[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a lace lock set for a shoe, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a side elevational view of a lace lock set for a shoe showing my new design;

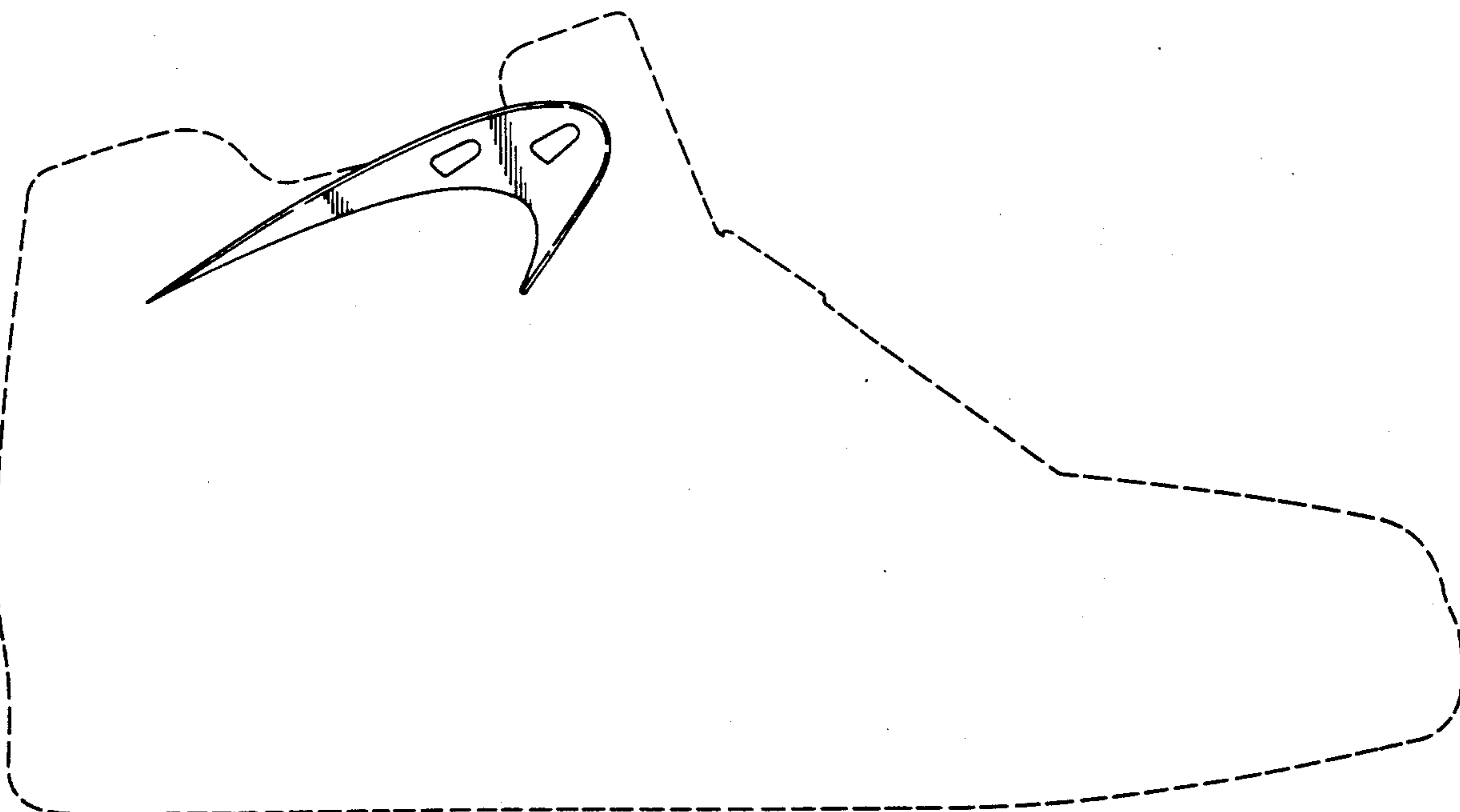
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view of the other lace lock on the other side of the shoe shown in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view taken along Section 3—3 in FIG. 2;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view of the lace lock set for a shoe according to FIGS. 1 and 2; and,

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the lace lock set for a shoe according to FIGS. 1 and 2.

The broken line showing of a shoe is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.



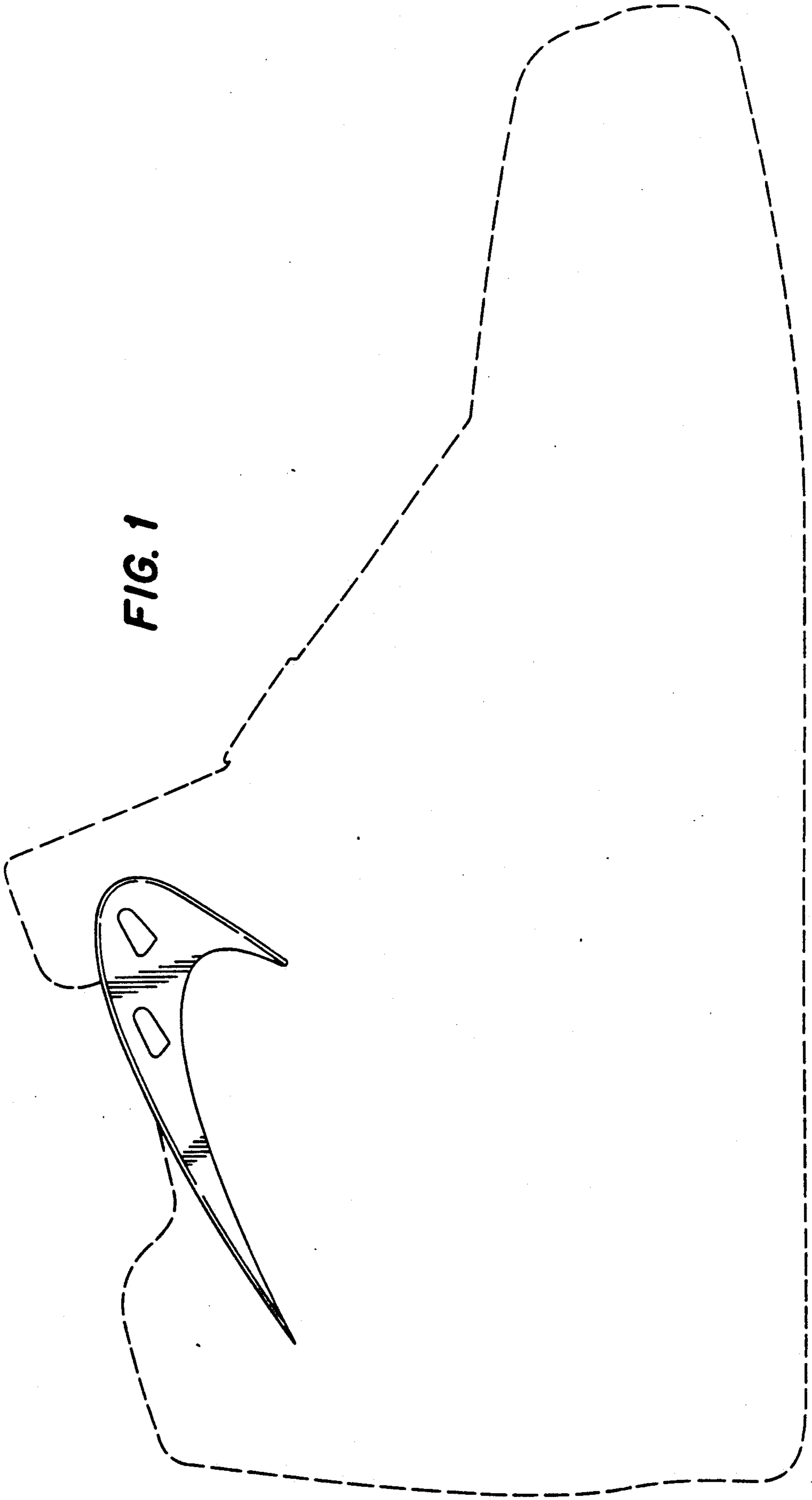

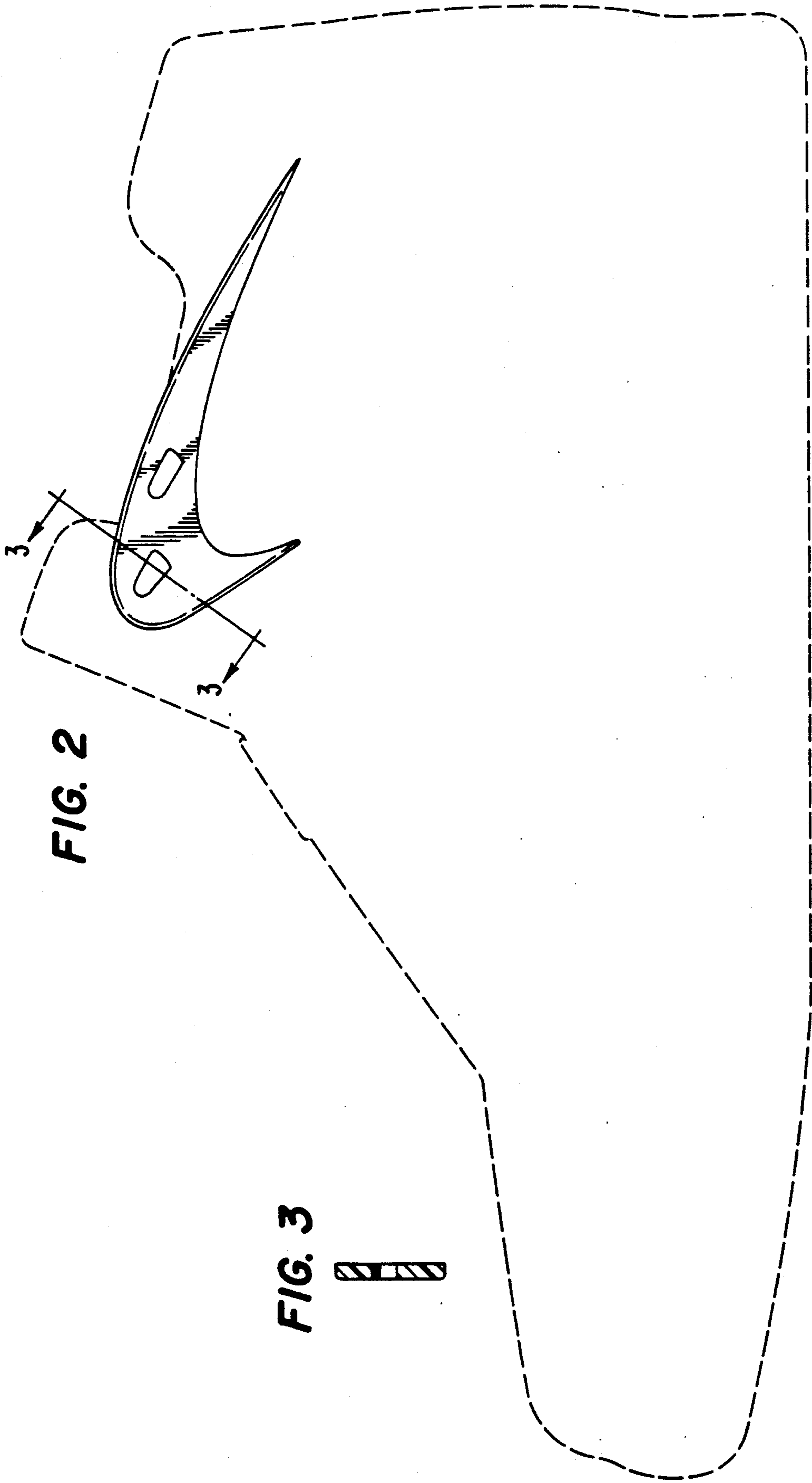

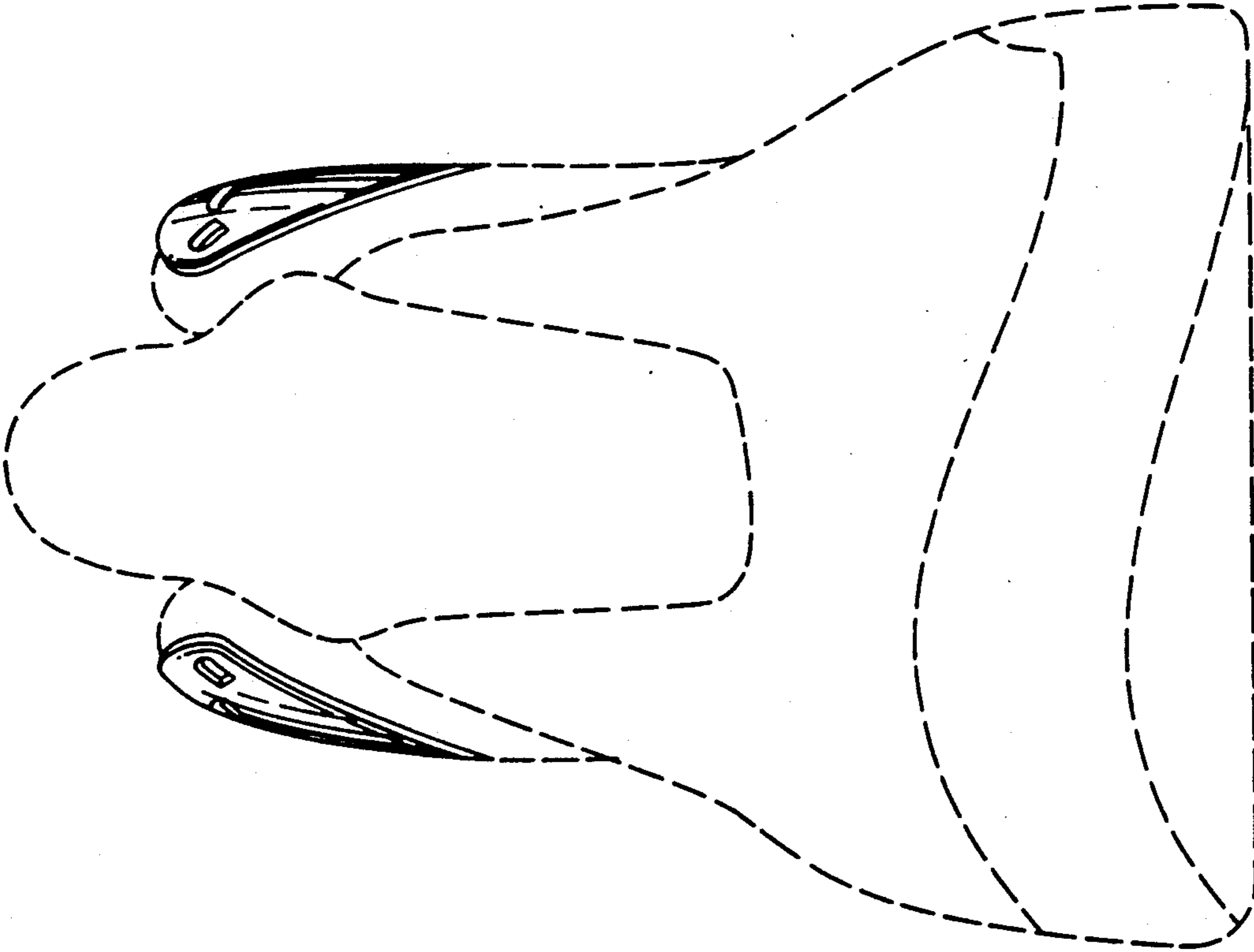
