FIG. 1 is a top and side perspective view of a recreational boat showing our new design;


FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, the left side view being a mirror image of that shown;


FIG. 4 is a bottom view thereof;


FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and
