[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a folding carbine gun stock, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a right side elevational view of a folding carbine gun stock, showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof; FIG. 4 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof; and FIG. 6 is a left side elevational view thereof. The broken line showing the part of a rifle is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

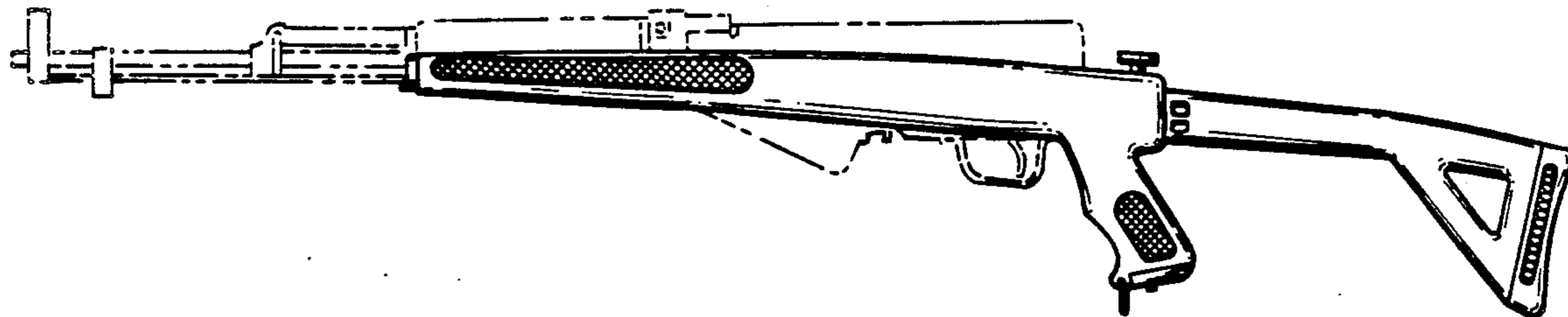

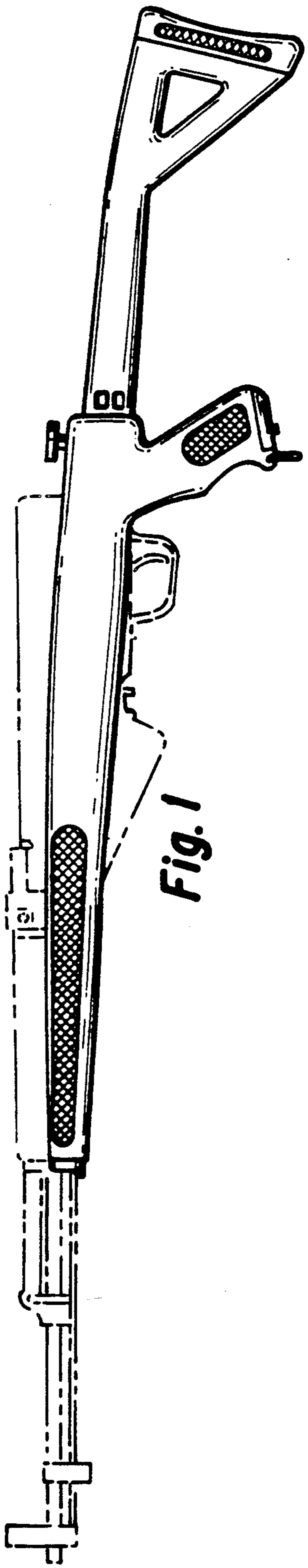

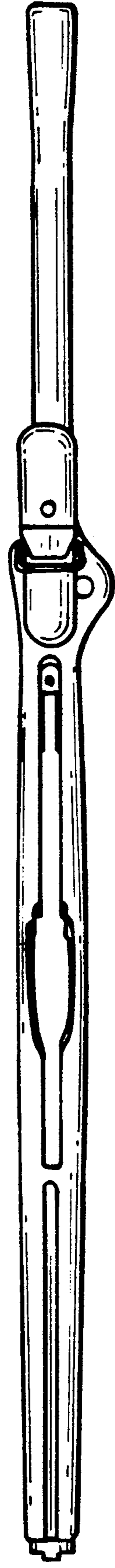

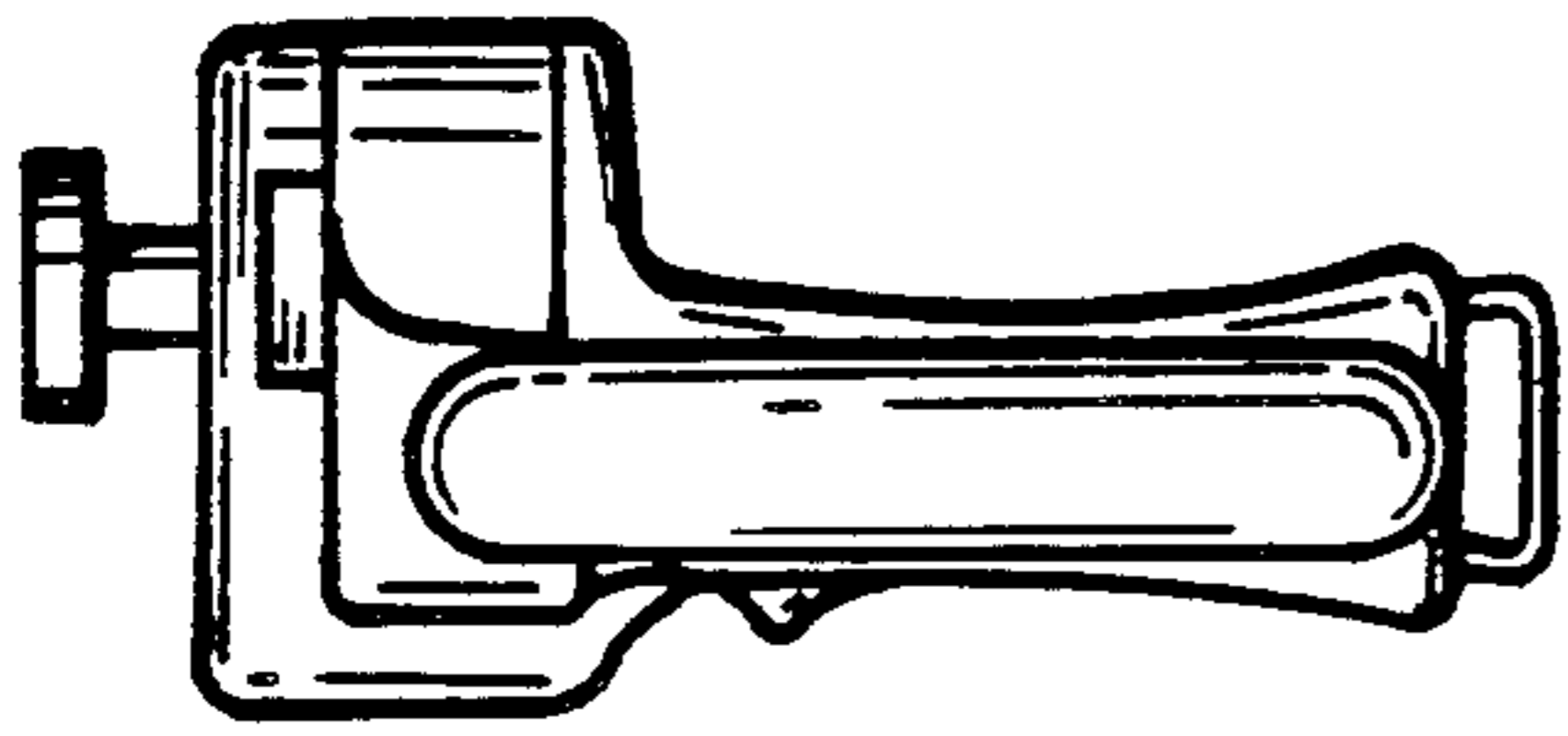

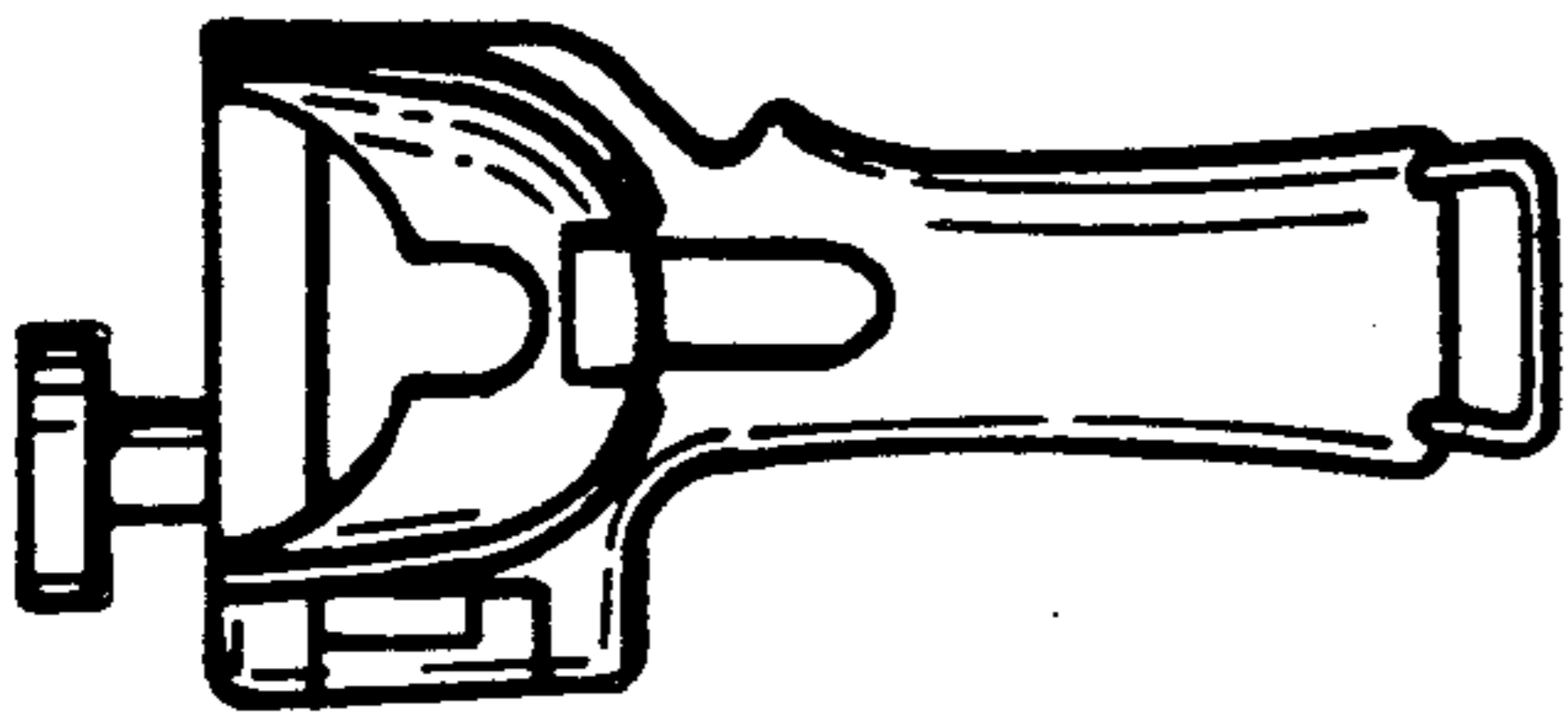

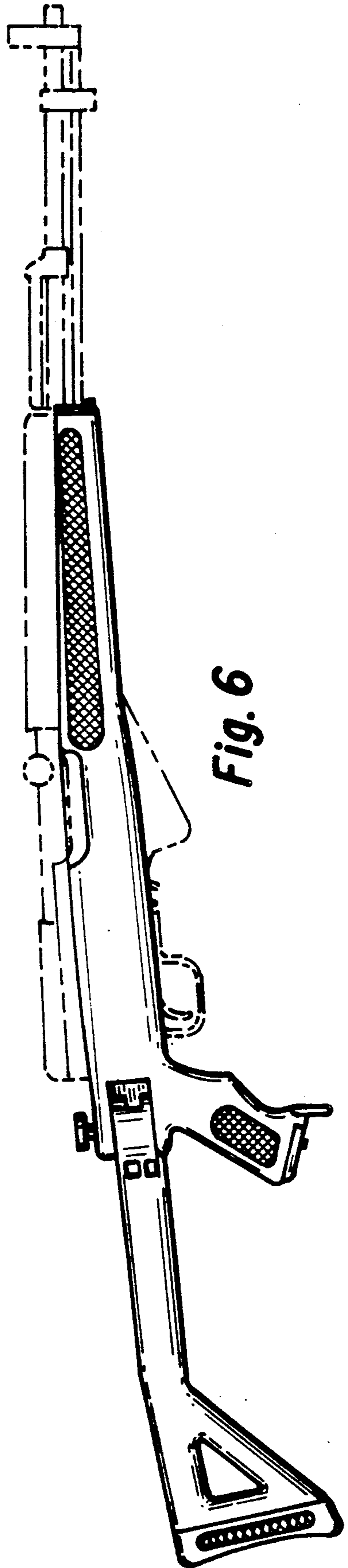
