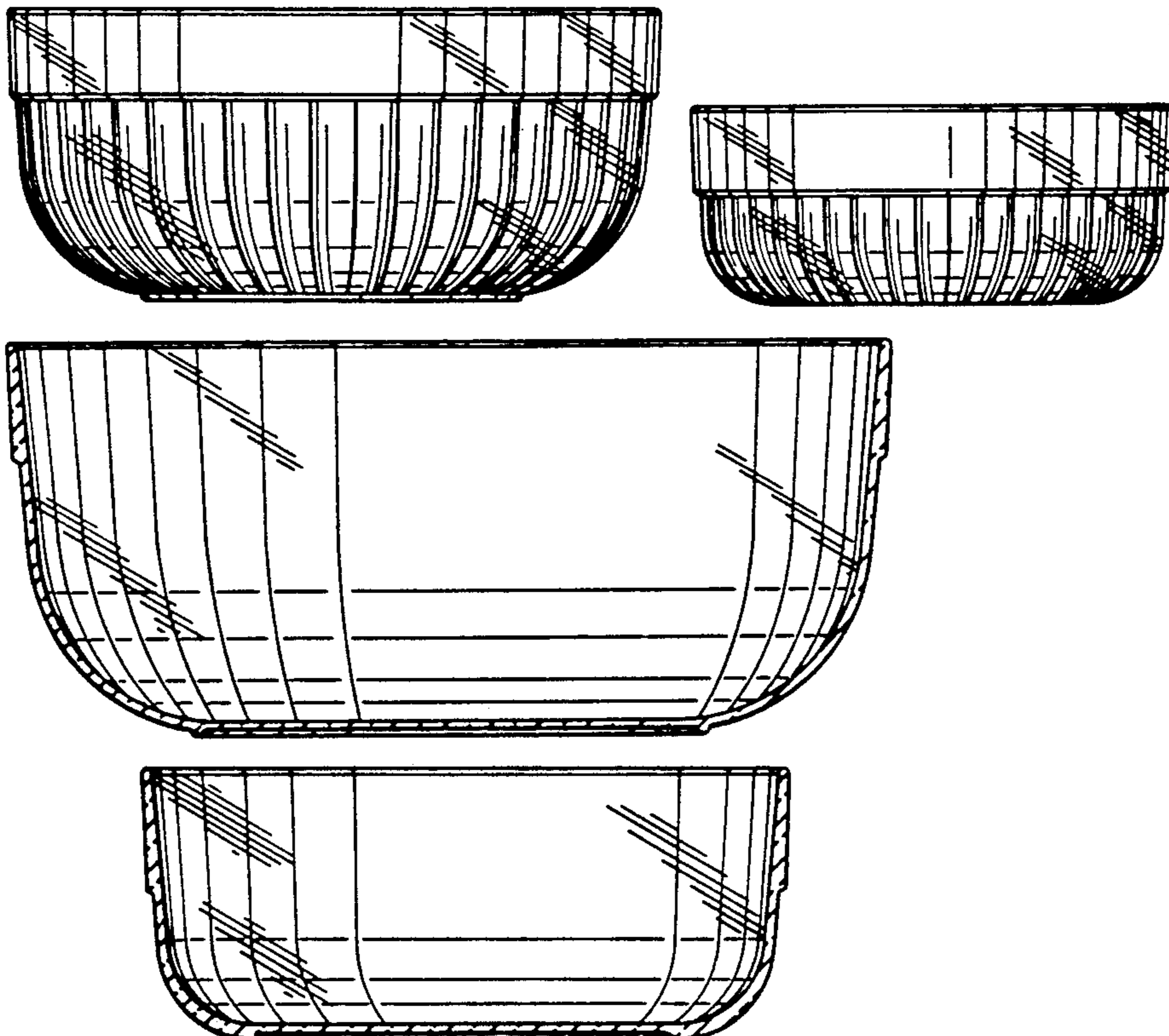

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for the salad bowl or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a first embodiment of the salad bowl or the like showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof with the panels which would be visible through the transparent walls having been omitted for convenience of illustration; FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 5 is a cross-sectional view on an enlarged scale taken on line 5—5 of FIG. 3; FIG. 6 is a top perspective view of a second embodiment of the salad bowl or the like; FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof; FIG. 8 is a top plan view thereof with the panels which would be visible through the transparent walls having been omitted for convenience of illustration; FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view thereof; and FIG. 10 is a cross-sectional view on an enlarged scale taken on line 10—10 of FIG. 8.



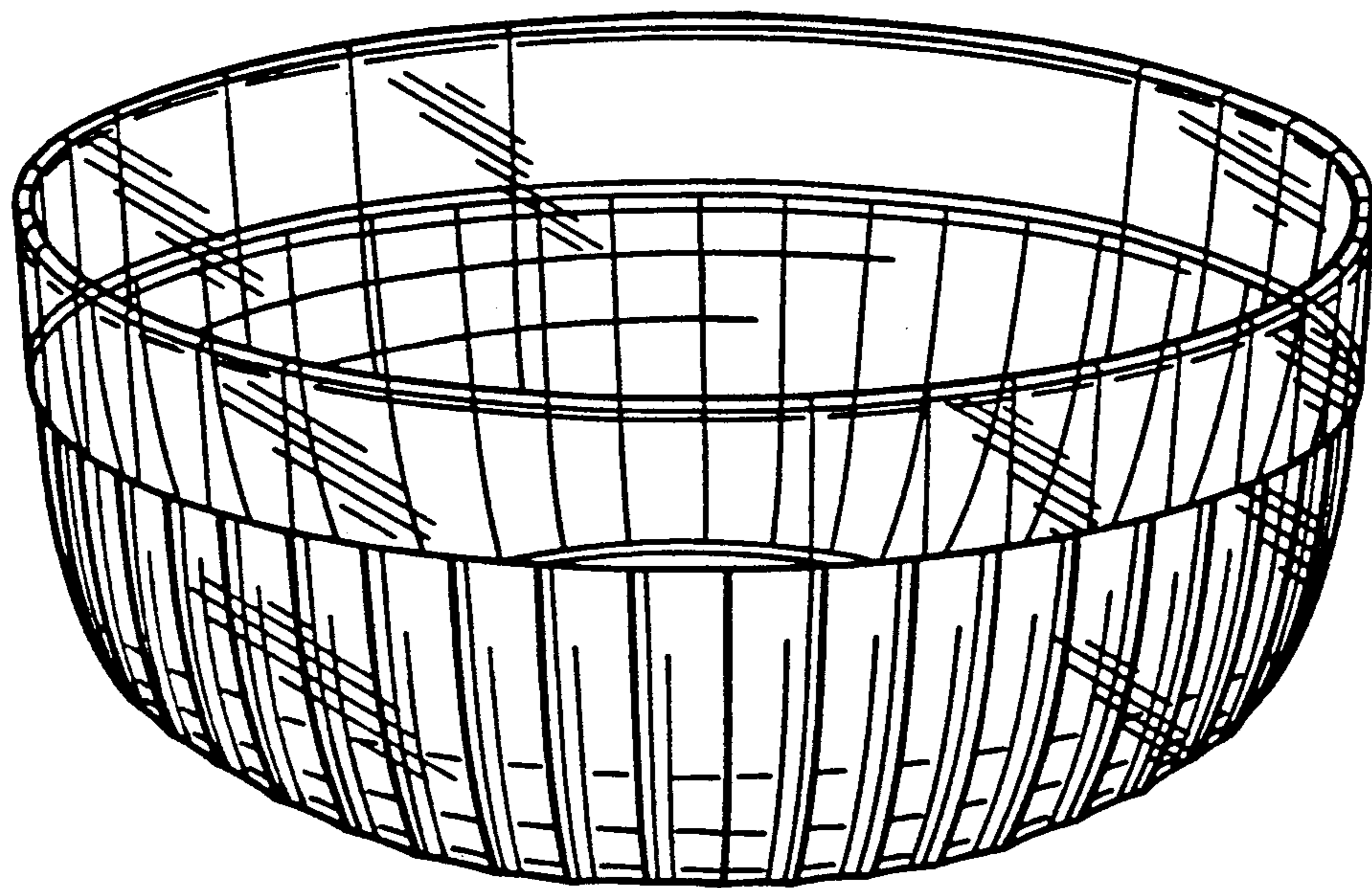

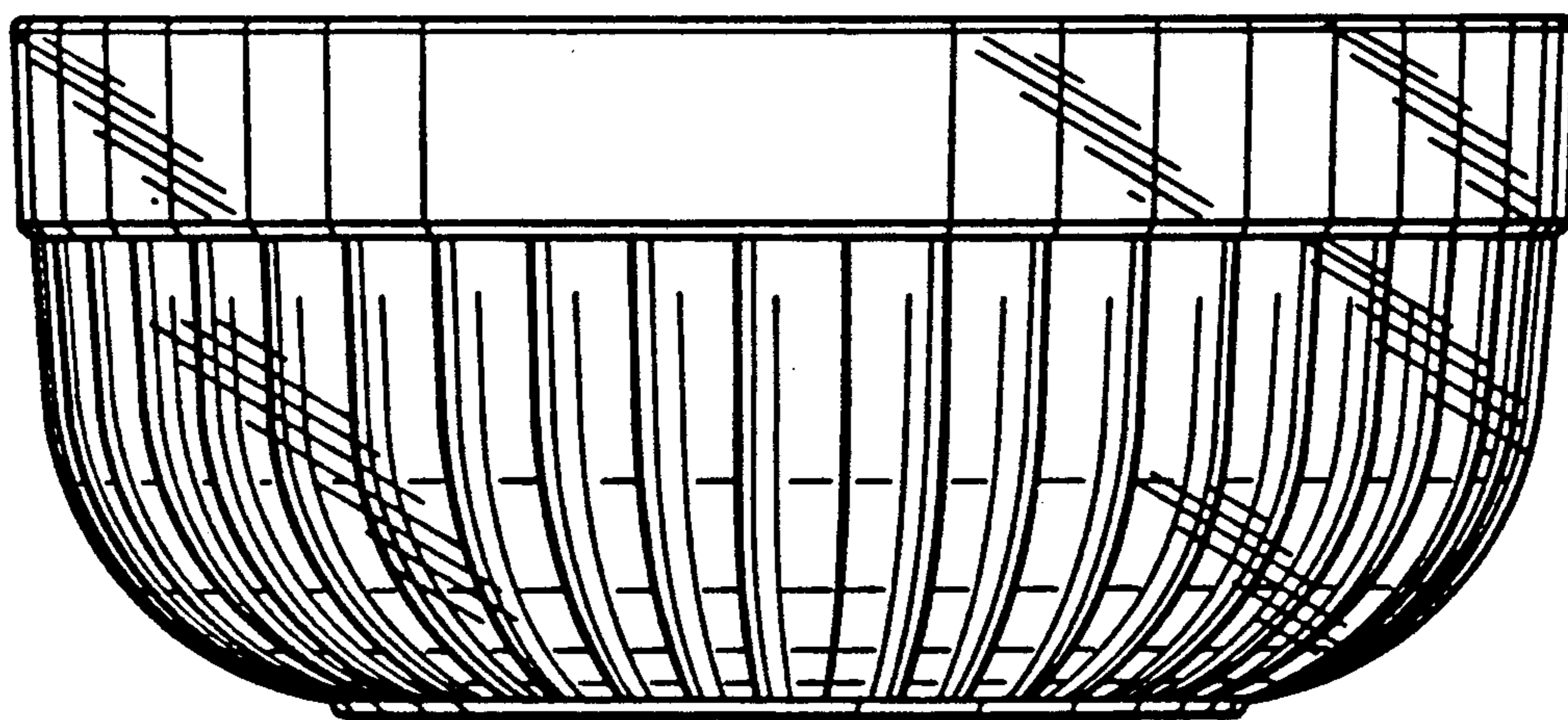

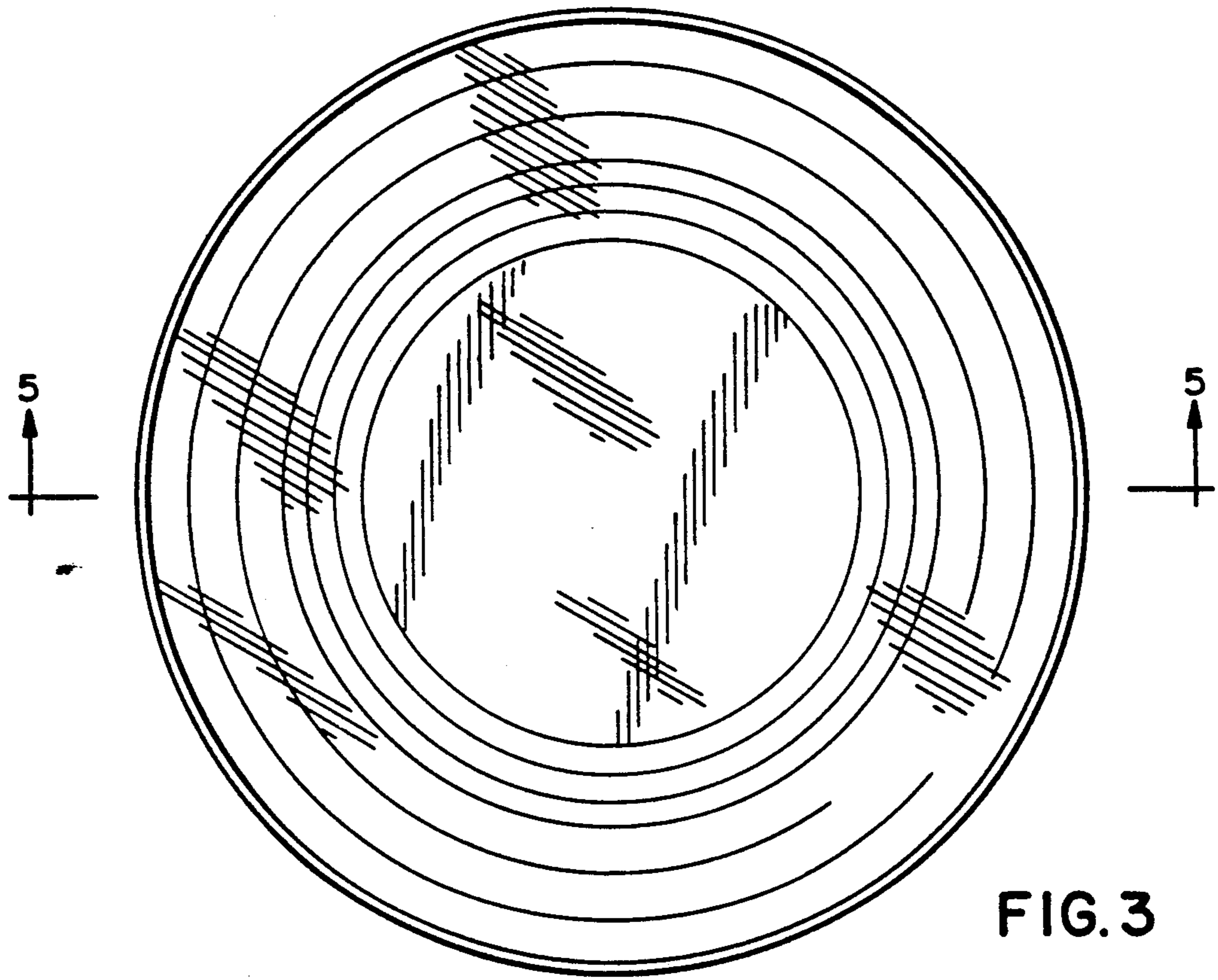

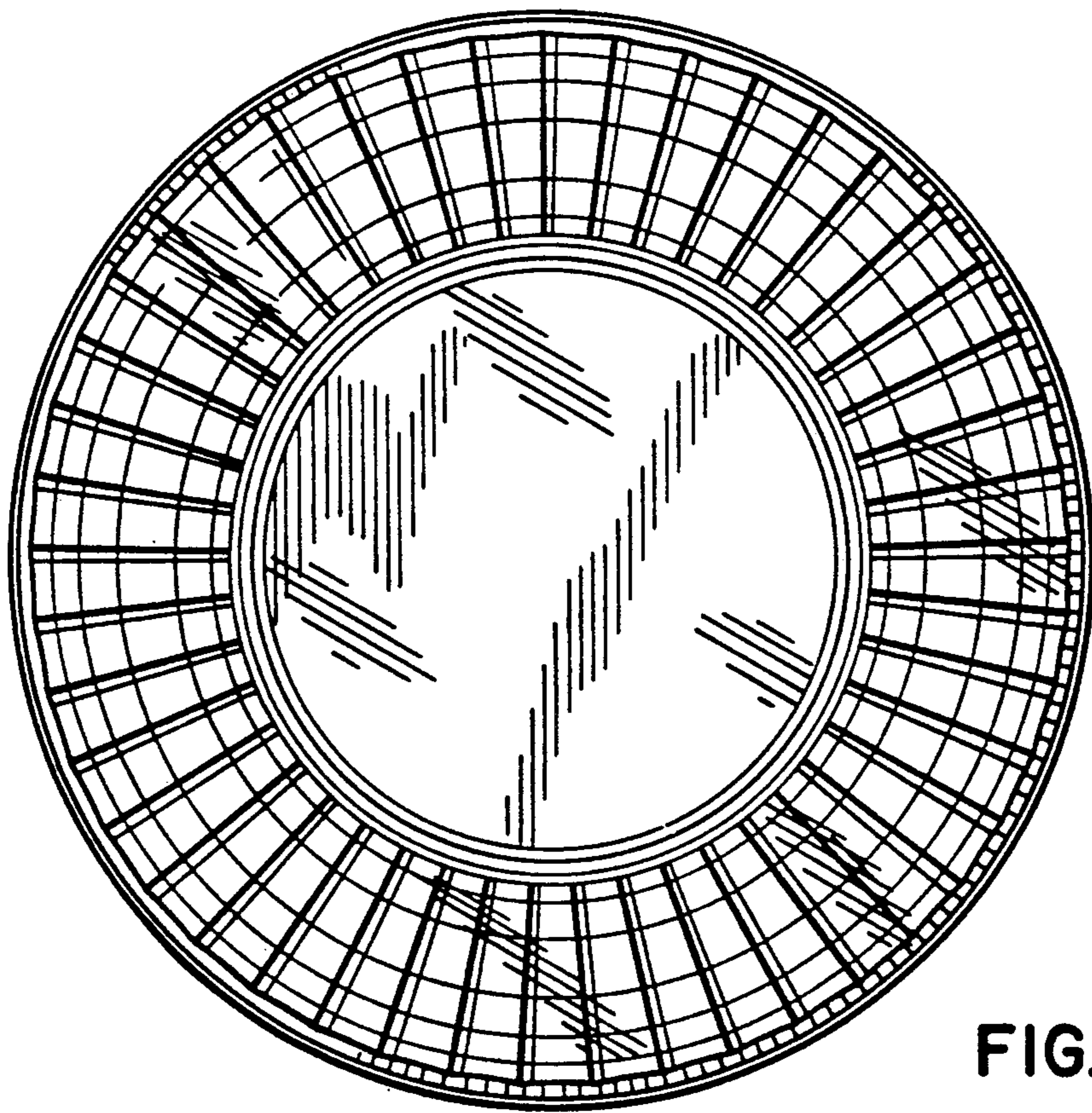

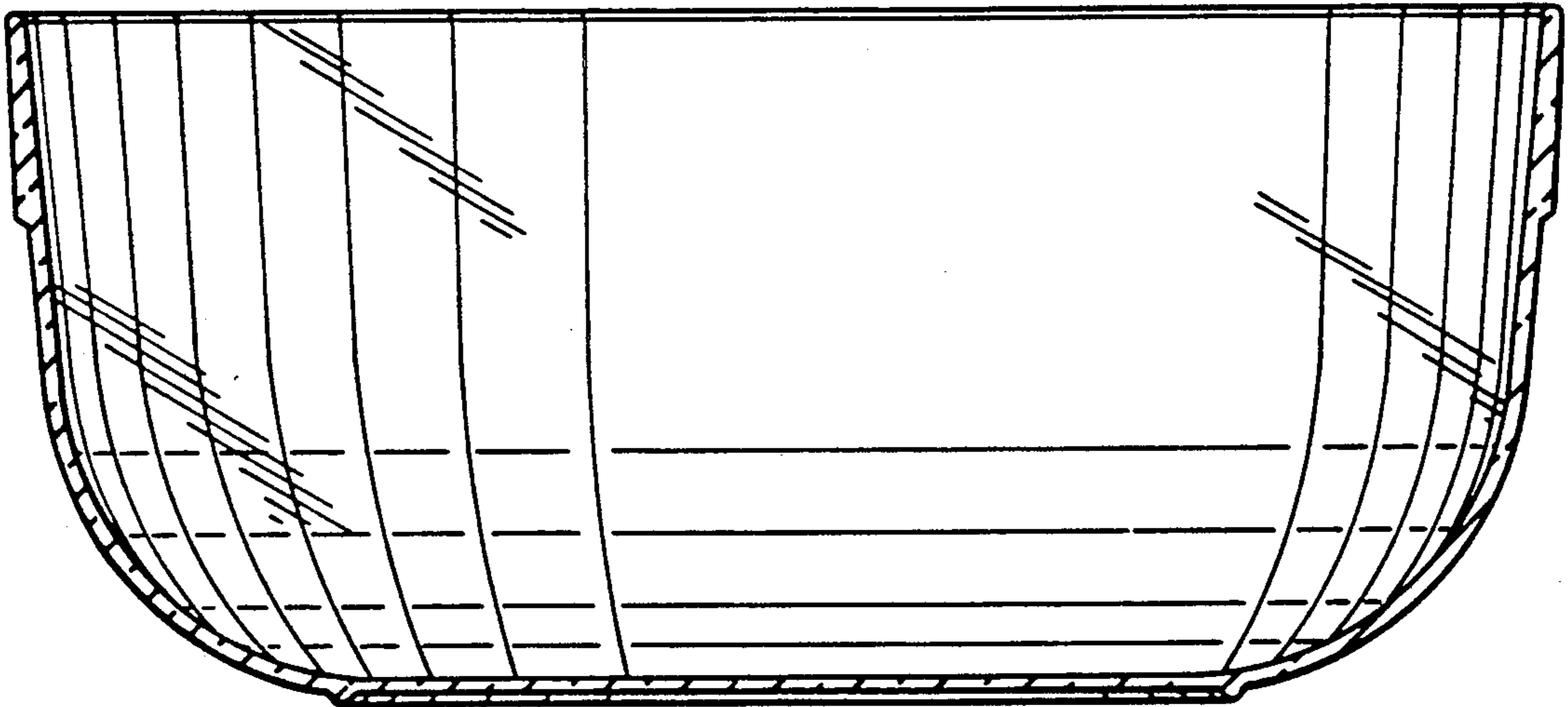

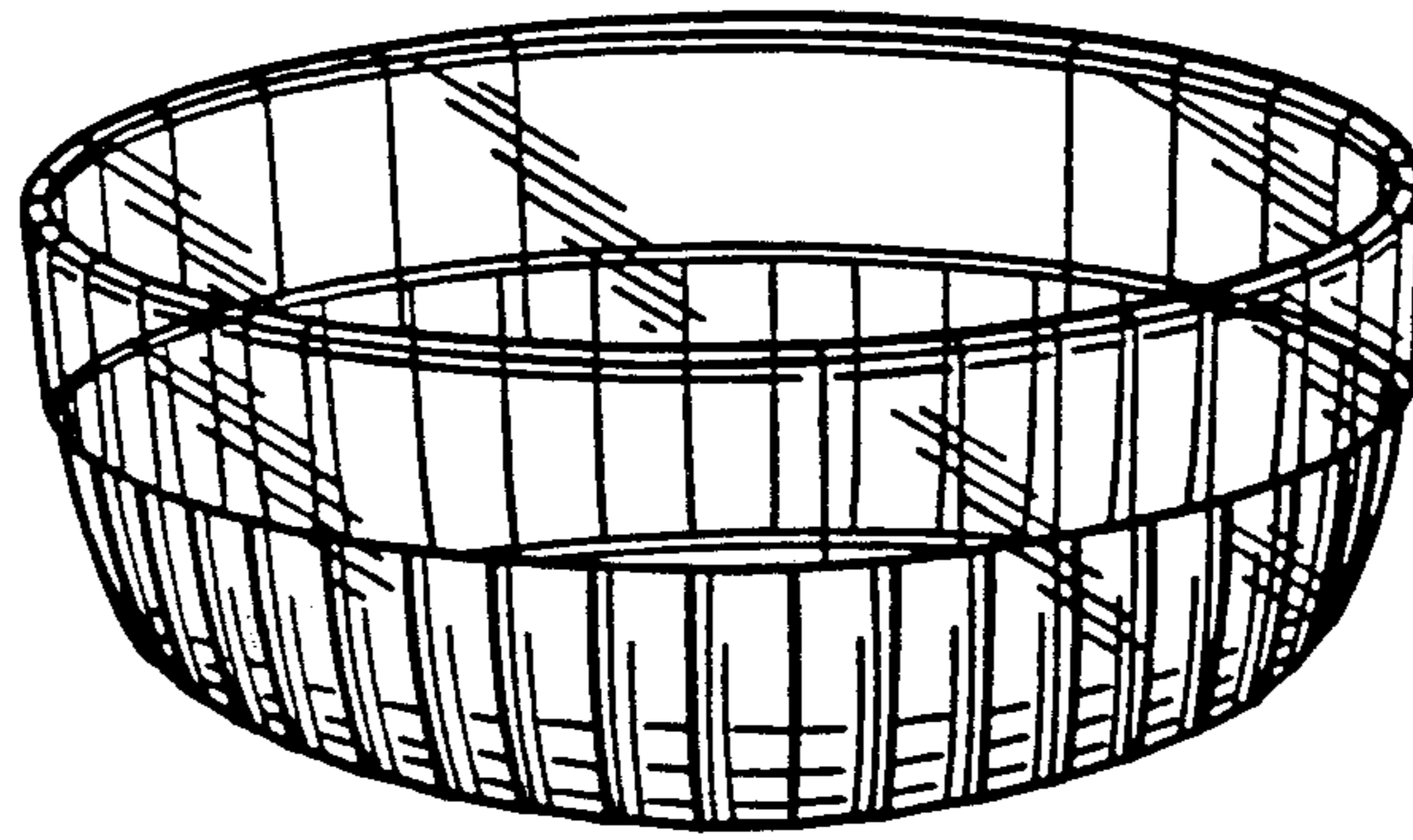

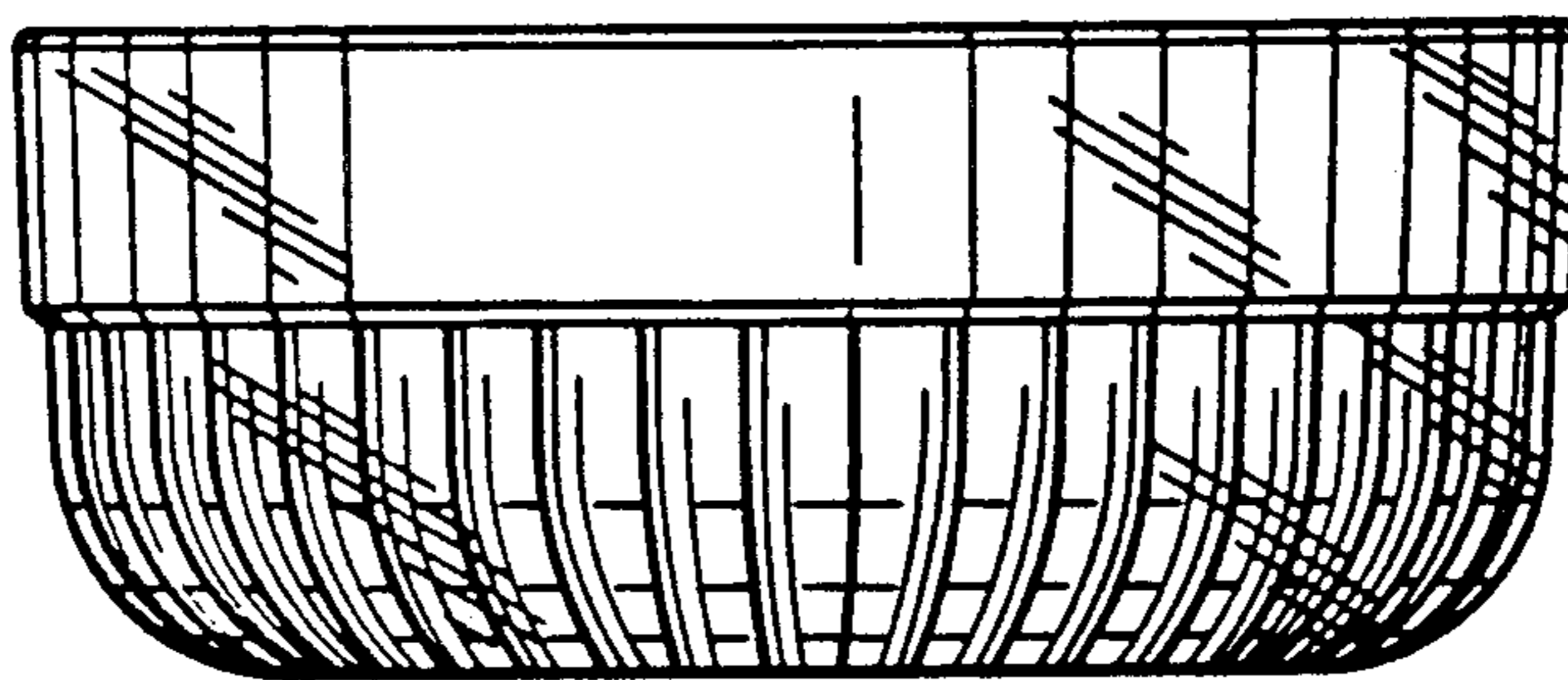

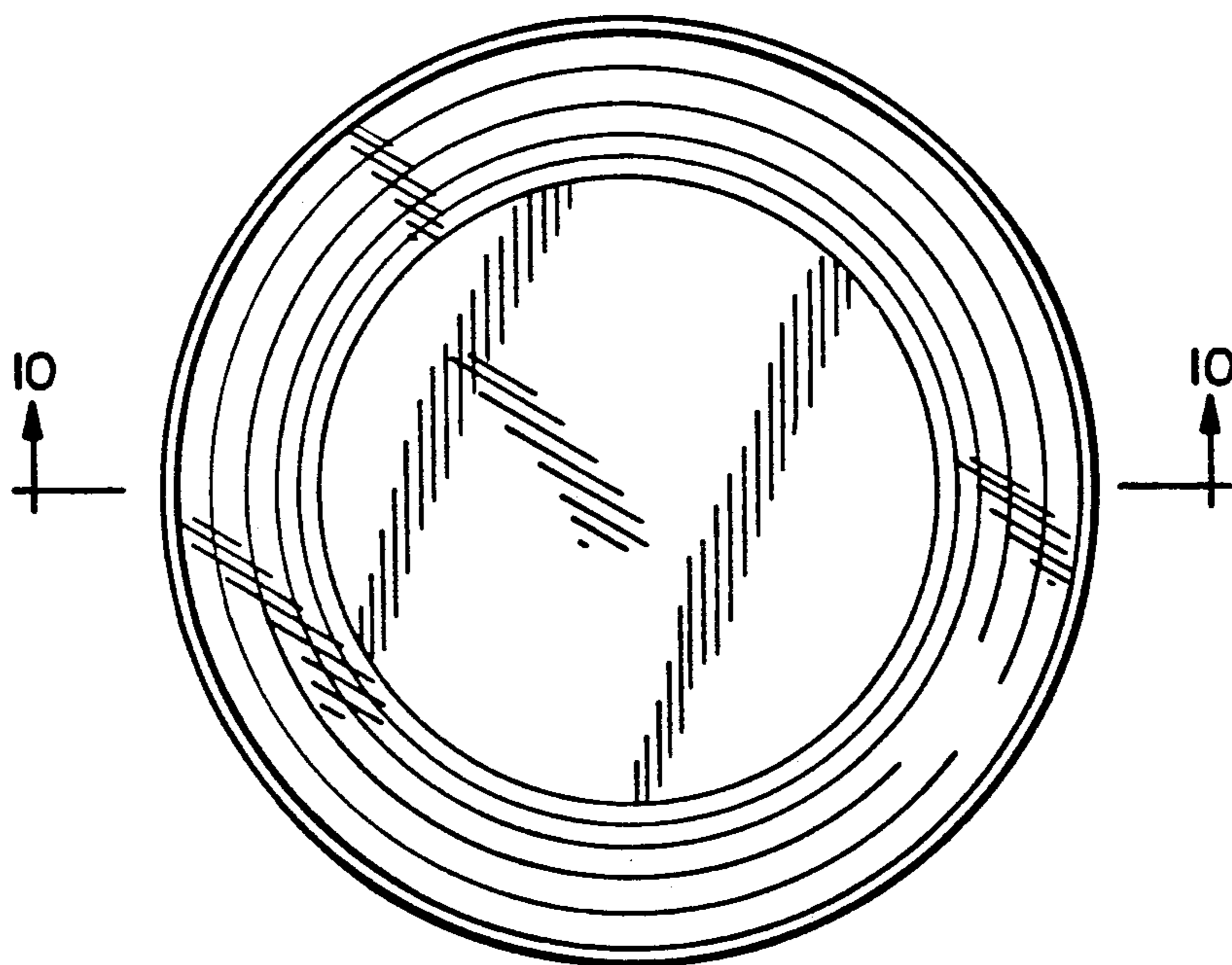

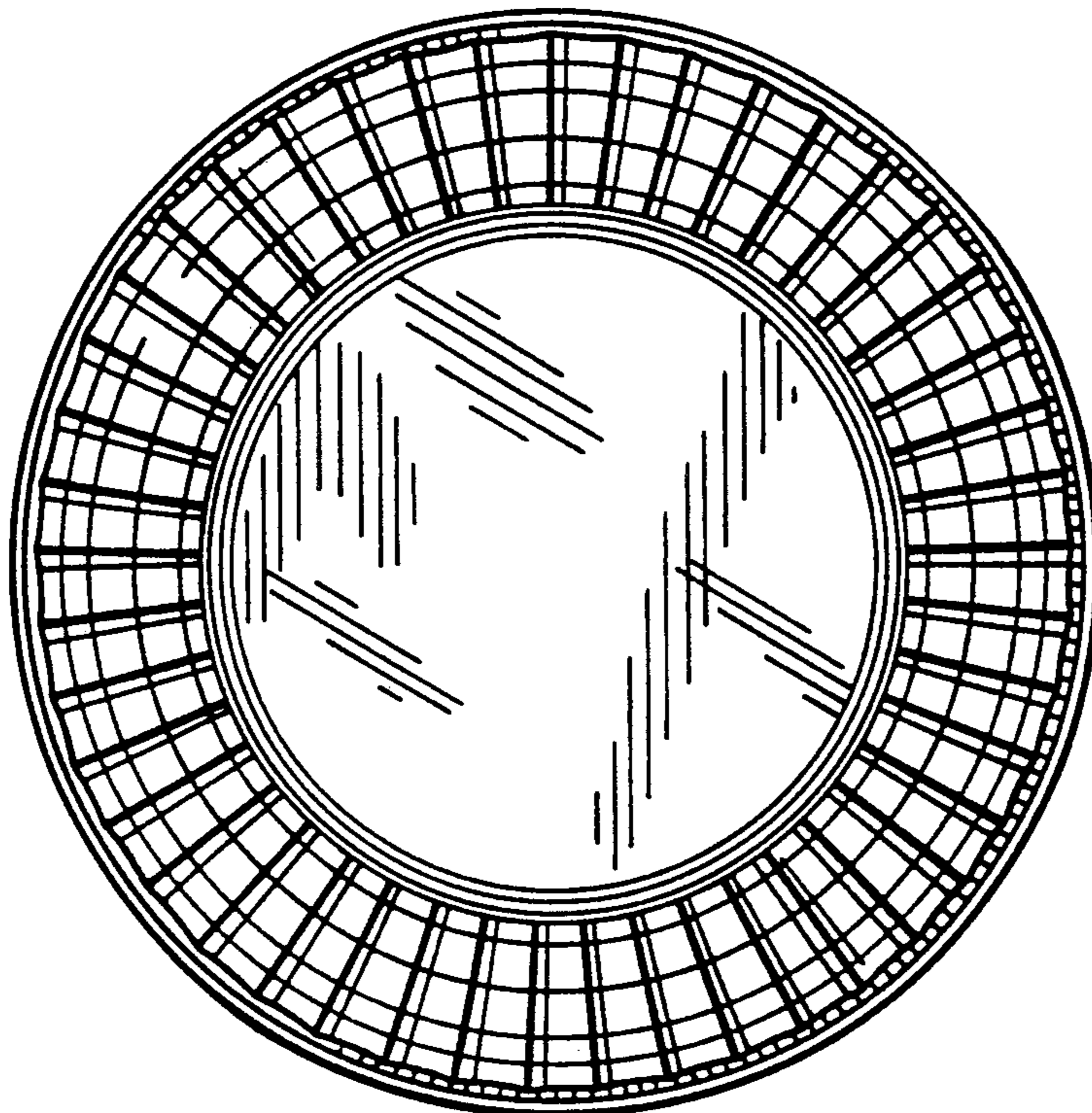

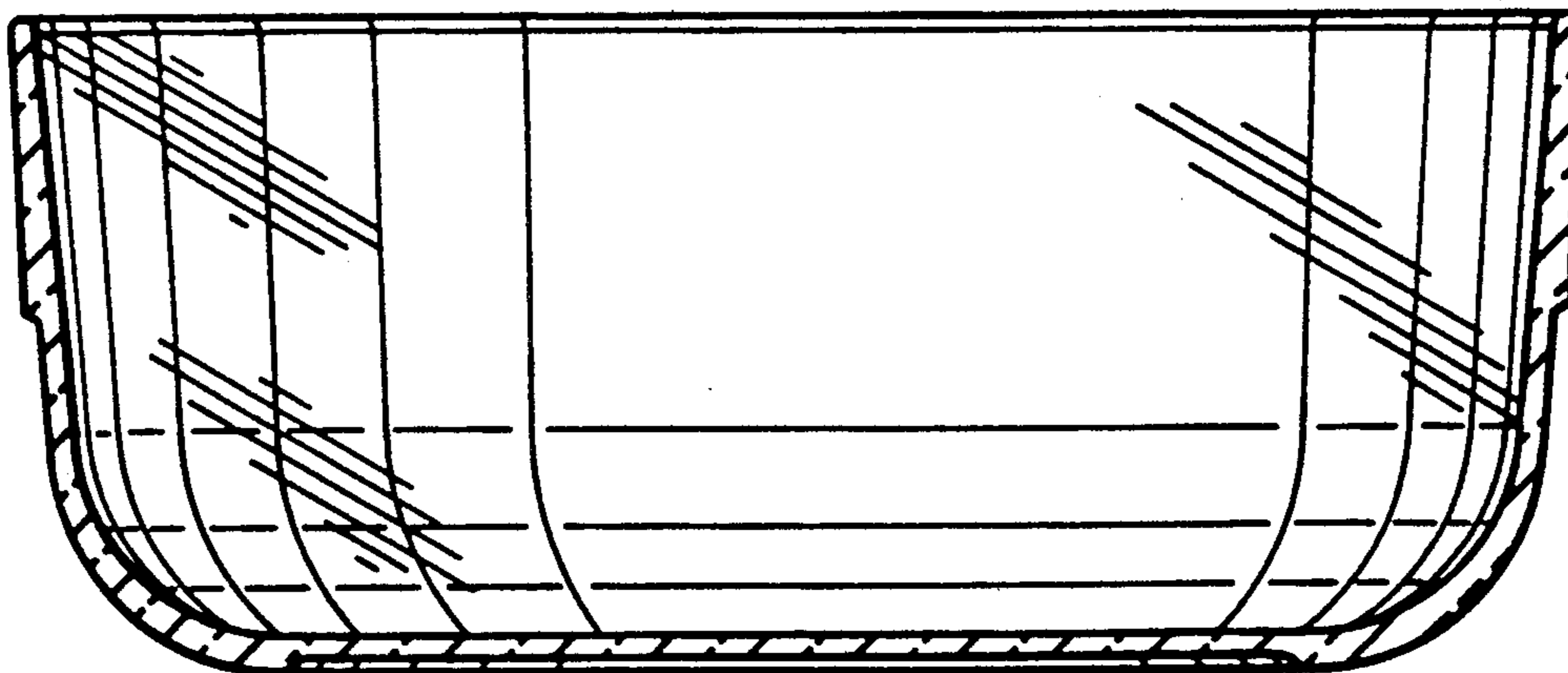
