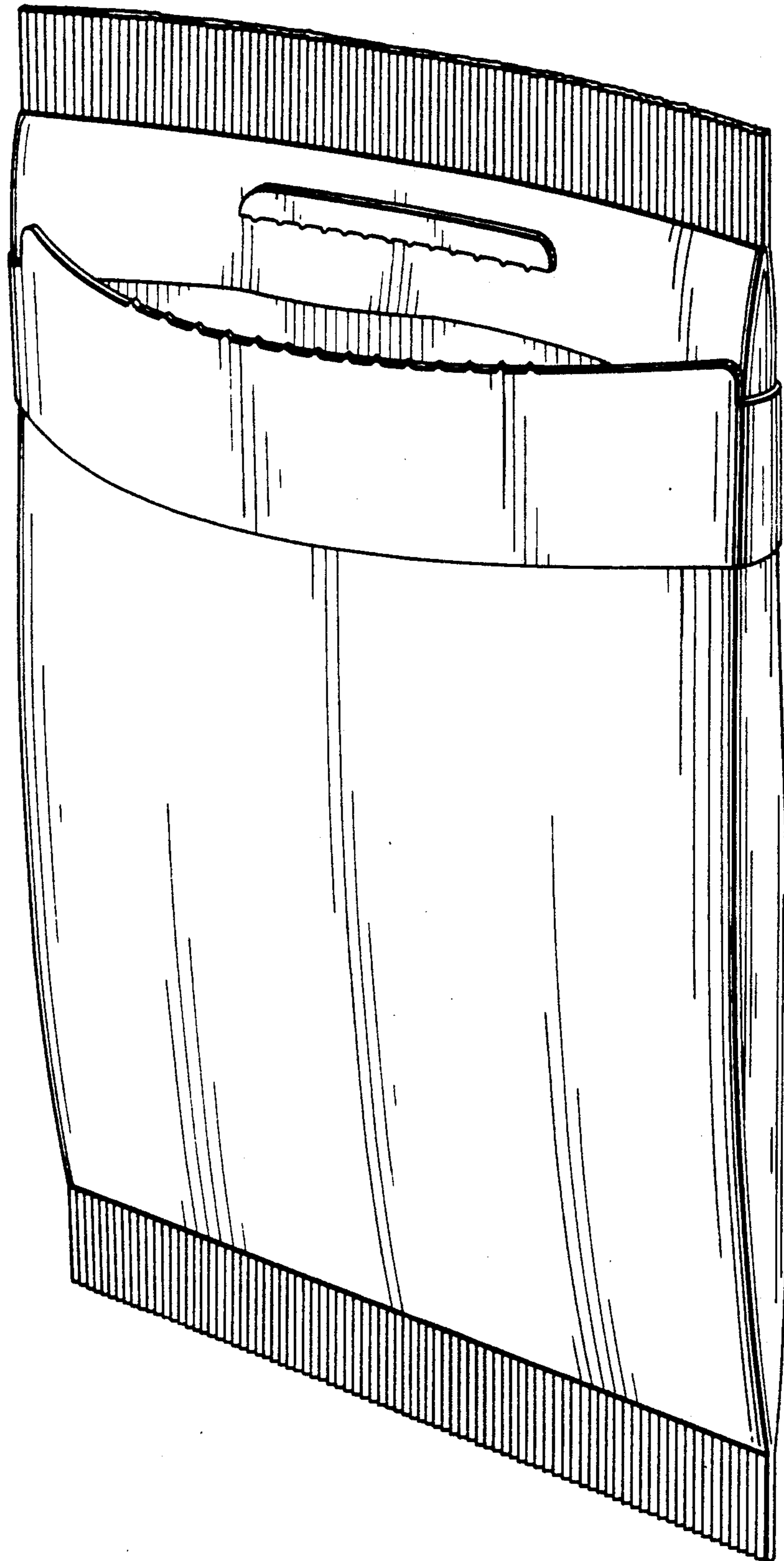

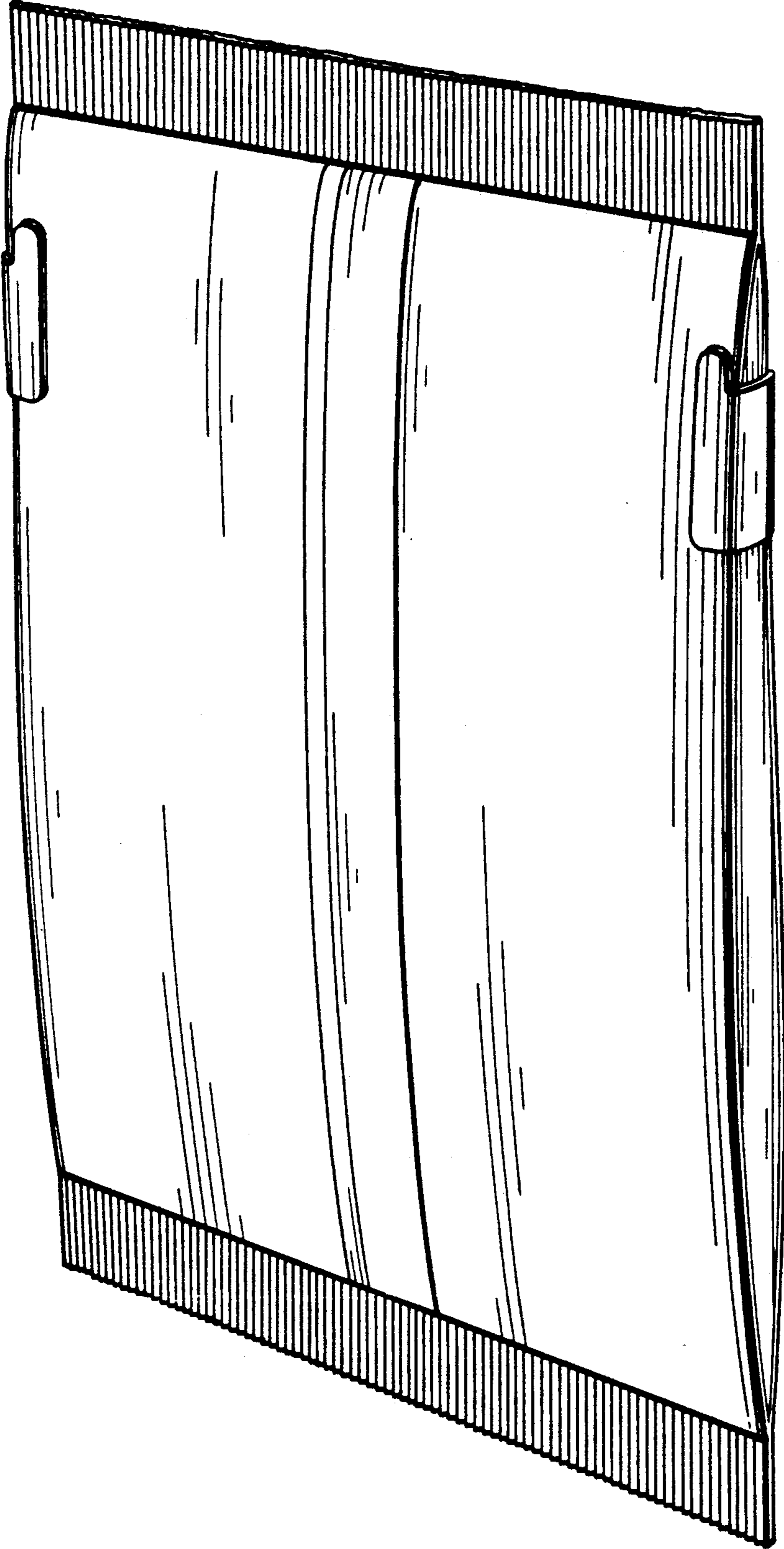
