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[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a faucet handle or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view taken from the top, front and right side of a faucet handle or the like showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a side elevational view thereof, the other sides being a mirror image of the side shown;

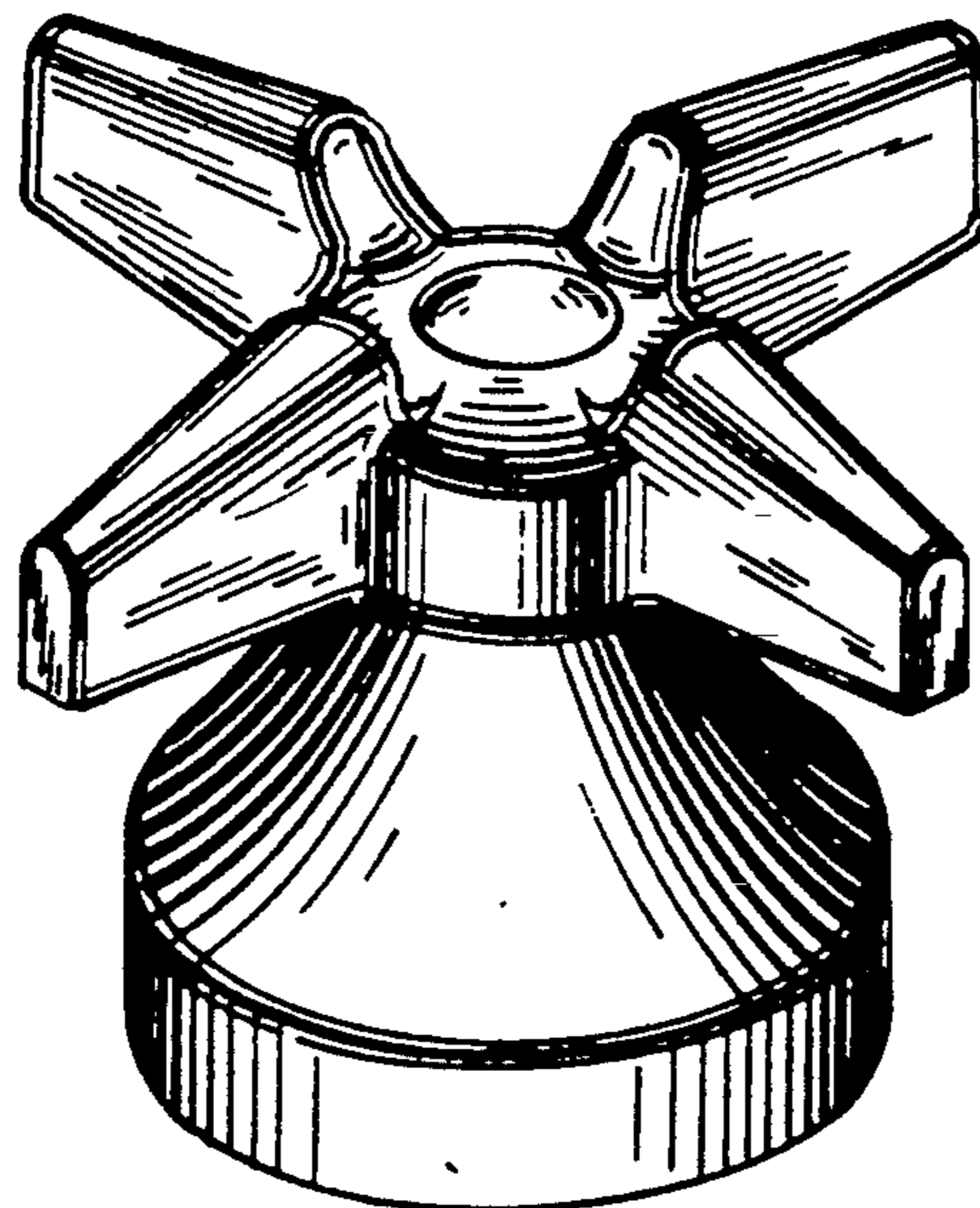
FIG. 3 is a top plan view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a side elevational view of a fourth embodiment thereof, the other sides being a mirror image of the side shown.



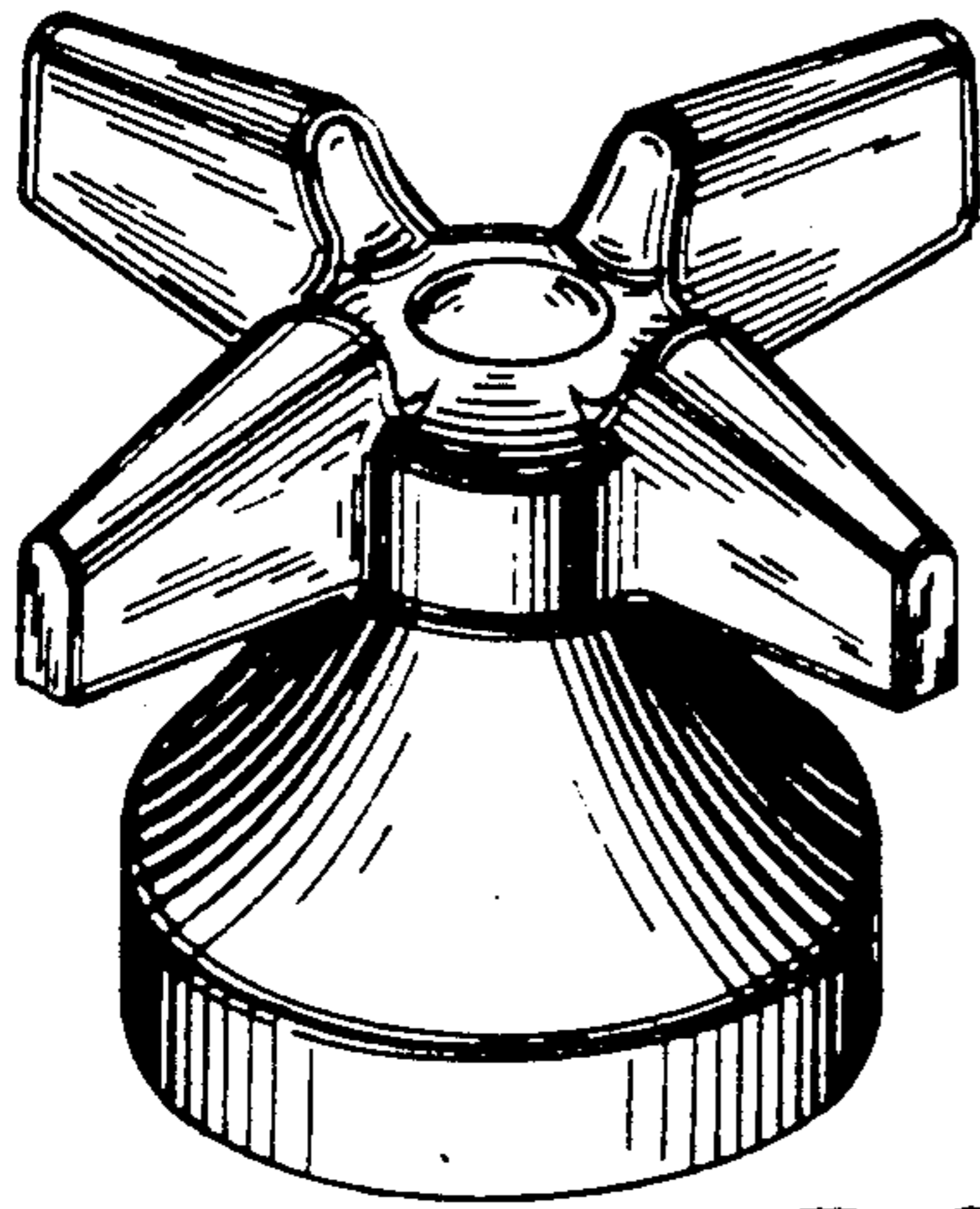

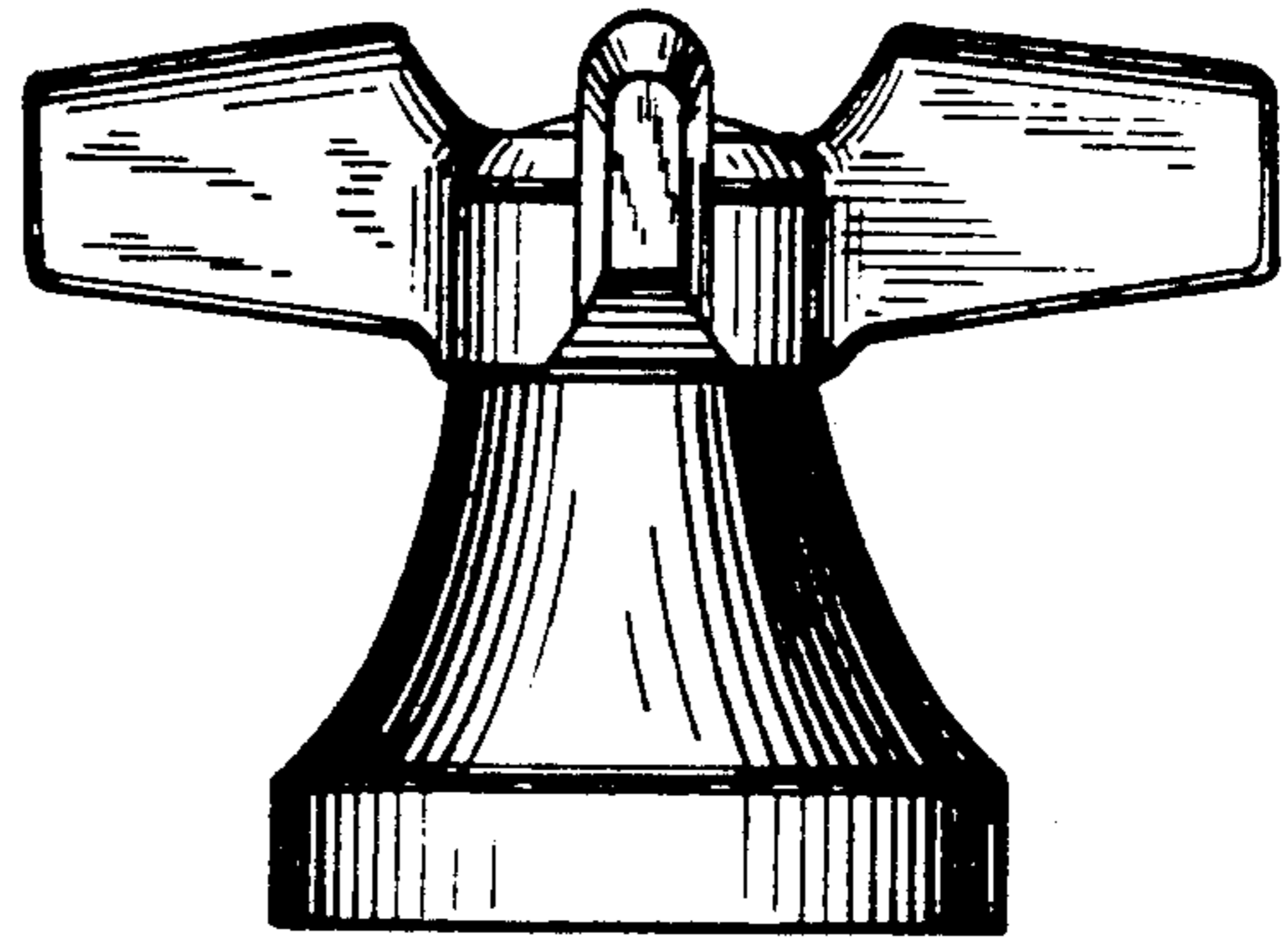

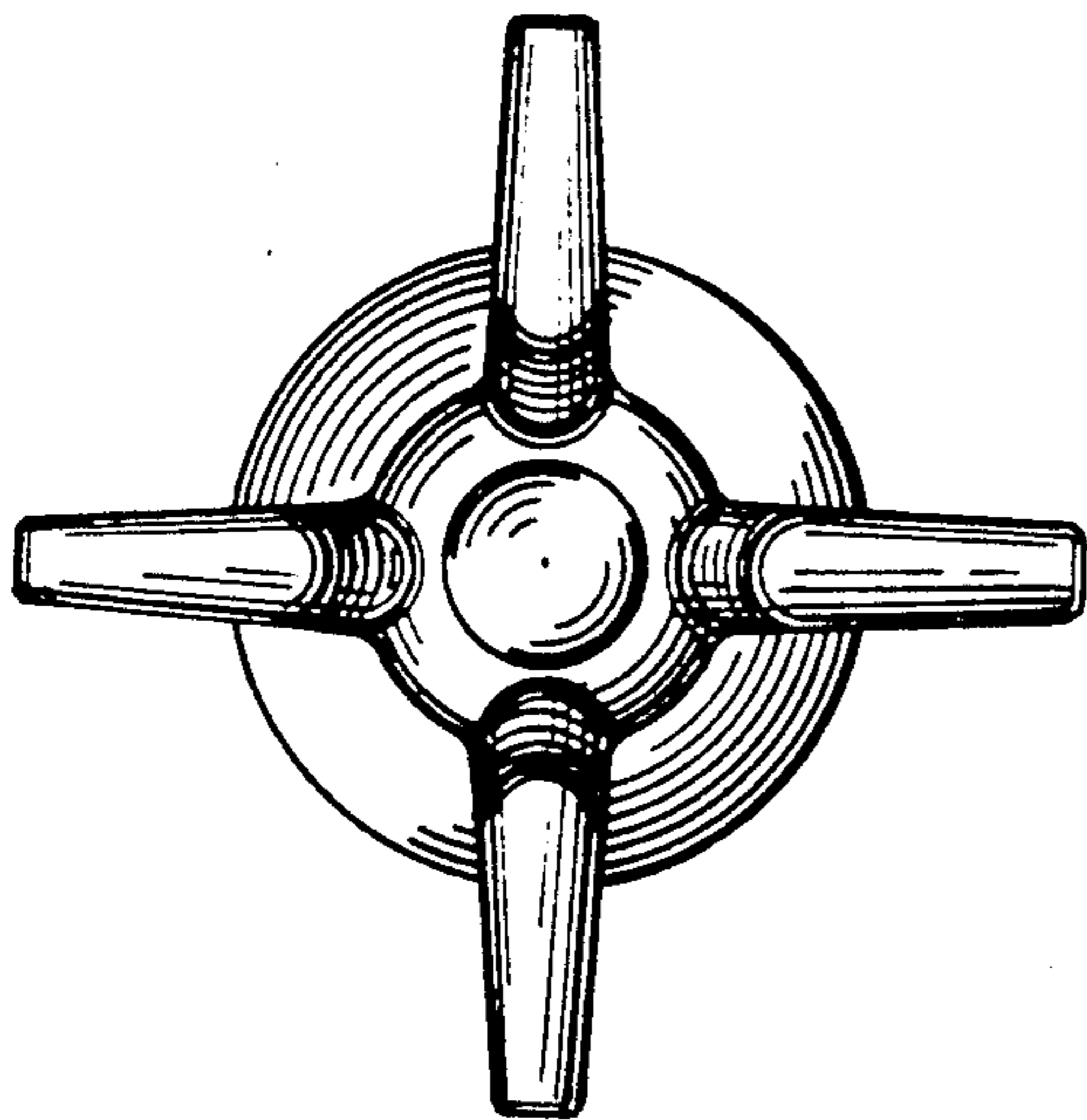

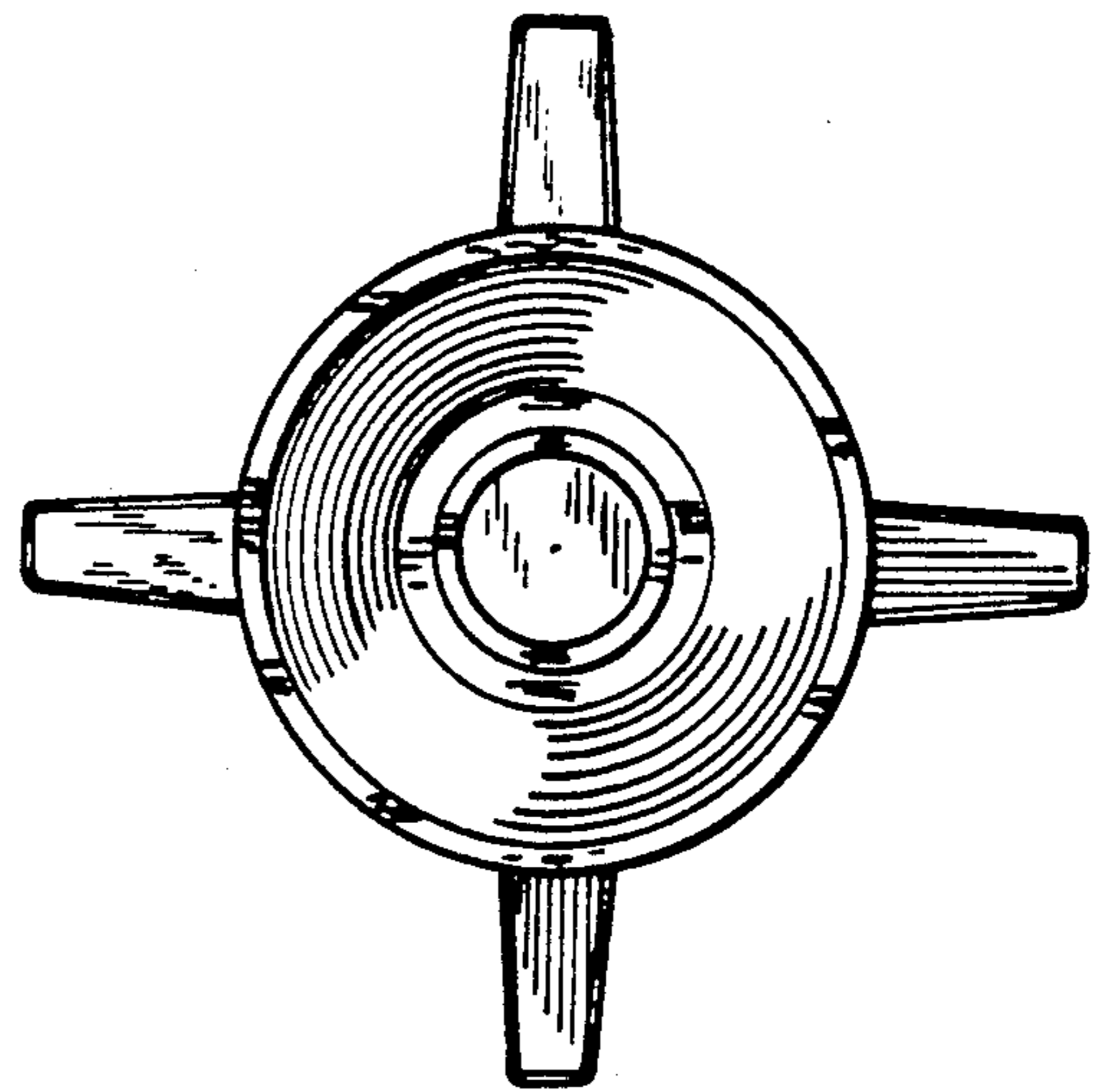

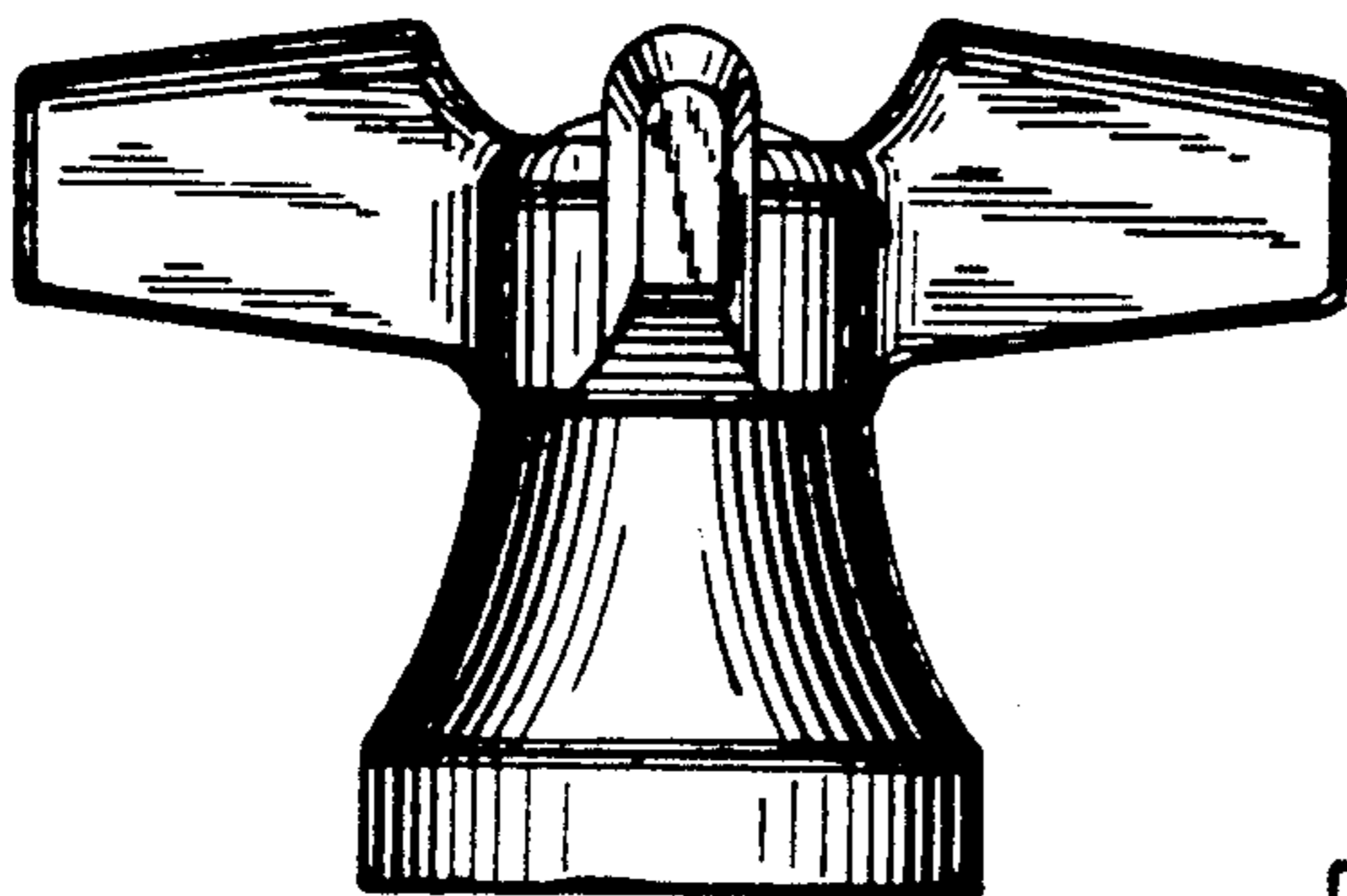

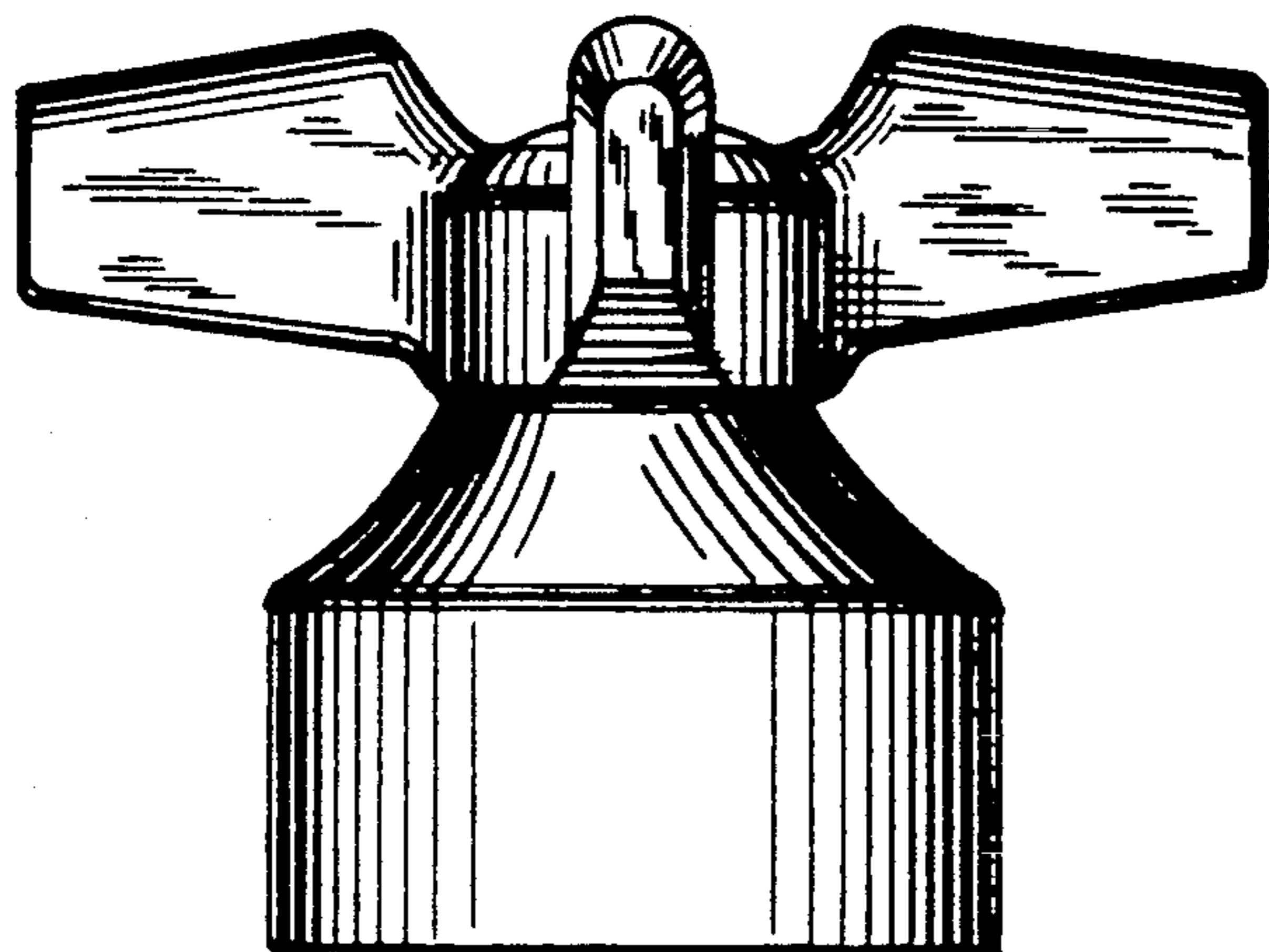

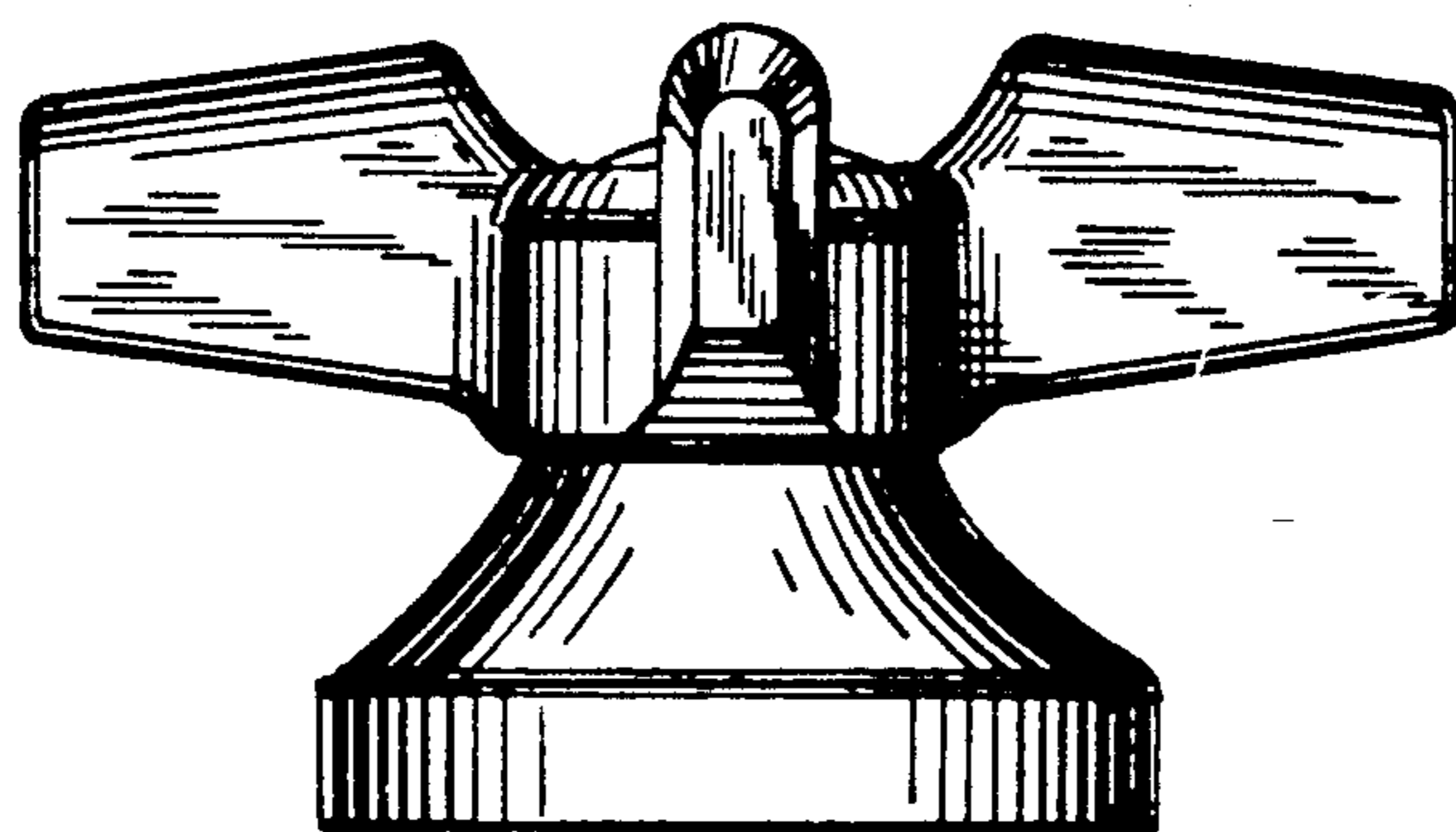
