#### **CLAIM** [57]

The ornamental design for a pleat shaped vertical support for window coverings, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pleat shaped vertical support for window coverings showing my new design, the broken lines showing of curtain pleats and a frame are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a fragmentary front elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a fragmentary right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a fragmentary rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 6 is a fragmentary side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a top plan view thereof, the broken line showing of adjacent curtain pleats is for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design;

FIG. 8 is a top plan view of a second embodiment of a pleat shaped vertical support for window coverings showing my new design;

FIG. 9 is a fragmentary left side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 10 is top plan view of a third embodiment of a pleat shaped vertical support for window coverings showing my new design;


FIG. 11 is a fragmentary right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 12 is a top plan view of a fourth embodiment of a pleat shaped vatical support for window coverings showing my new design;


FIG. 13 is a fragmentary right side elevational view thereof;


FIG. 14 is a top plan view of a fifth embodiment of a pleat shaped vertical support for window coverings showing my new design; and


FIG. 15 is fragmentary left side elevational view thereof.

















