The article of the present design is a front shoe sole which is attached to the upper part of a shoe. The design is symmetrical in respect of the corresponding opposite front shoe sole.

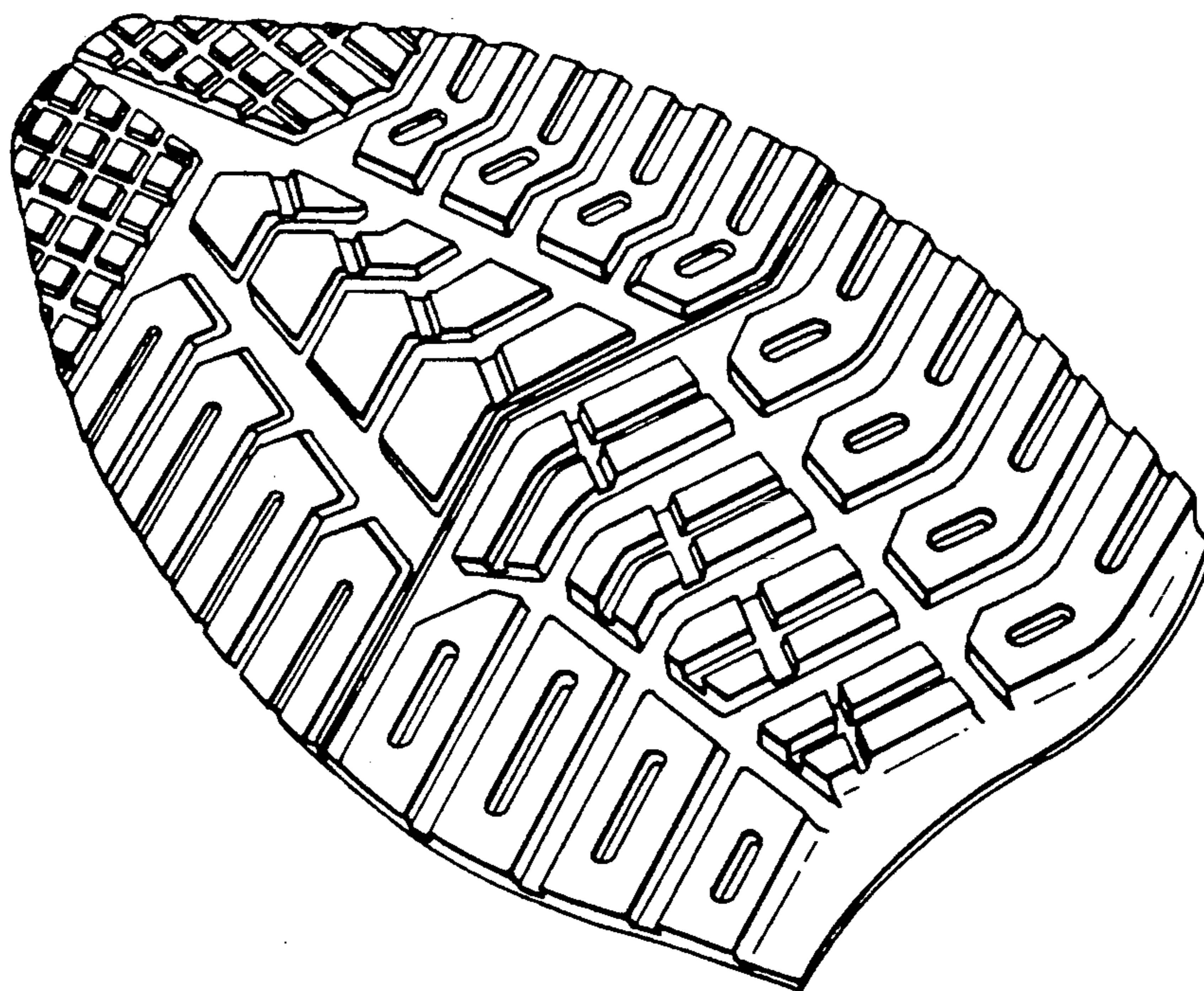

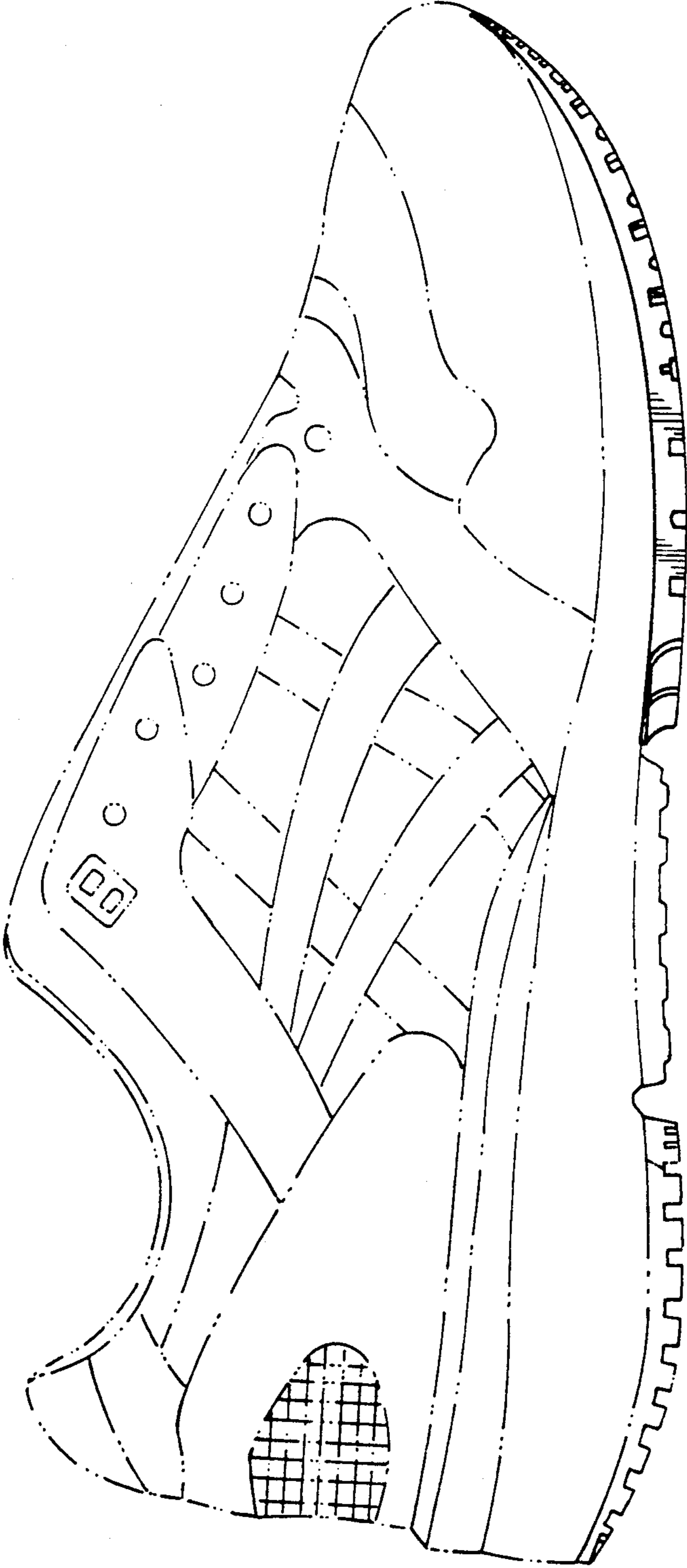

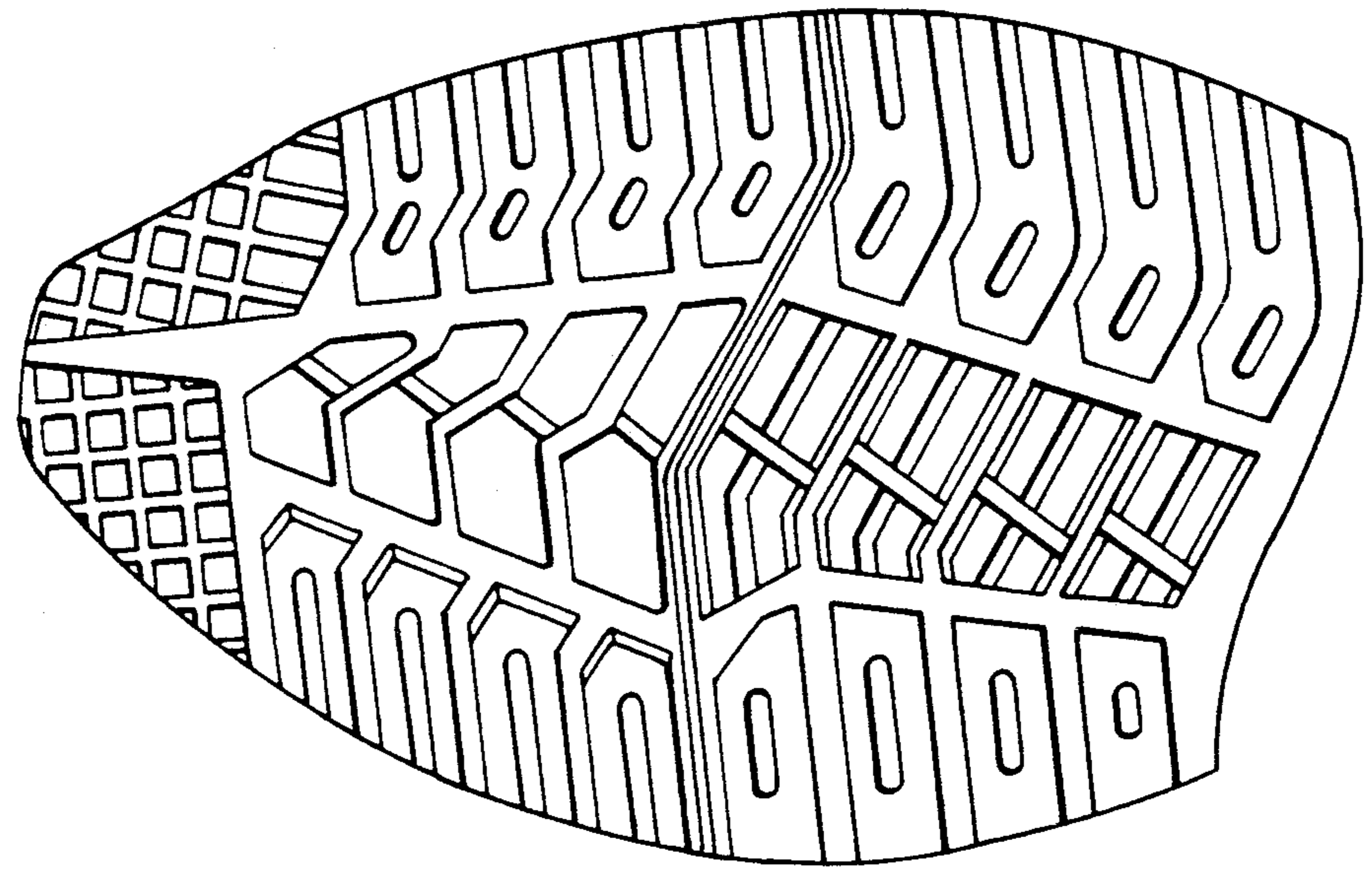

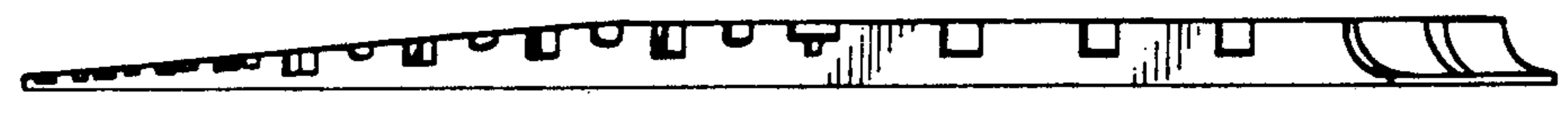

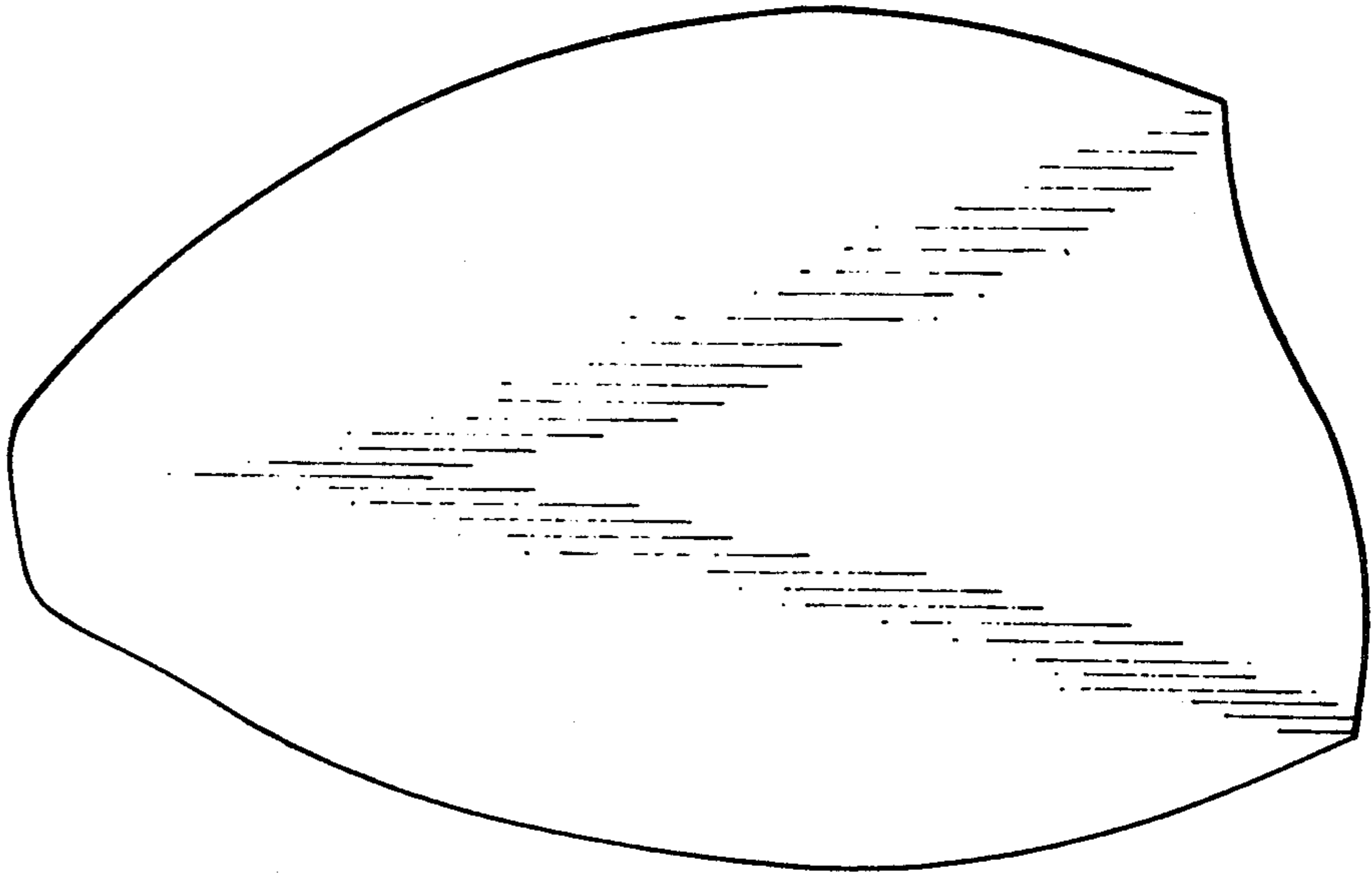
