FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front
and left side of a sink showing our new design;

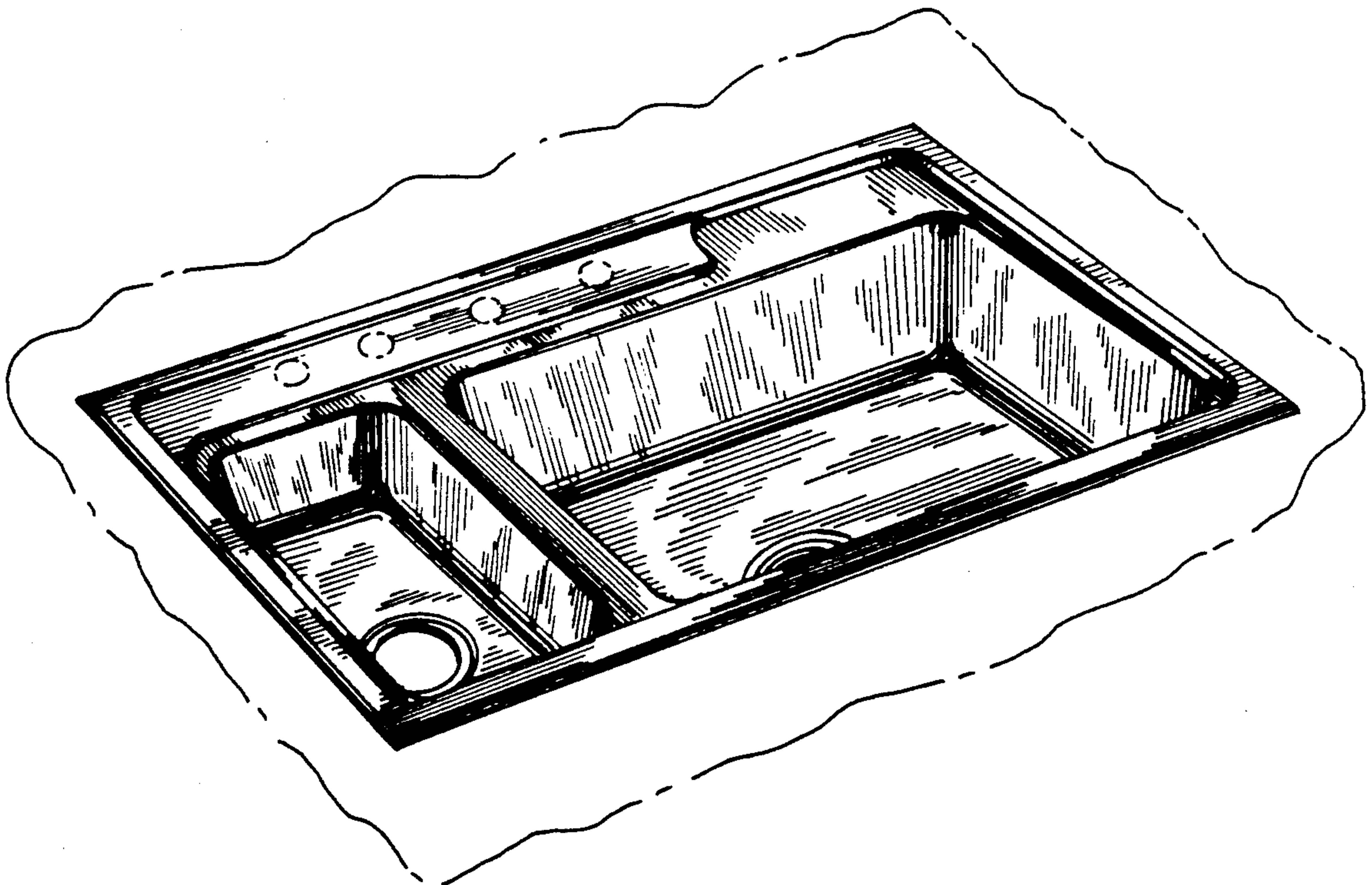
FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

part of the claimed design.



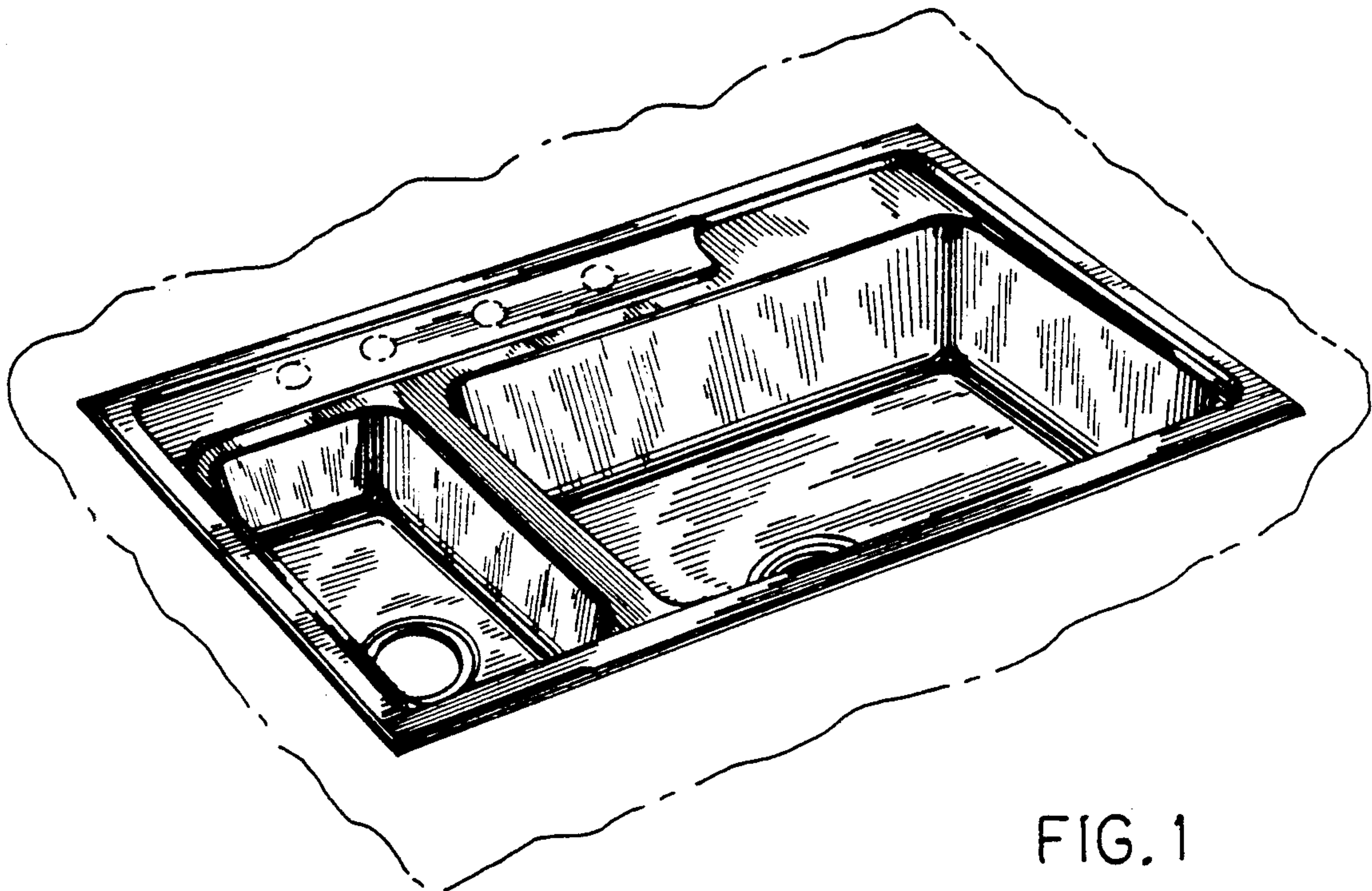
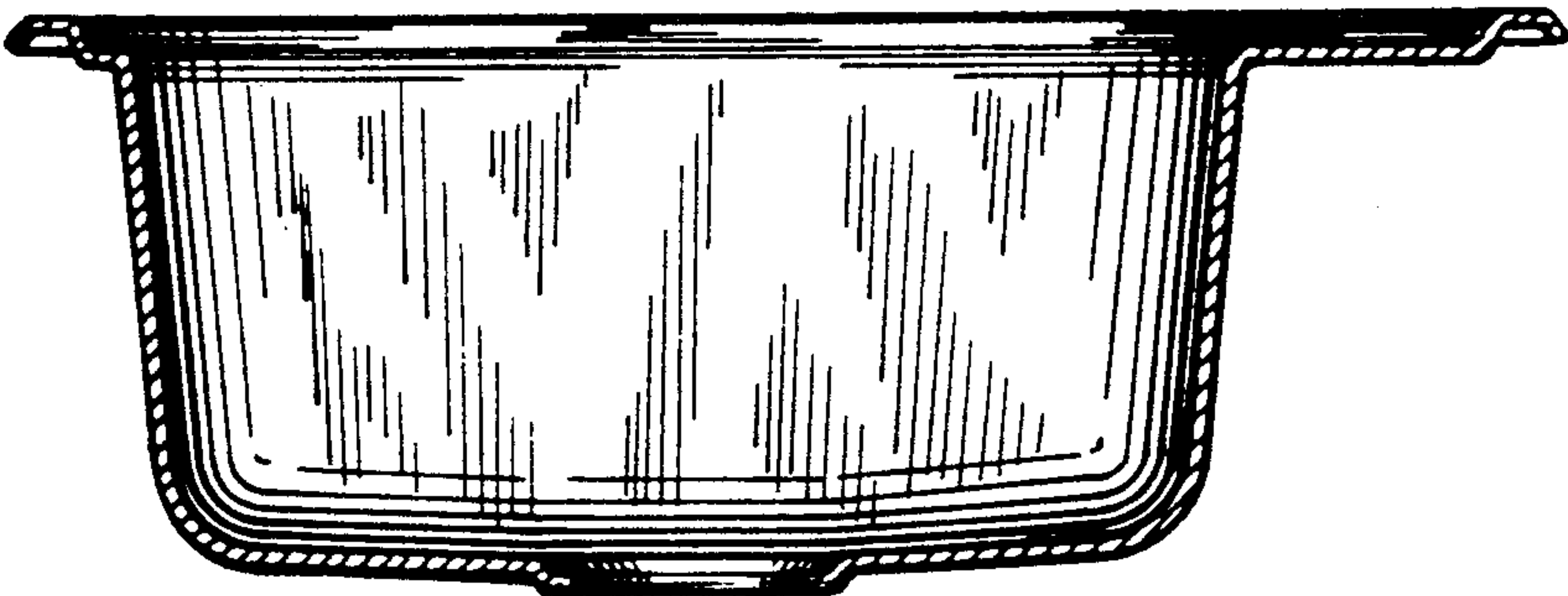

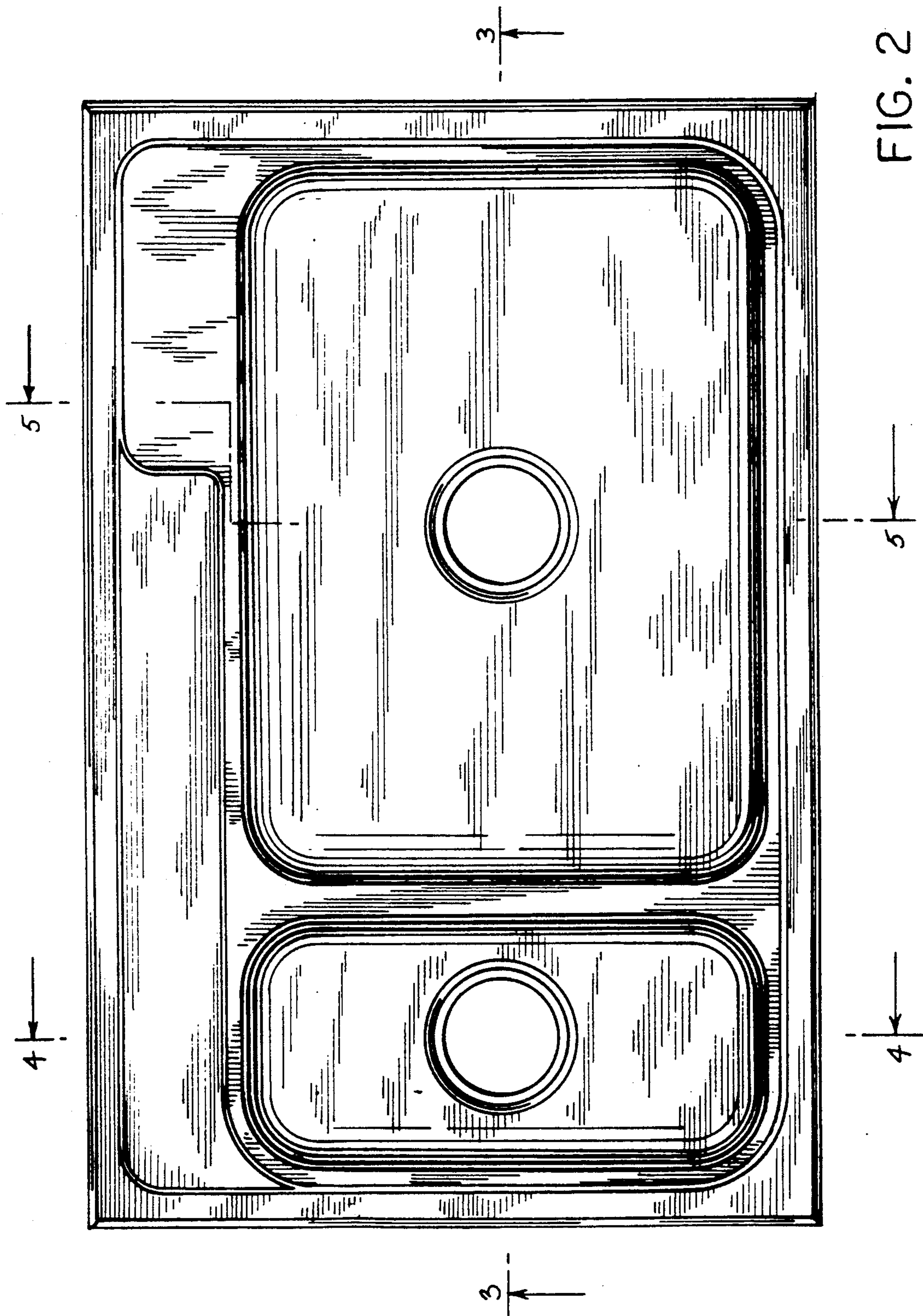

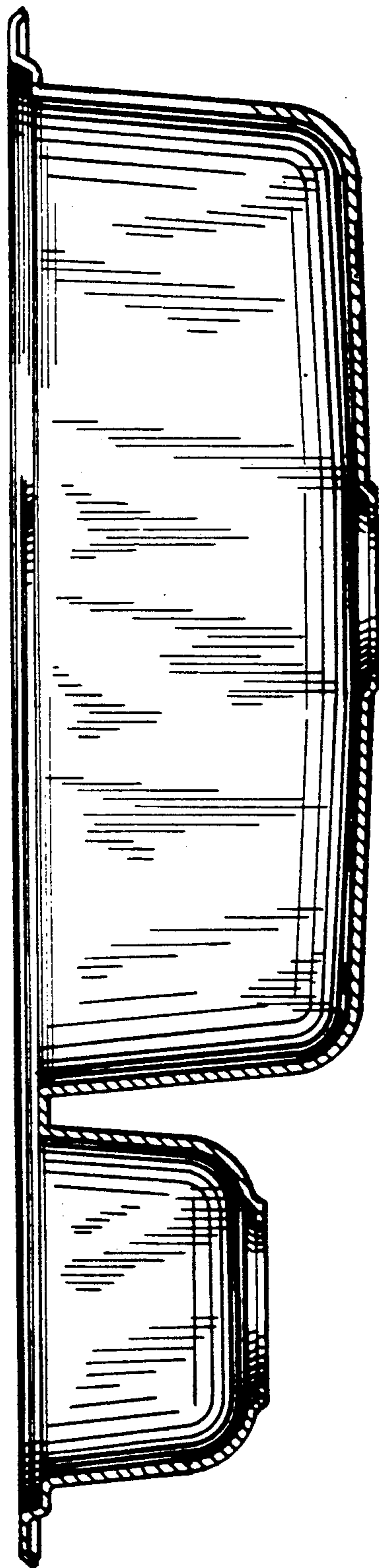

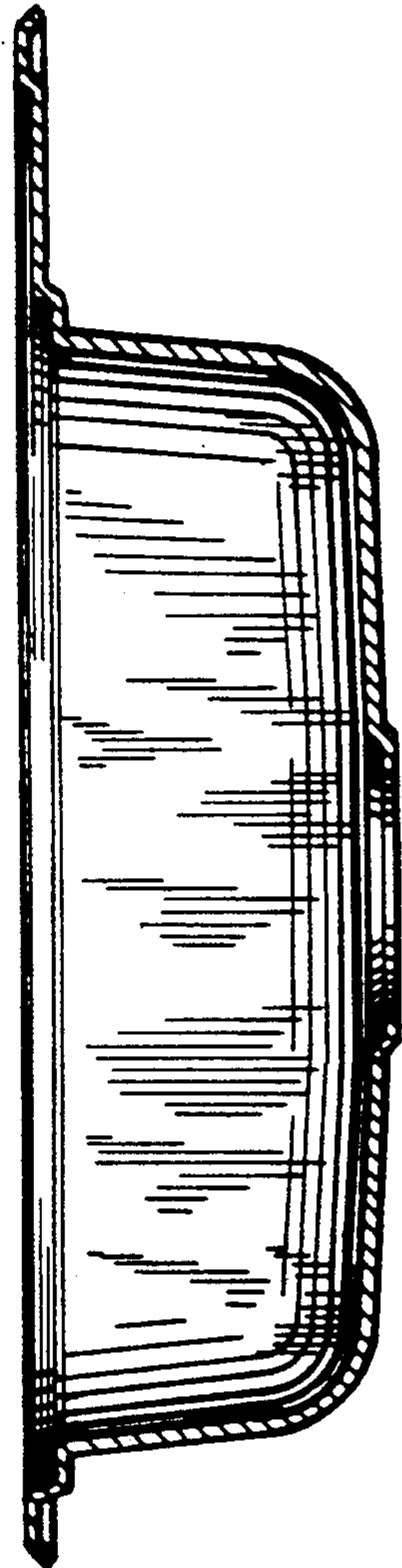
