FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view;

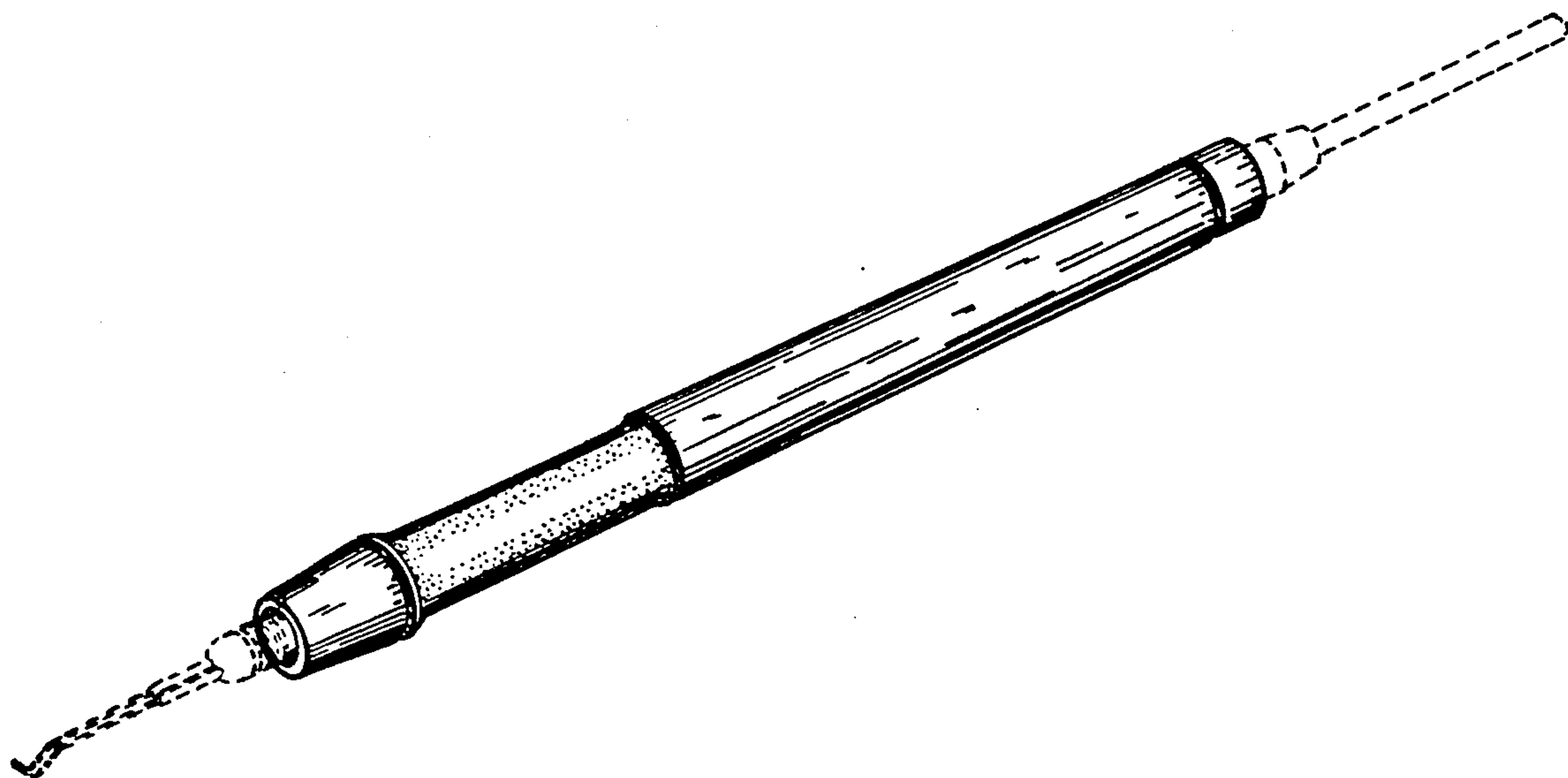
FIG. 5 is a front elevational view;

The broken-line showings of FIGS. 1 and 2 are environmental only and form no part of the claimed design.



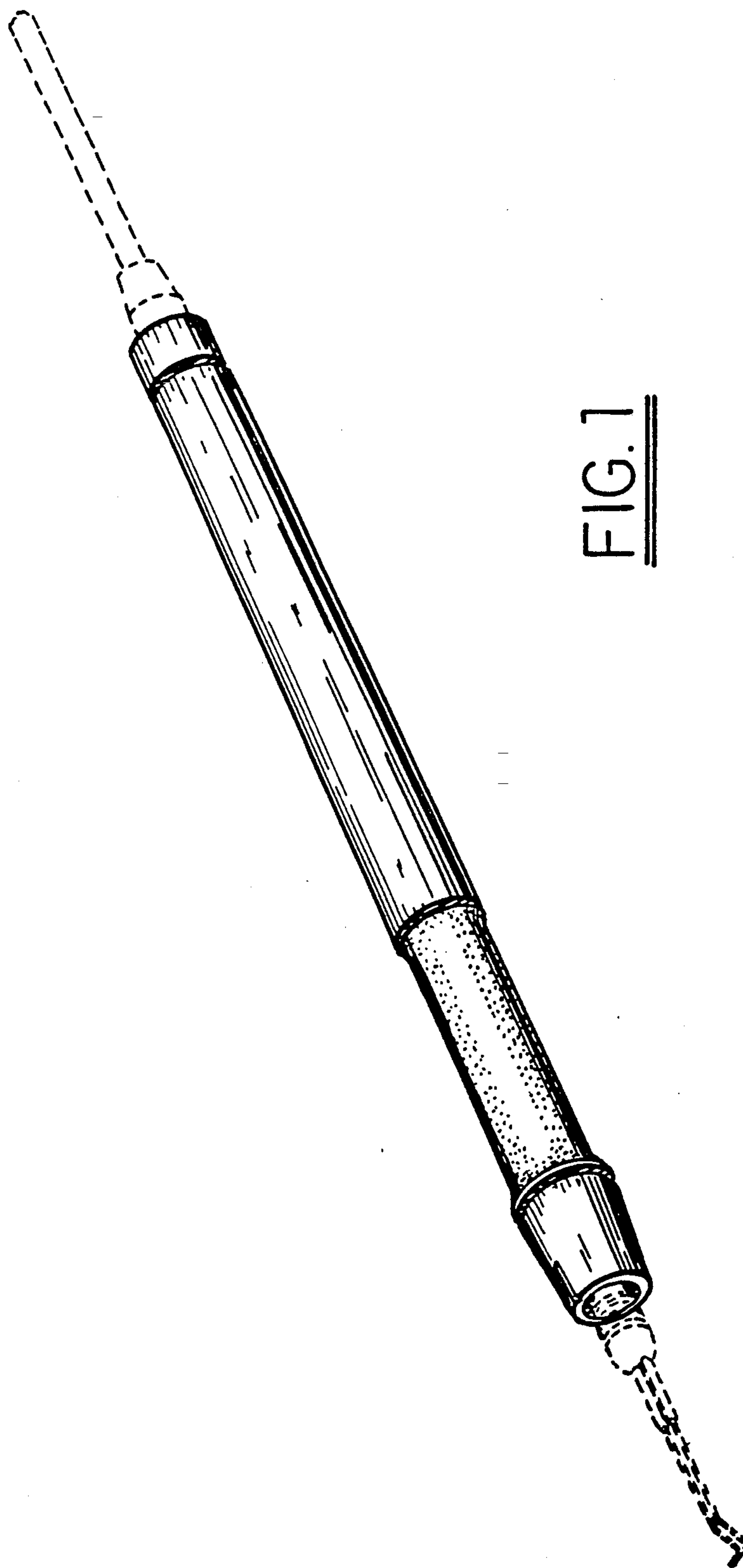

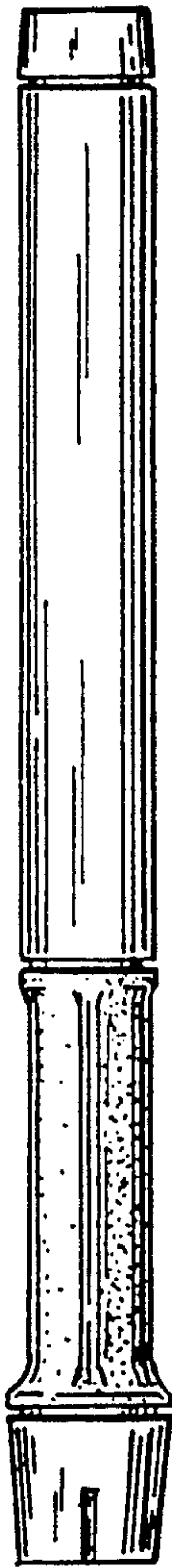

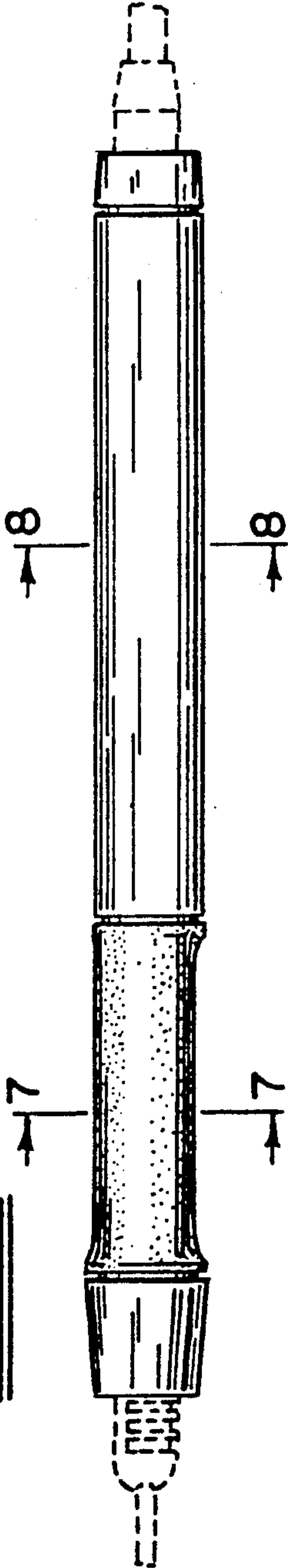

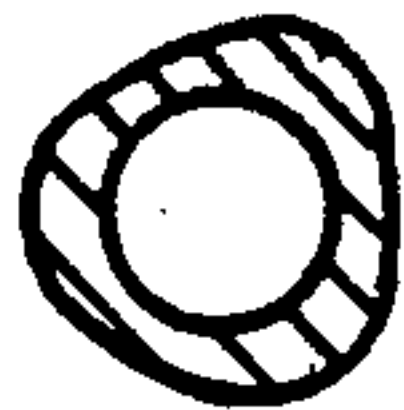

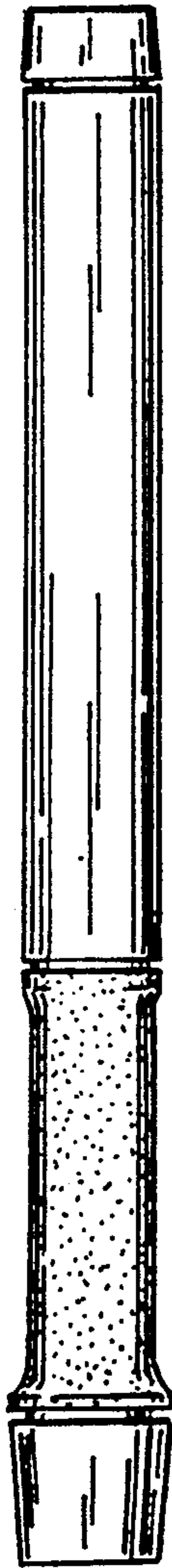
