[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a side of a shoe midsole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of one side of a side of a shoe midsole showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the other side of the side of the side of the shoe midsole shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the side of the shoe midsole shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a sectional view taken along line 4—4 of FIG.

The broken line showing of a shoe sole, including the cupped vertical sides of the sole, and the broken line showing of a shoe upper, are for illustrative purposes and form no part of the claimed design.
