DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and left side of a sink showing our new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 3-3 of FIG. 2; FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 4-4 of FIG. 2; and FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view taken on line 5-5 of FIG. 2. The broken line representation of holes and the fragmentary broken line representation of a counter top in FIG. 1 are for purposes of illustration only and form no part of the claimed design.
