FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof.

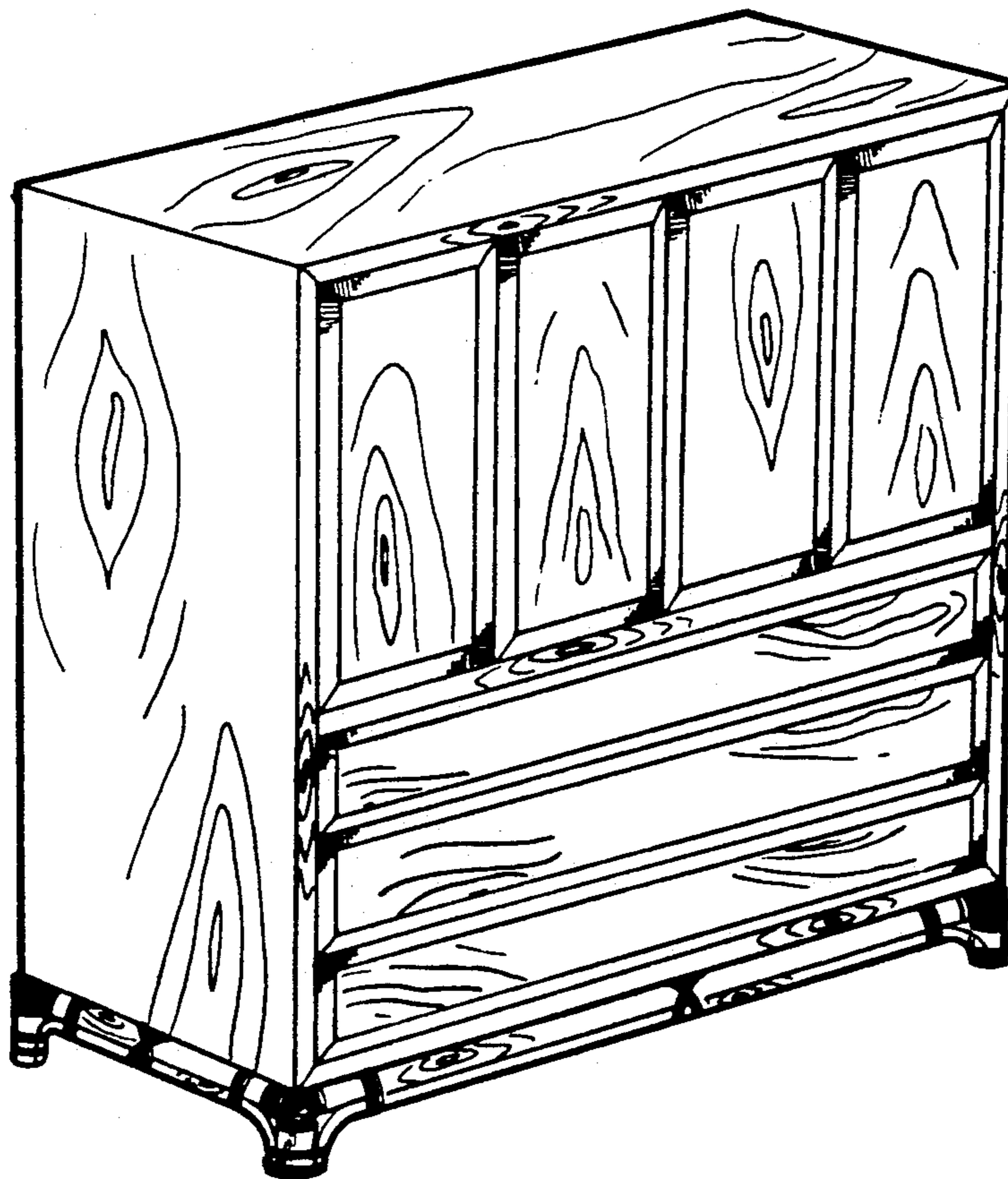
FIGS. 2, 3, and 4 have been drawn to a reduced scale in respect to FIG. 1.

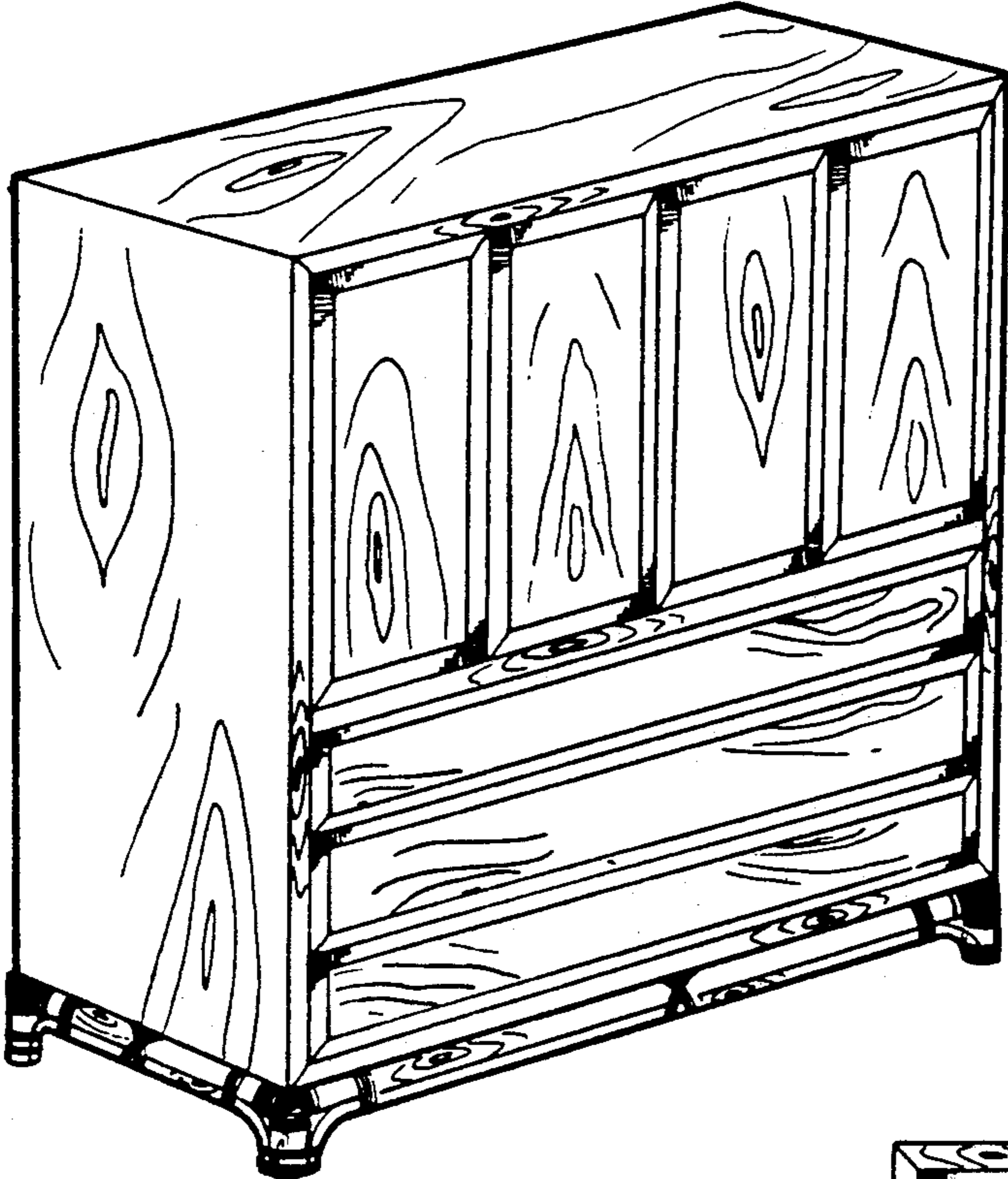

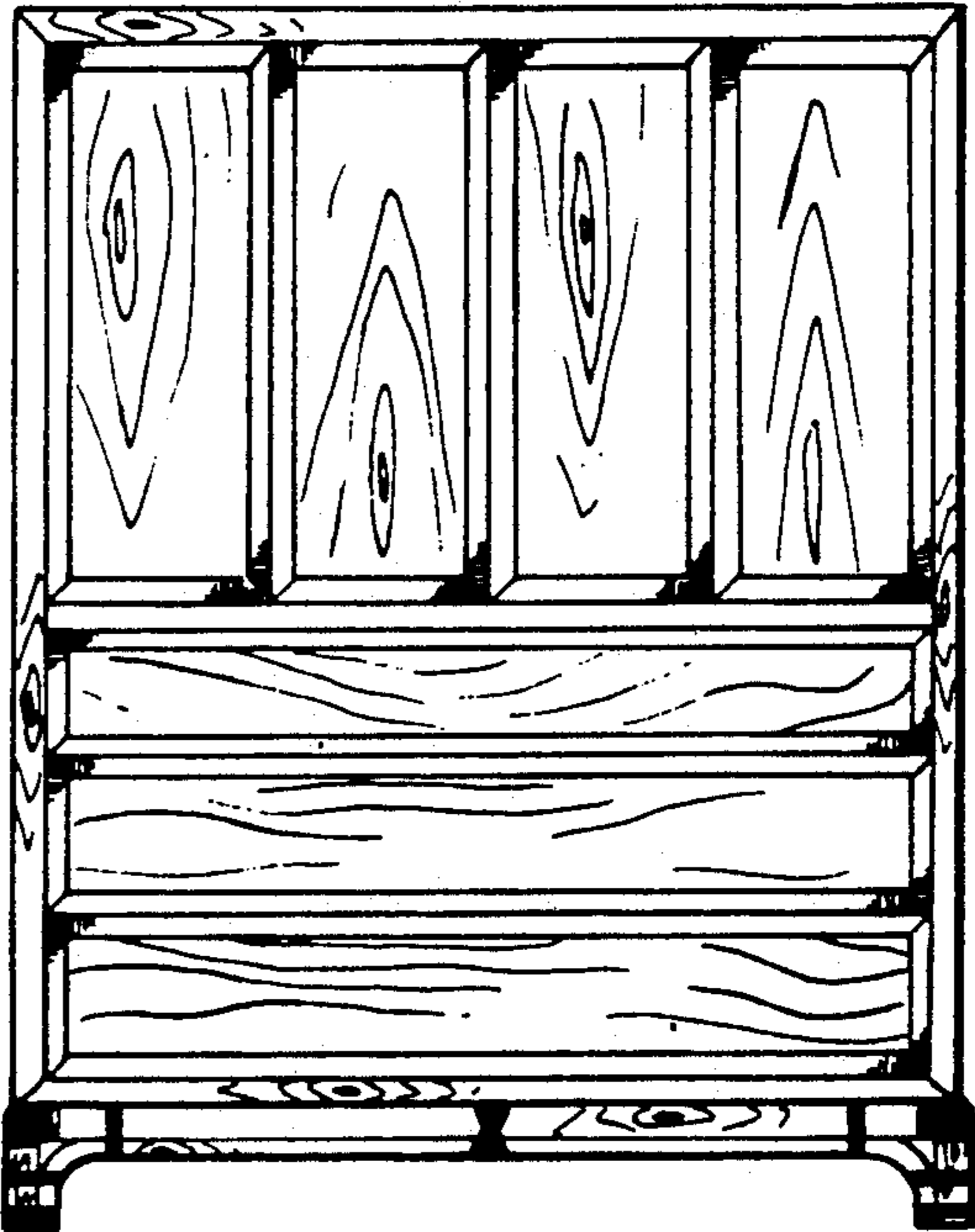
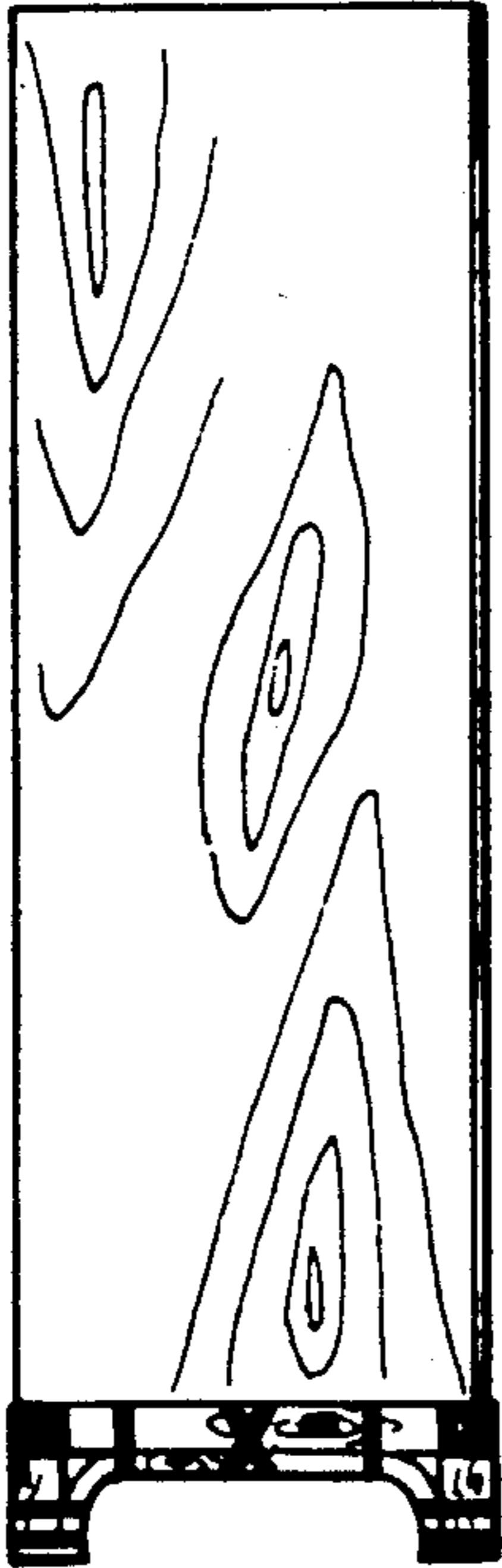
