DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top perspective view of a vehicle windshield defroster, showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 3 is a front elevation view thereof, the rear being a mirror image of that shown;

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

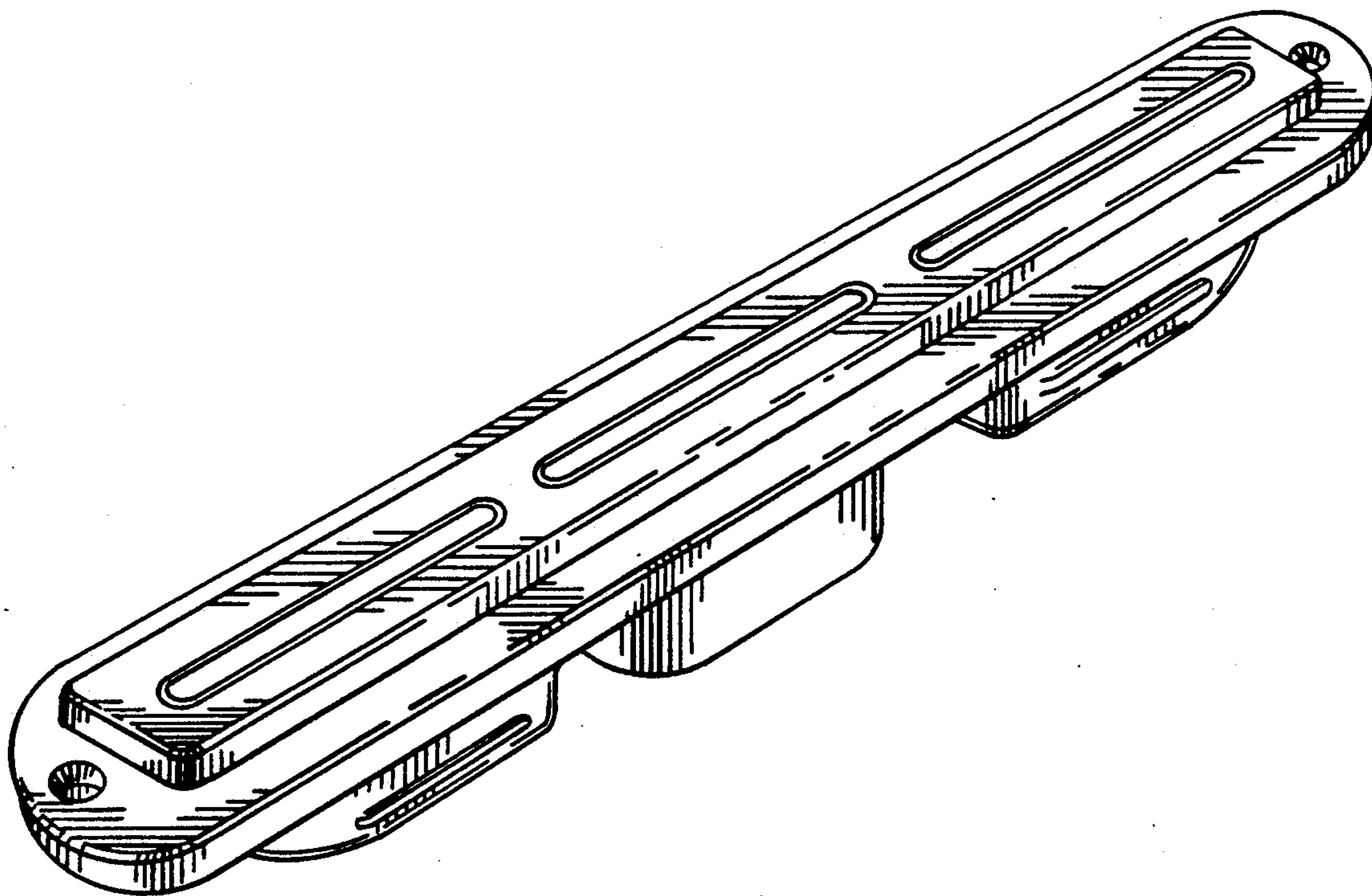
FIG. 5 is an end elevation view thereof, the opposite end being a mirror image of that shown;

FIG. 9 is a bottom plan view of FIG. 6.



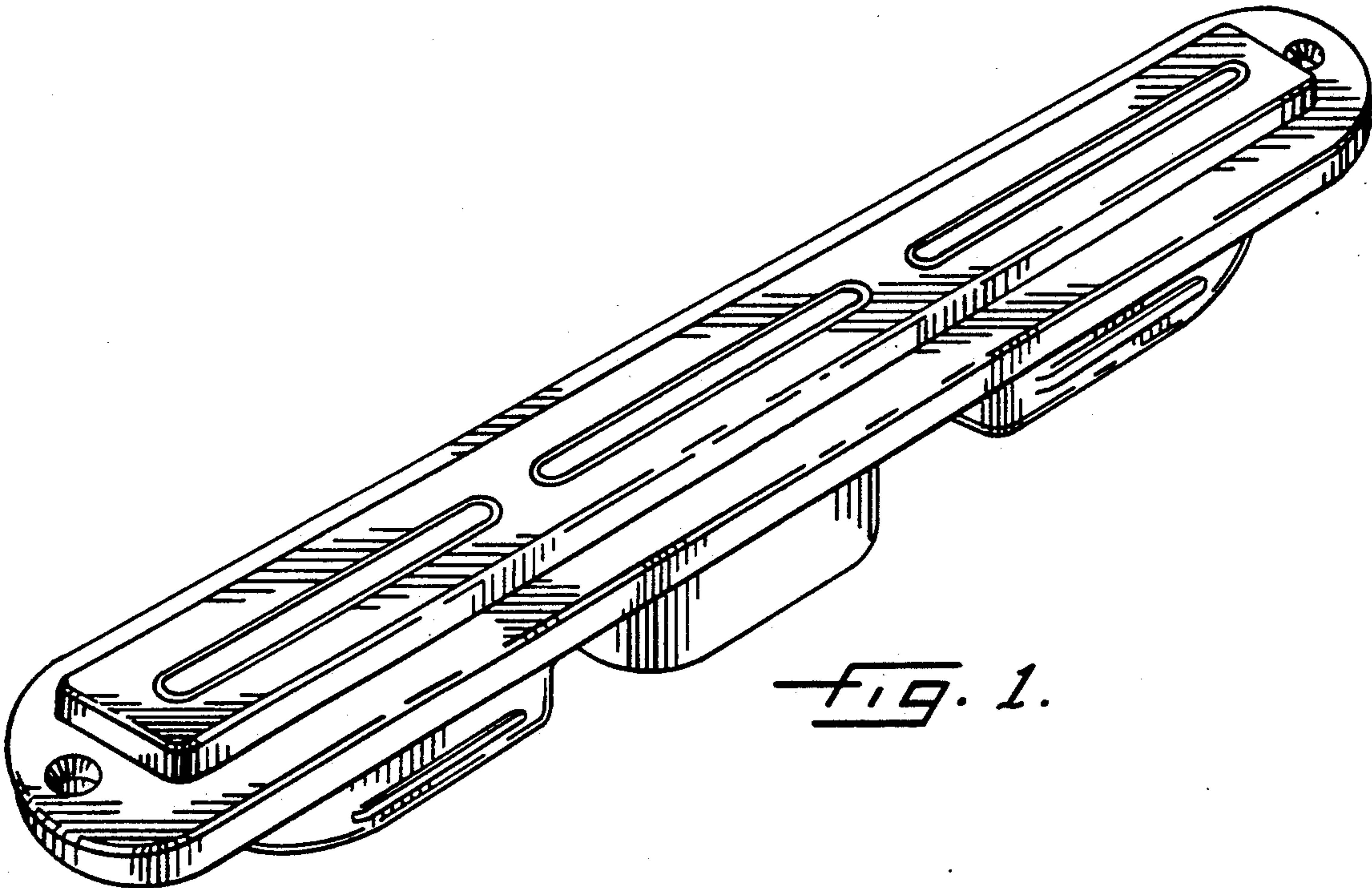

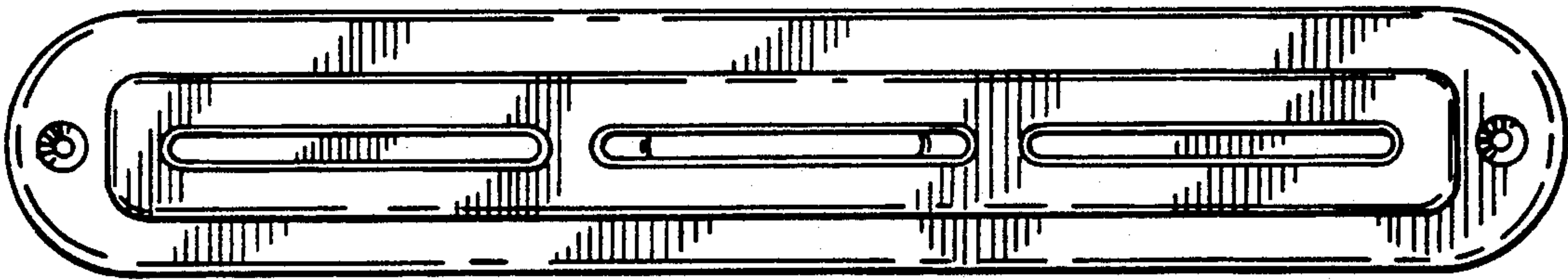

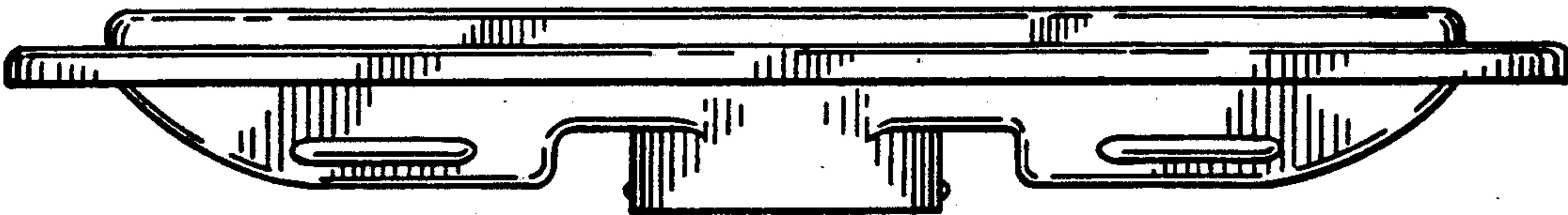

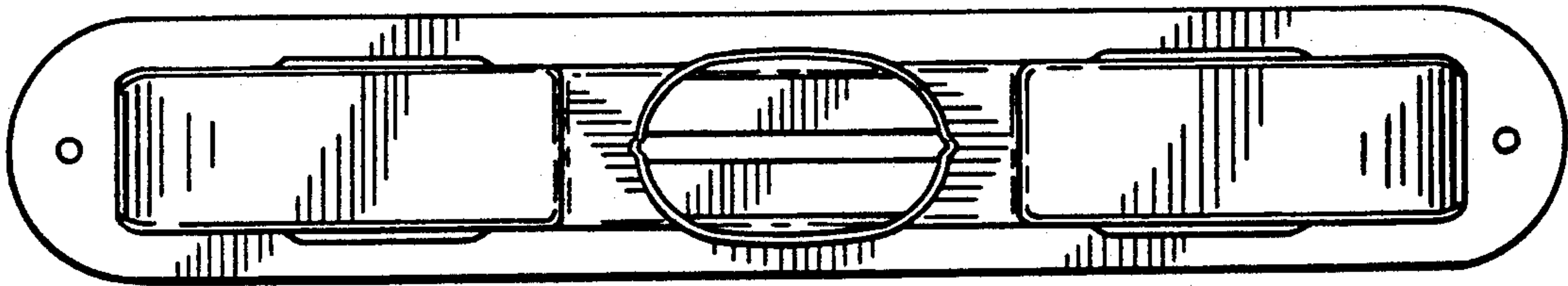

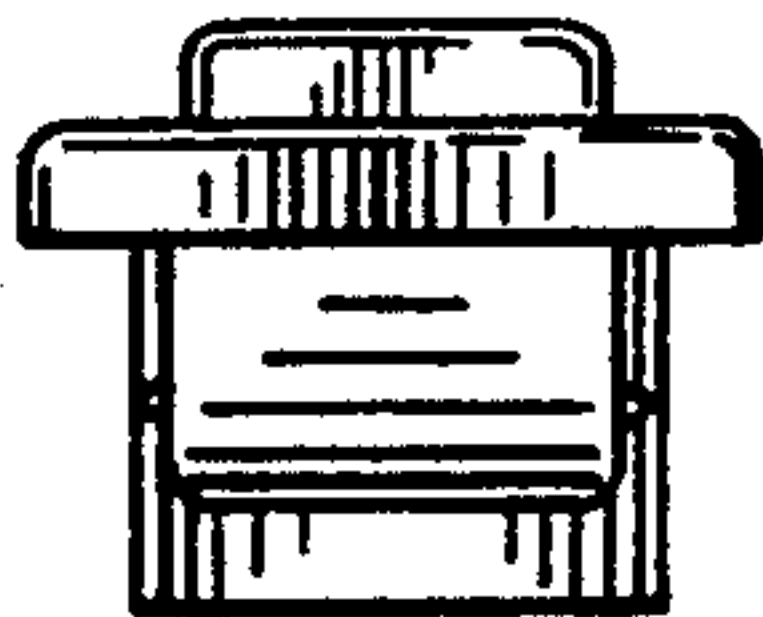

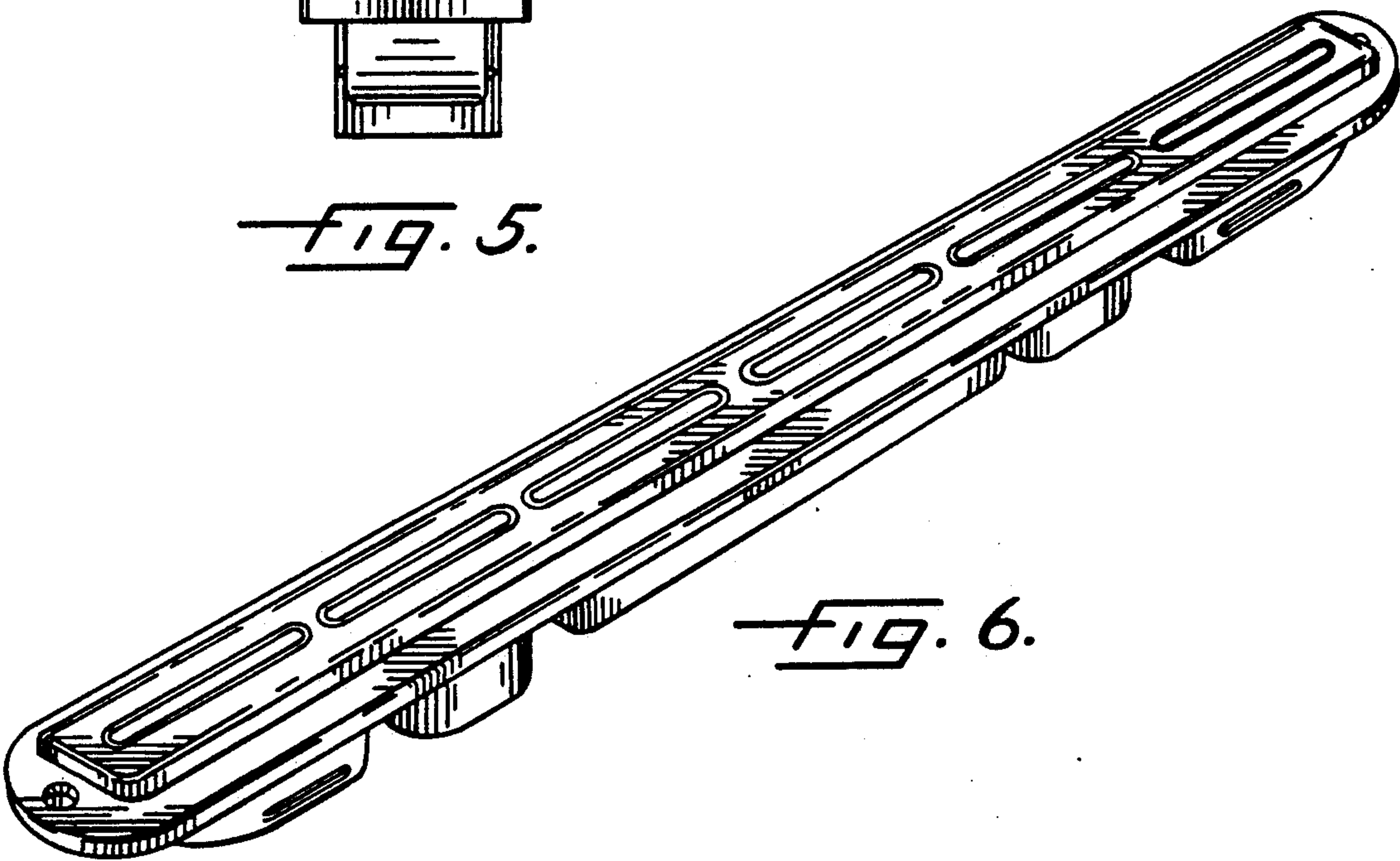

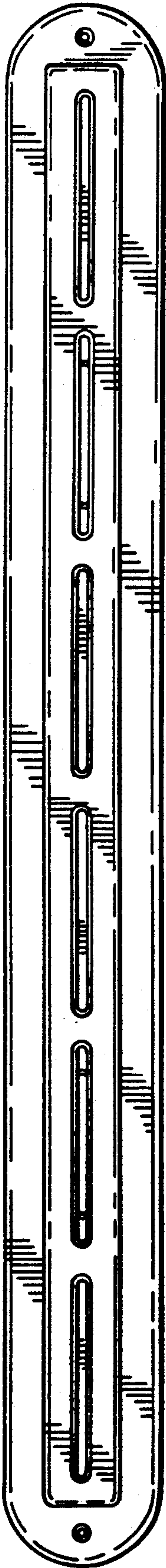

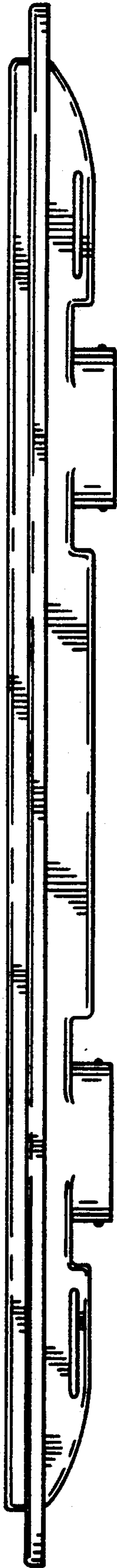

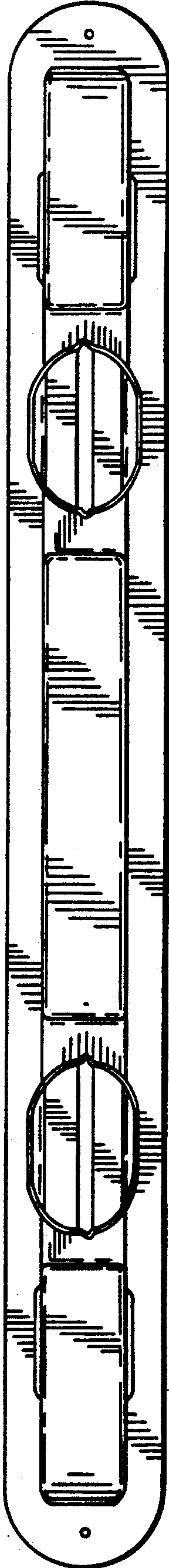
