showing my new design;

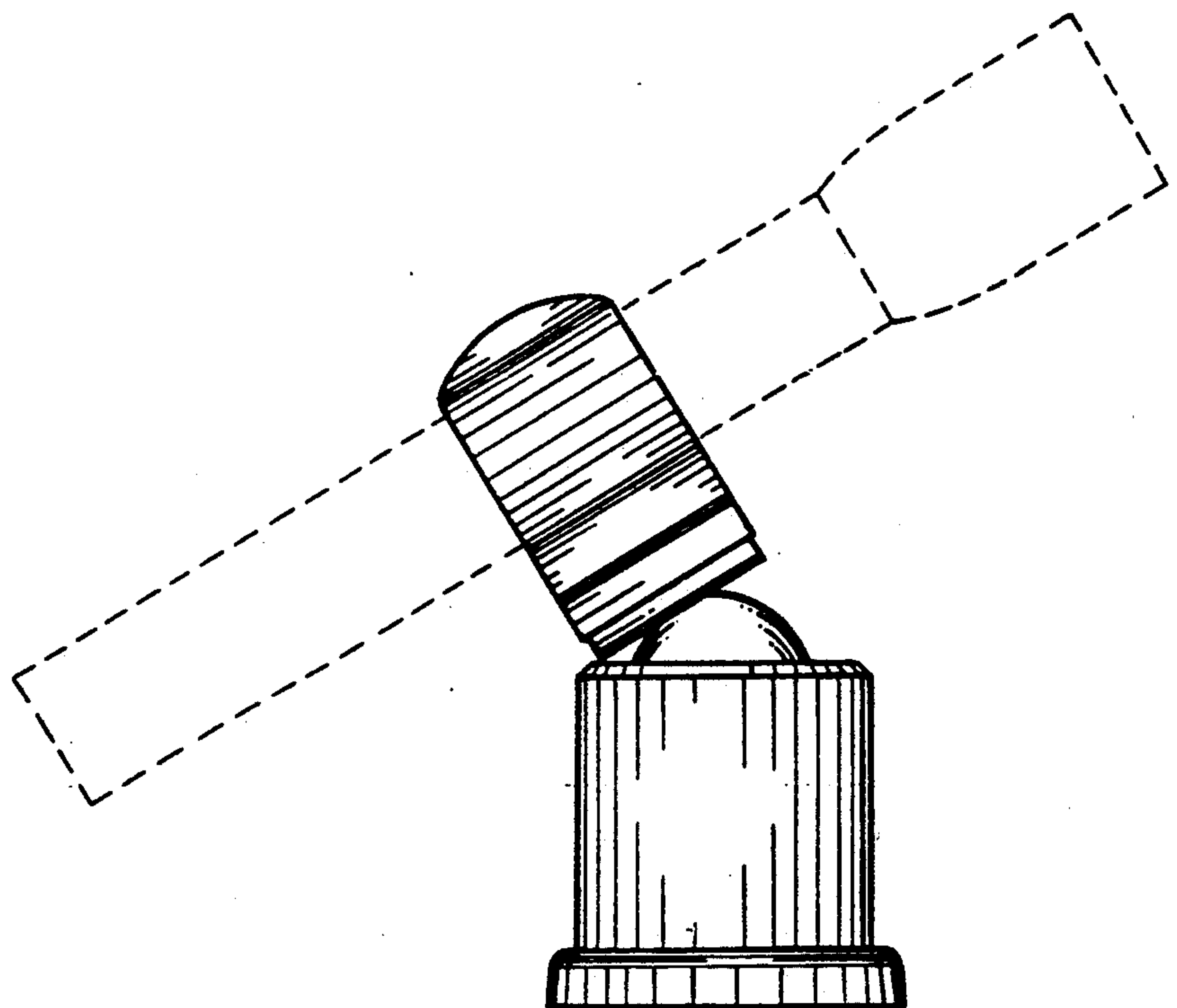
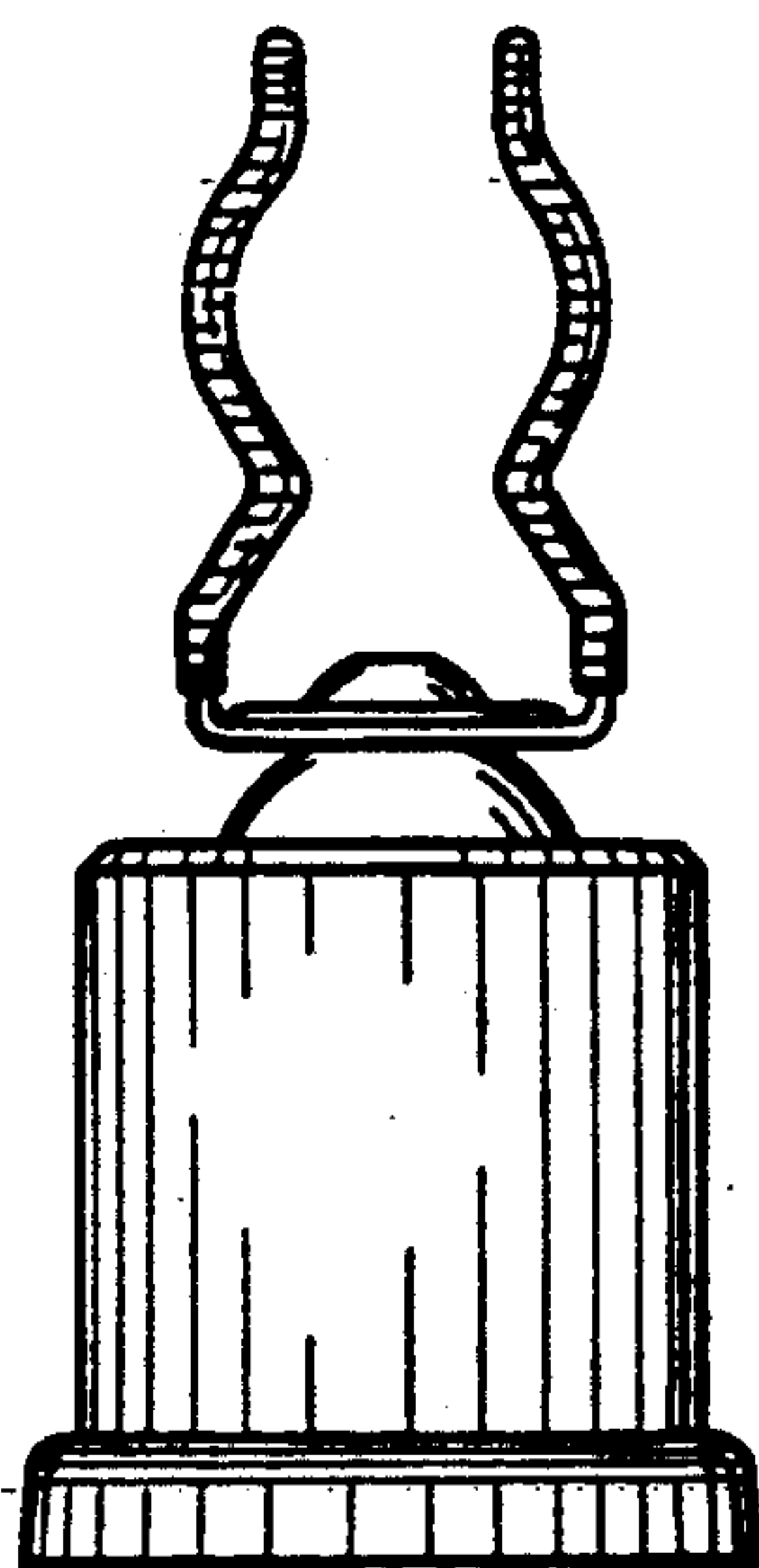
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof, the rear being

claimed design.



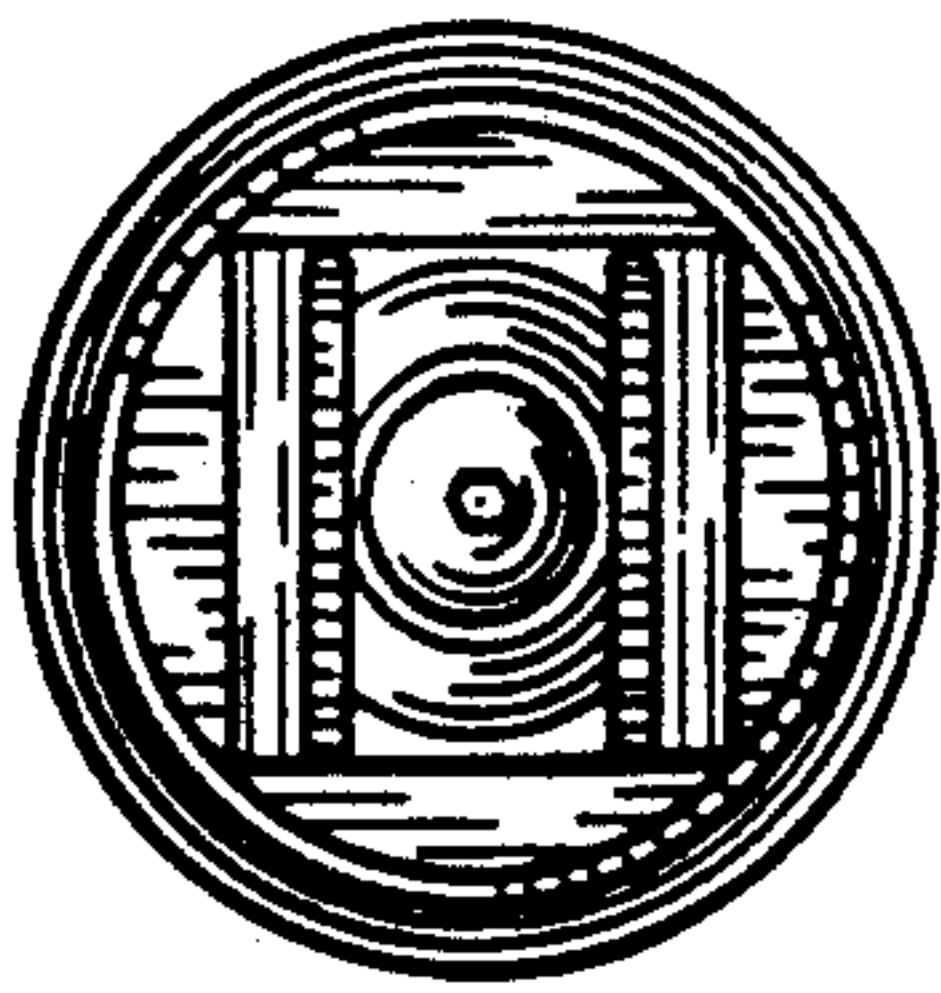

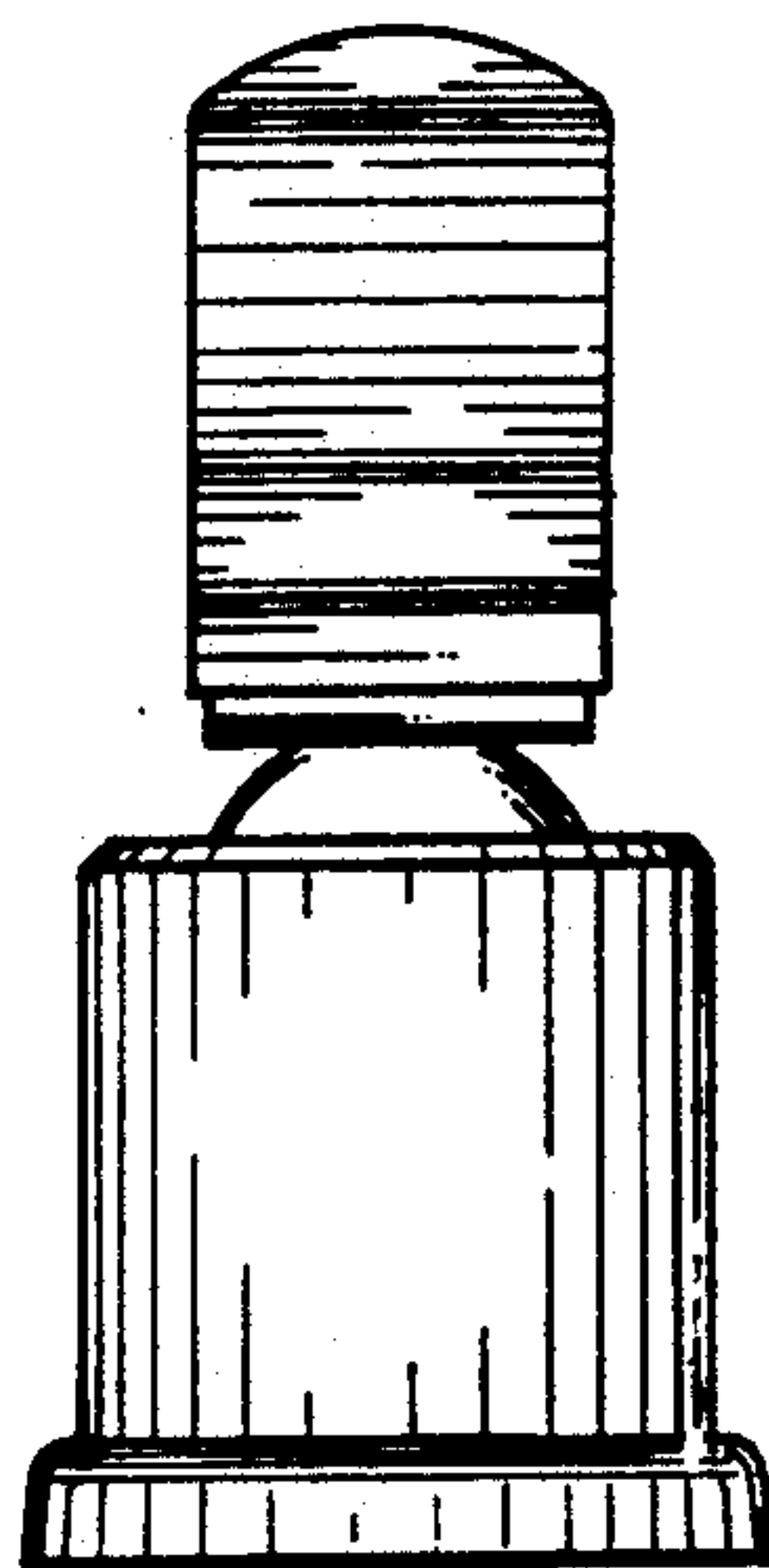

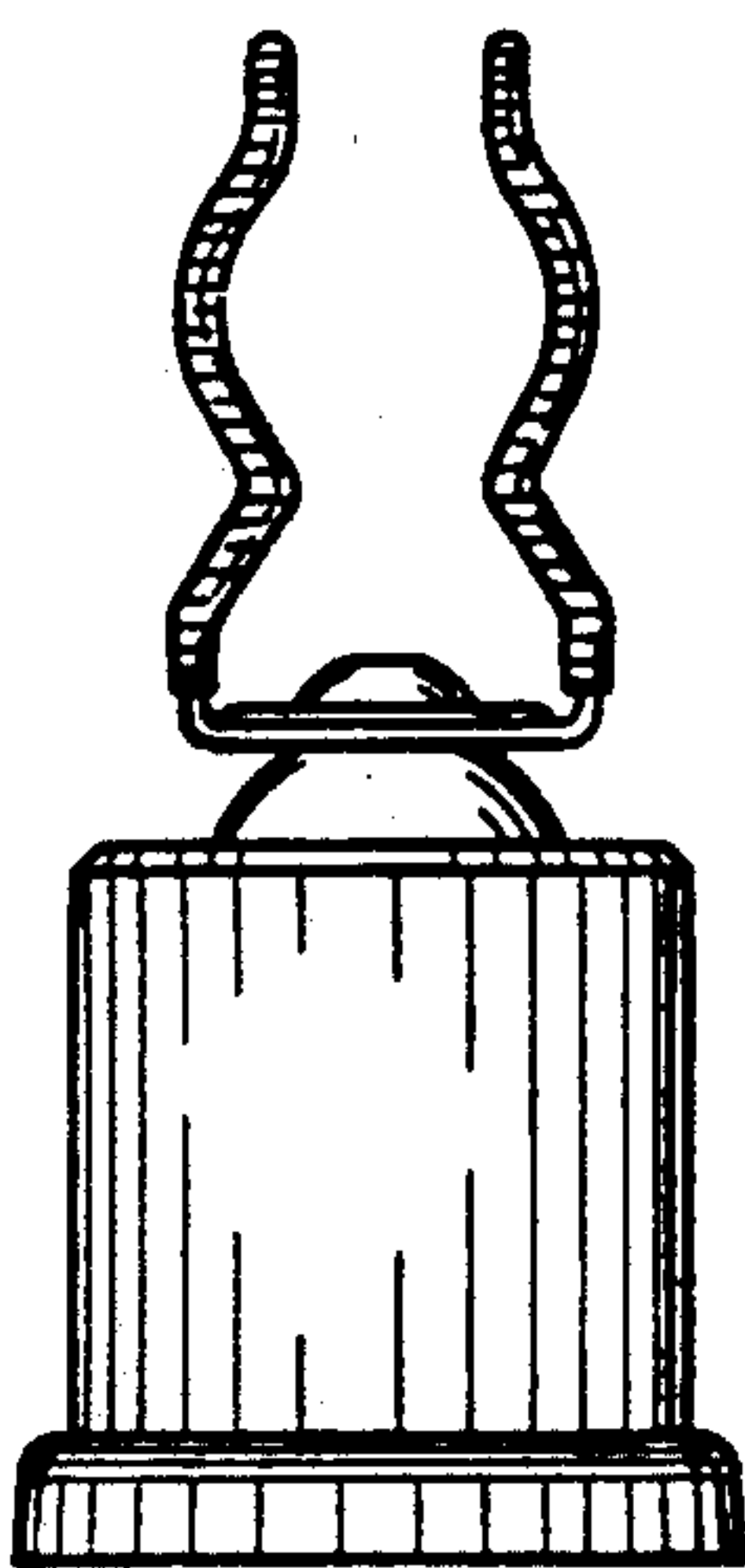

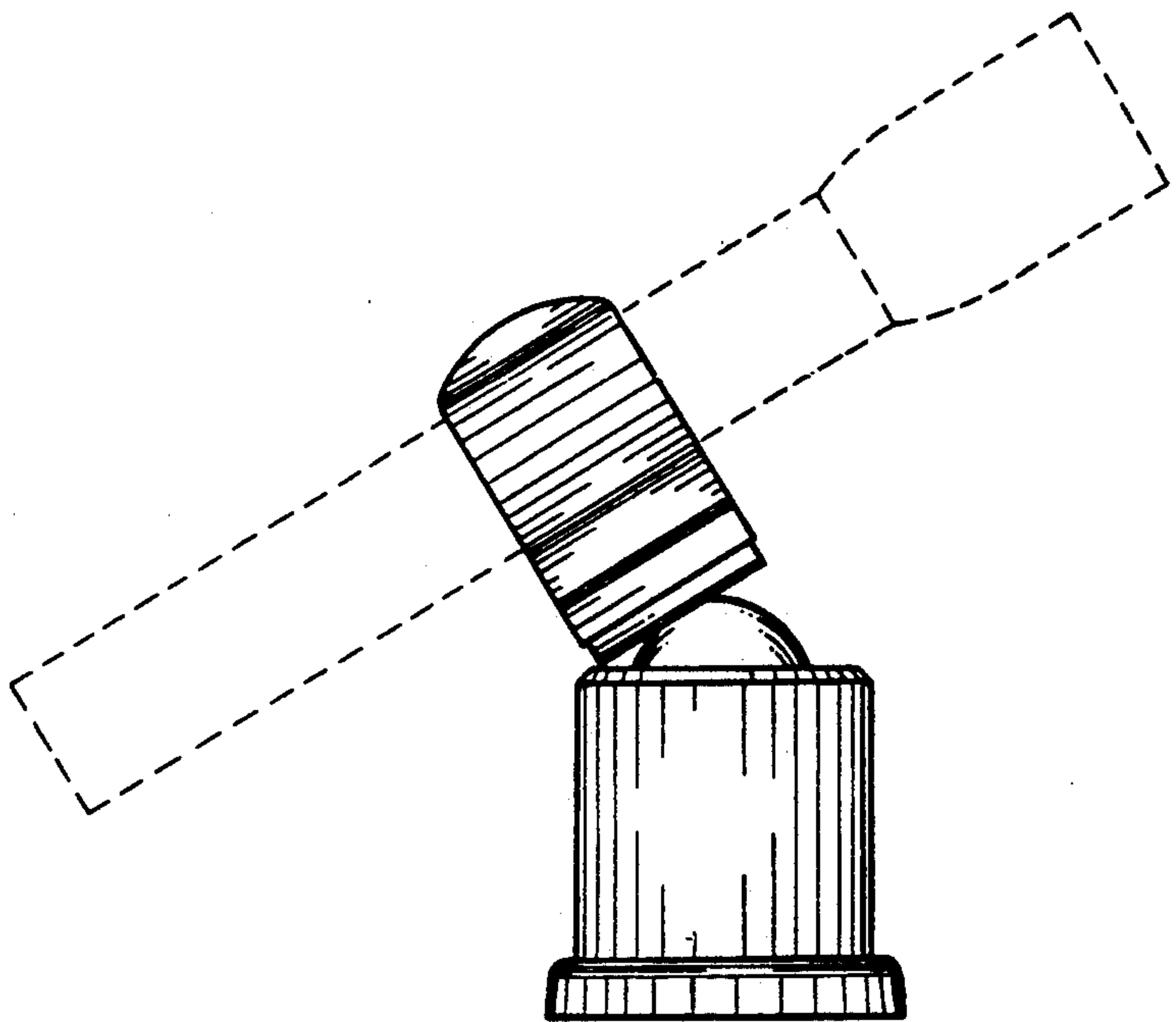

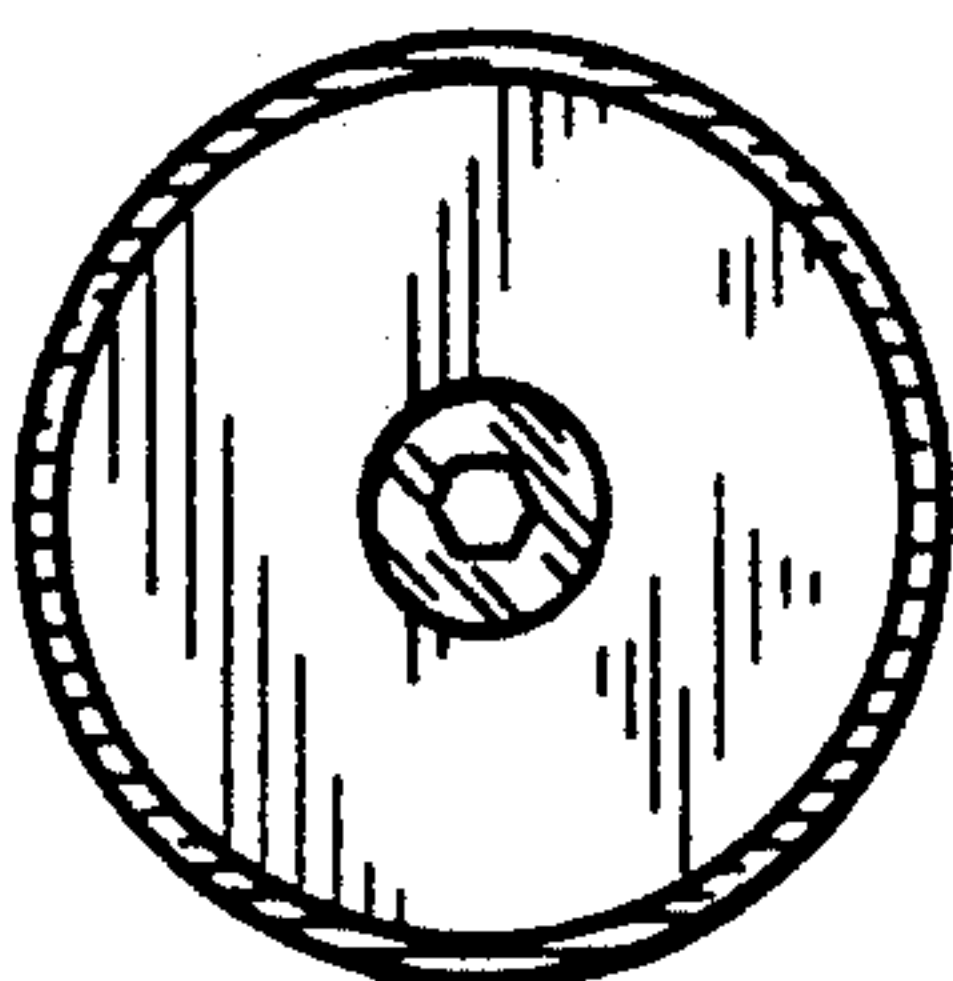
