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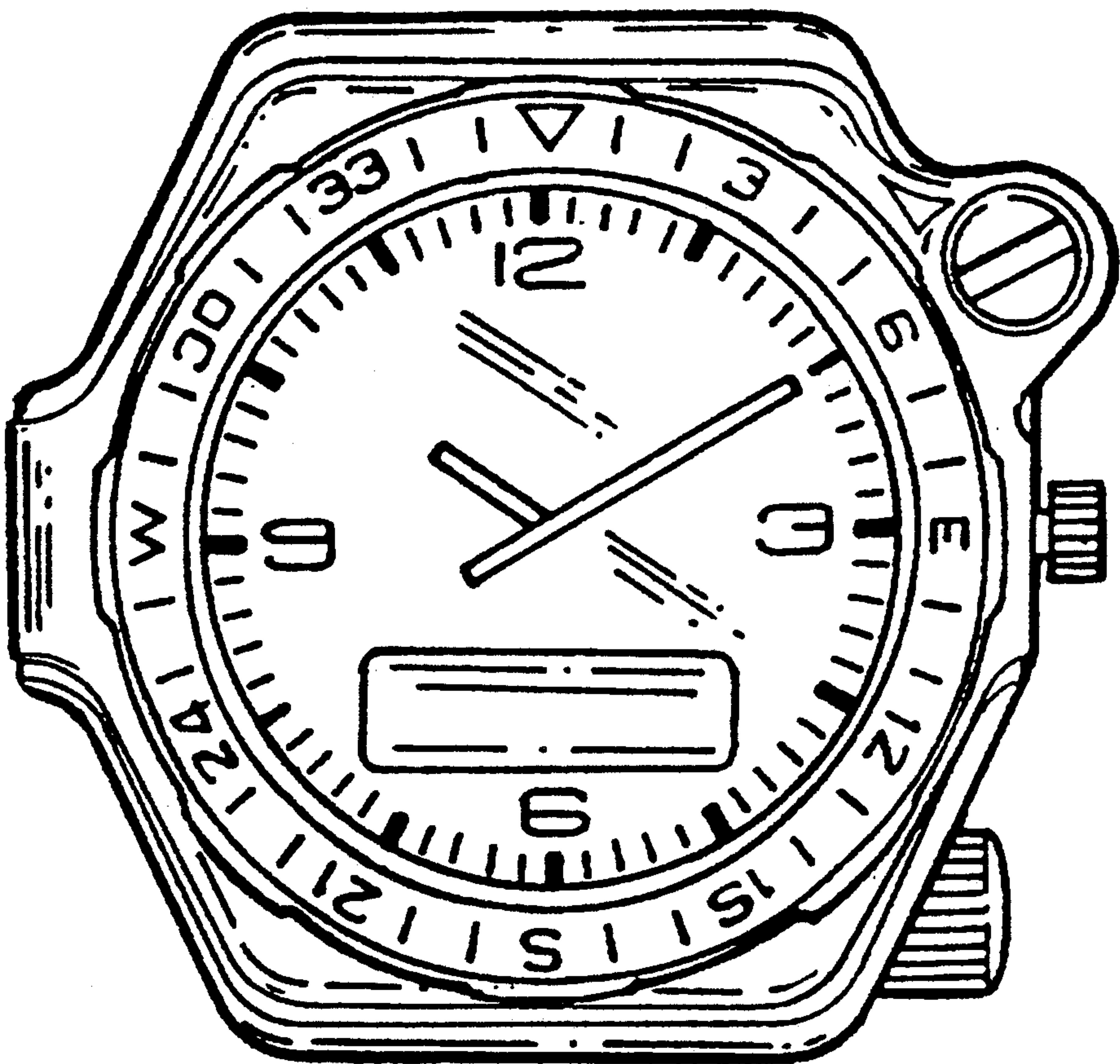

The ornamental design for a wrist-watch, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a wrist-watch showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view, with the emergency signalling component shown extended;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view, with the watch case shown in an open position;
FIG. 5 is a left side elevational view; and,
FIG. 6 is a right side elevational view thereof.
The top and bottom plan views of the wristwatch not shown are conventional in form.



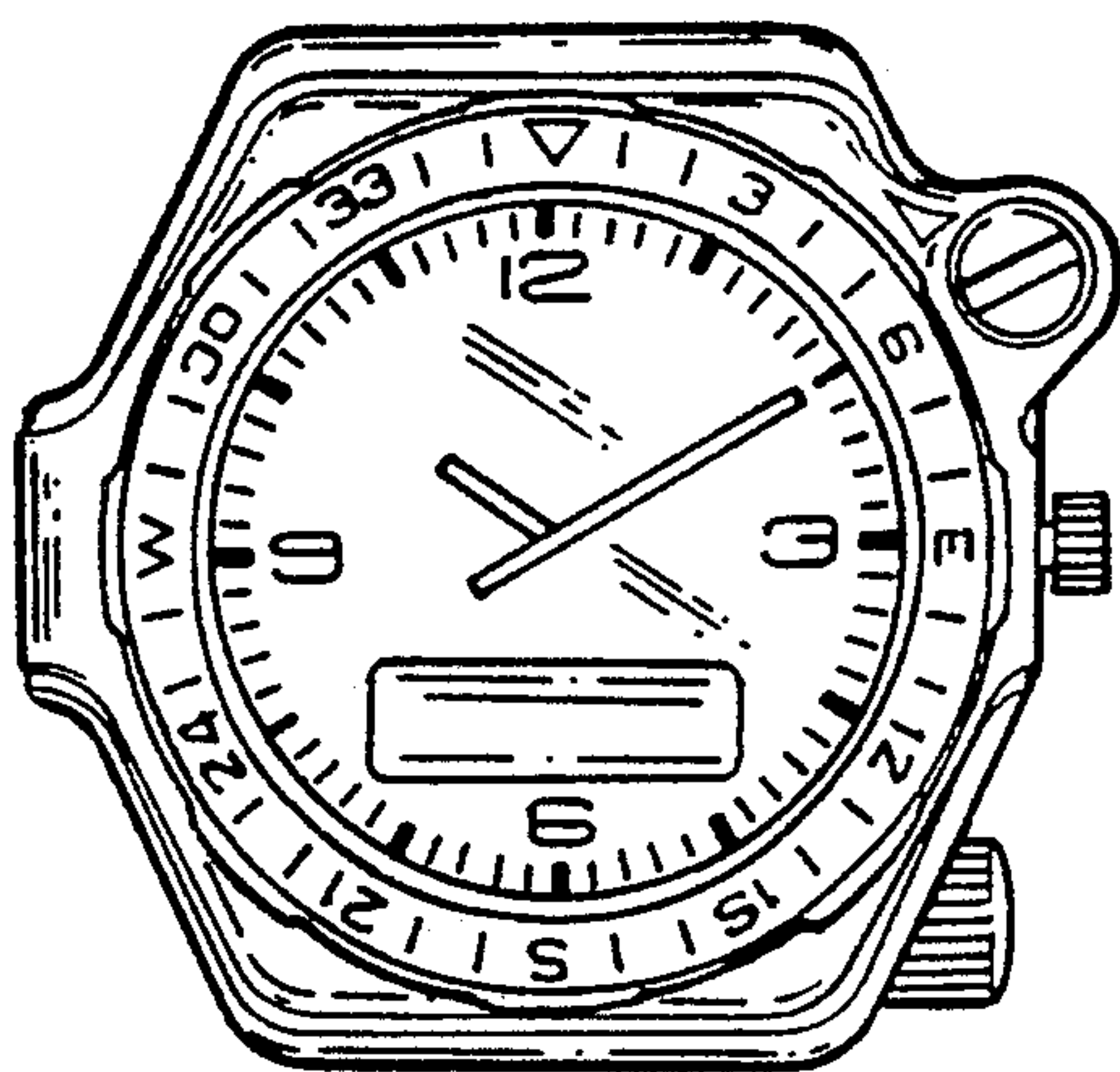

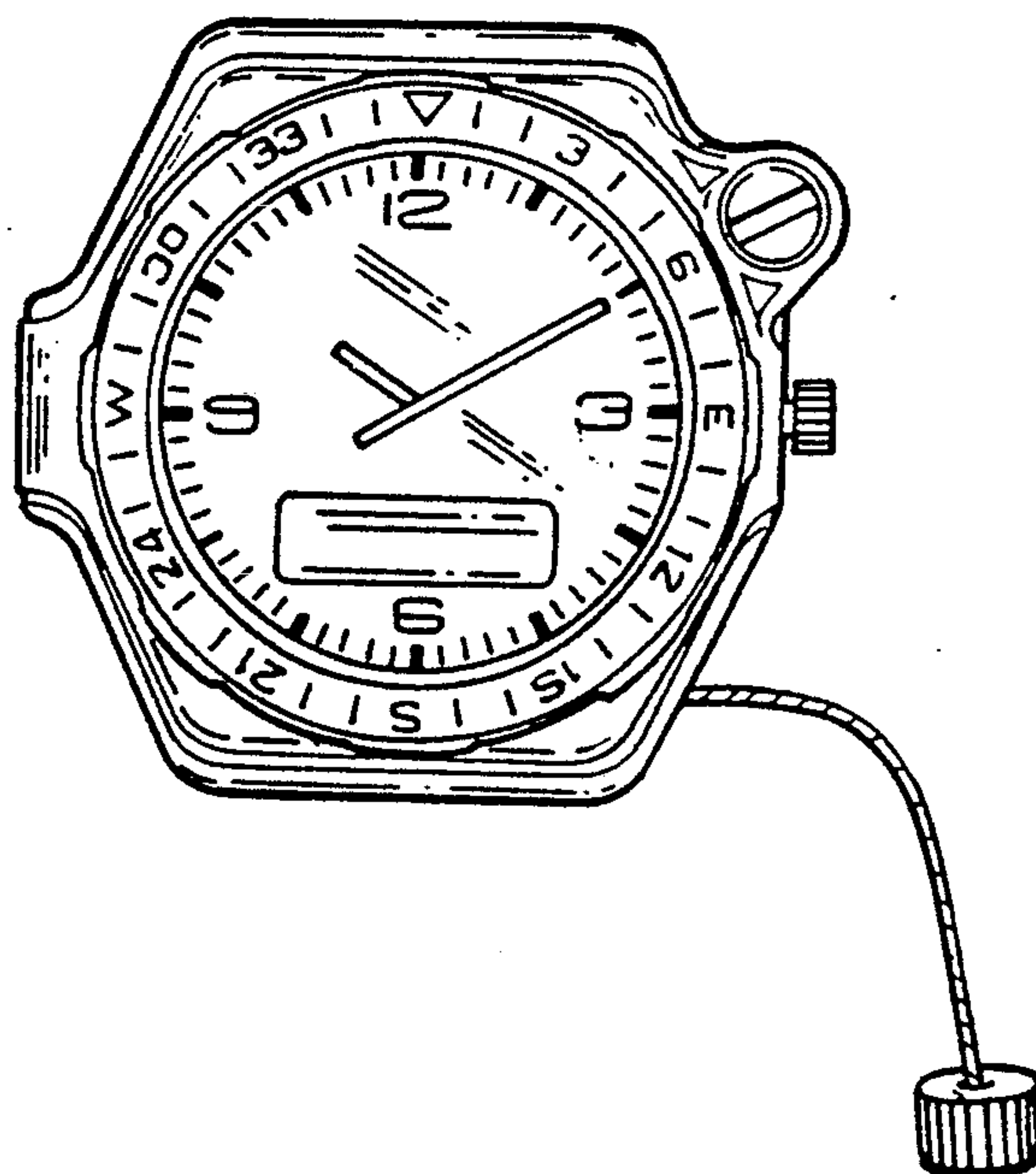

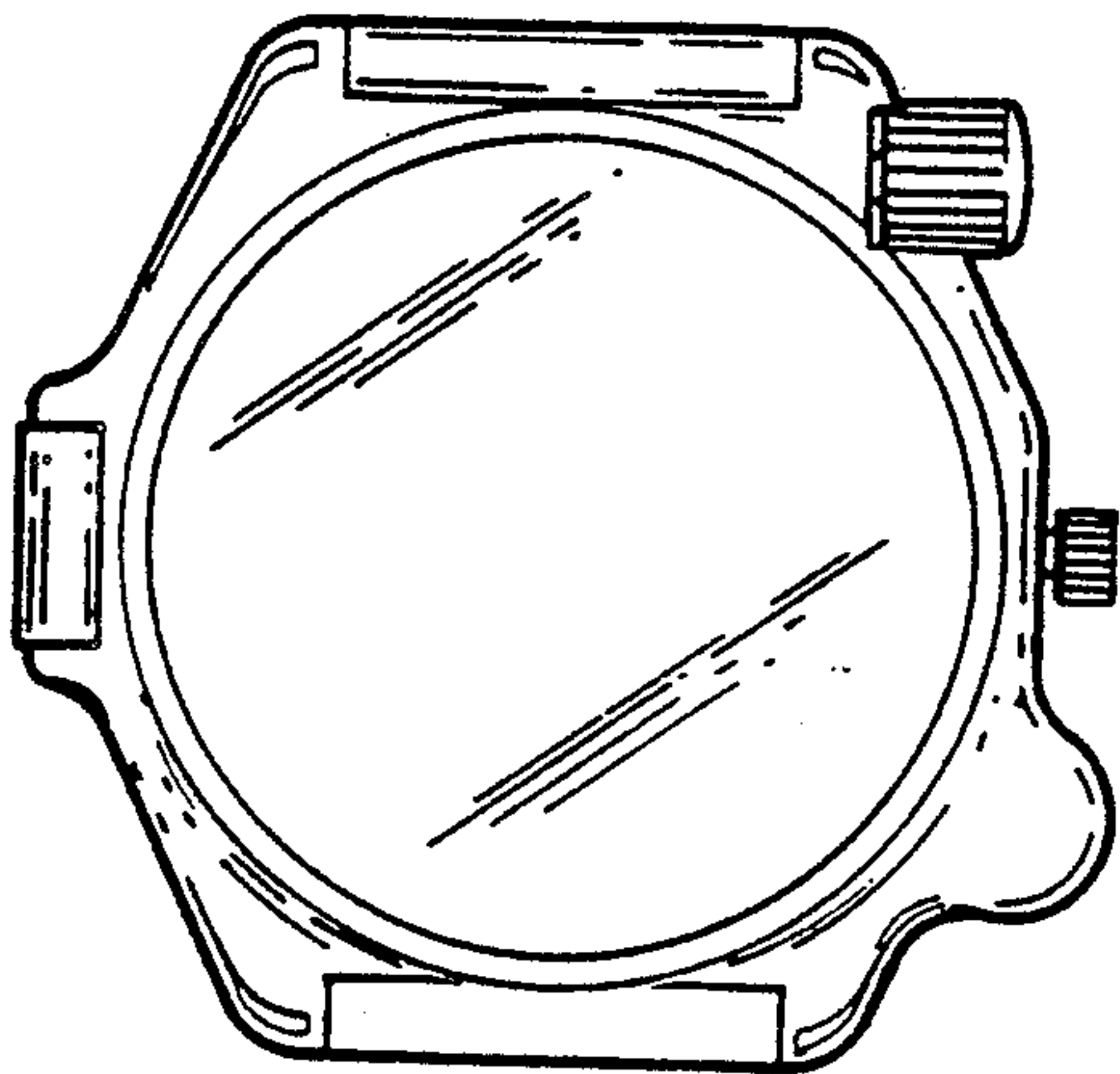

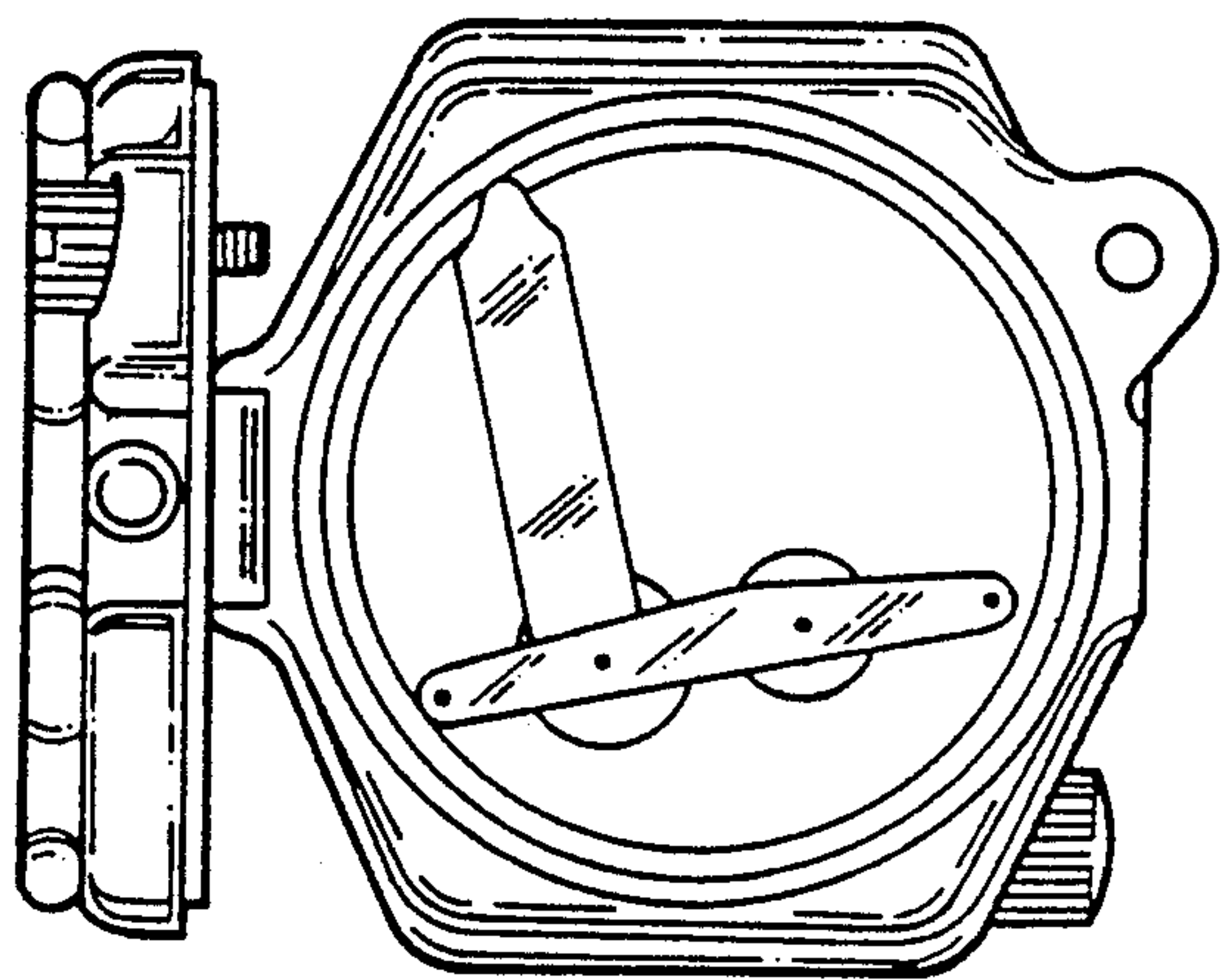

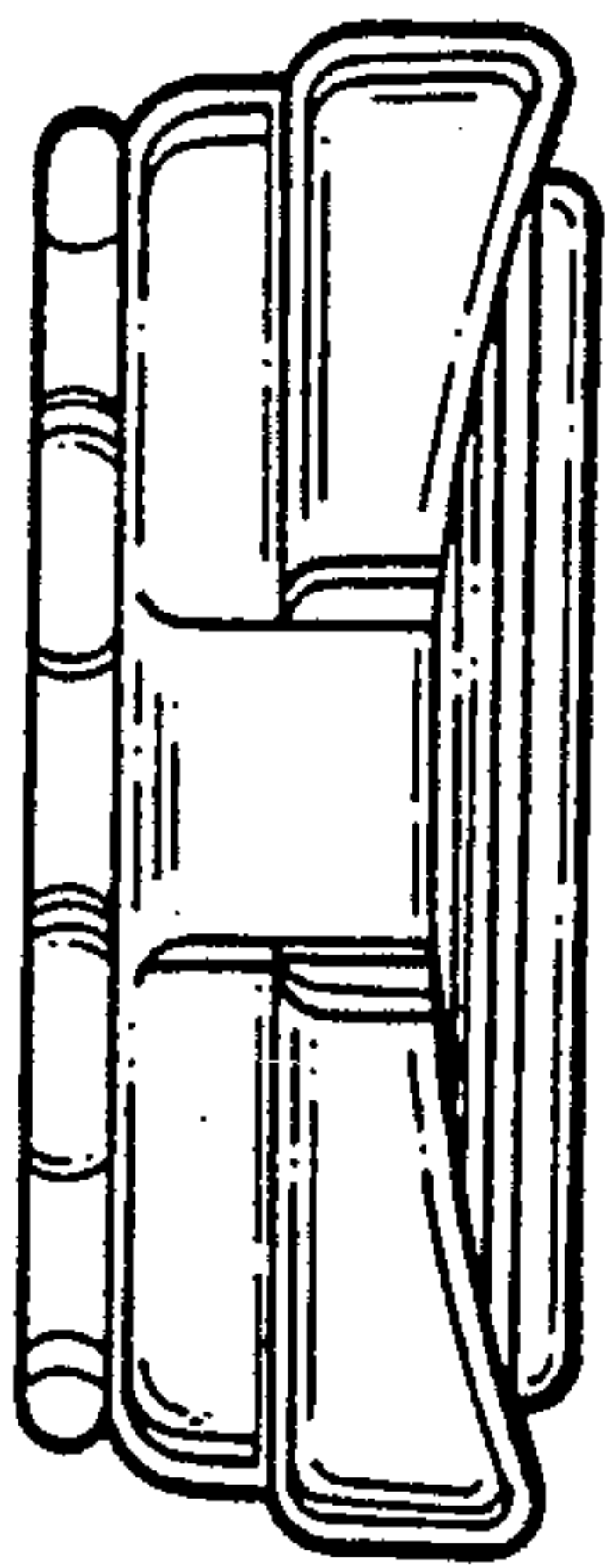

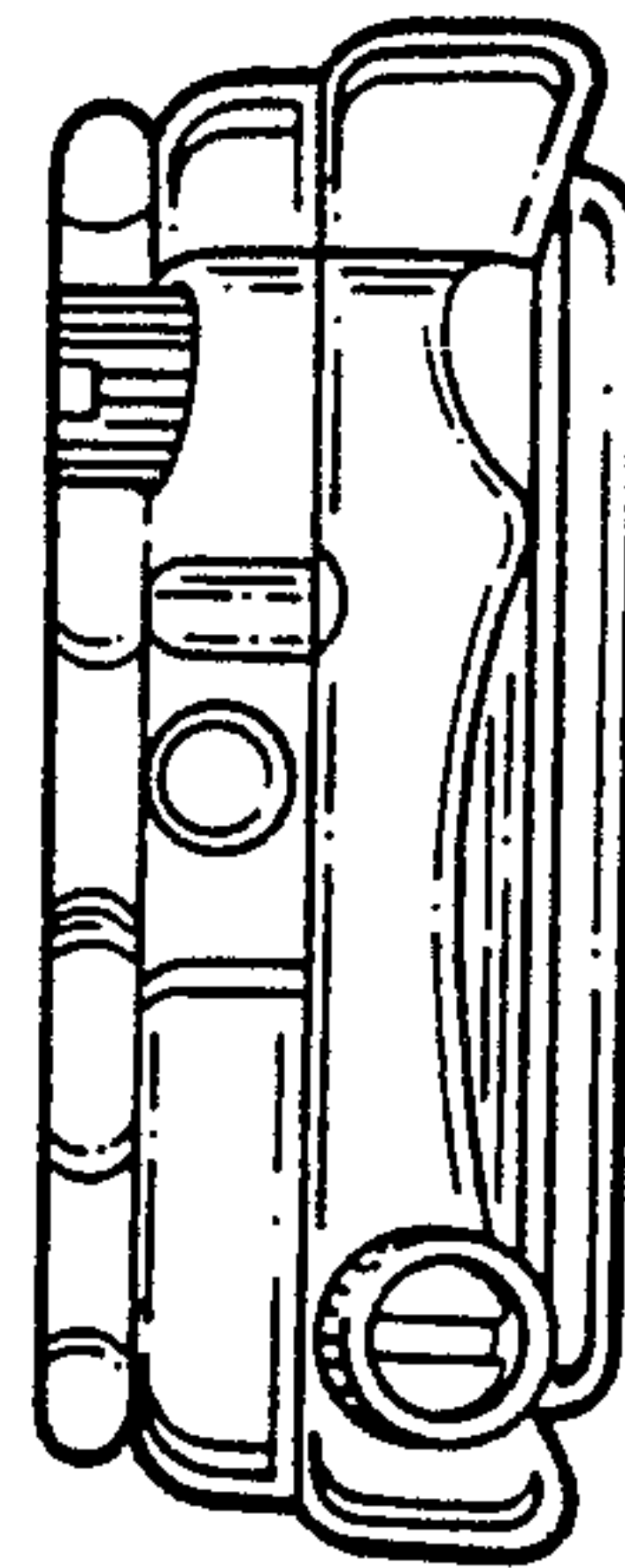
