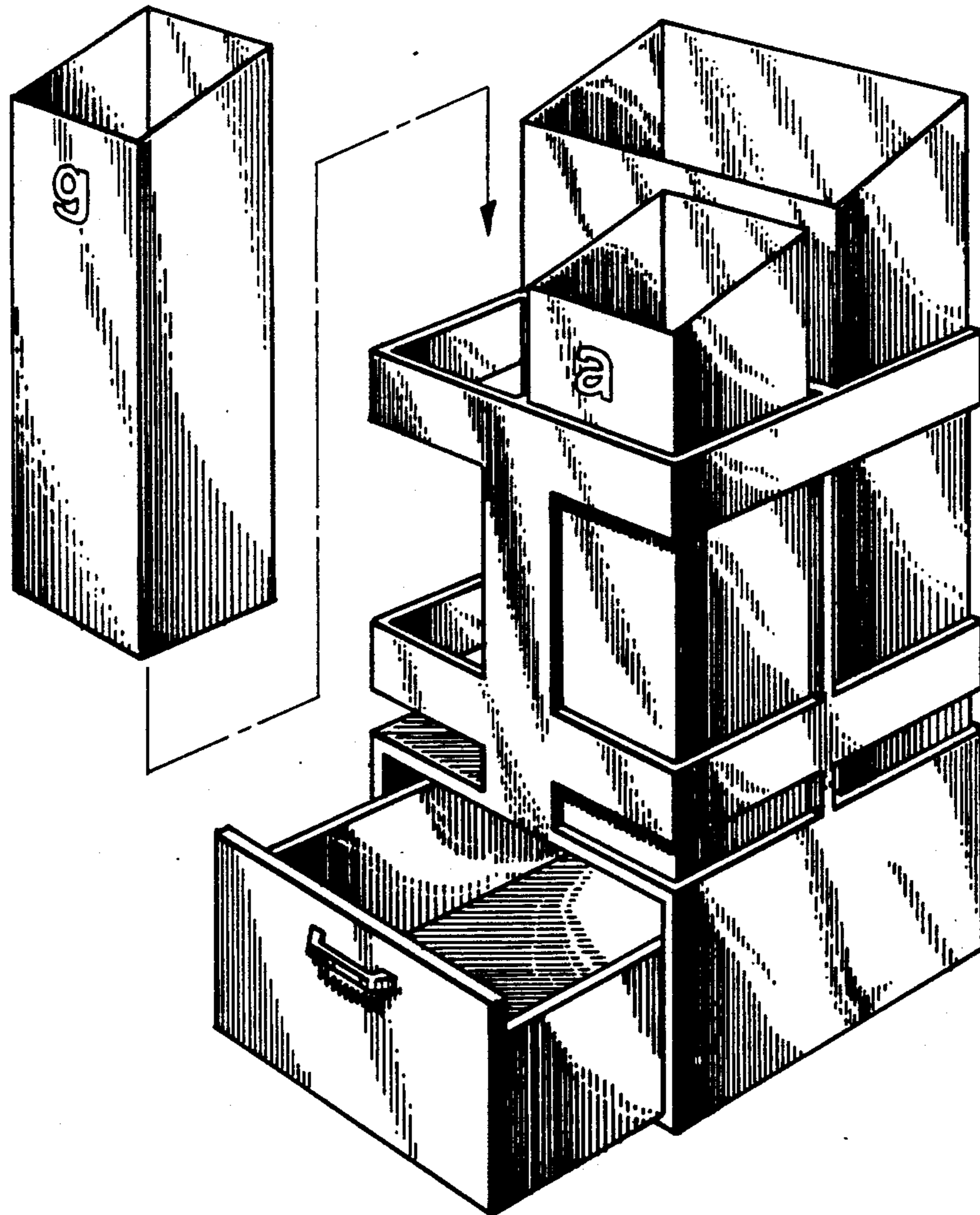

FIG. 5 is a front perspective view thereof, the bottom container being opened and one of the trash container being removed from the rack for clarity of illustration.



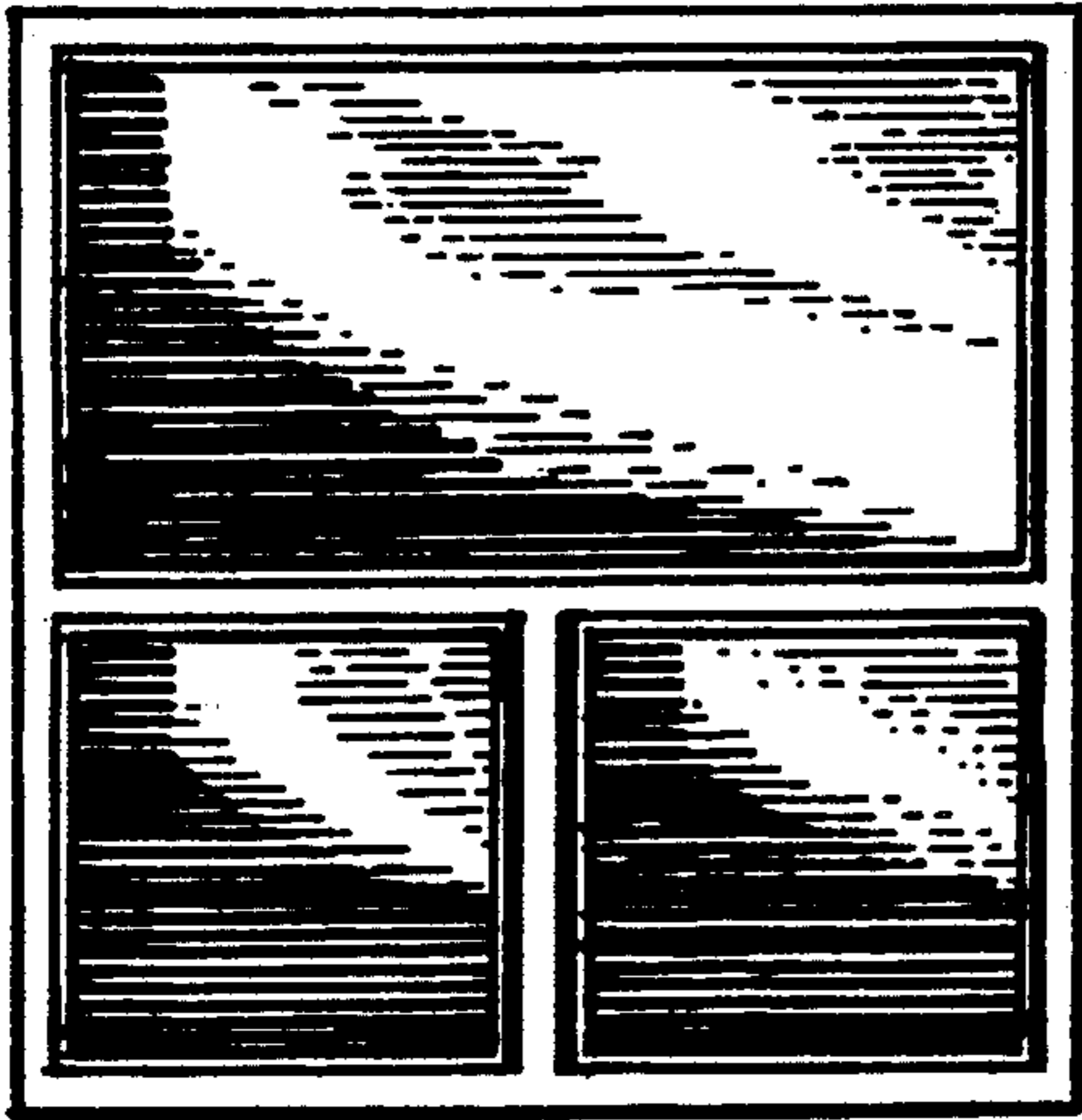

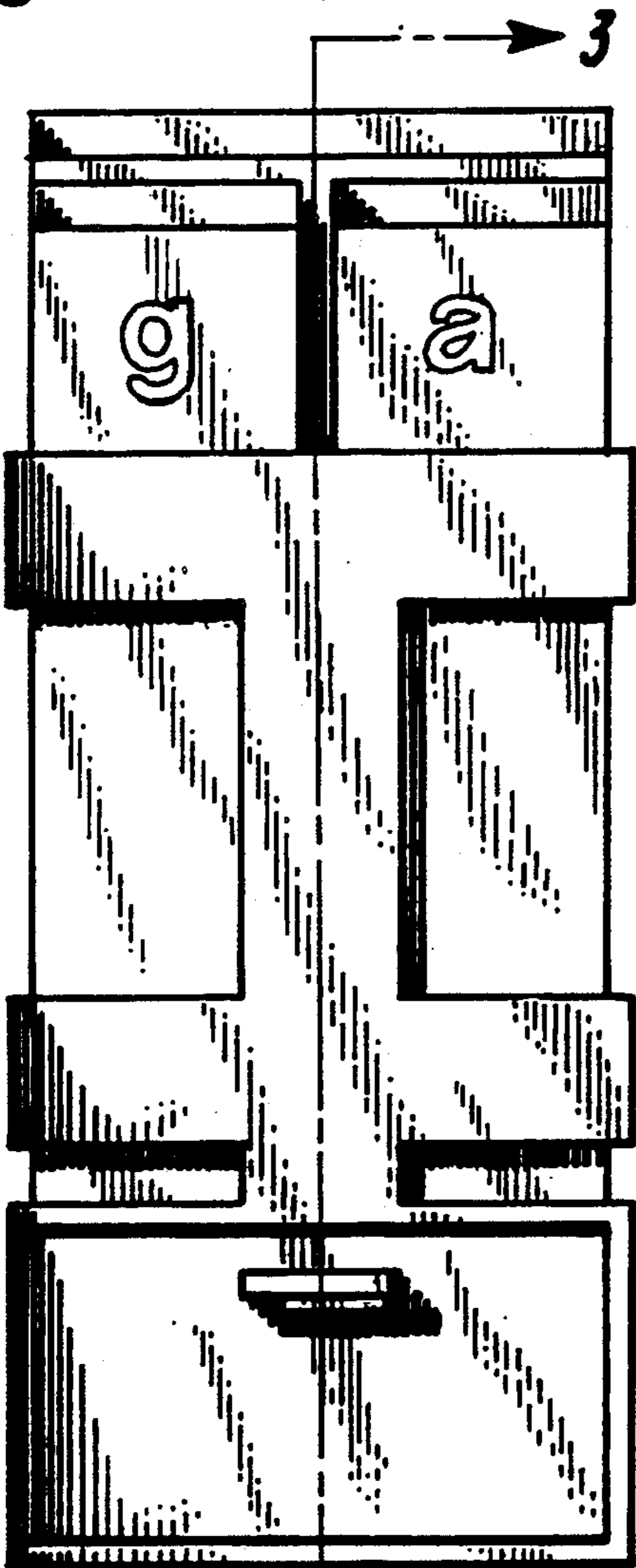

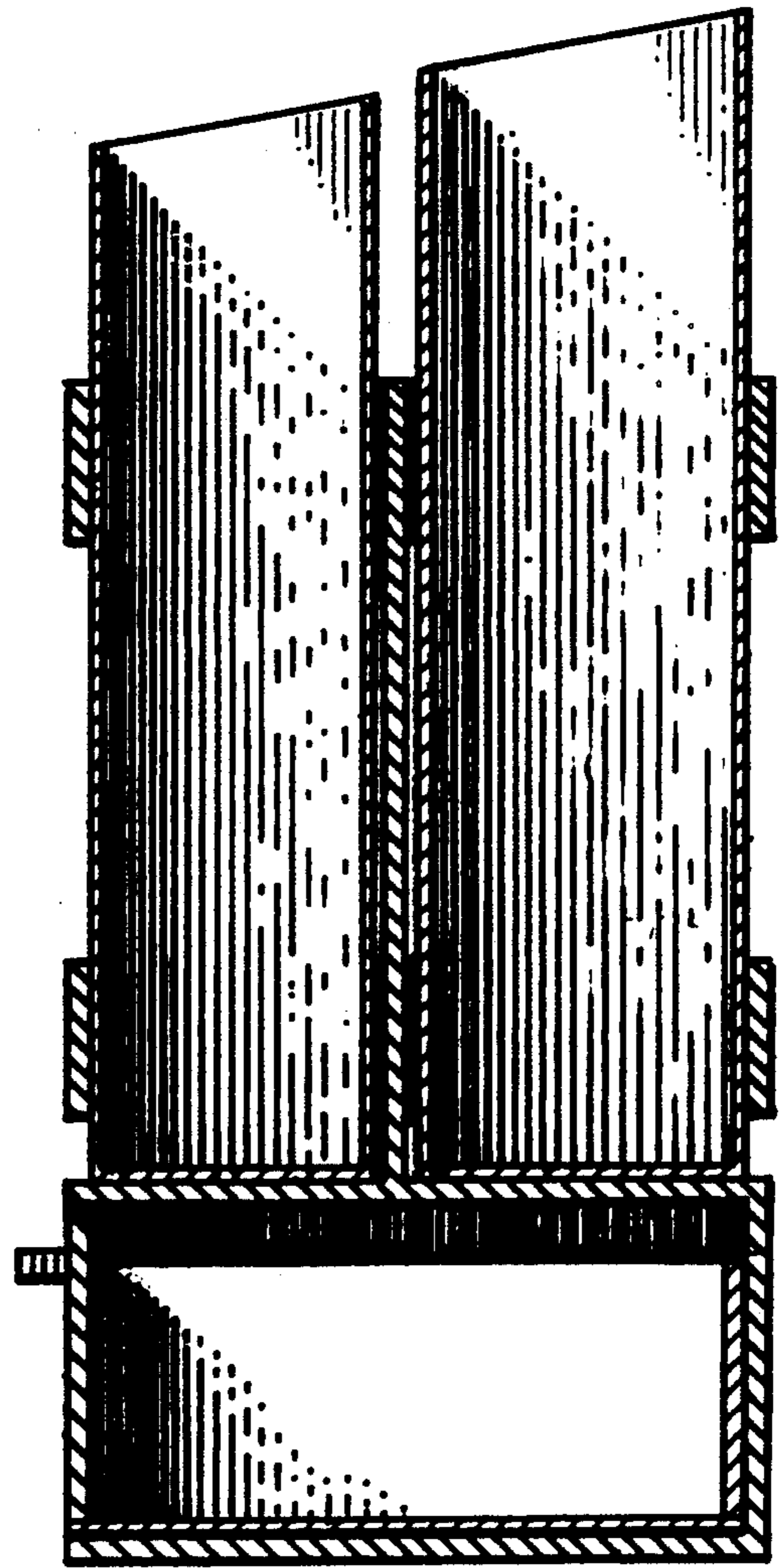

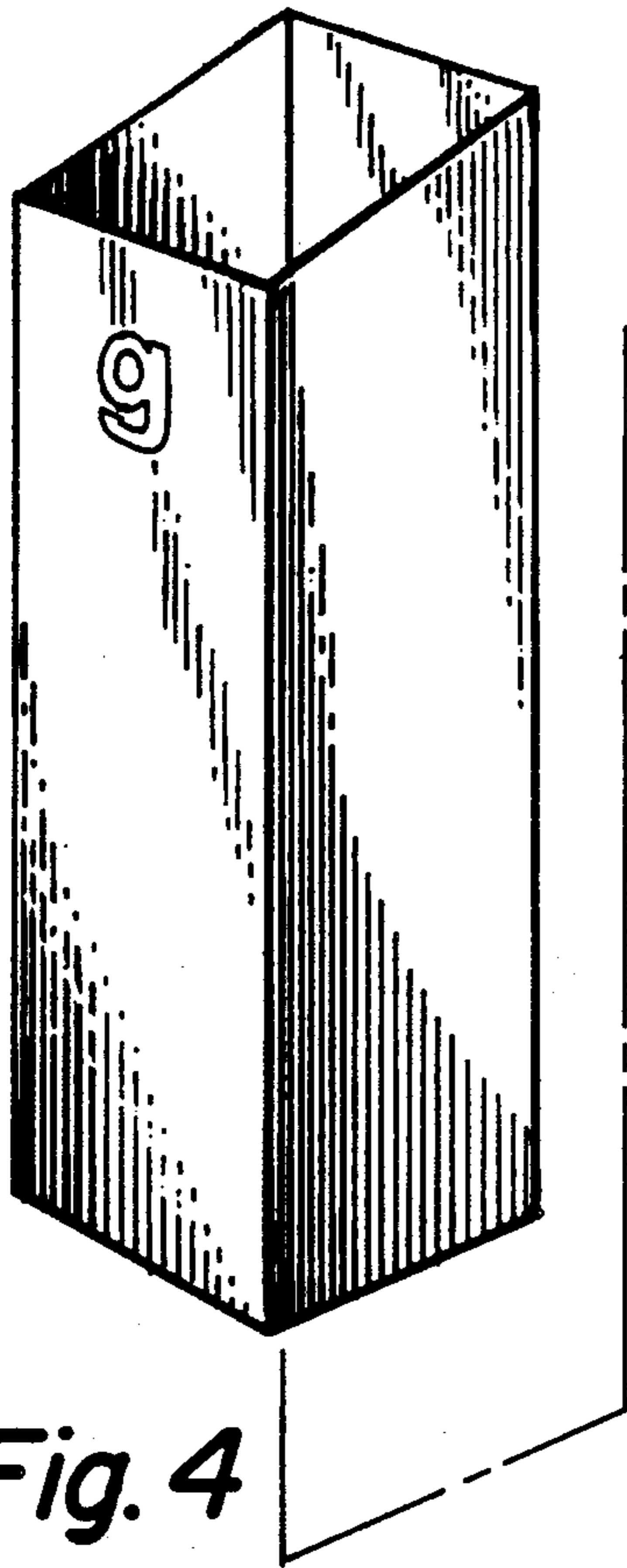

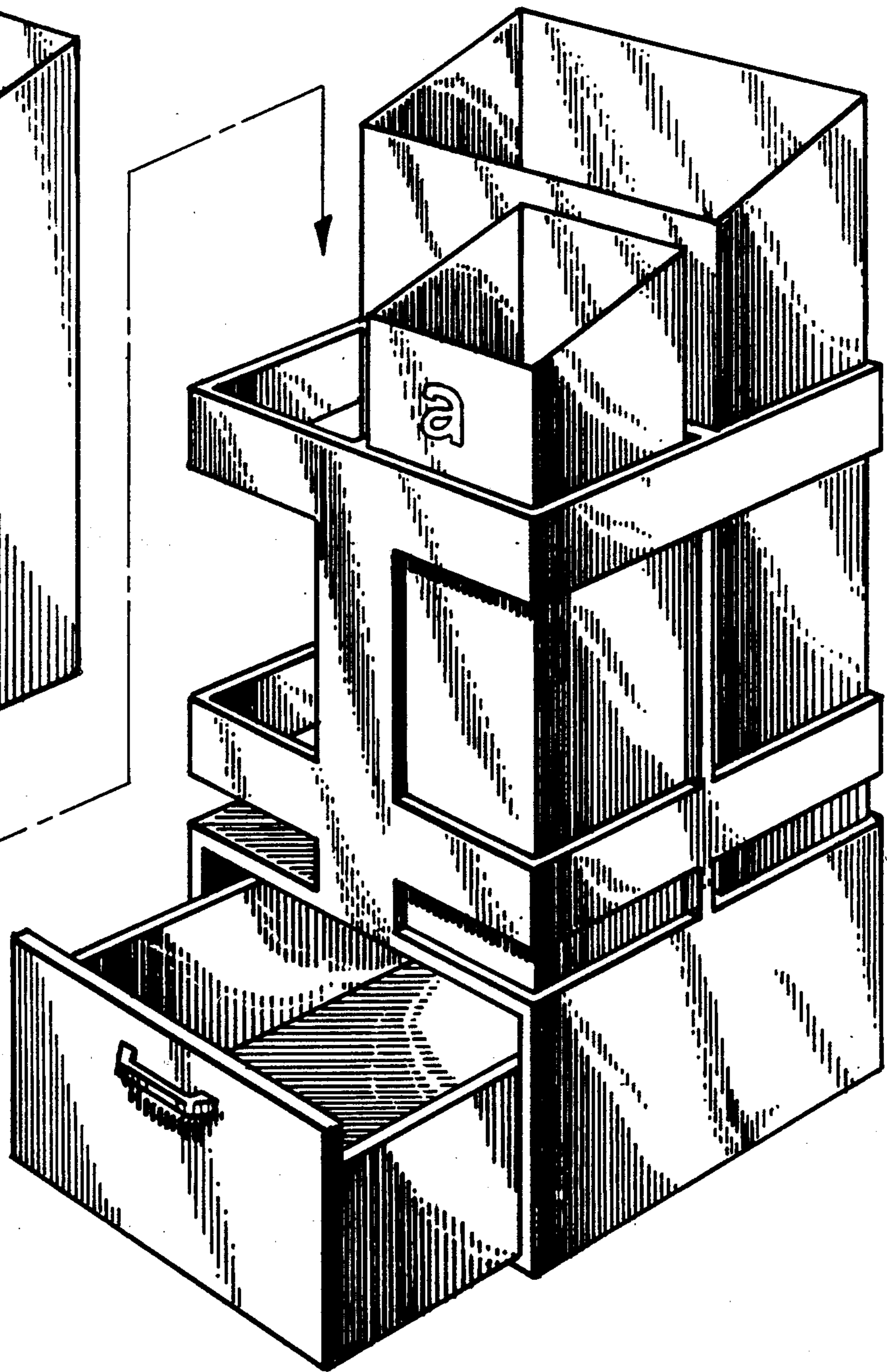
