ational boat showing our new design;

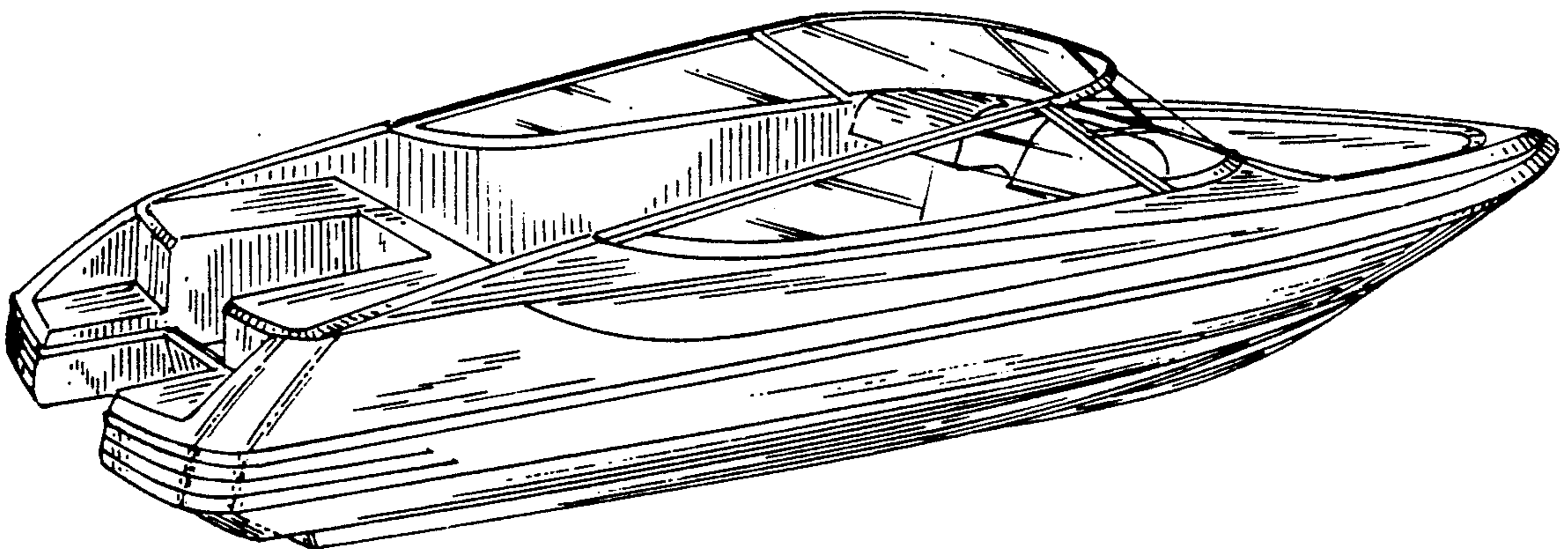
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.



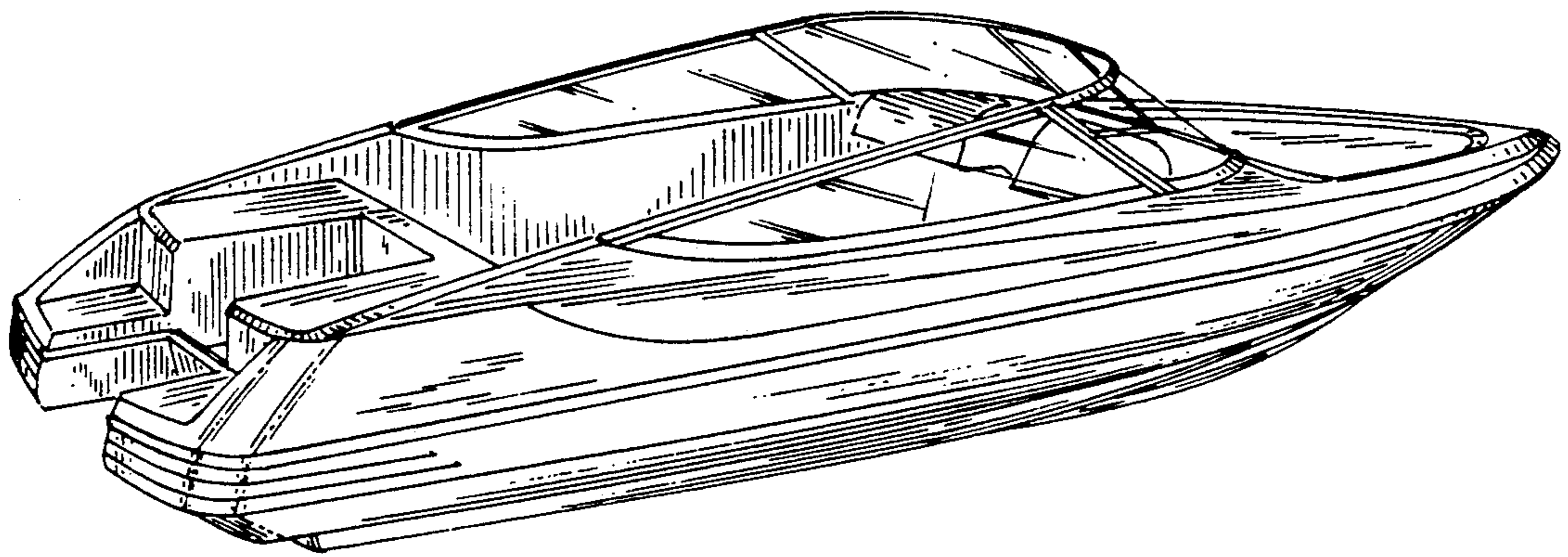

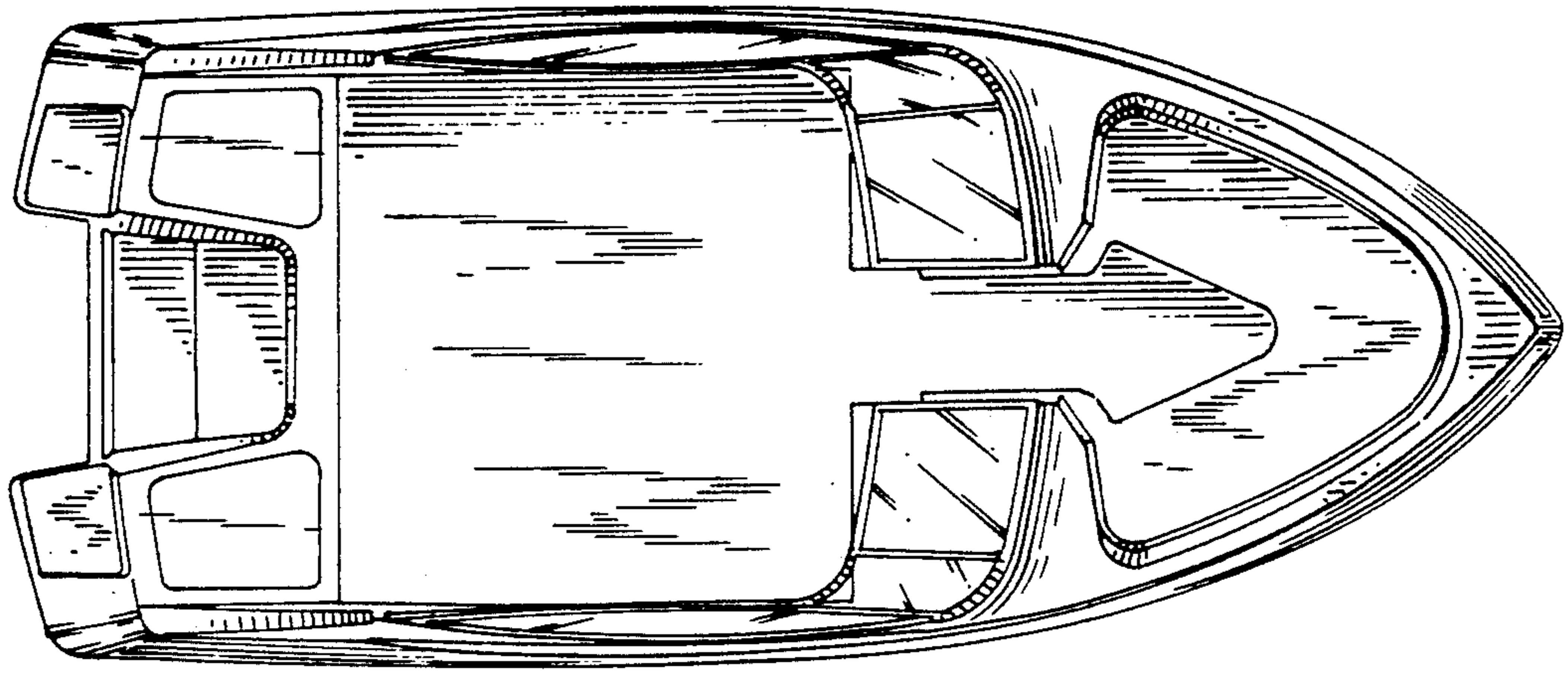

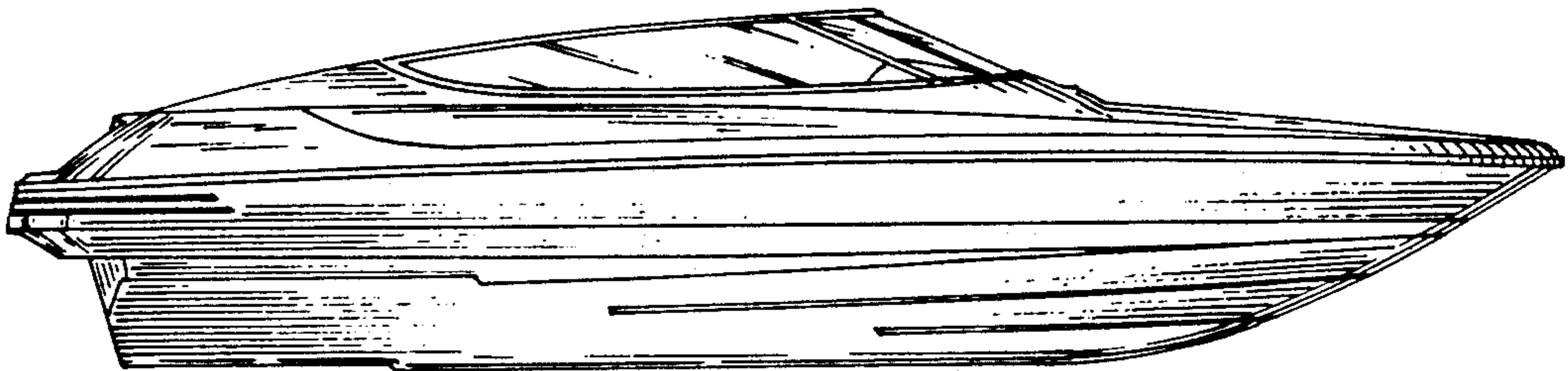

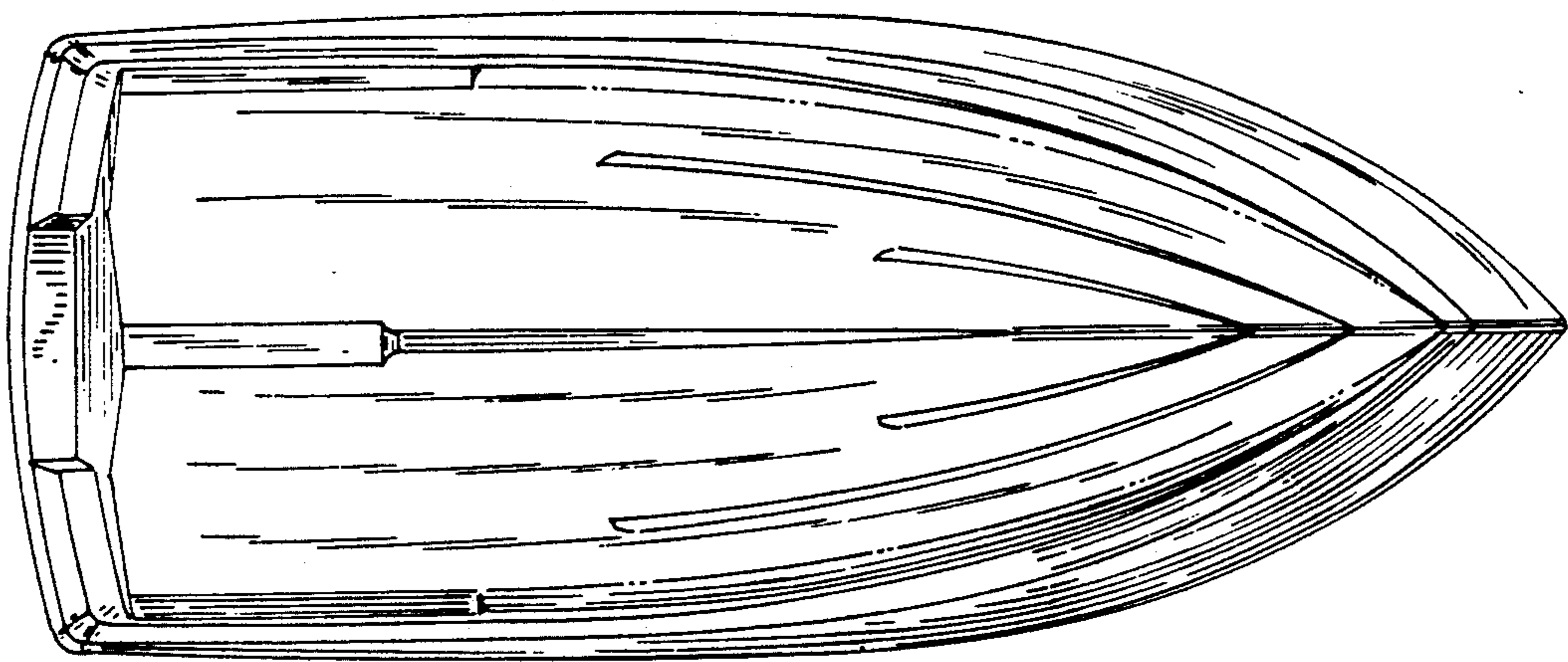

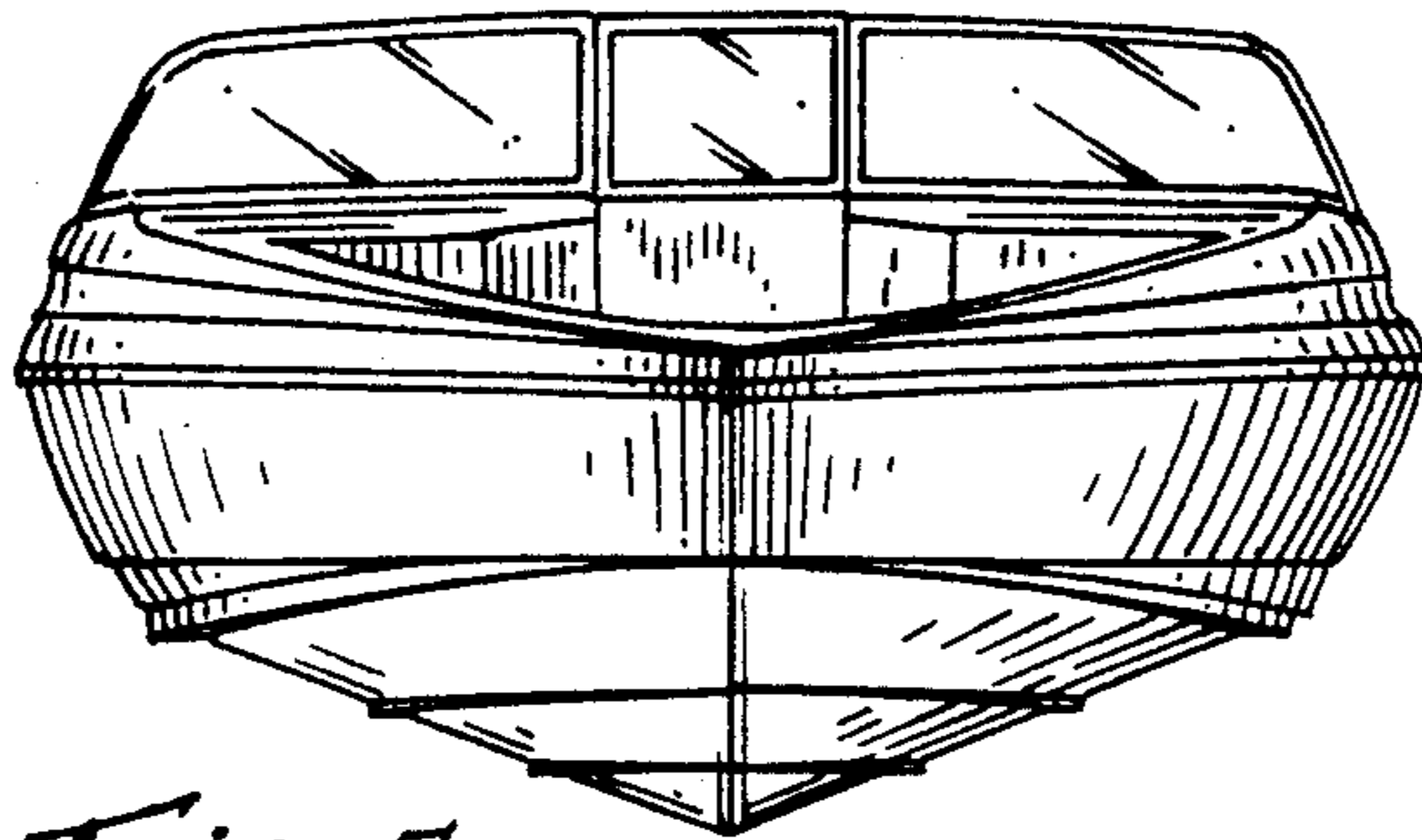

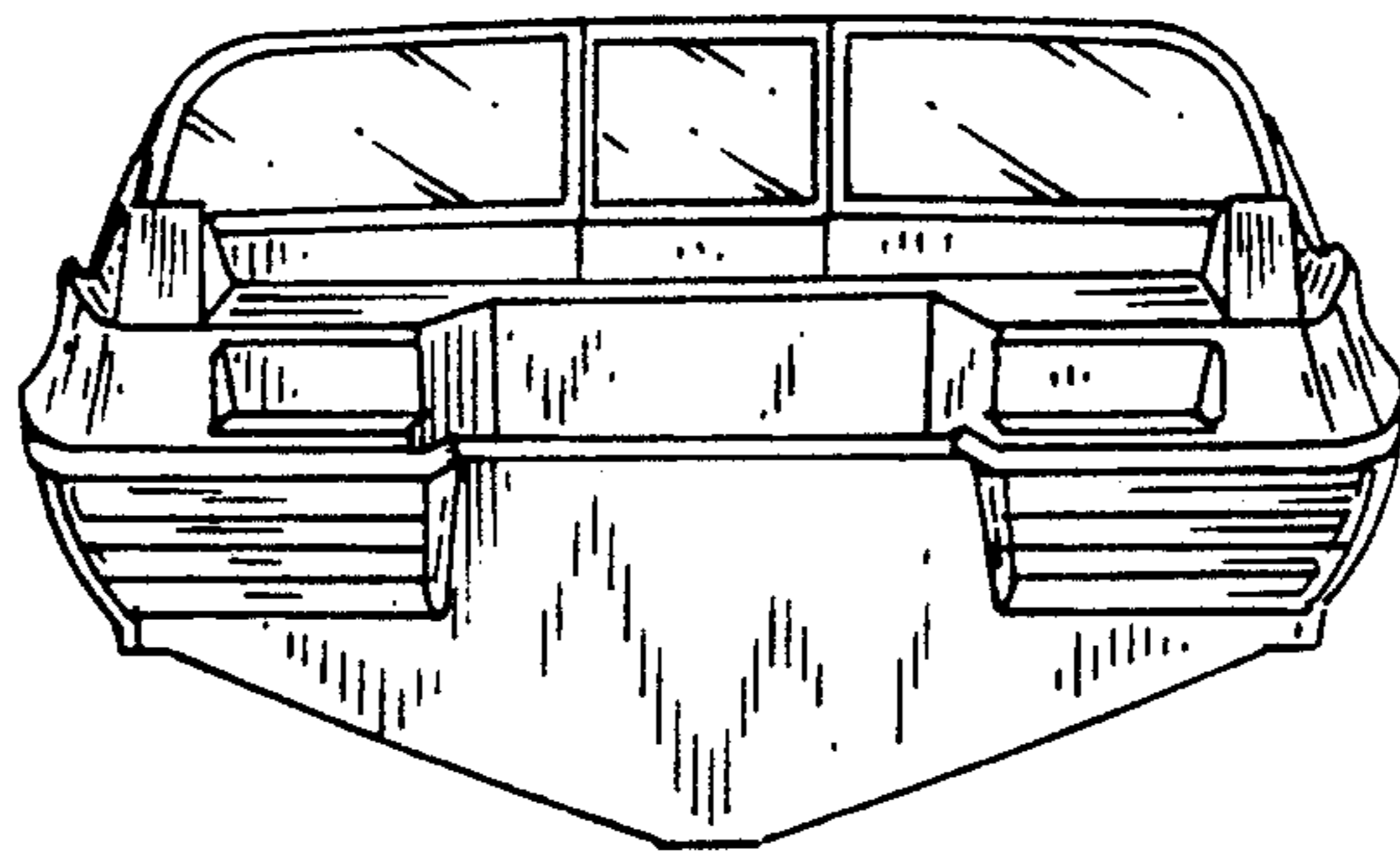
