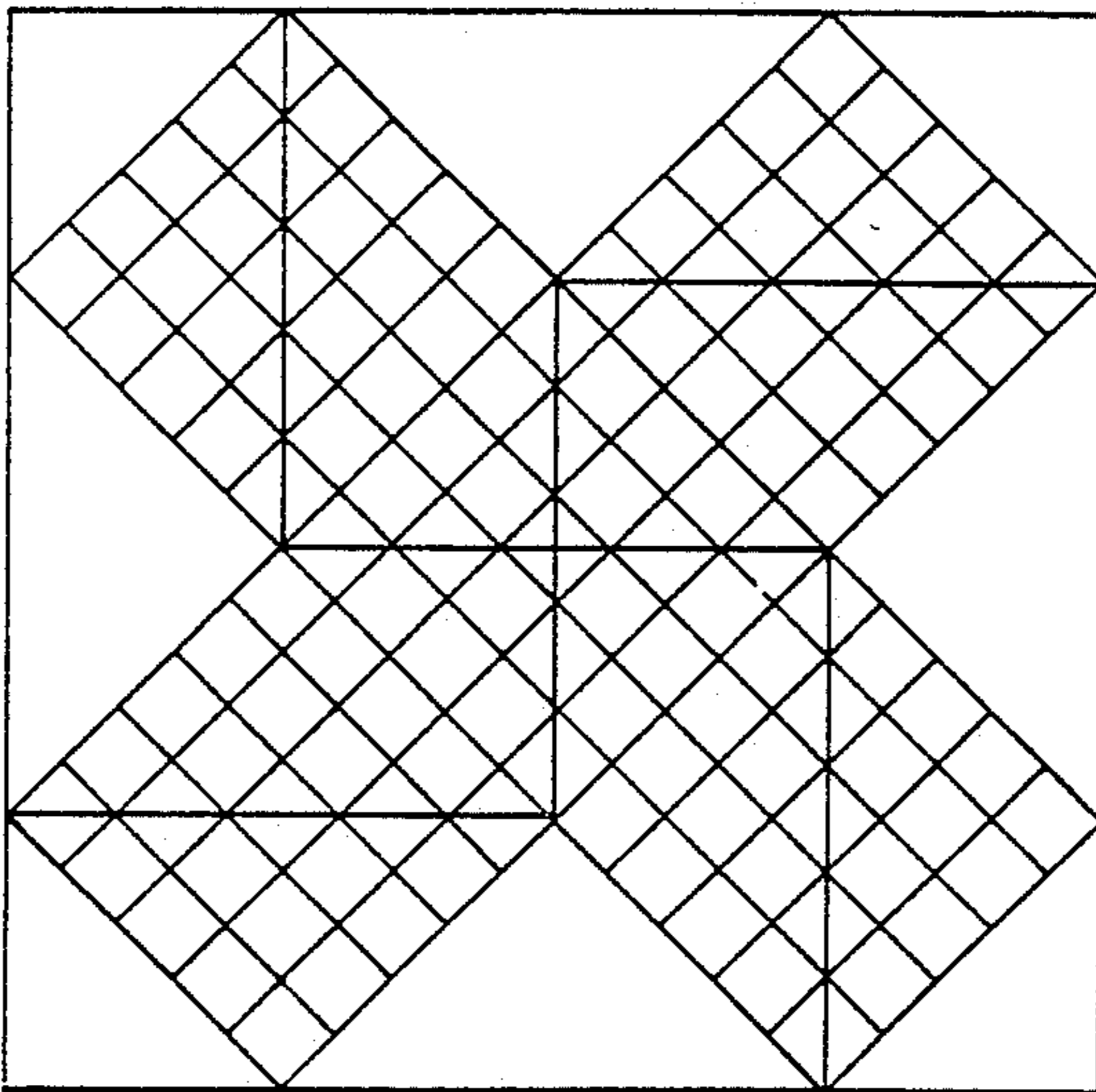
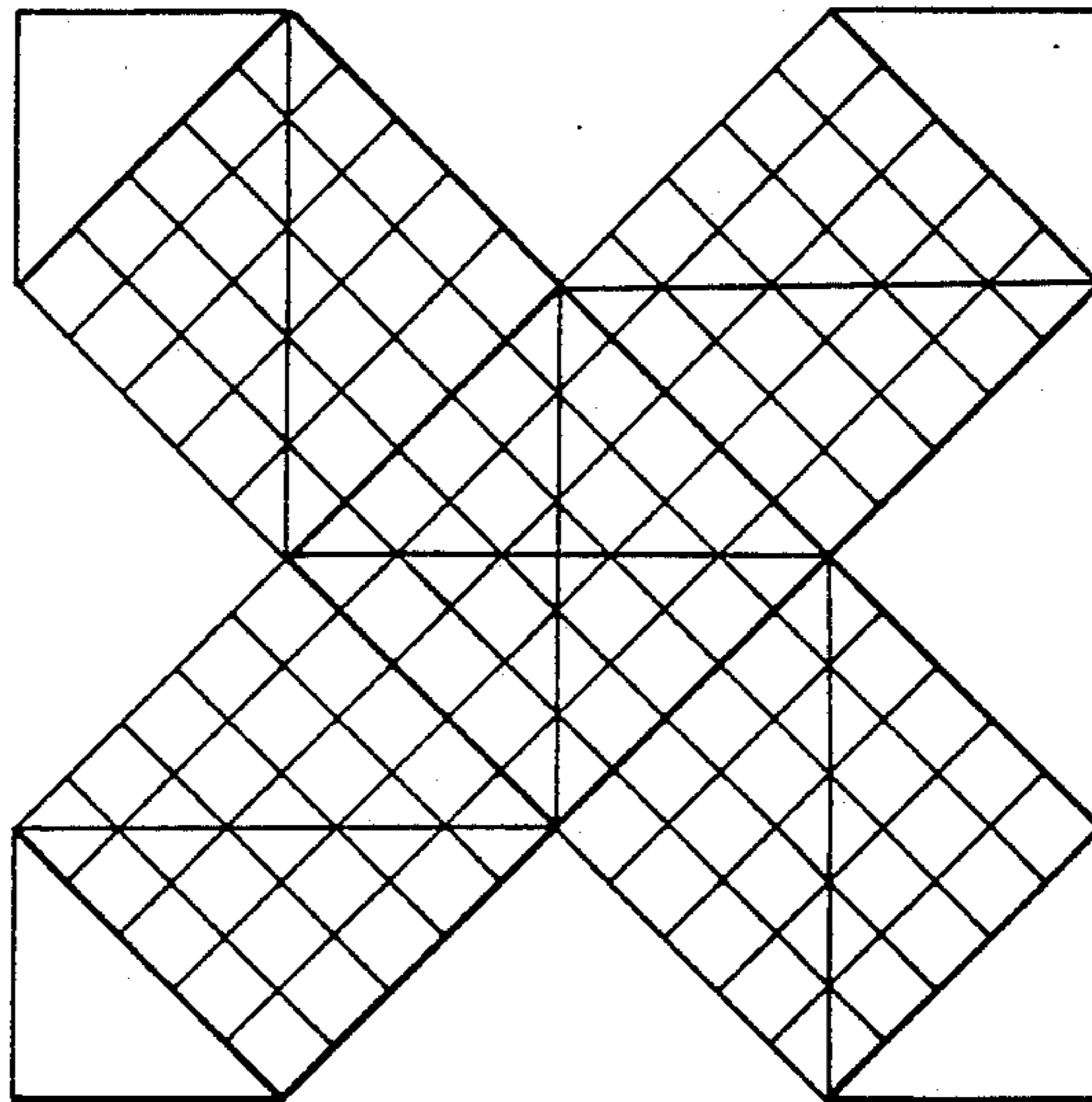

FIG. 4 is a bottom perspective view of FIG. 3.



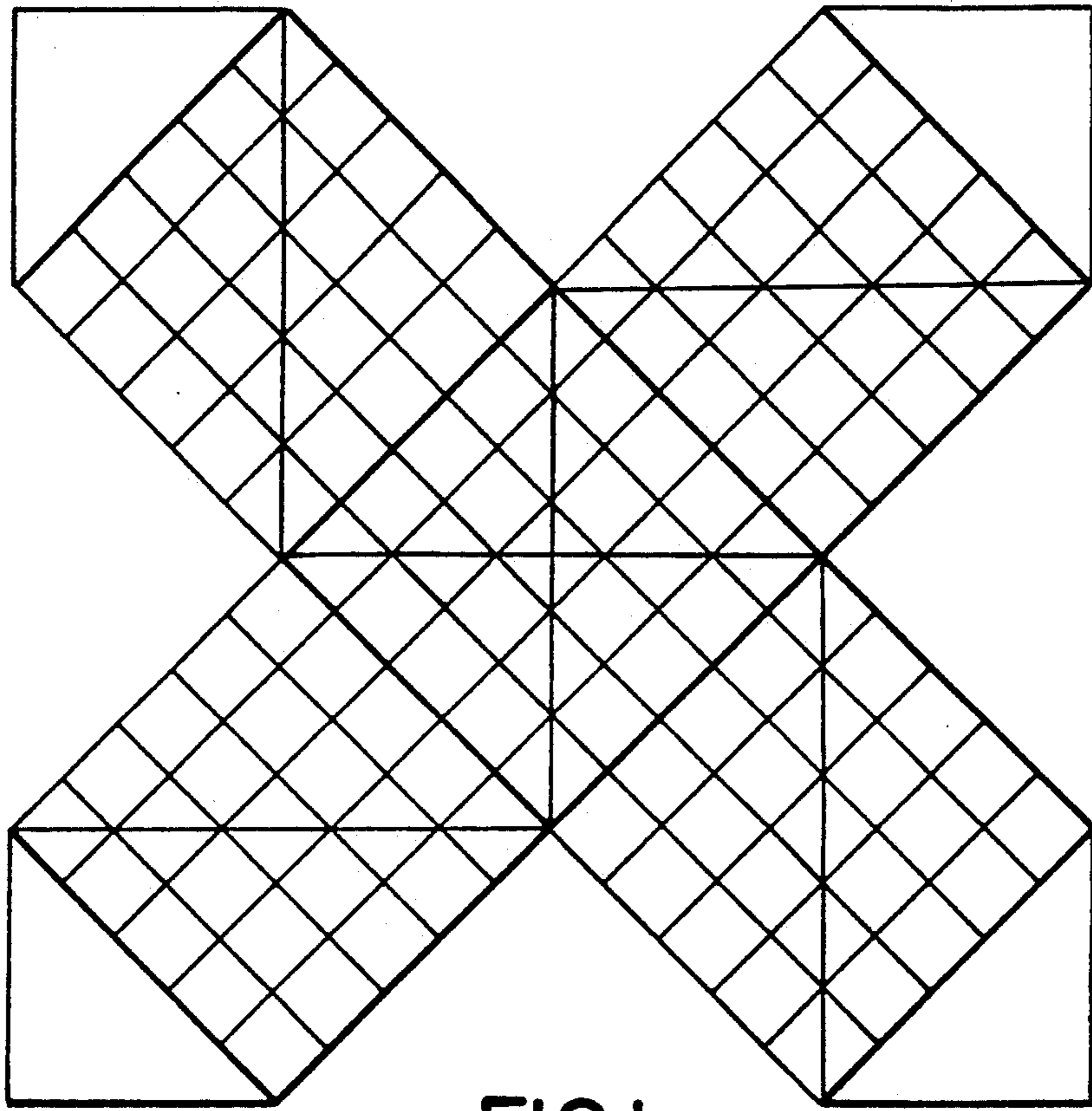

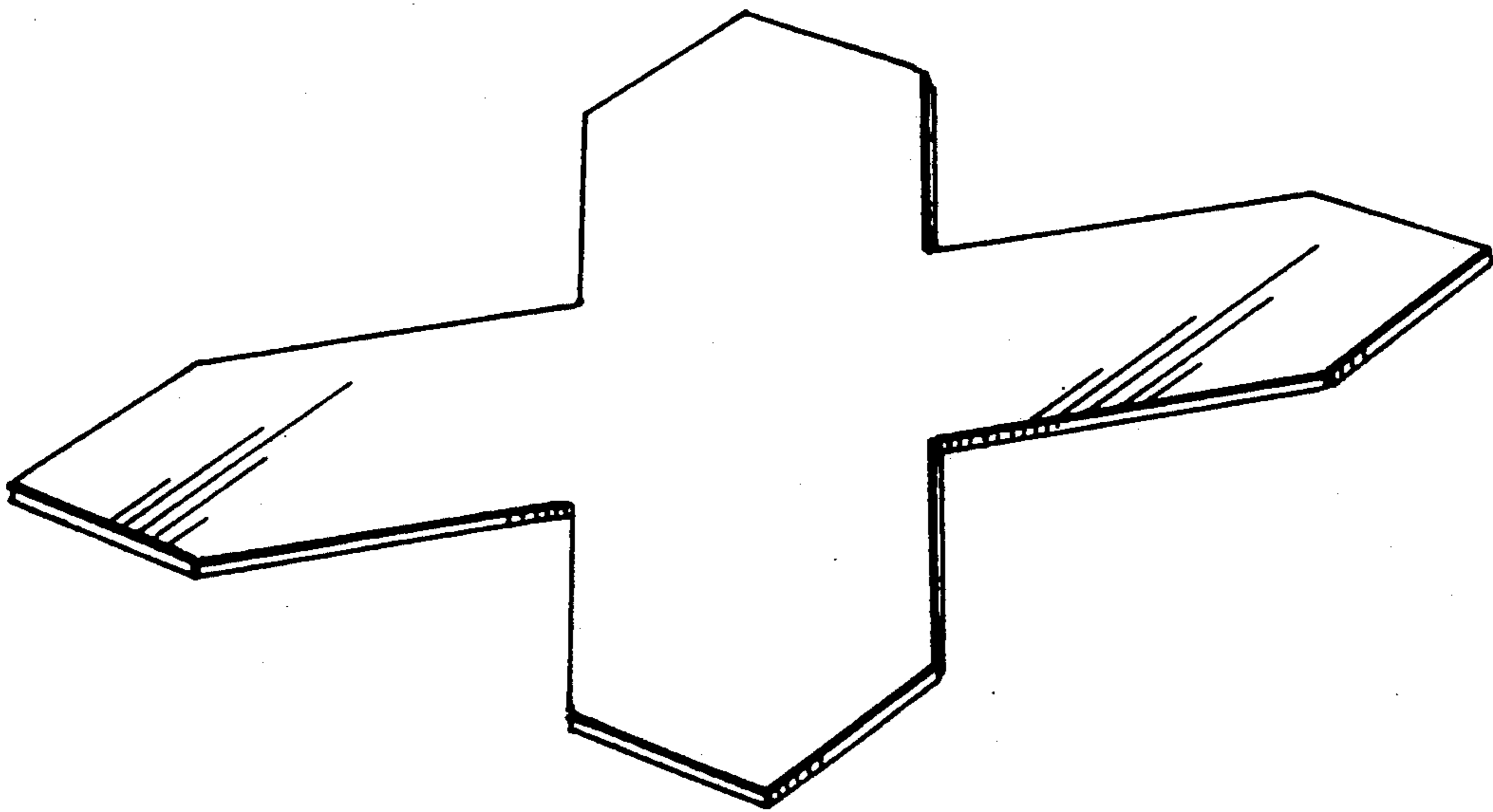

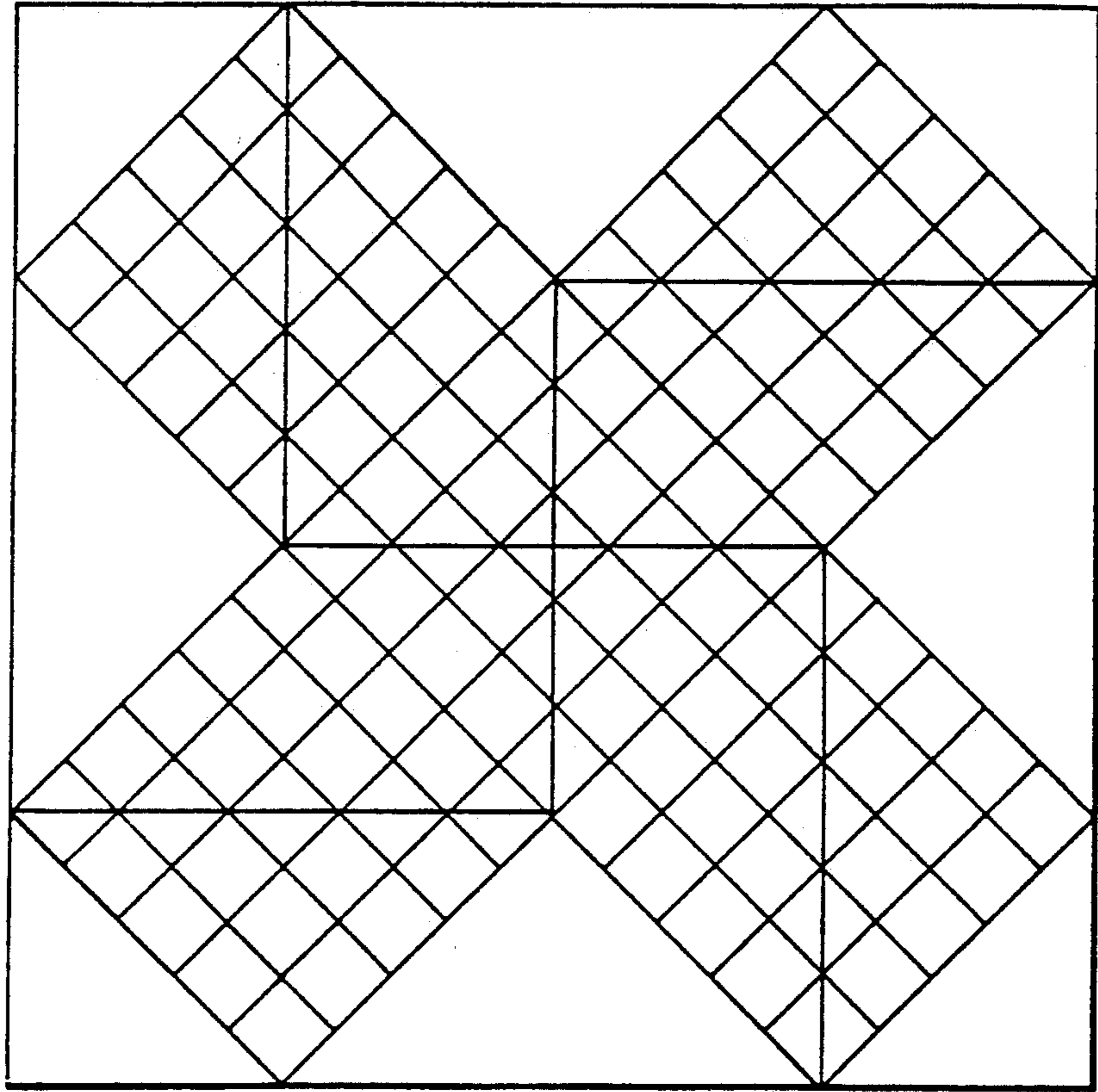

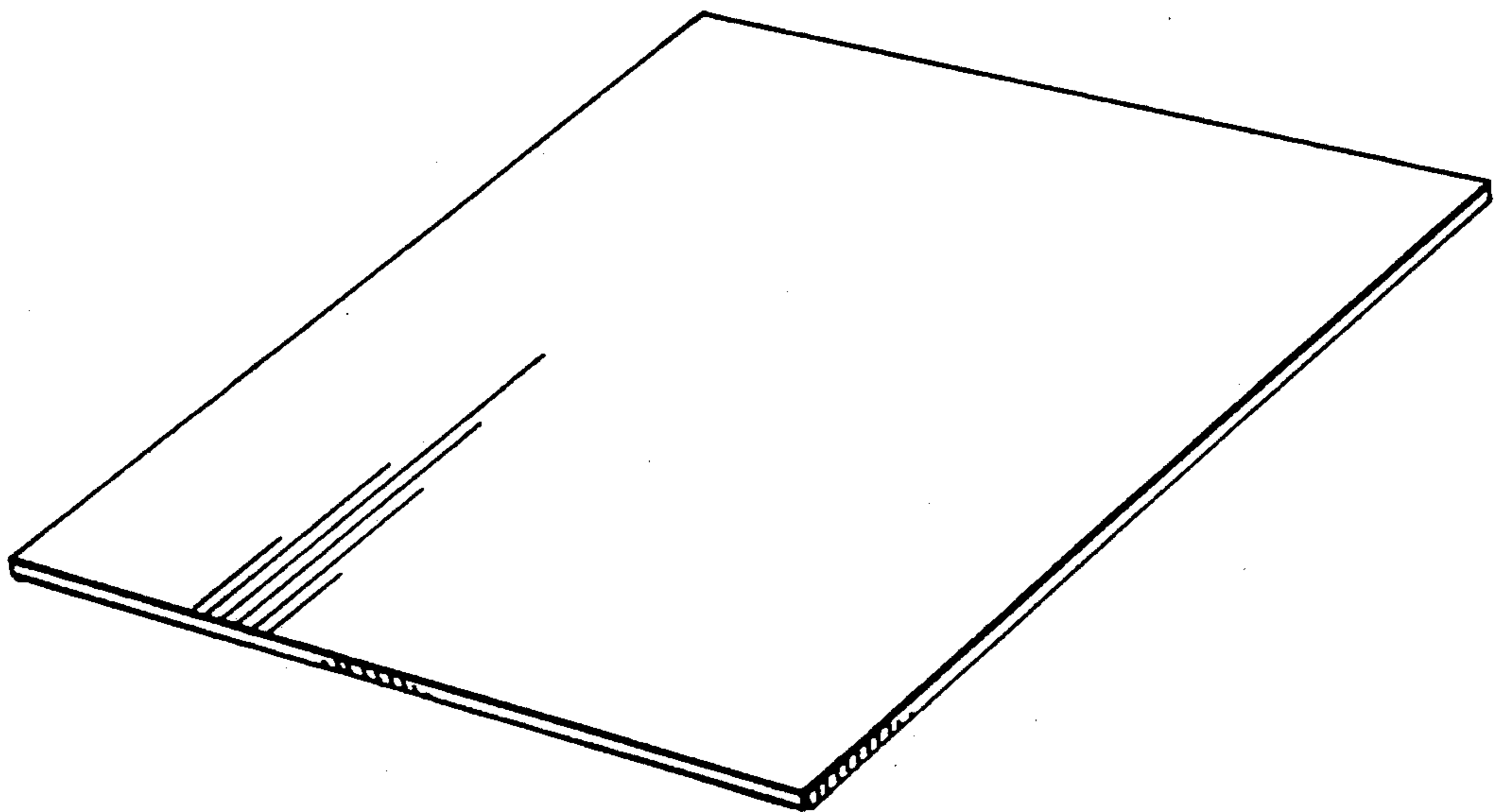
