FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view thereof;

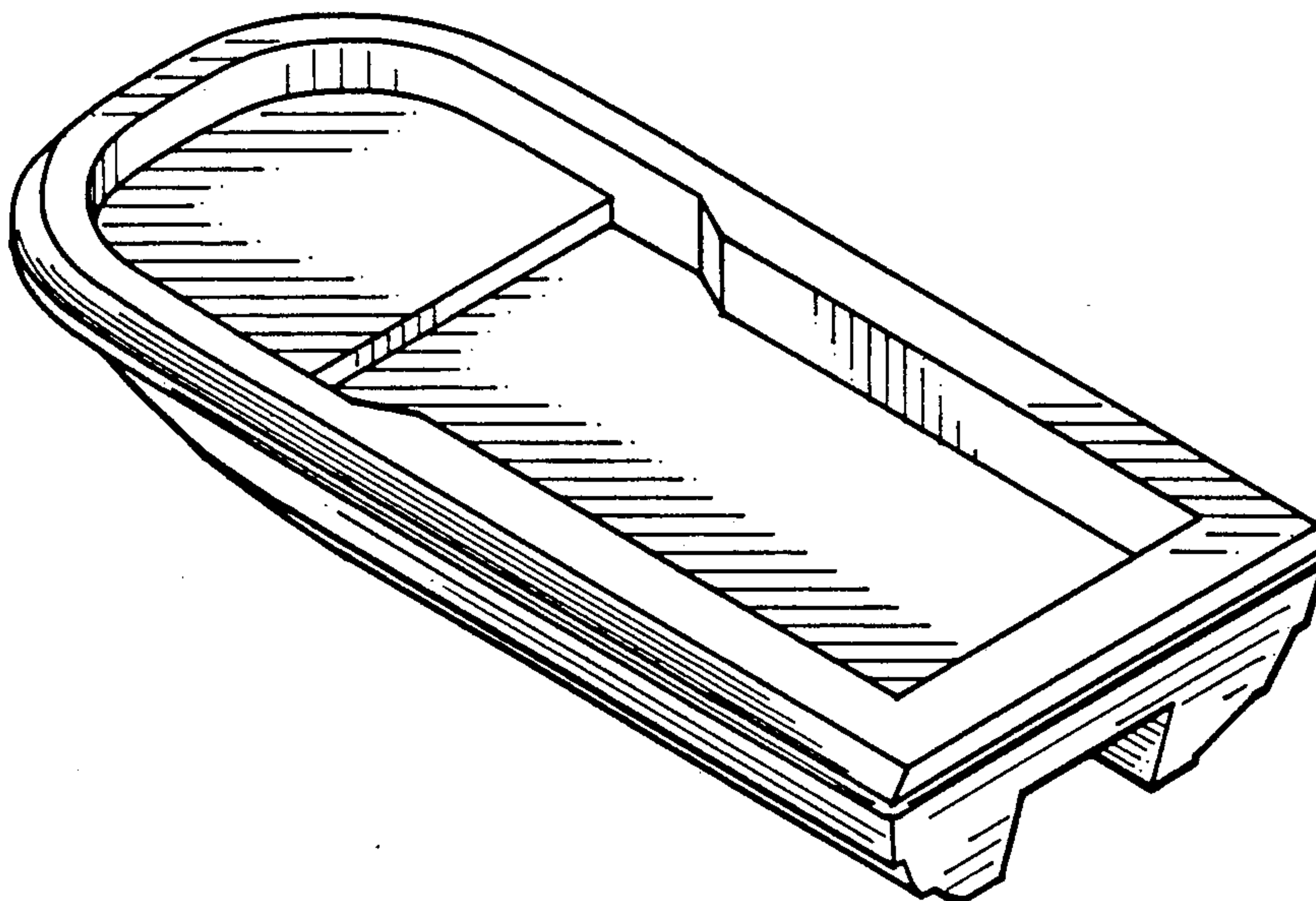
FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 8 is a bottom perspective view thereof.



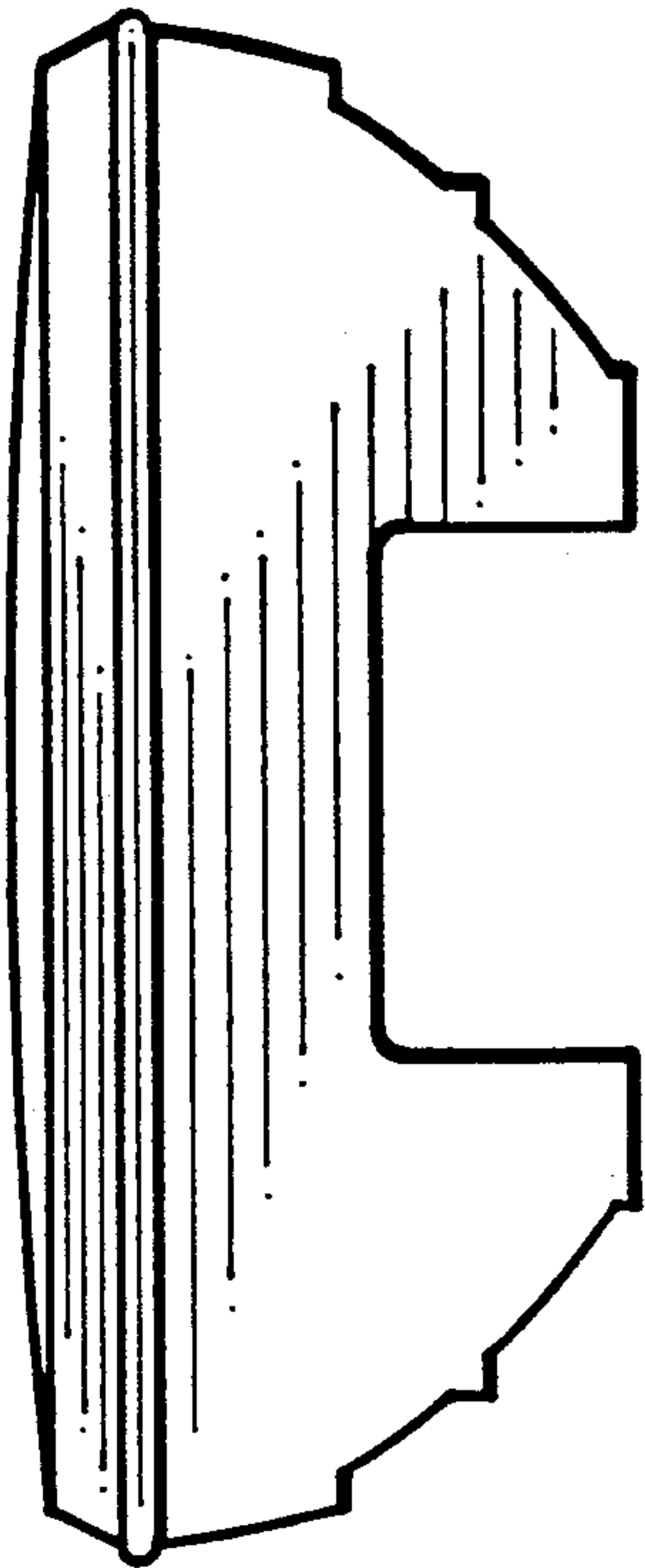

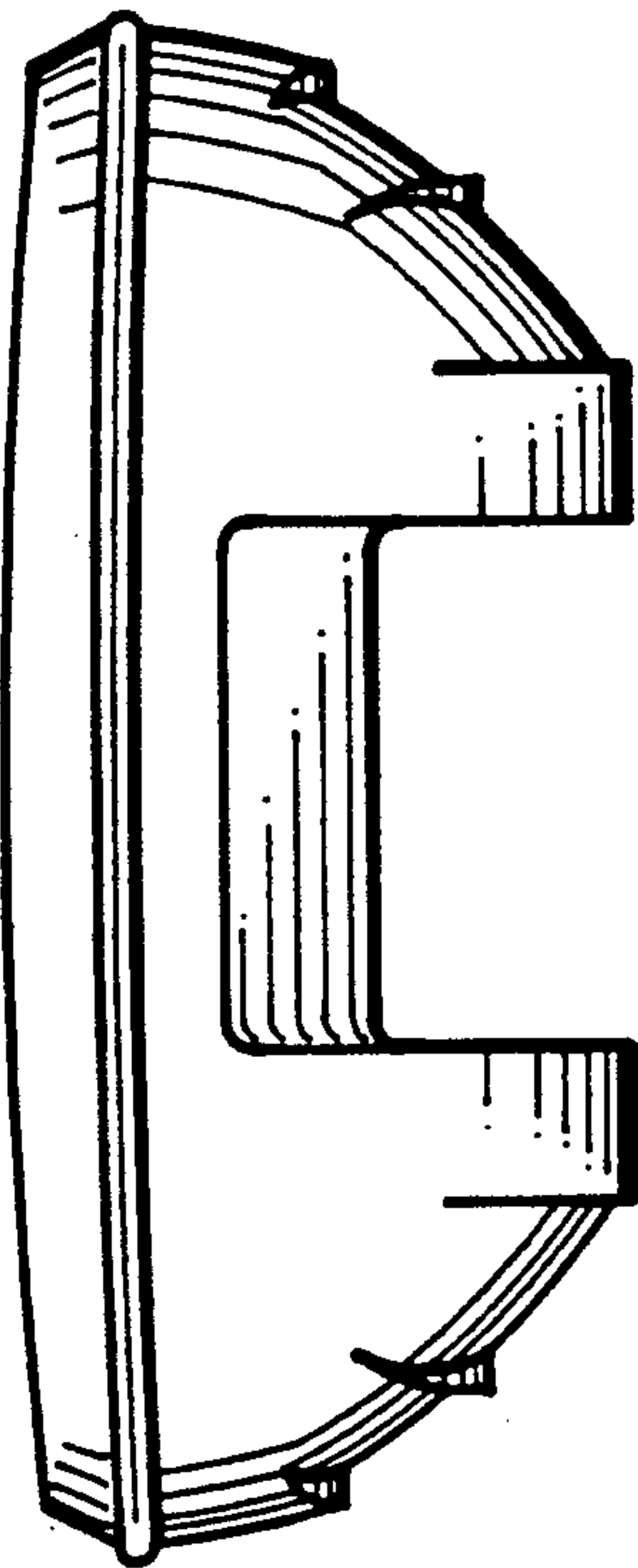

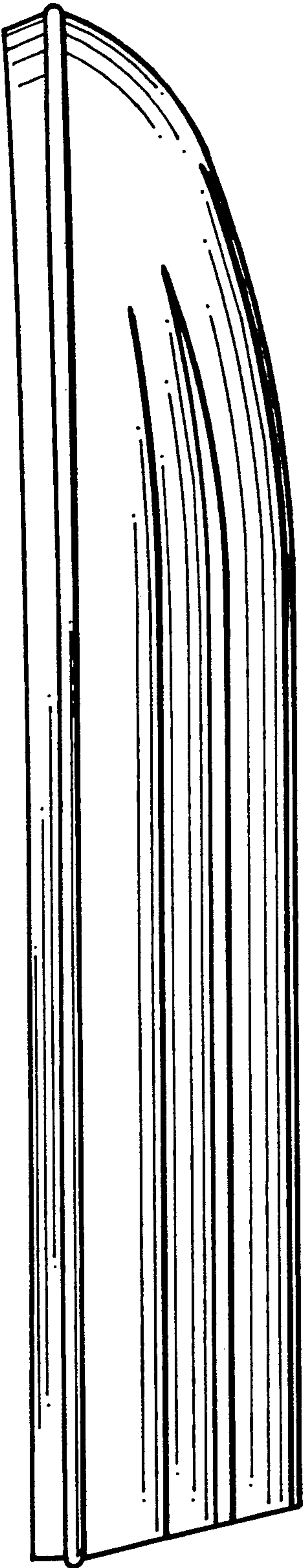

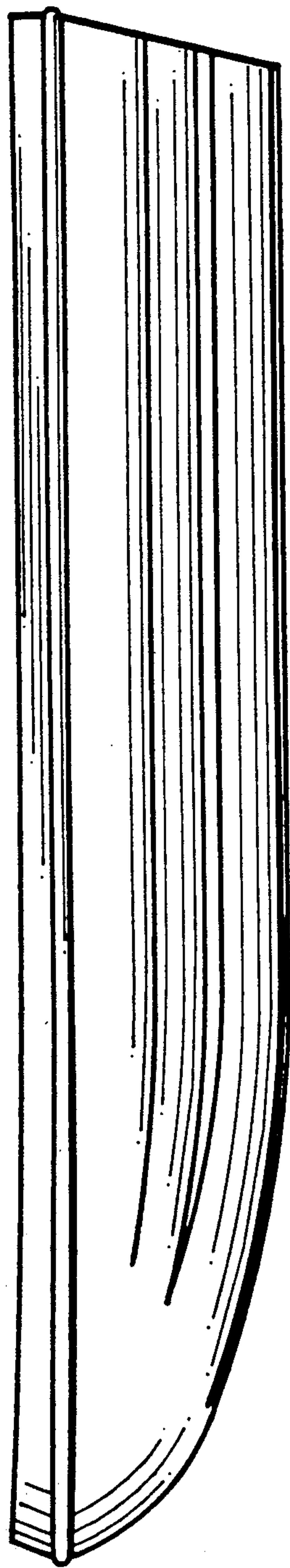

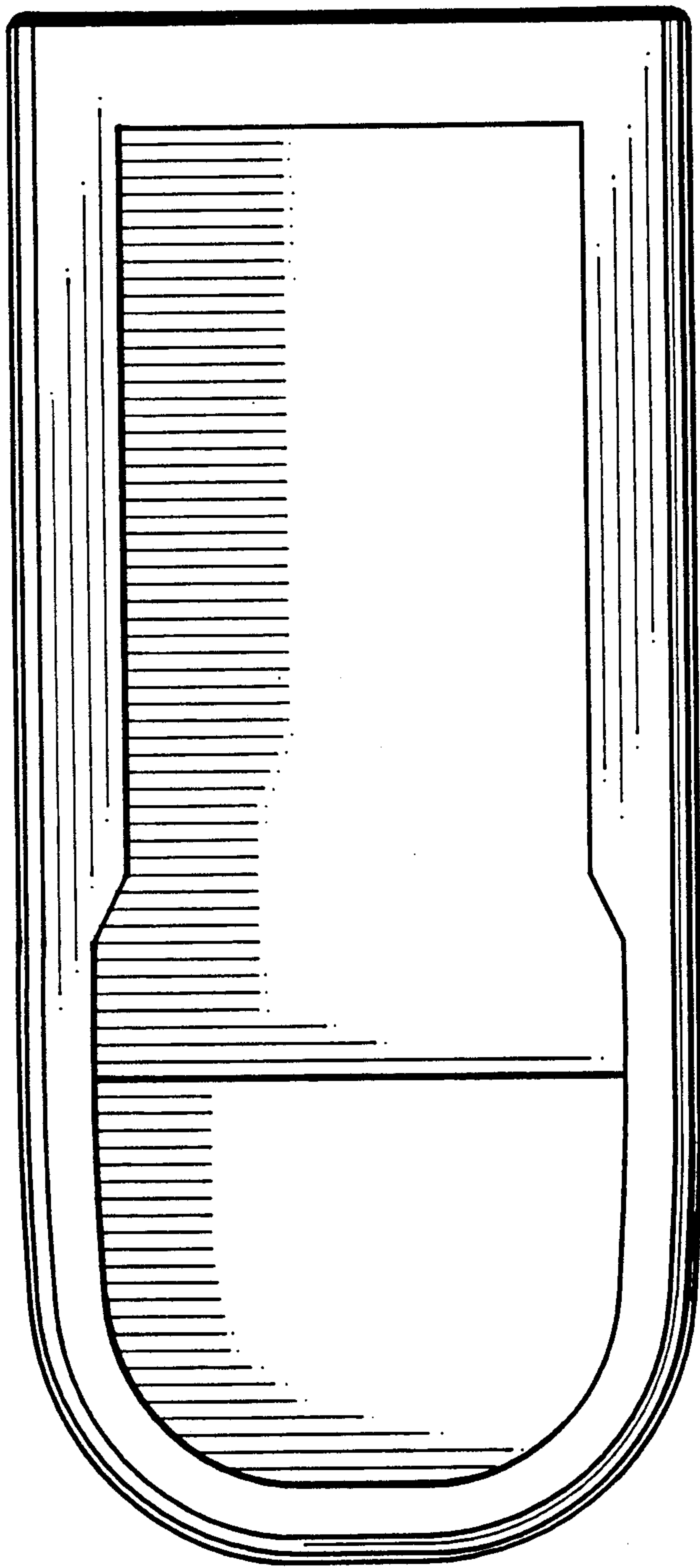

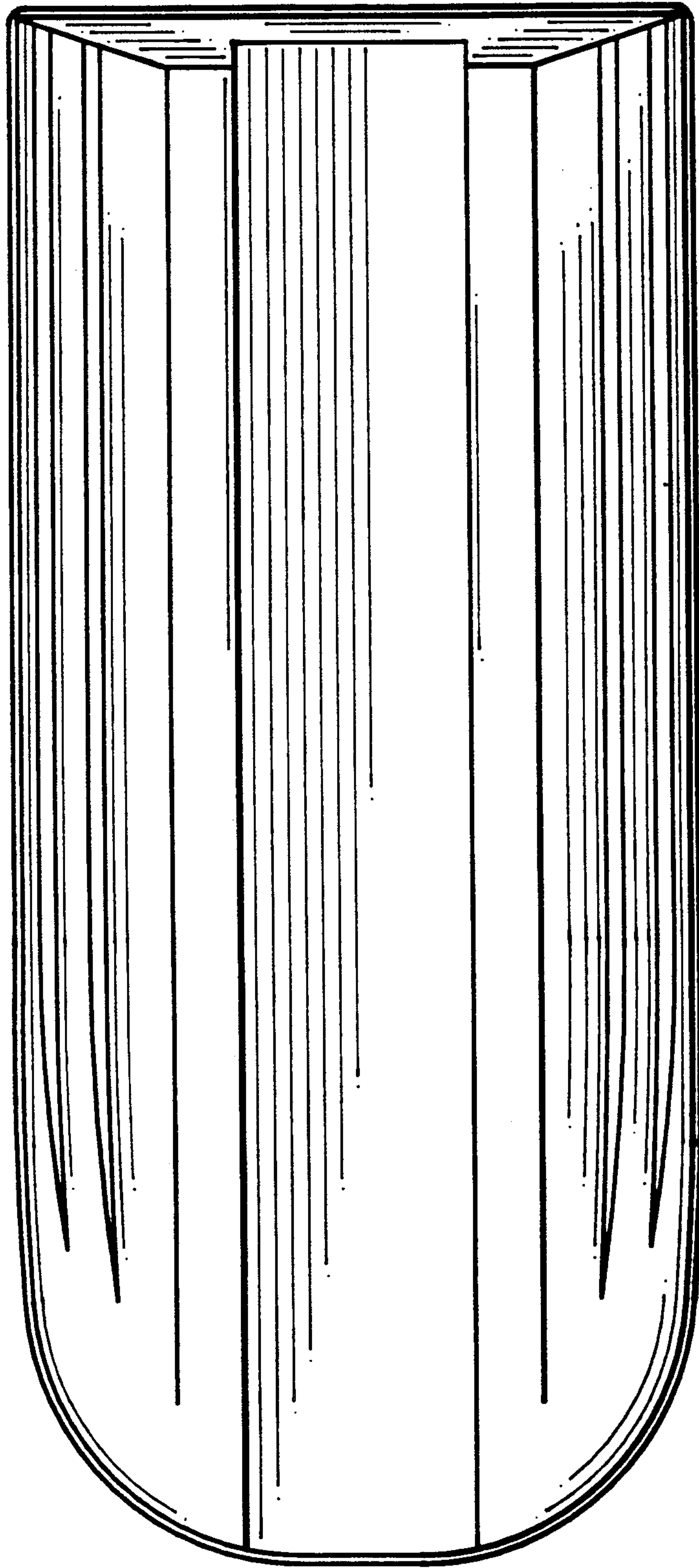

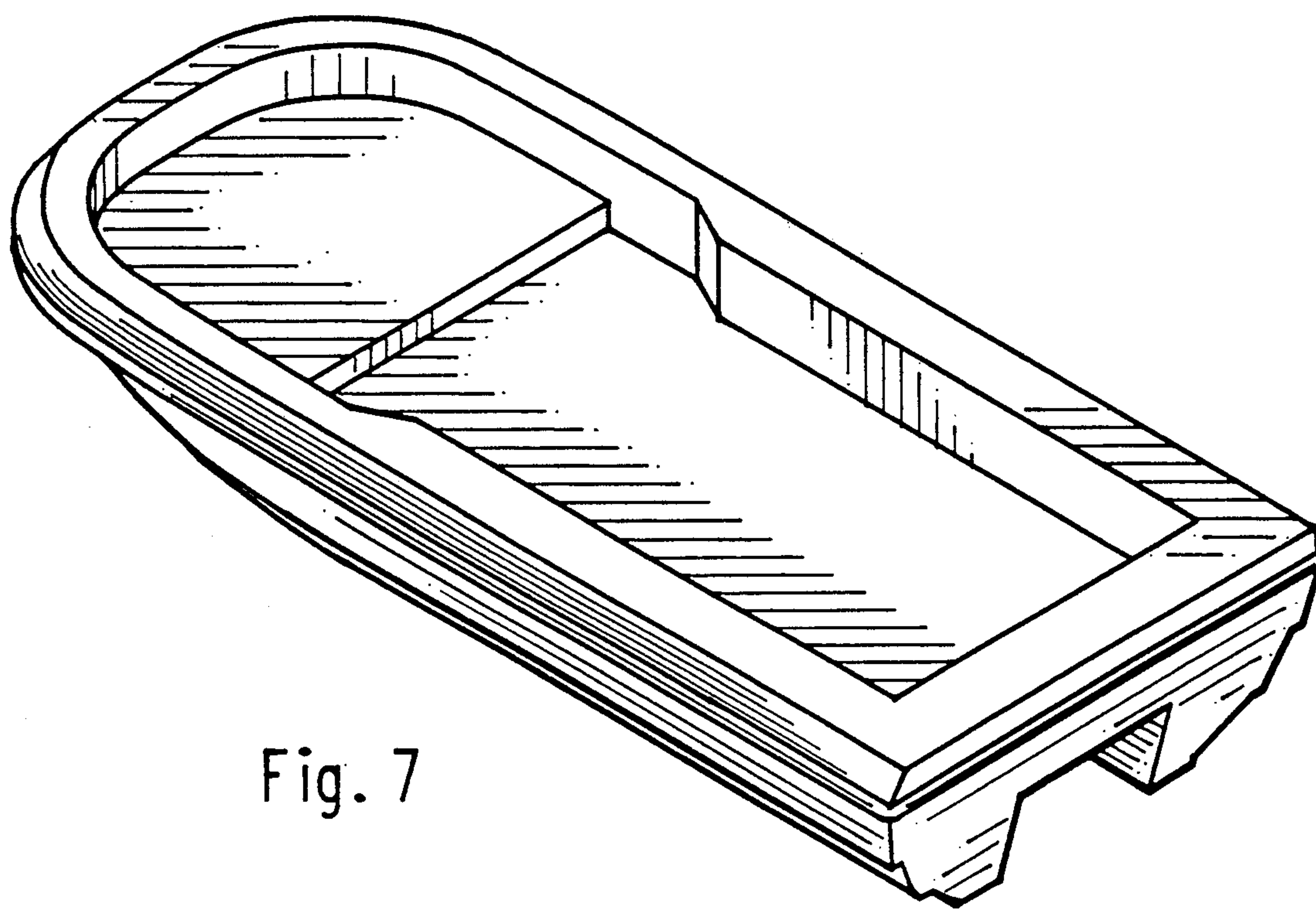

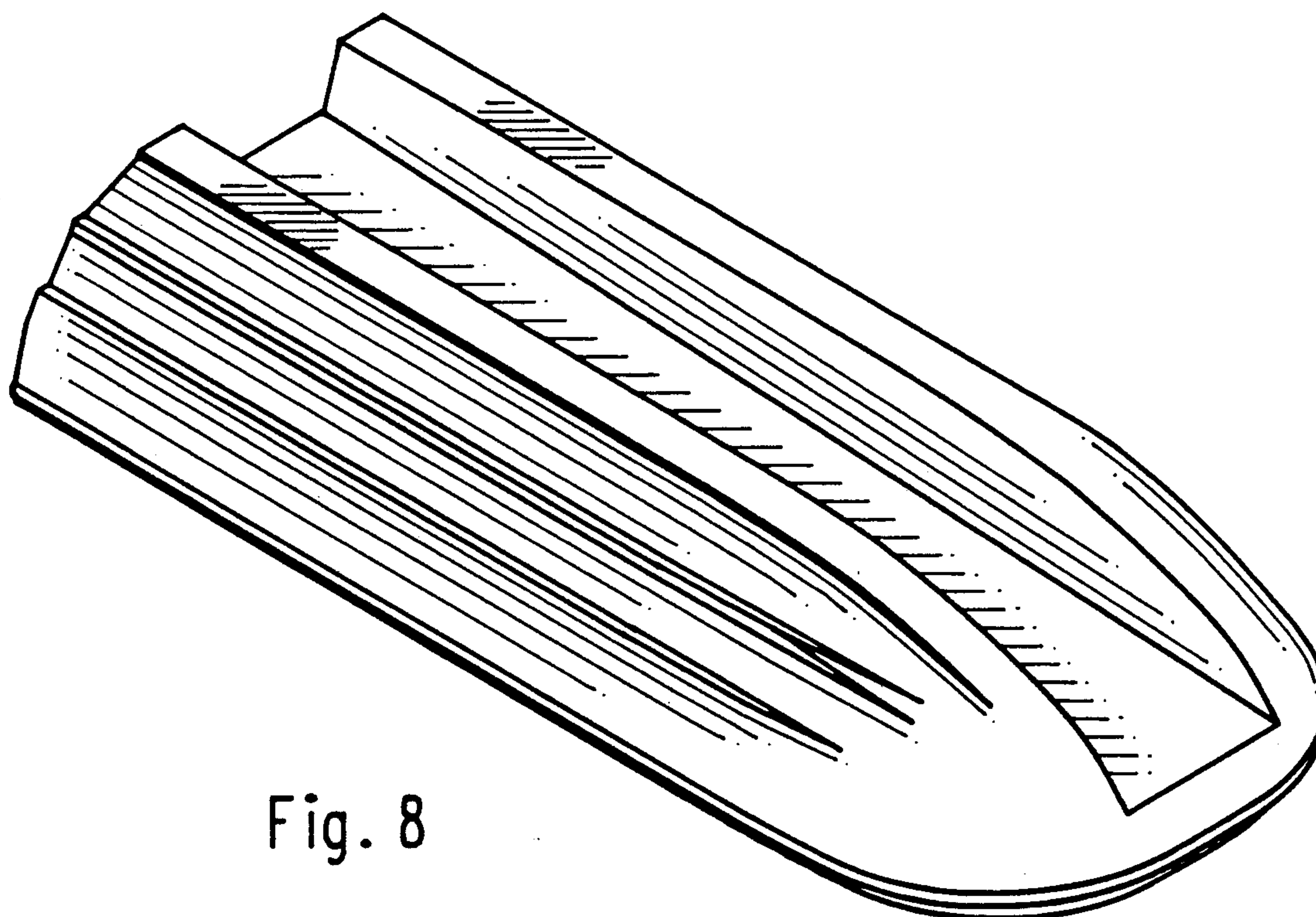
