The ornamental design for an infant automobile booster seat, as shown and described.

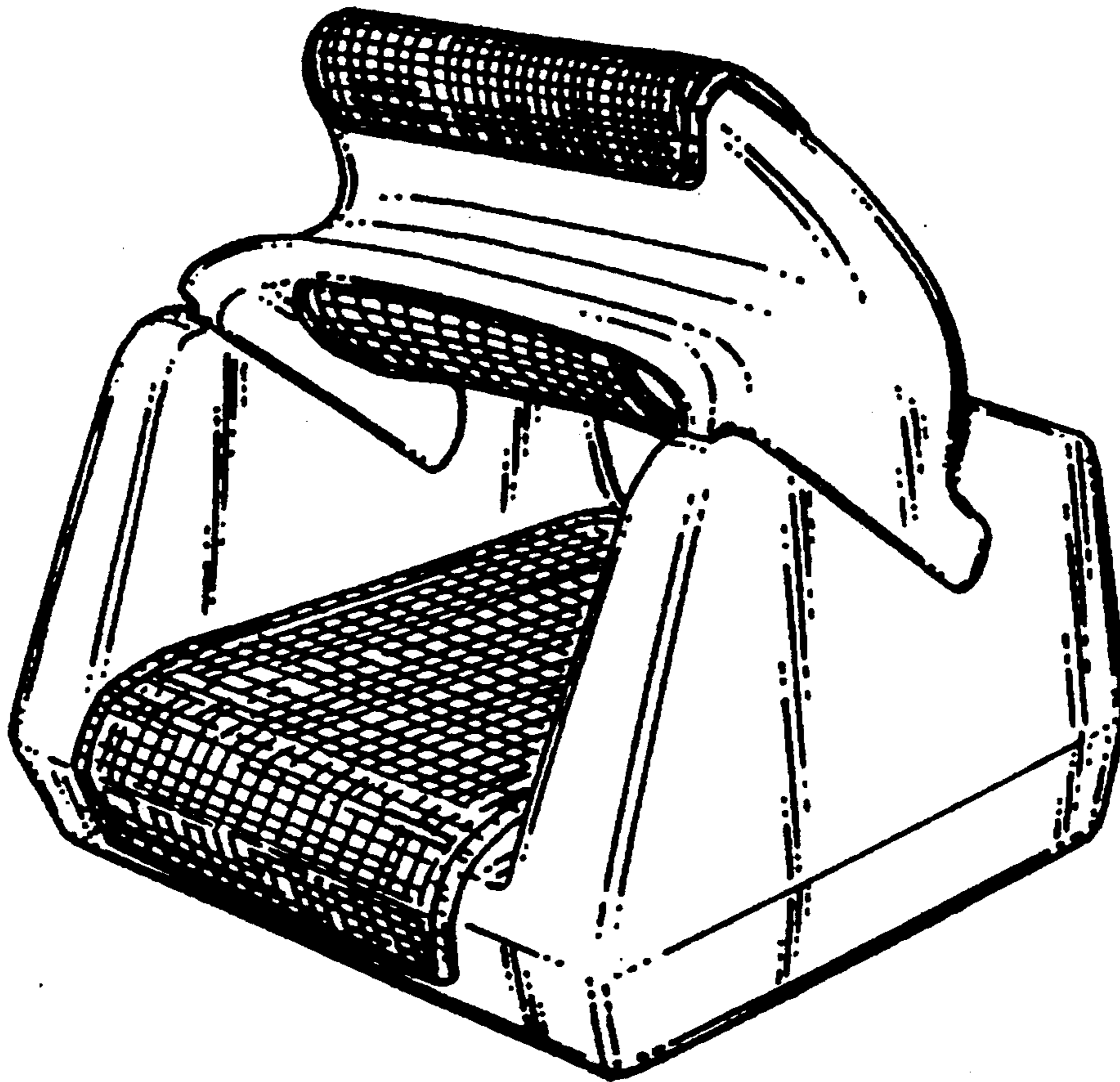
DESCRIPTION

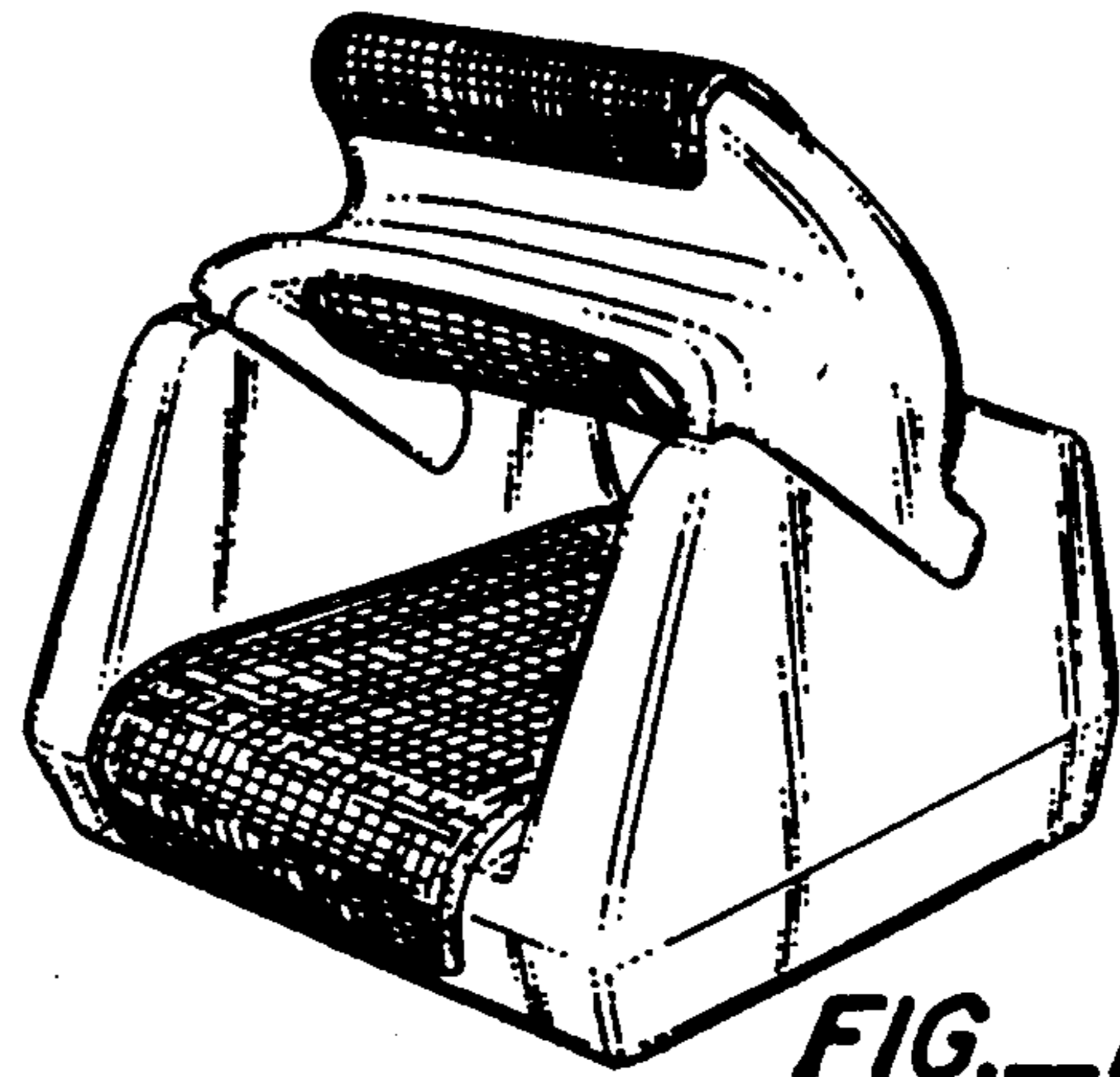

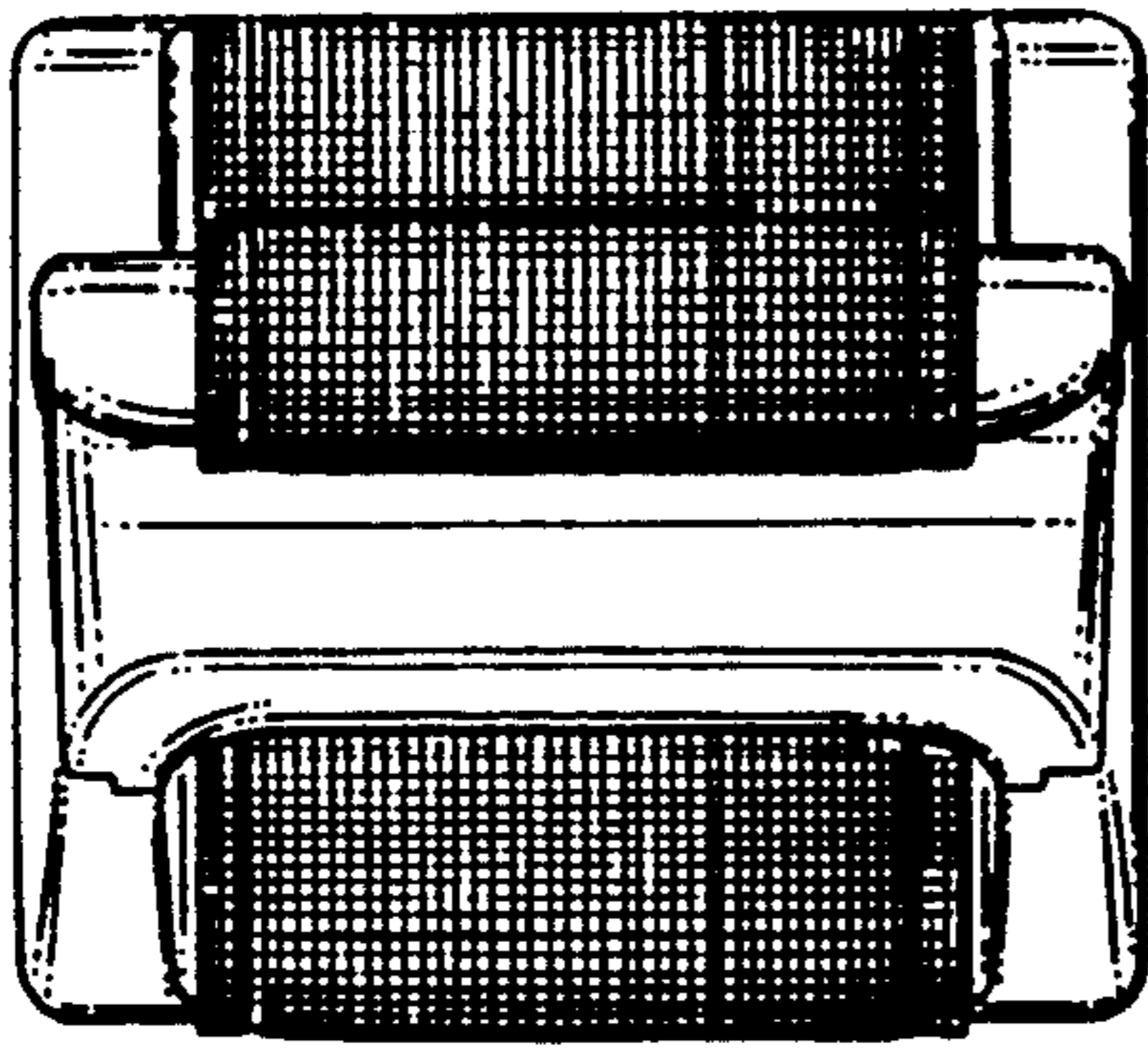

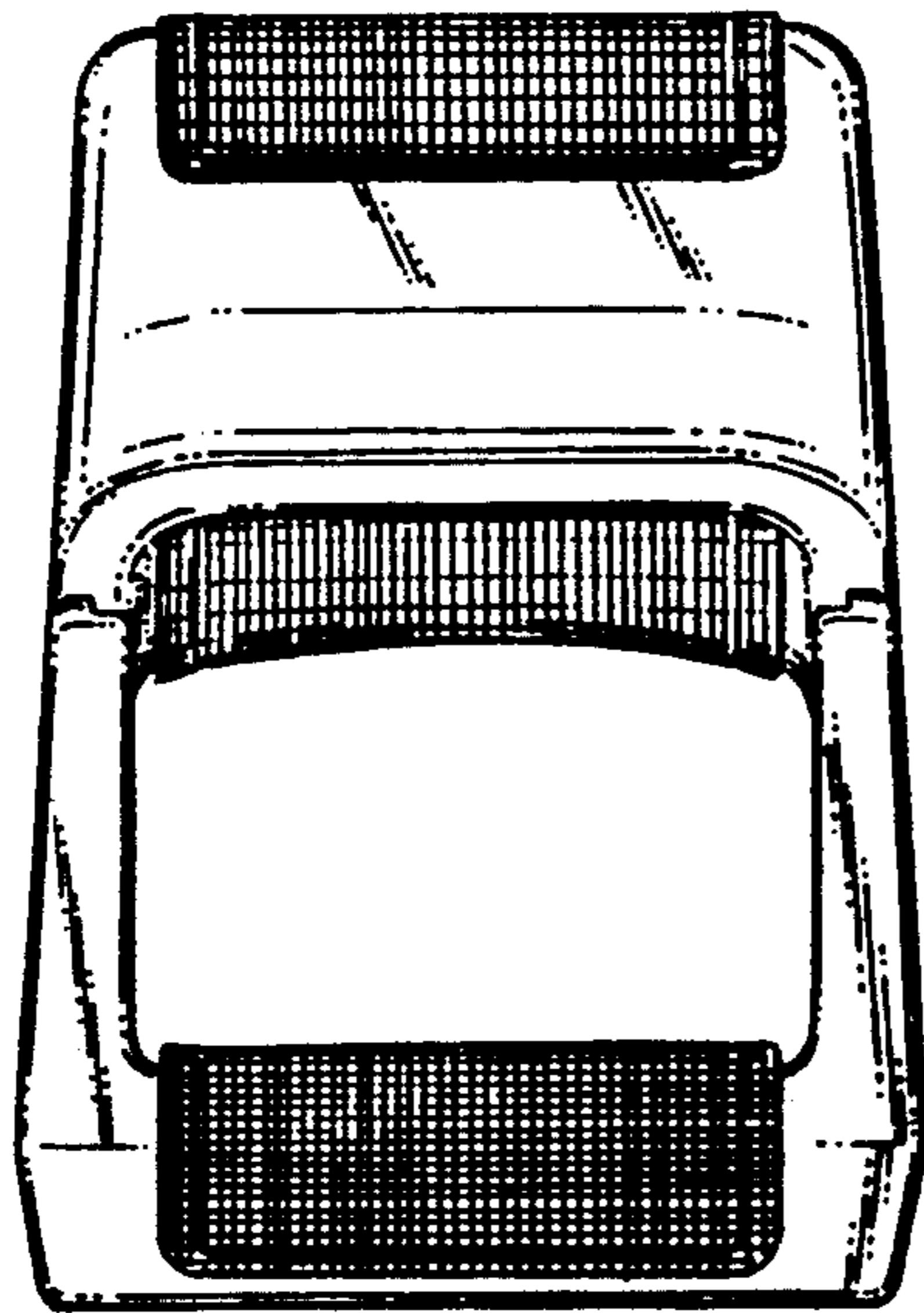

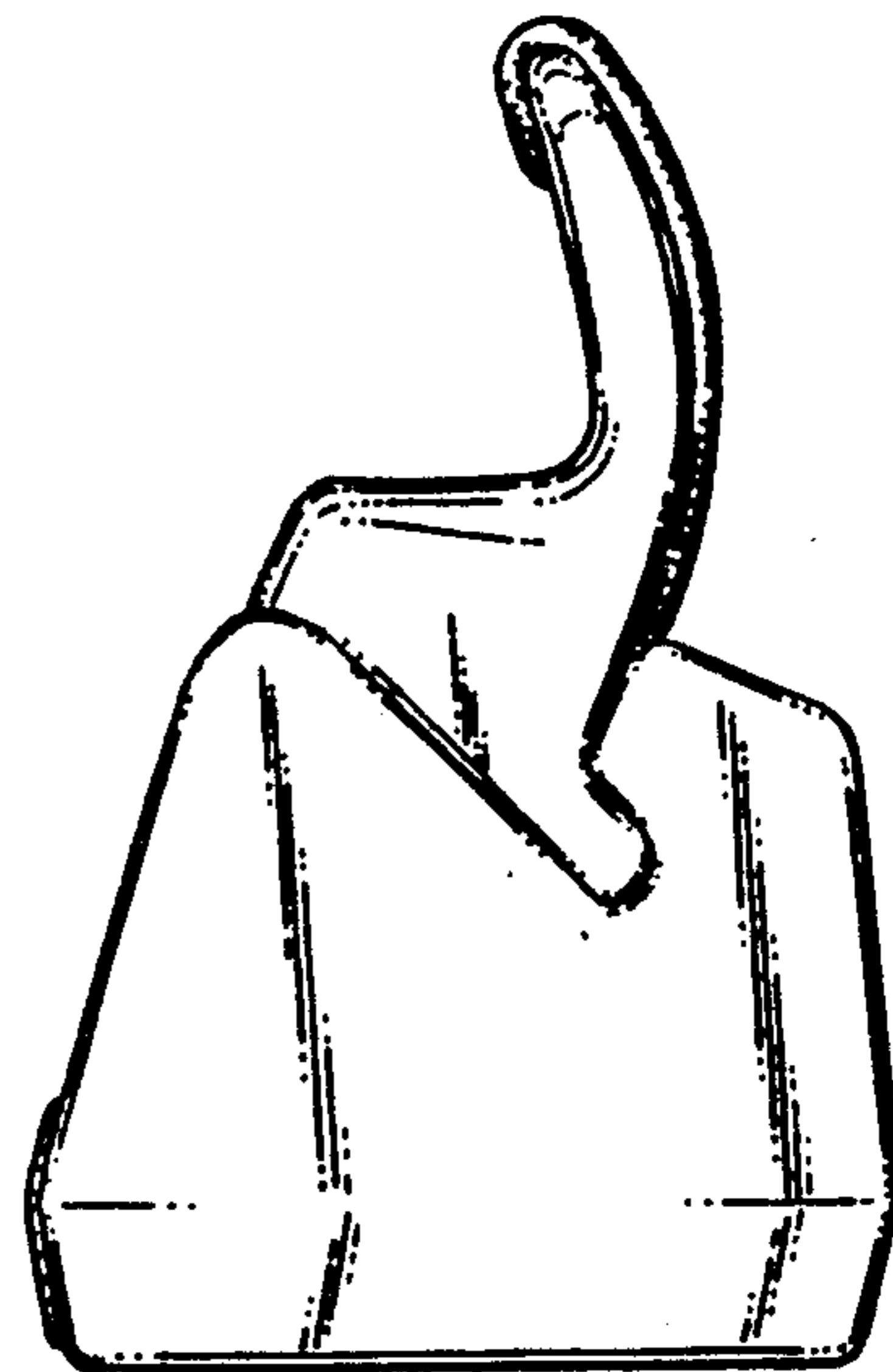

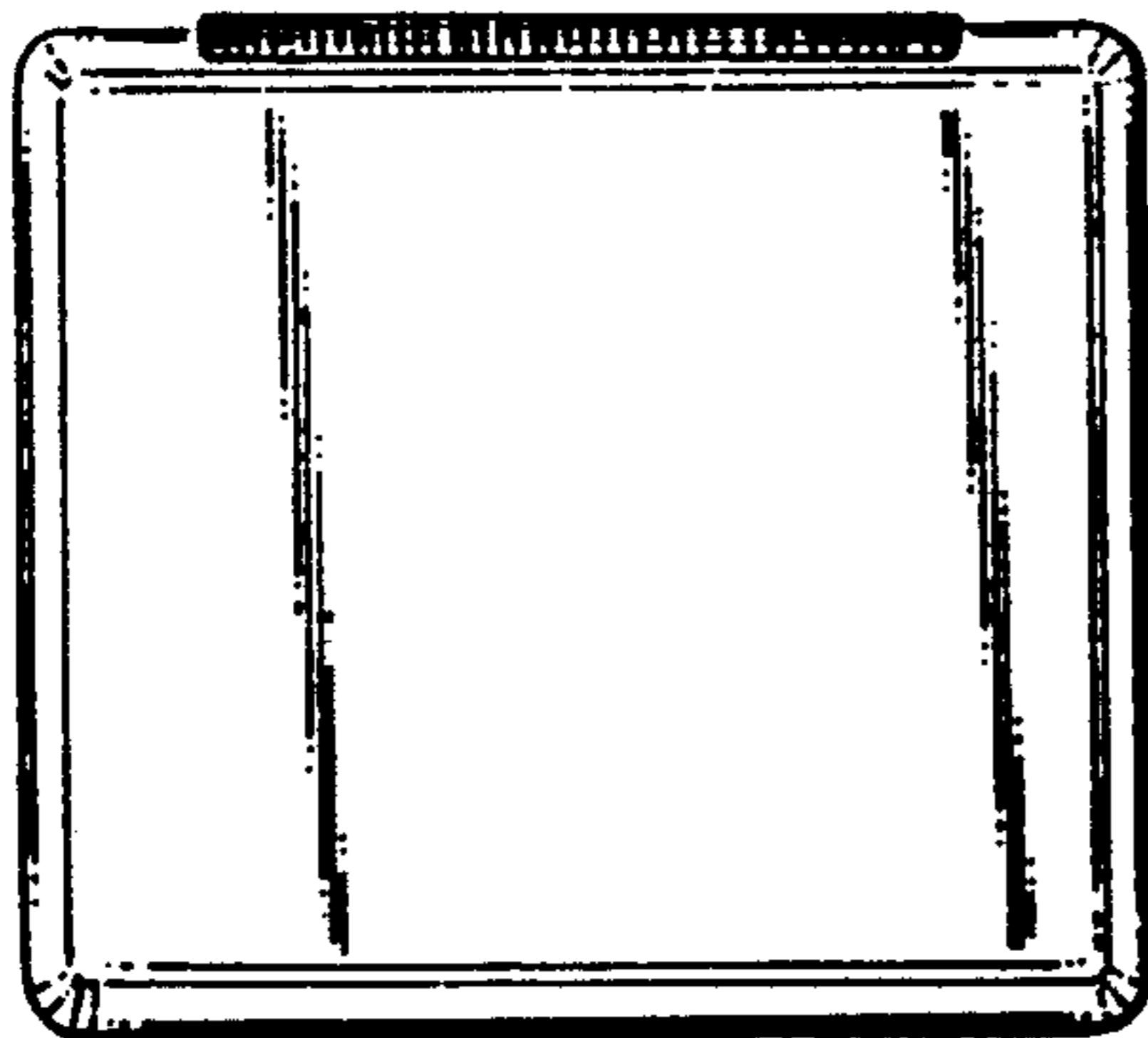

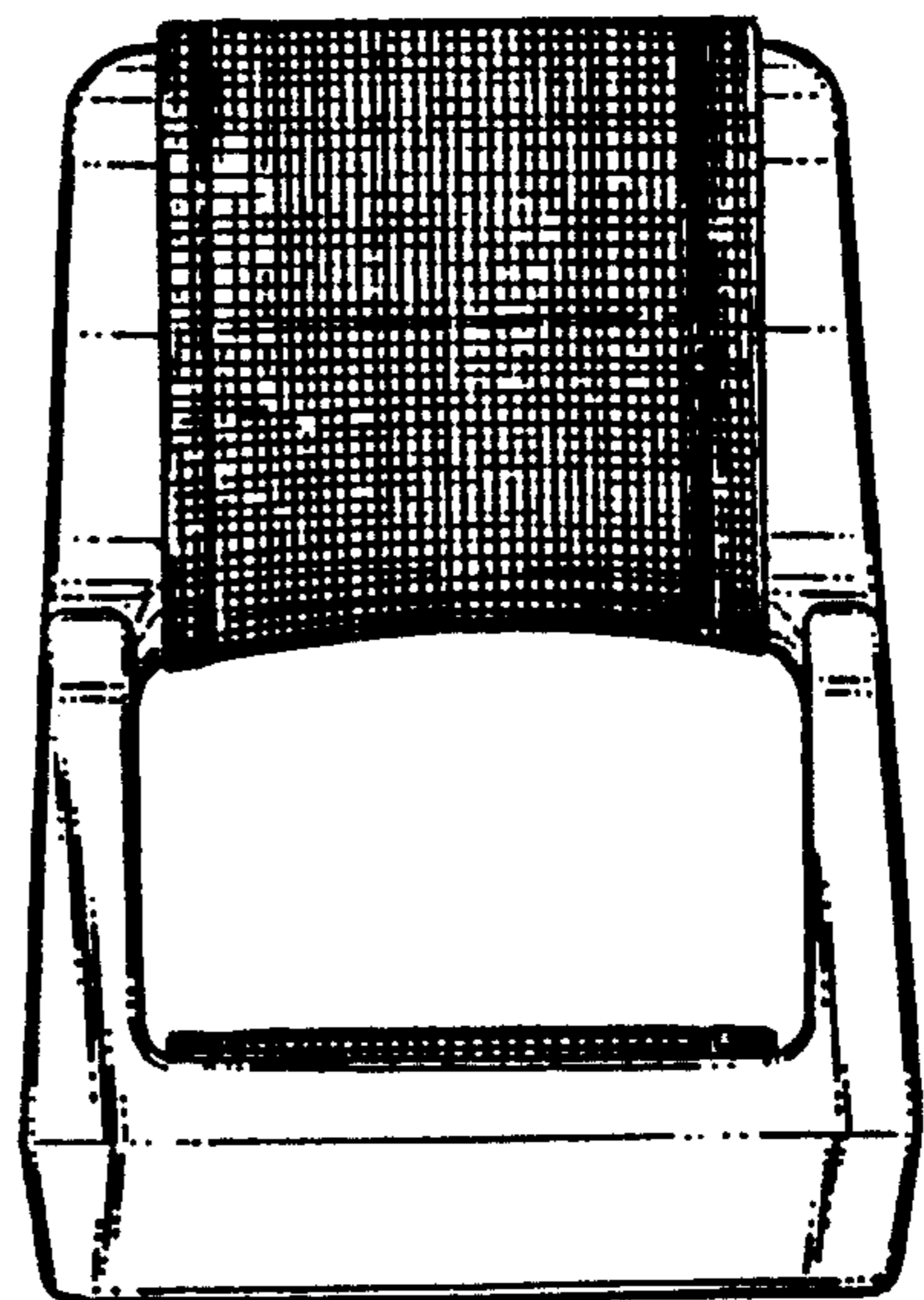
