## [57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for an adjustable cosmetic applicator, as shown and described.

#### DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of an adjustable cosmetic applicator, showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view thereof, with the brush shown in an alternative position;

FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view thereof, with the brush shown in an alternative position;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of a second embodiment, the only difference being the configuration of the applicator tip;

FIG. 6 is a top plan view of a third embodiment, the only difference being the configuration of the applicator tip;

FIG. 7 is a front elevational view of a fourth embodiment, the only difference being the configuration of the rotatable knob;

FIG. 8 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 7;

FIG. 9 is right side elevational view of FIG. 7, with the brush shown in an alternative position;

FIG. 10 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 7, with the brush shown in an alternative position;

FIG. 11 is a top plan view of a fifth embodiment, the only difference being the configuration of the applicator tip;

FIG. 12 is a top plan view of a sixth embodiment, the only difference being the configuration of the applicator tip;

FIG. 13 is a front elevational view of a seventh embodiment, the only difference being the configuration of the rotatable knob;

FIG. 14 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 13;

FIG. 15 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 13, with the brush in an alternative position;

FIG. 16 is a right side elevational view of FIG. 13, with the brush shown in an alternative position;

FIG. 17 is a top plan view of an eighth embodiment, the only difference being the configuration of the applicator tip; and

FIG. 18 is a top plan view of a ninth embodiment, the only difference being the configuration of the applicator tip.
