The ornamental design for a spiral earring for doublepierced ear, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a spiral earring for double pierced ear showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a perspective view thereof worn on a double pierced ear which is shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;


FIG. 6 is a perspective view of a spiral earring for double pierced ear showing a mirror image embodiment of my new design;


FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof;


FIG. 8 is a front elevational thereof;

The broken line showing an ear in FIG. 5 is for illustrative purposes only, and forms no part of the claimed design.


















