The broken line showing of a portion of a belt and a gun in FIG. 1 is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

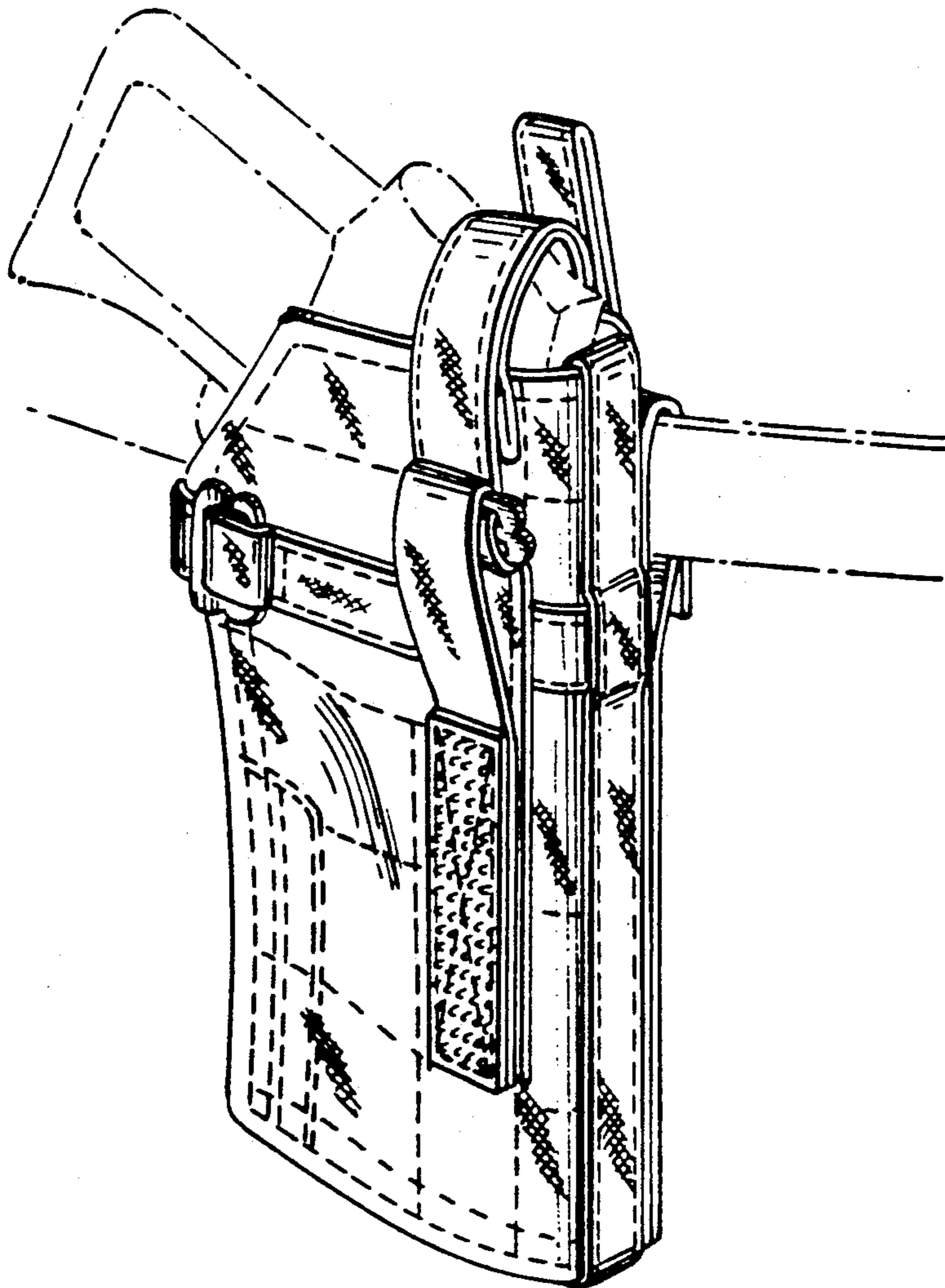

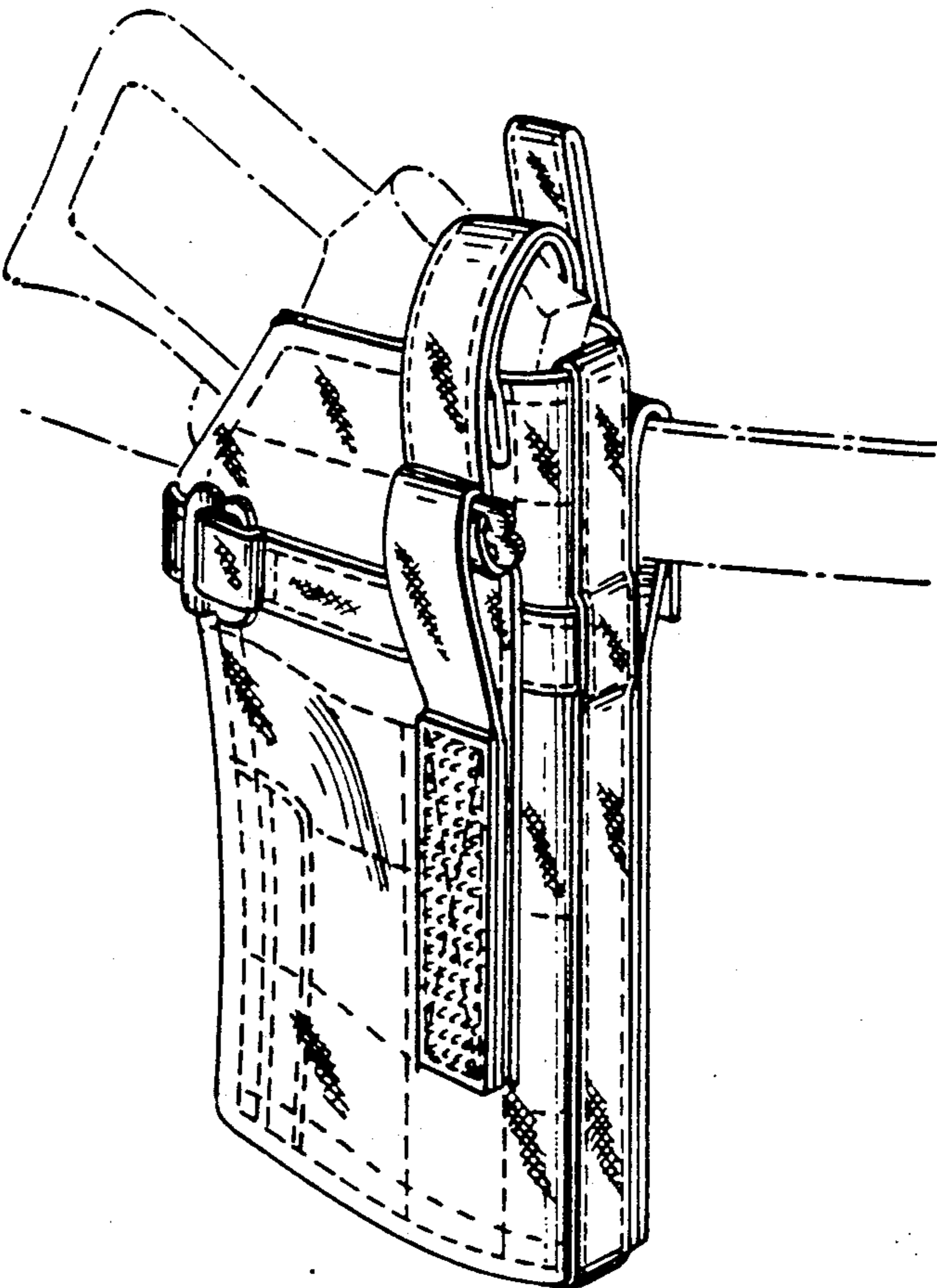

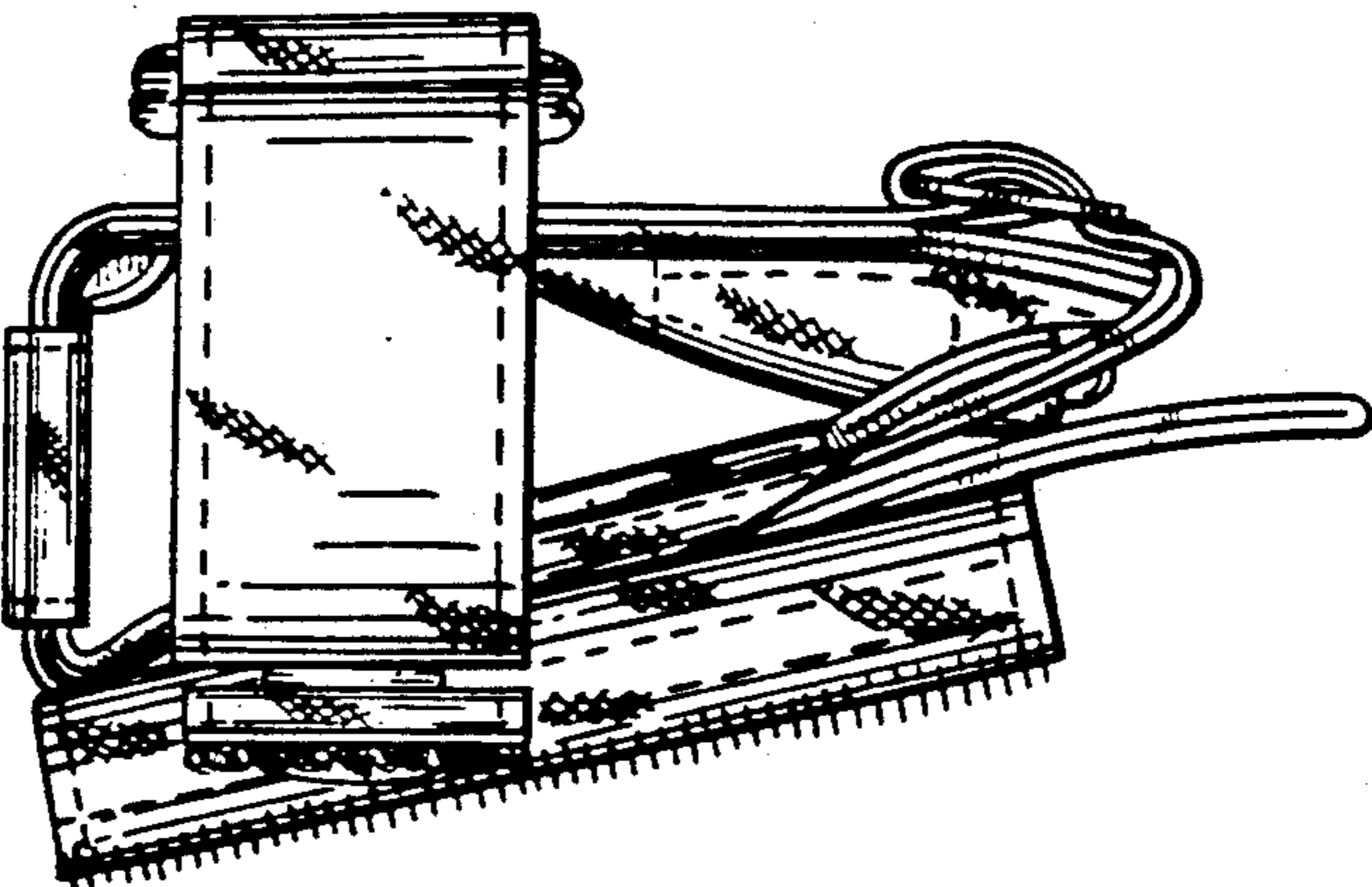

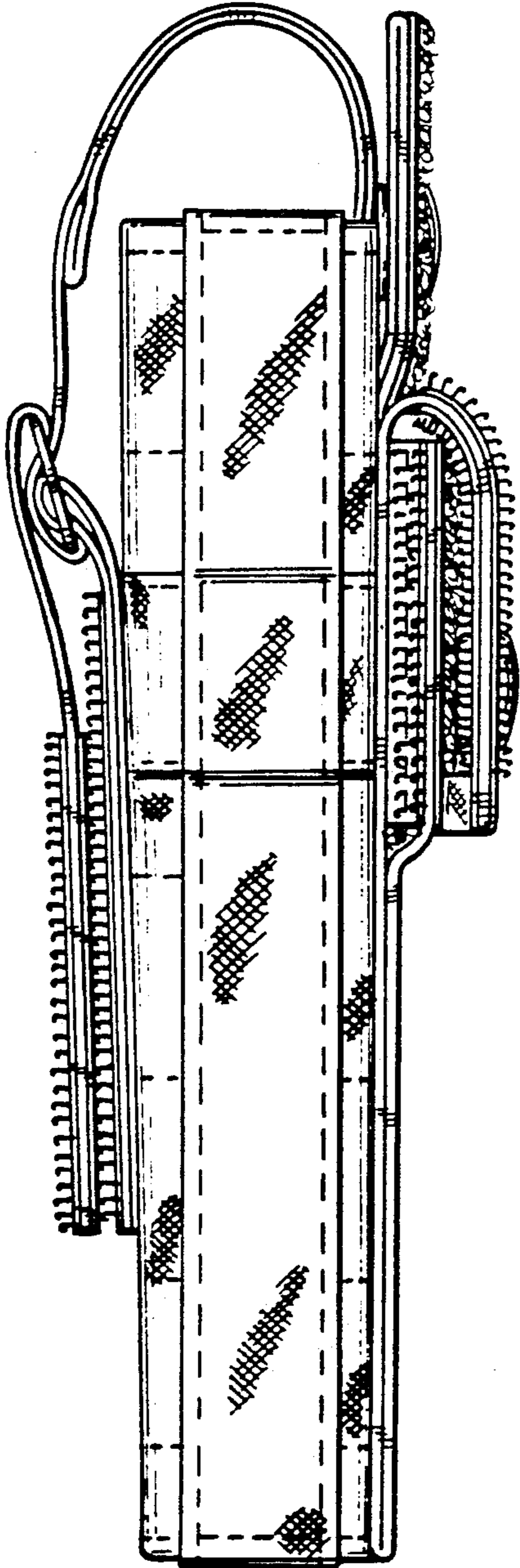

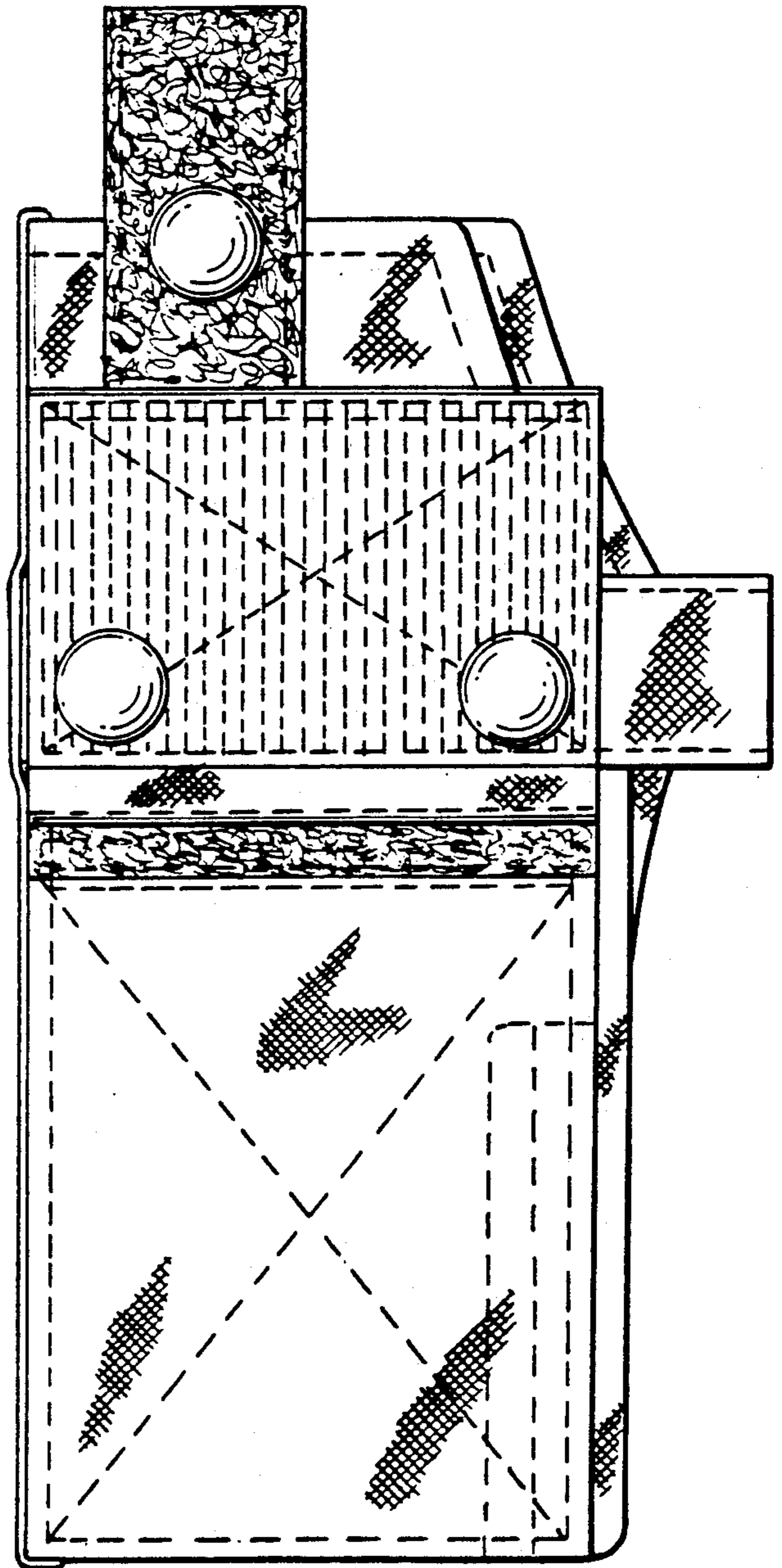

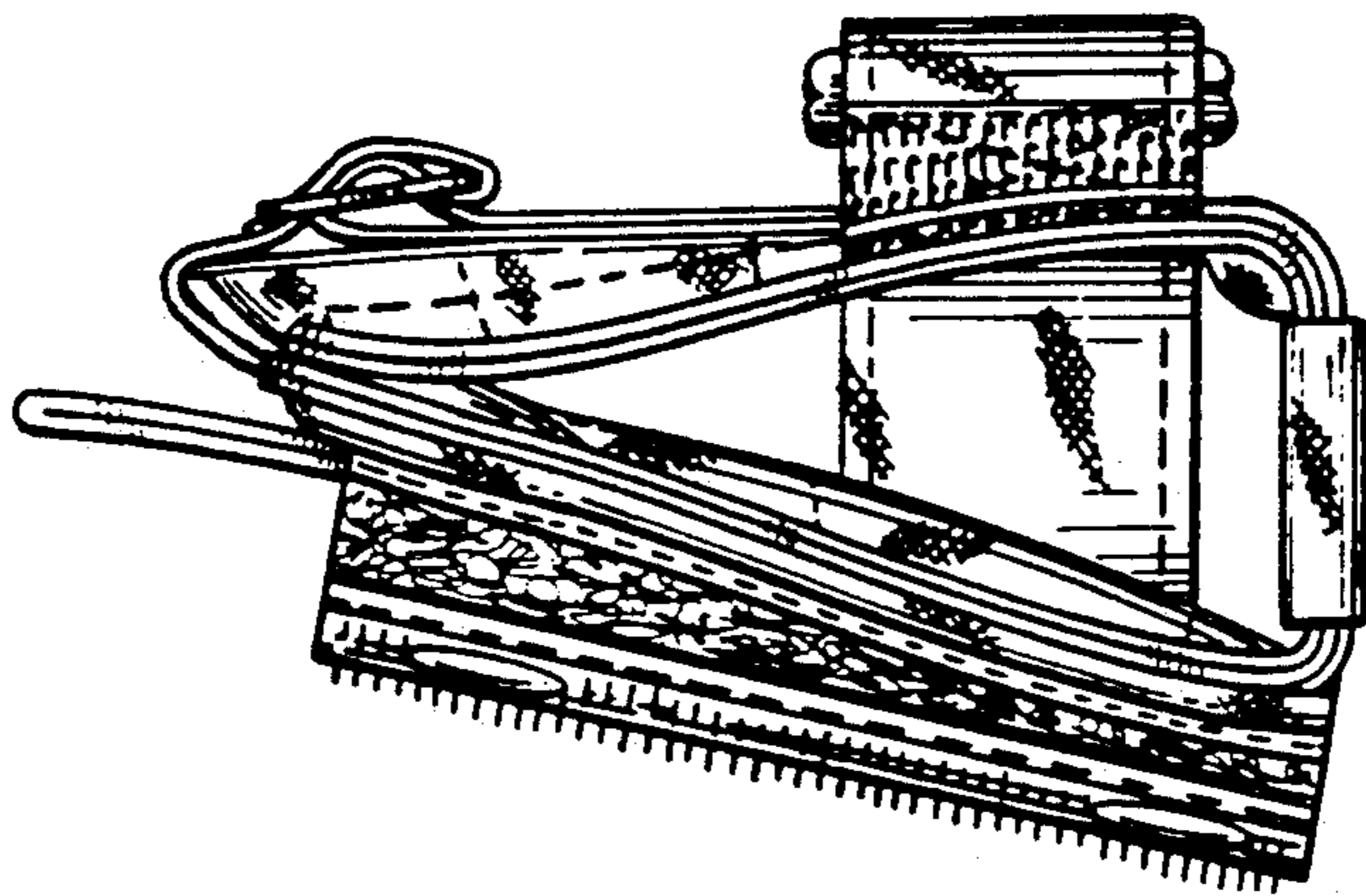
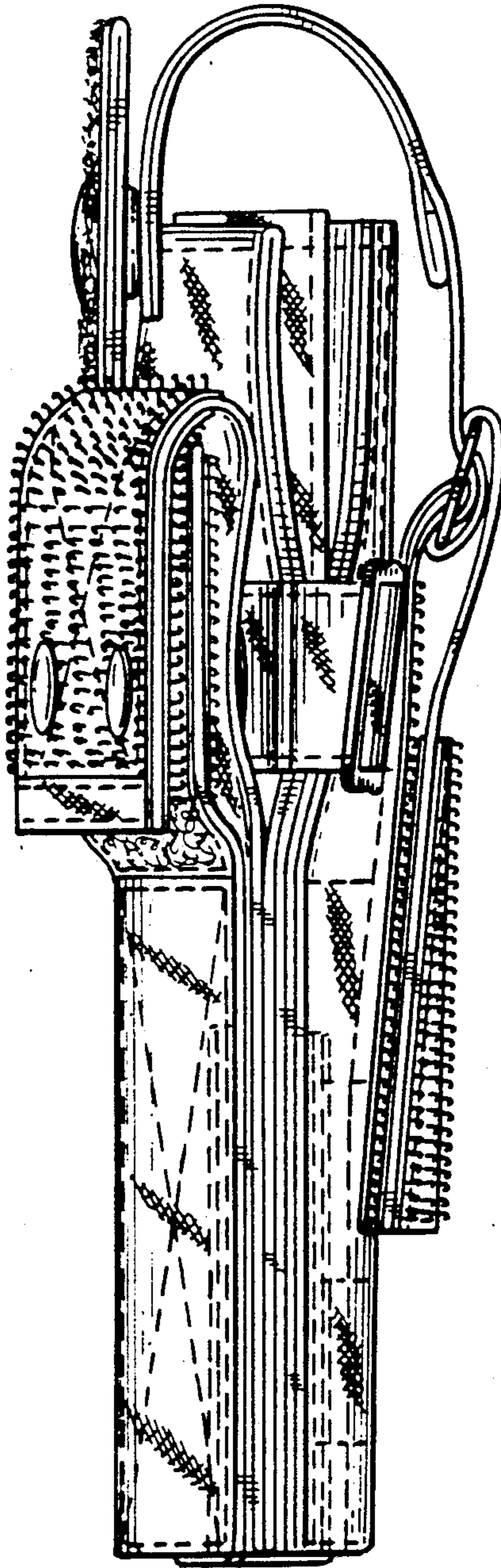
