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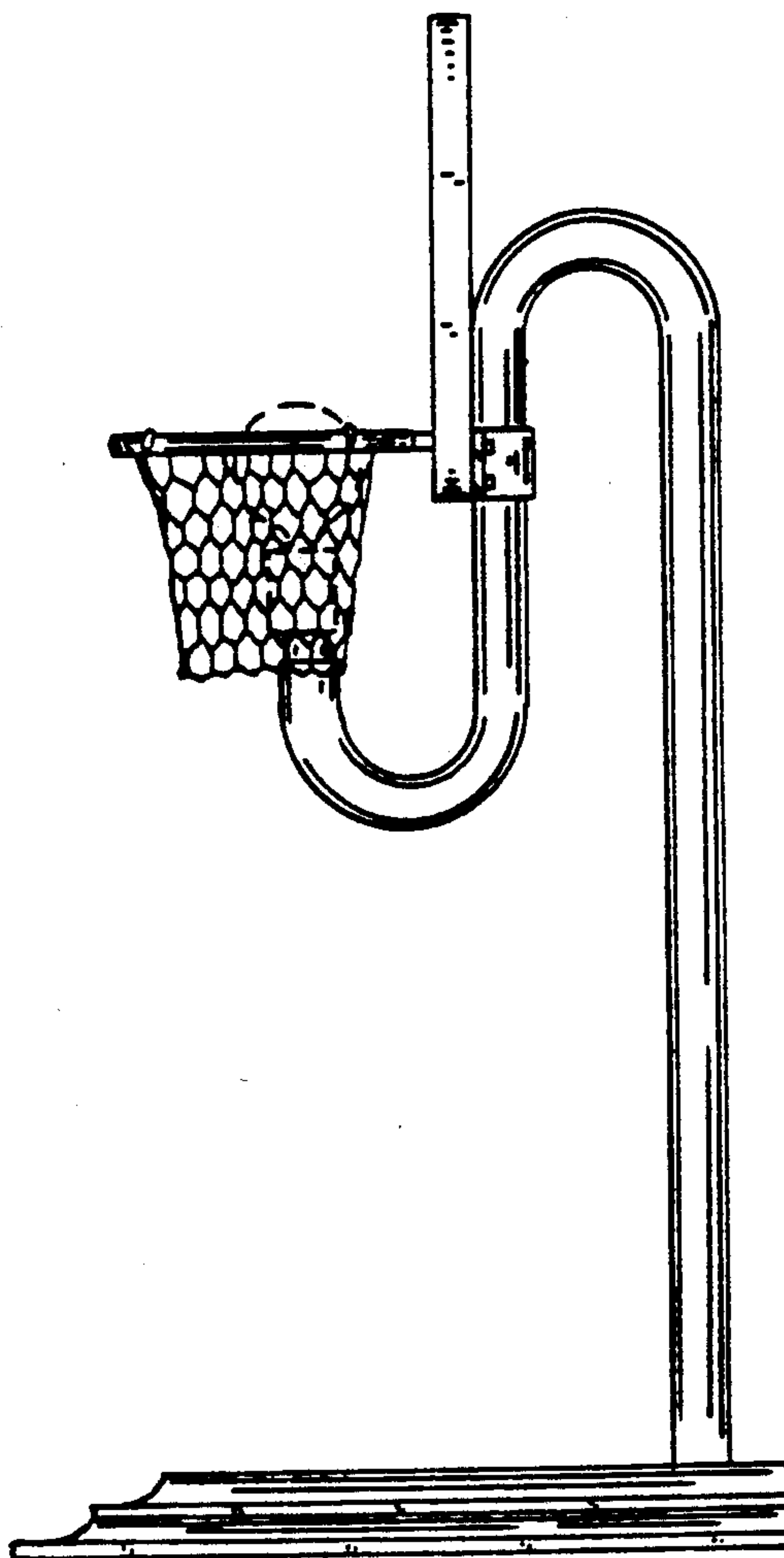
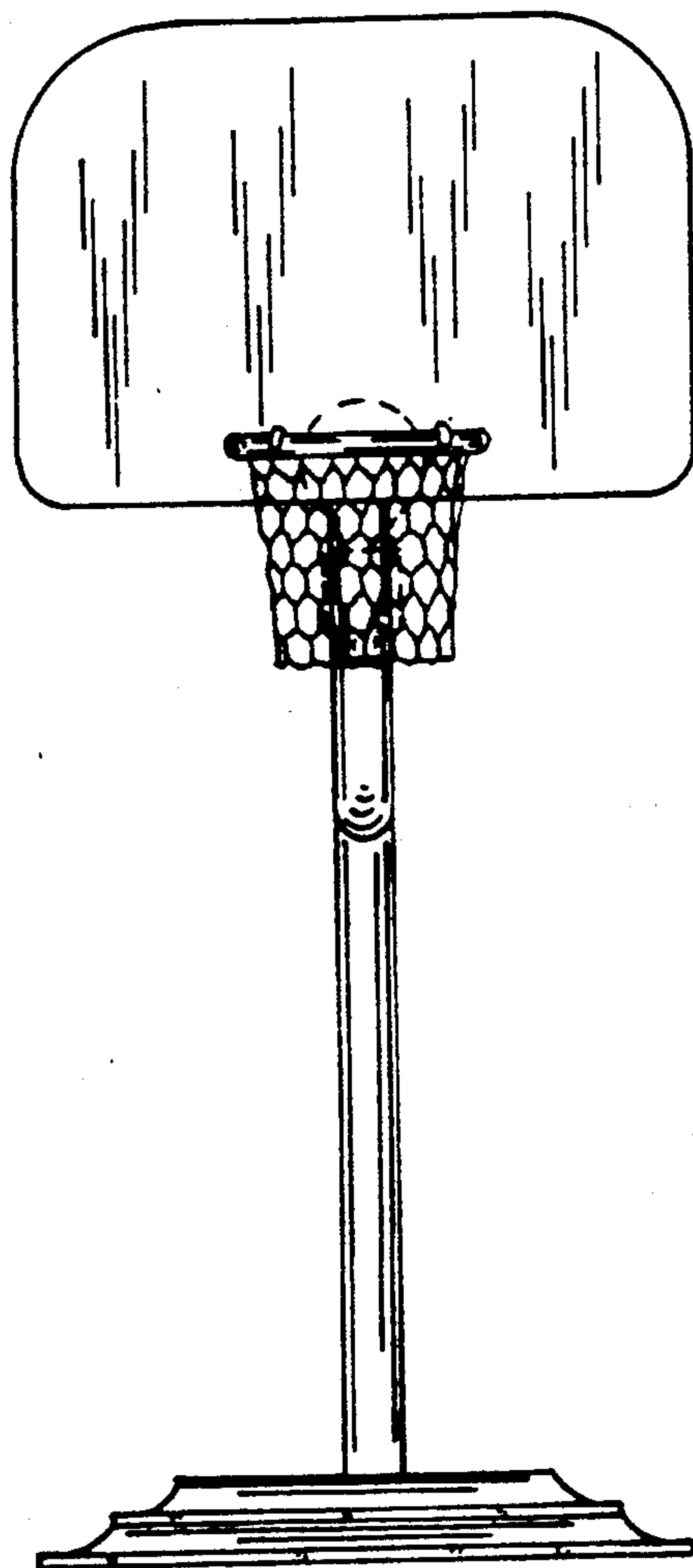

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the lamp showing our new design, the light bulb and socket apparatus shown in broken lines are for illustrative purposes only and form no part of the claimed design; FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view with the opposite side being a mirror image thereof; FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof; and, FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



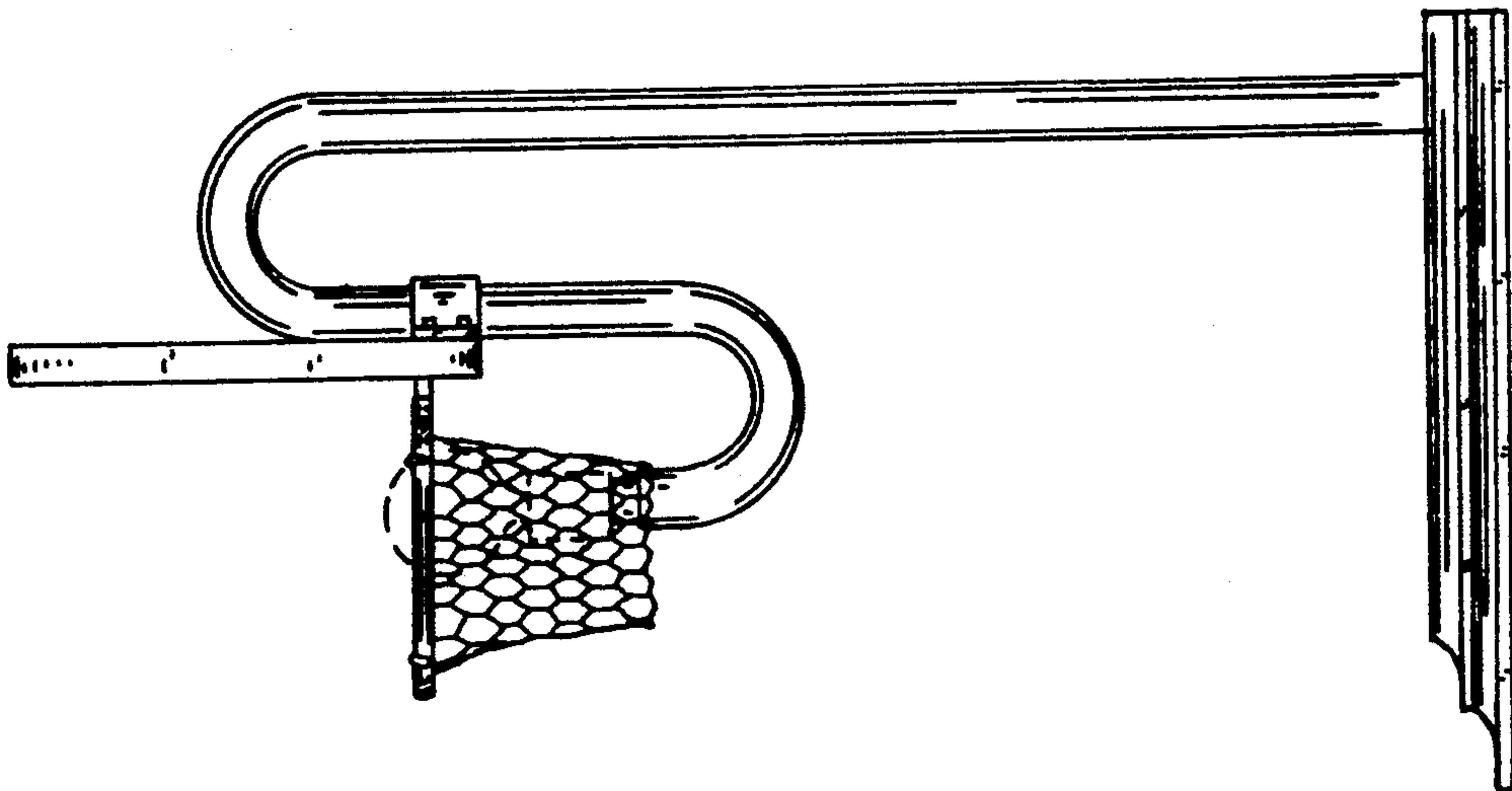

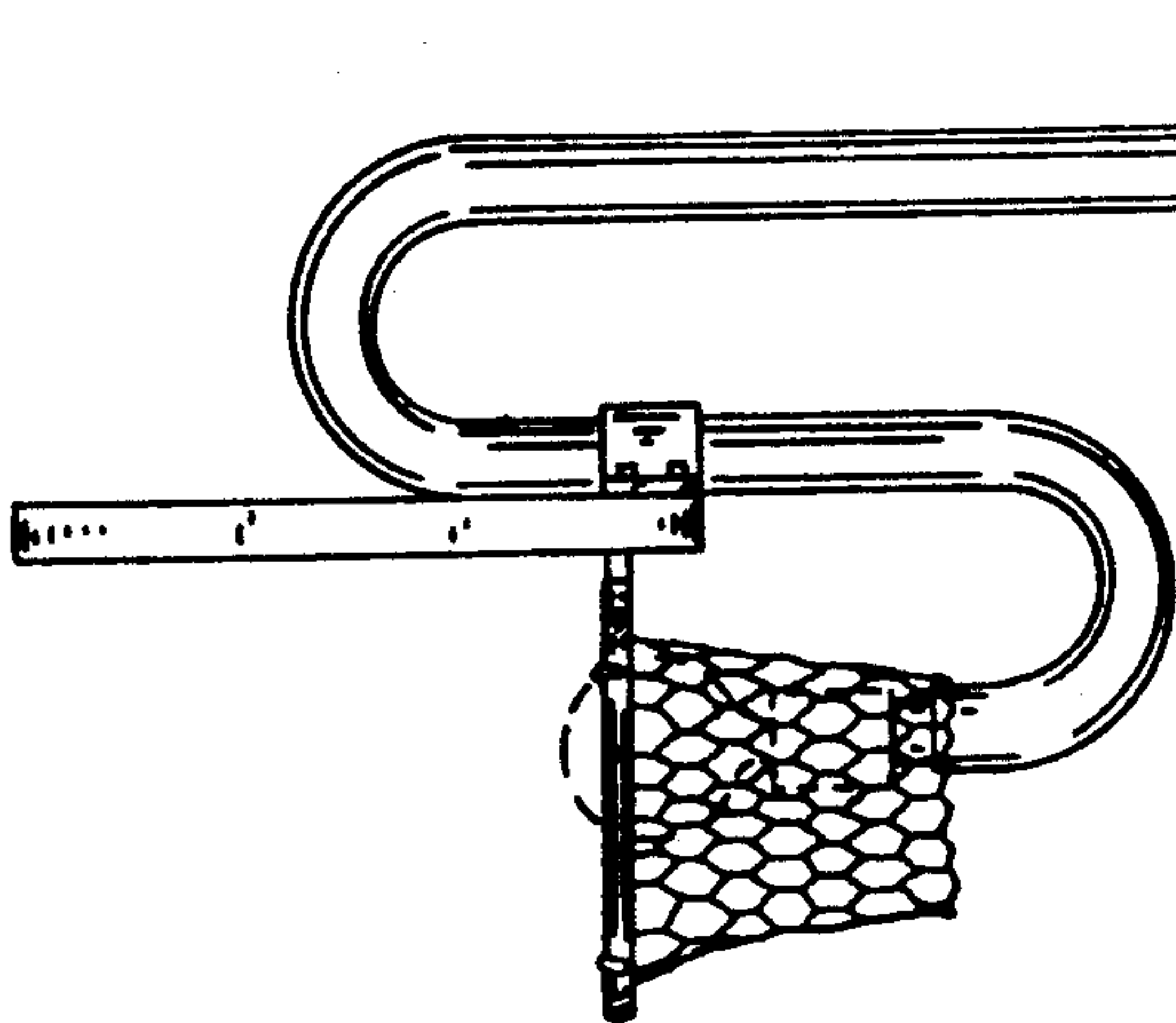

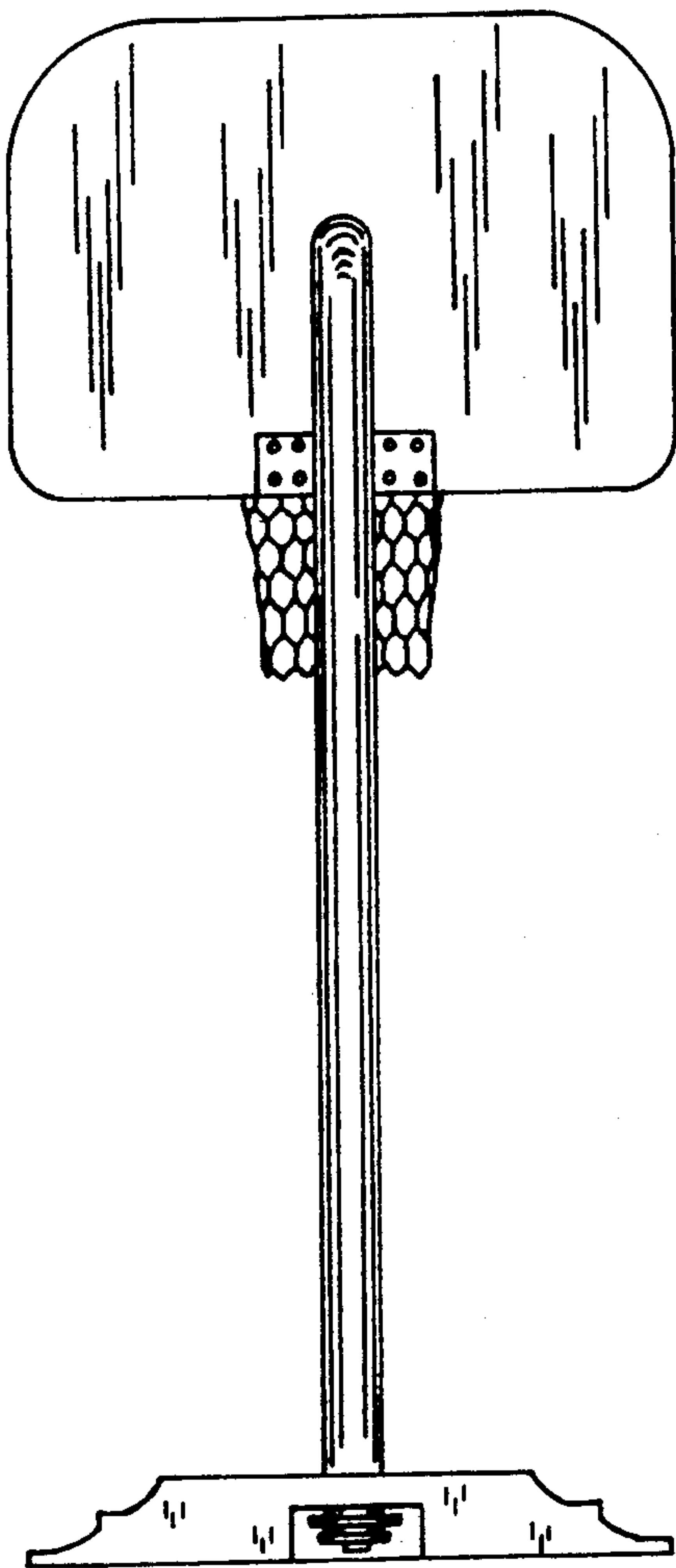

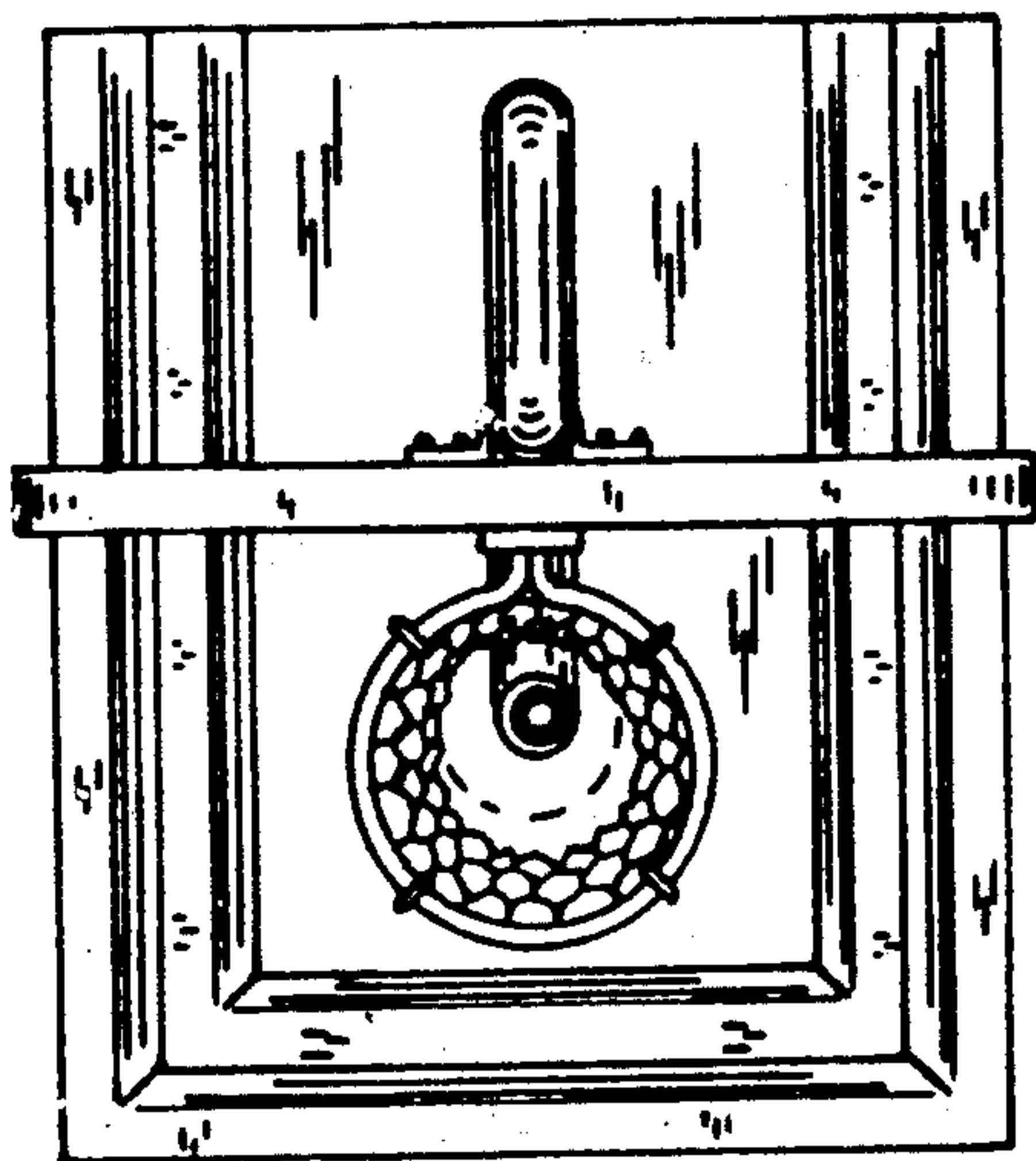

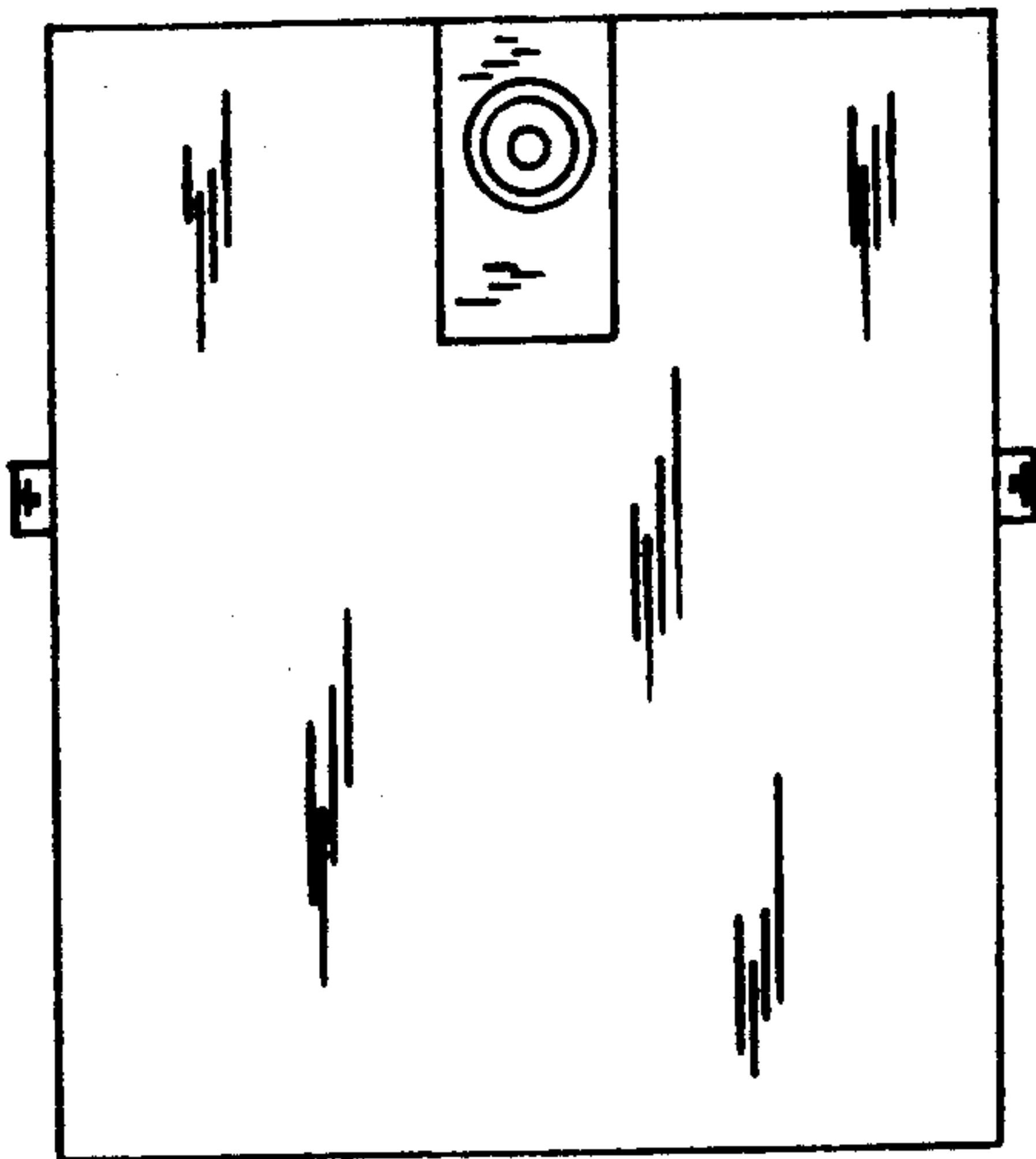
