[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for the beach tote bag with head support, shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a beach tote bag showing my new design;
 FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the undisclosed side being a mirror image;
 FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;
 FIG. 5 is an elevational view of the exterior thereof, in a fully opened position;
 FIG. 6 is an elevational view of the interior thereof, in a fully opened position, as seen from the opposite side of FIG. 5;
 FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof, in a fully opened position, the undisclosed side being a mirror image; and,
 FIG. 8 is an elevational view of the interior thereof, in a fully opened position, with the zipper member in an alternate, open position.
 The broken lines shown in all Figures represent conventional stitching.

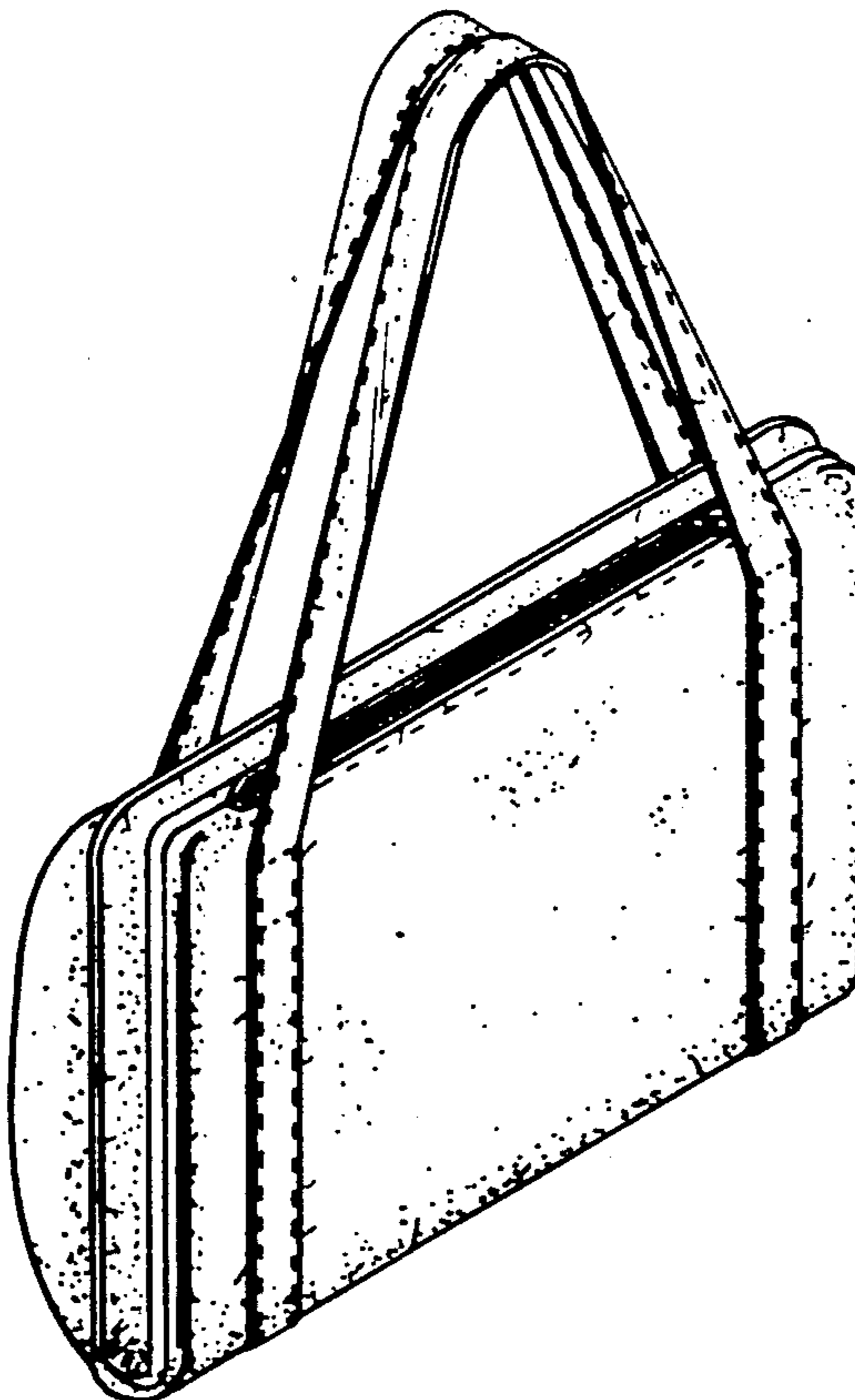

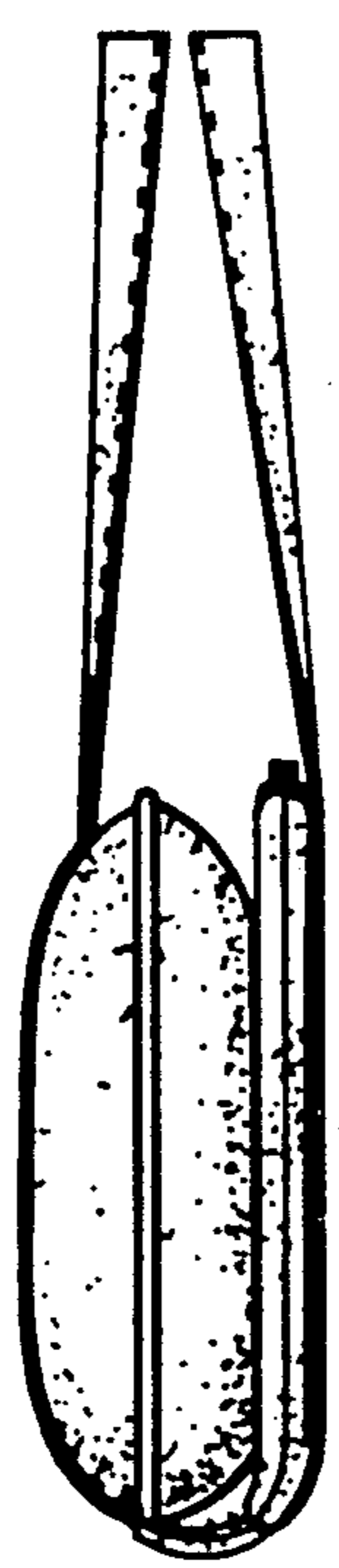
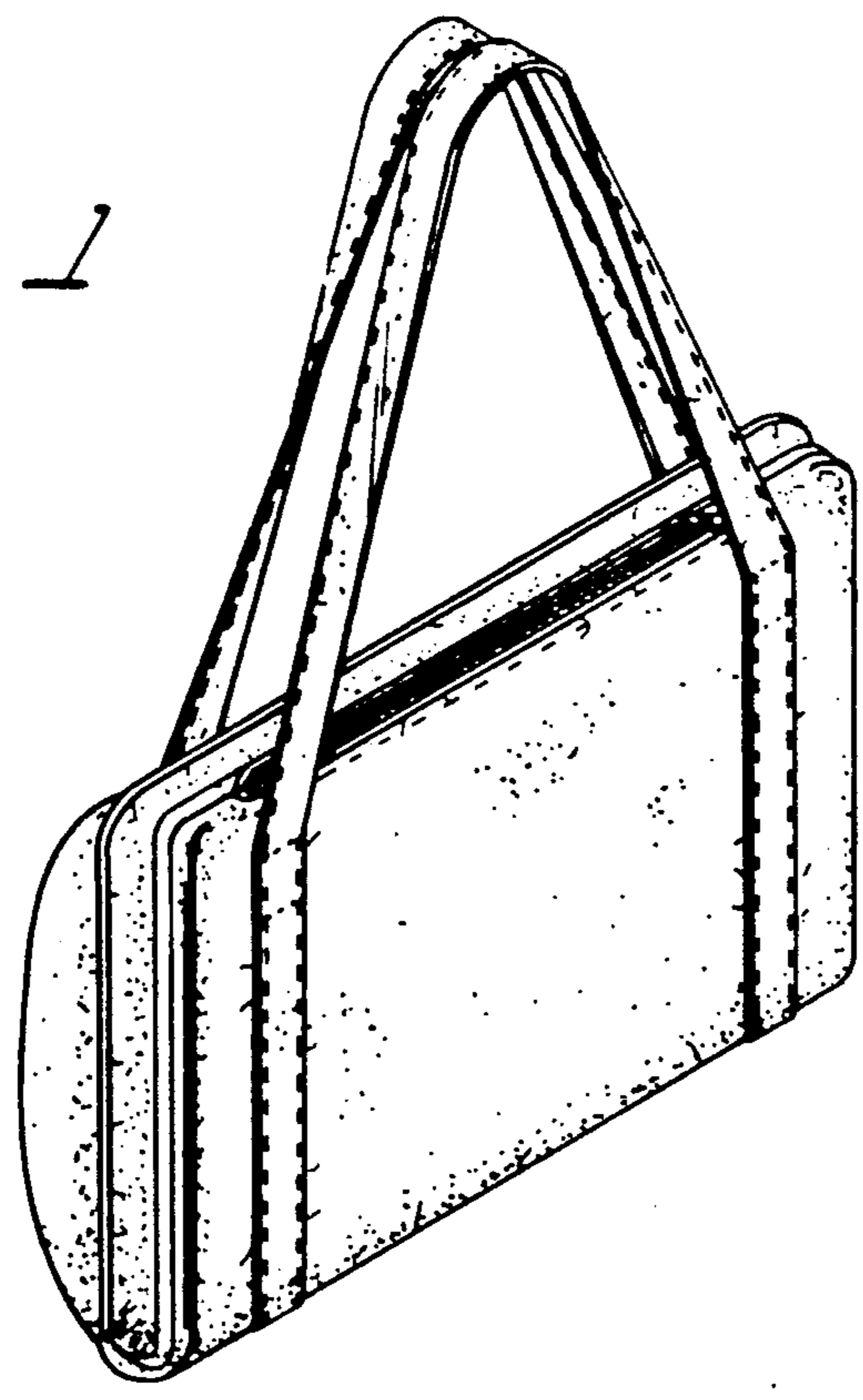

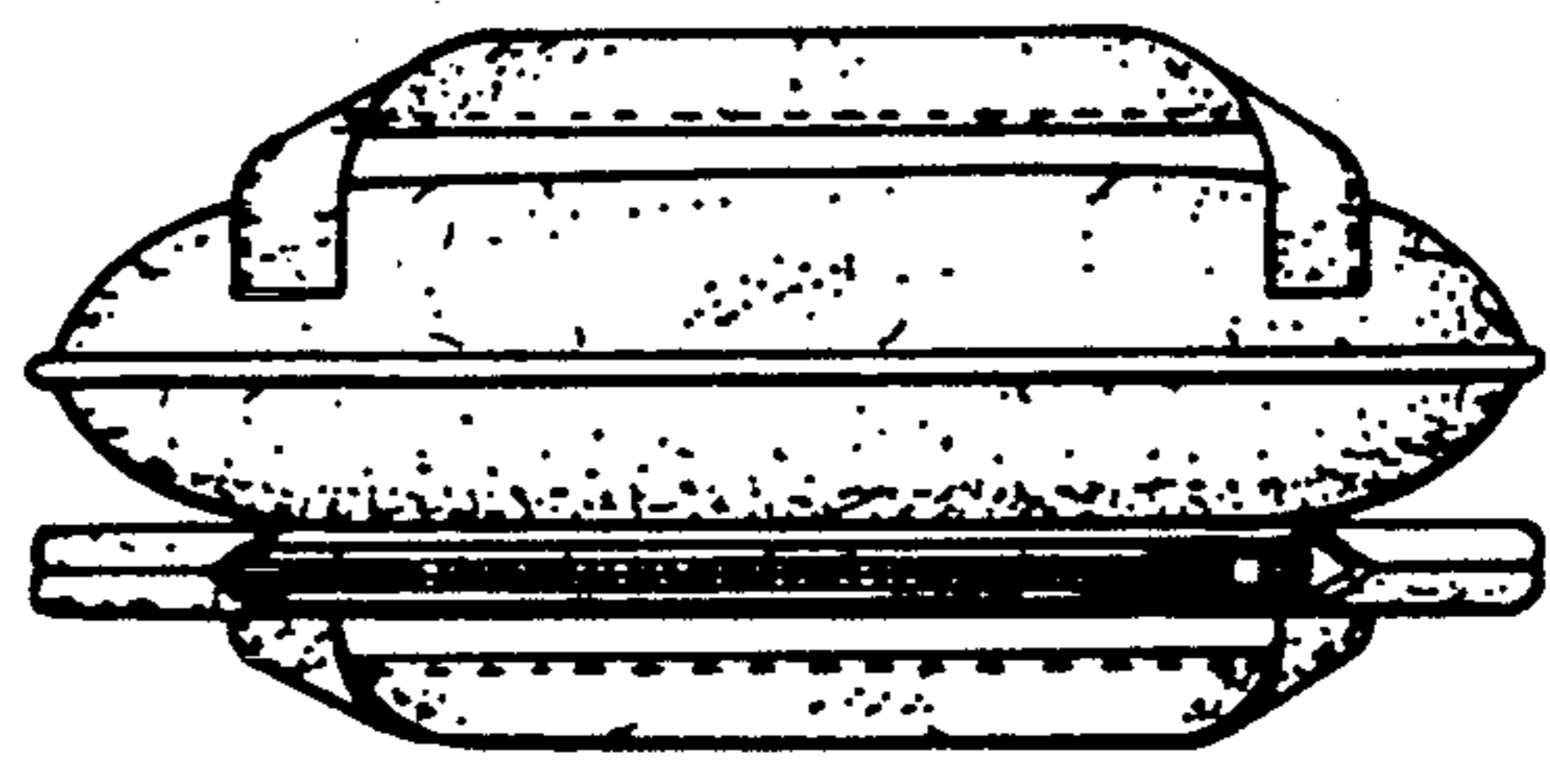

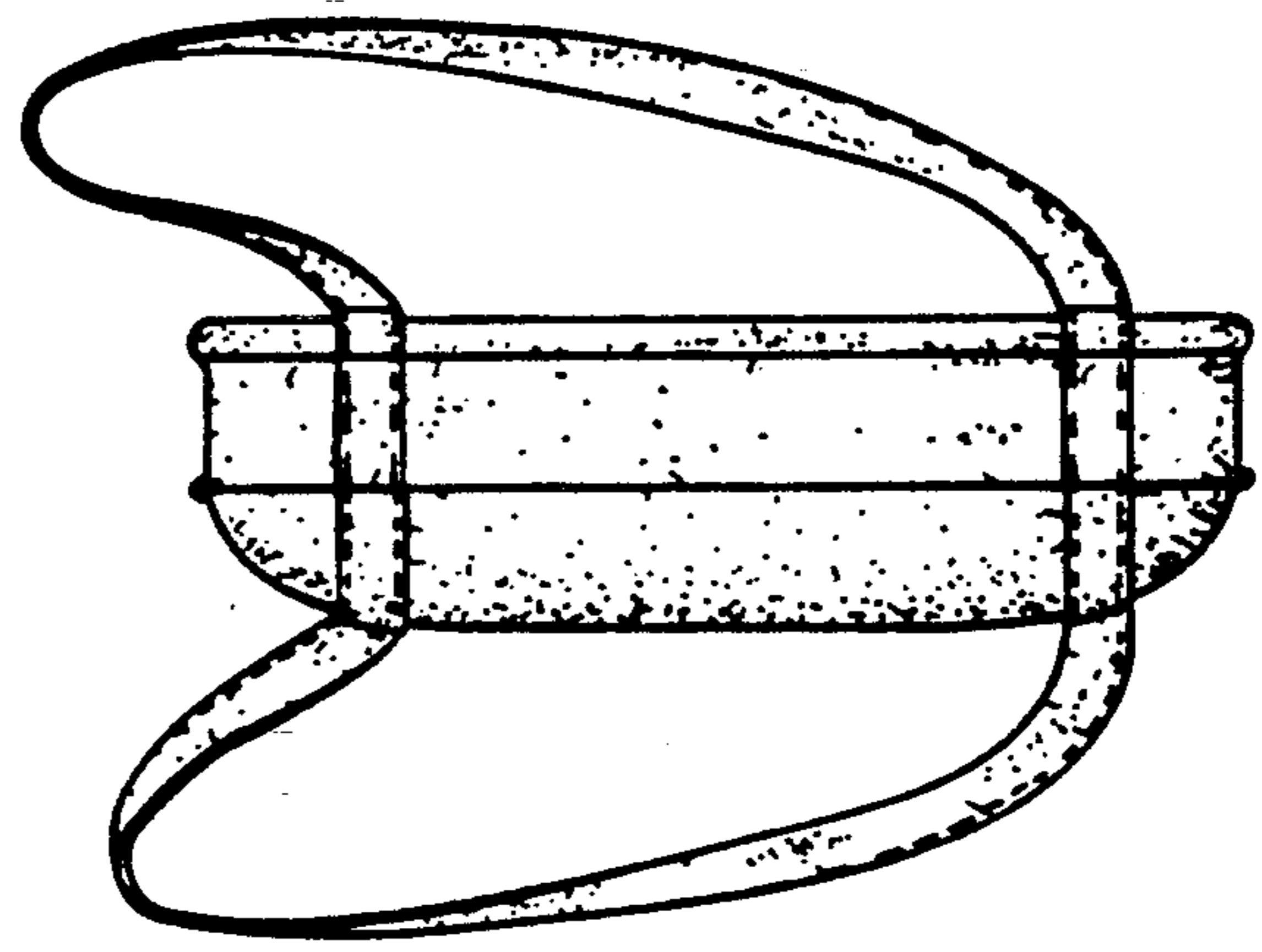

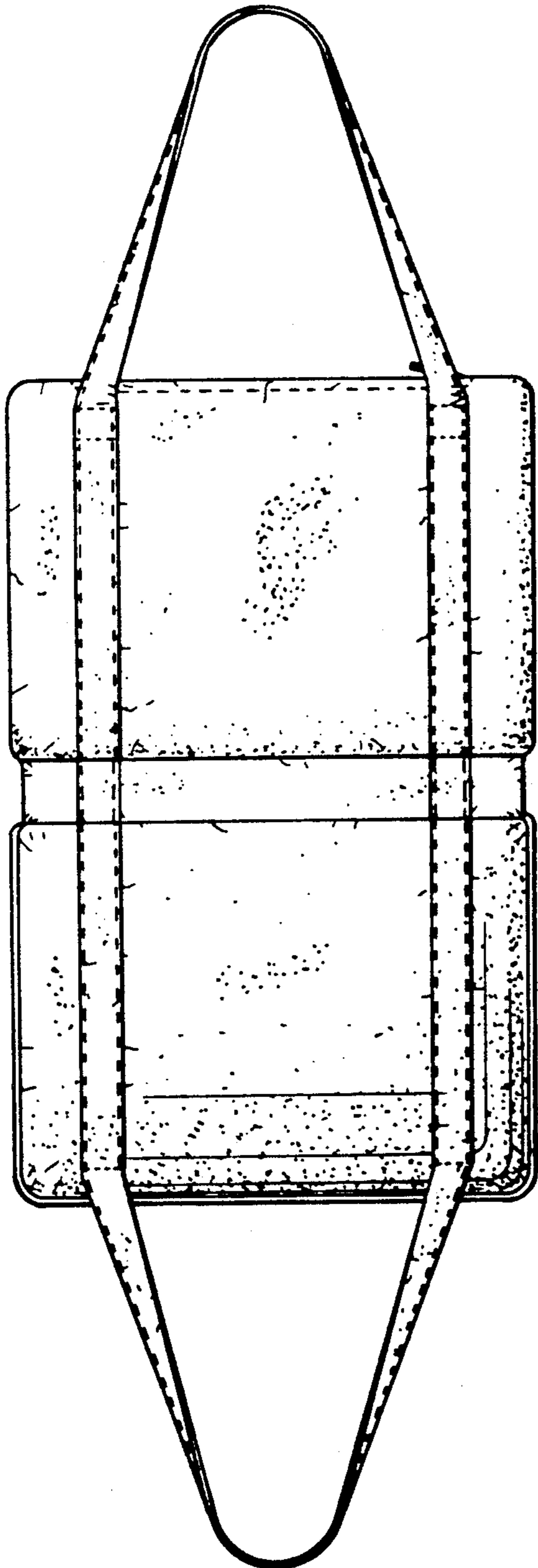

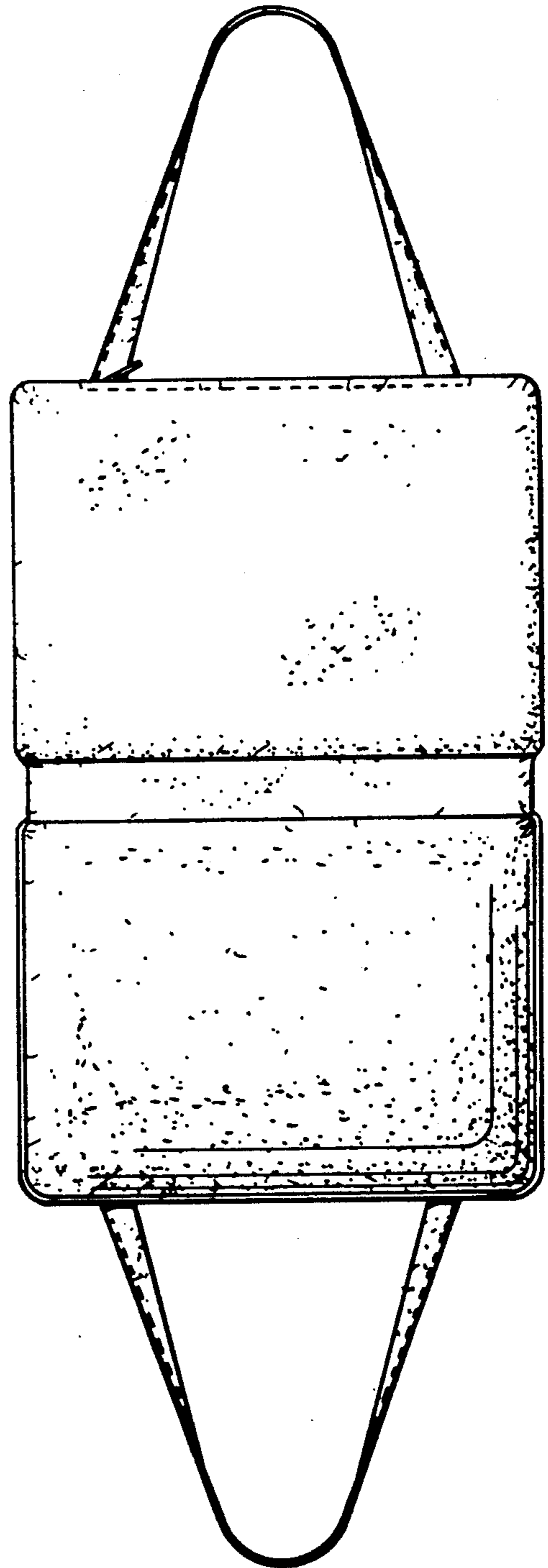

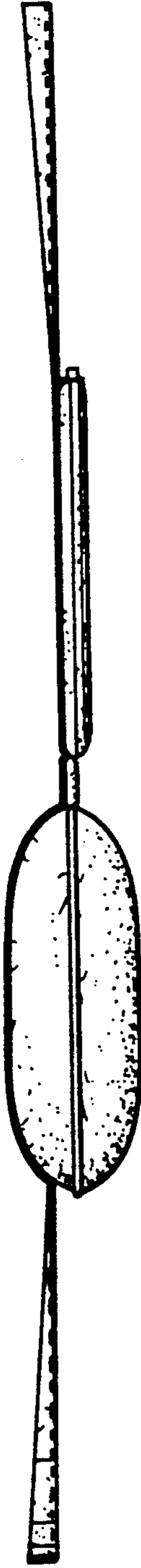
