The broken line showing of a ball is for illustrative purposes only and forms no part of the claimed design.

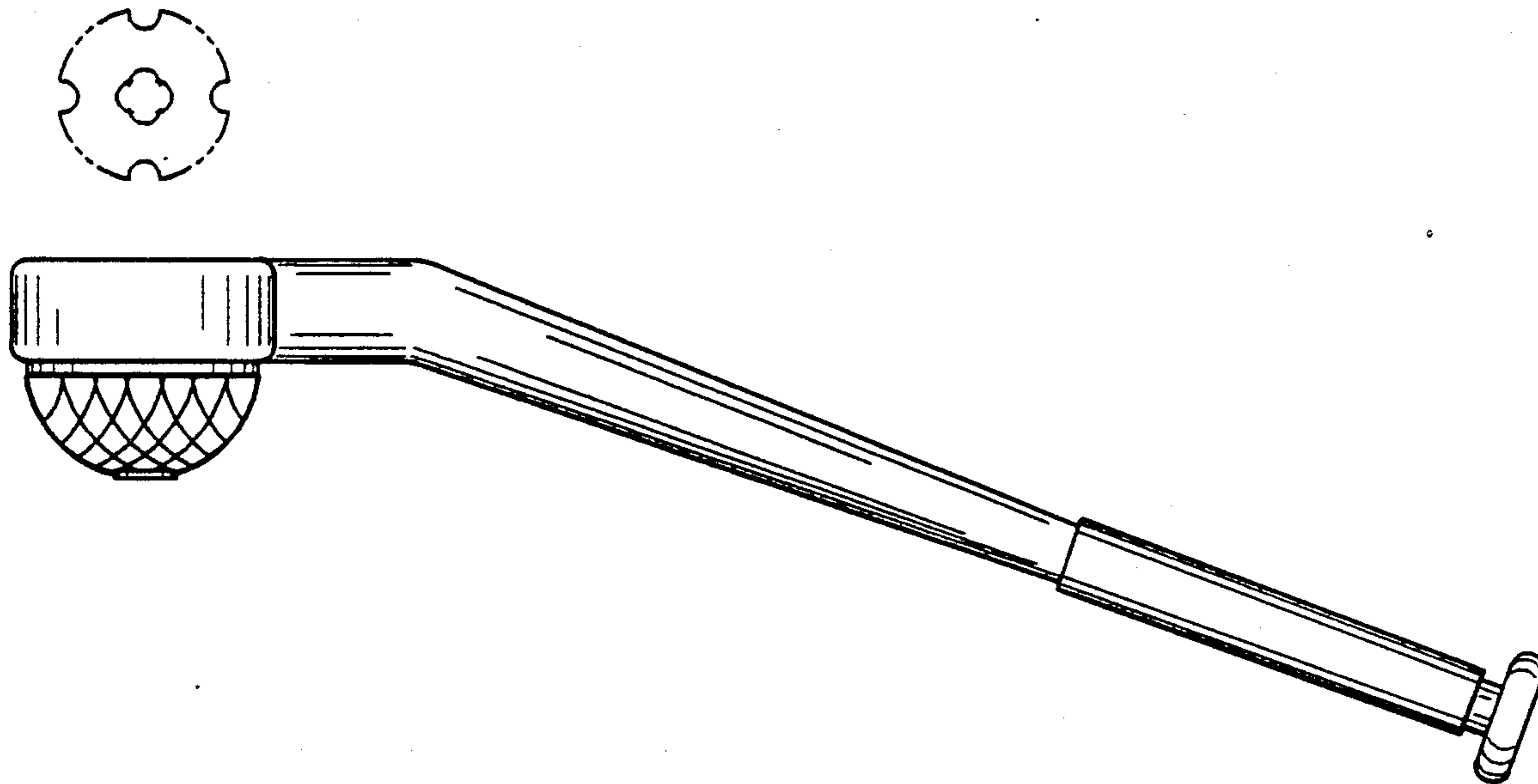

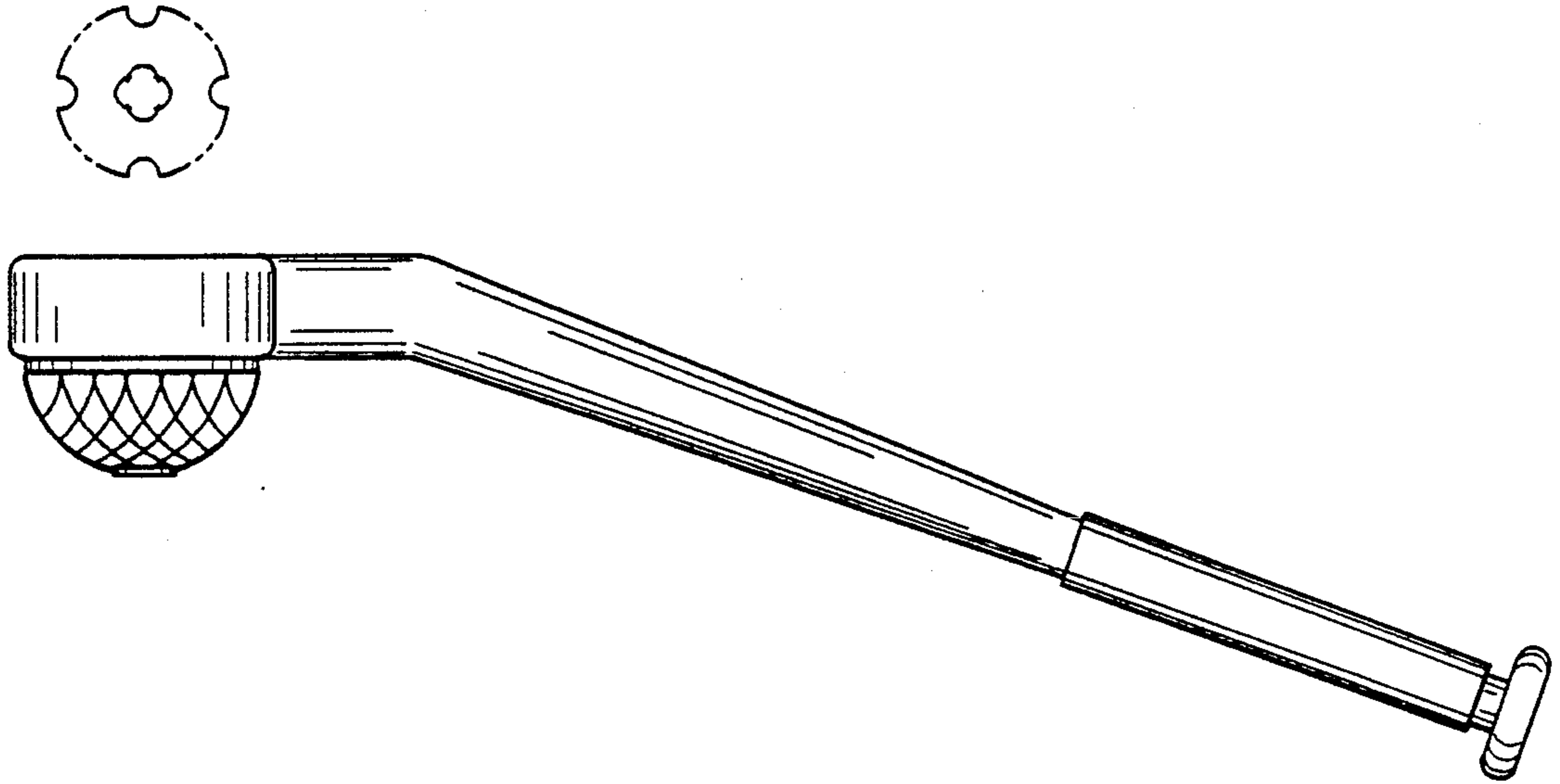

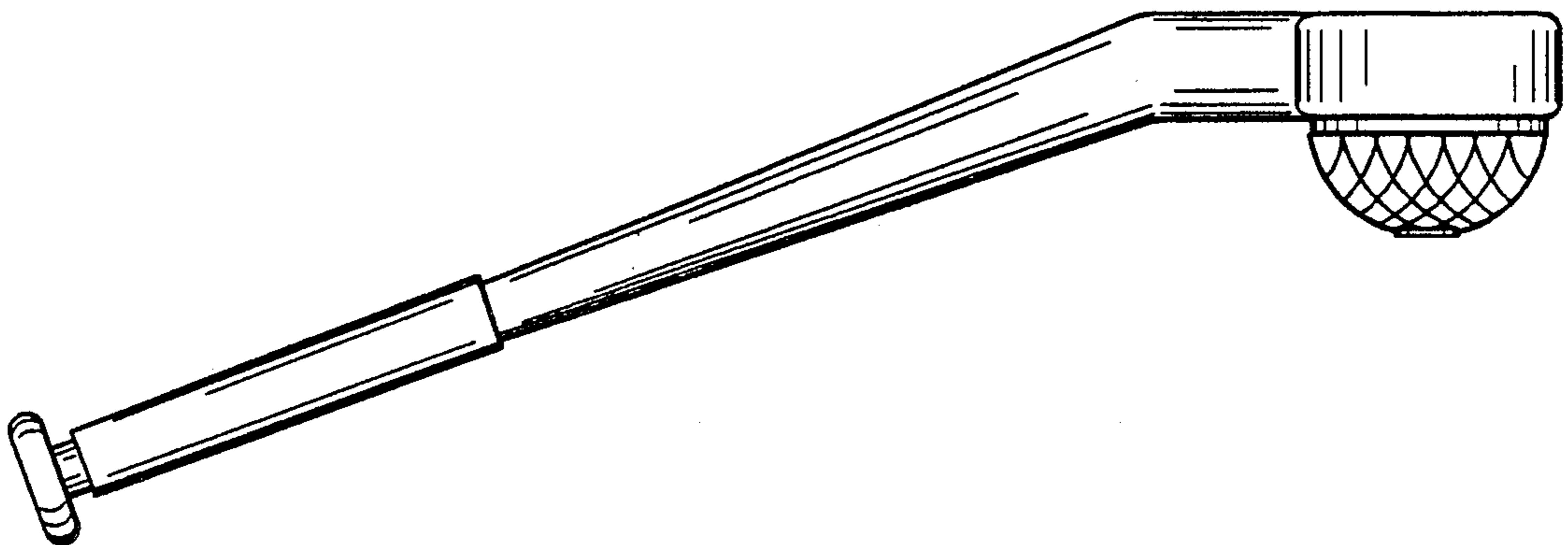

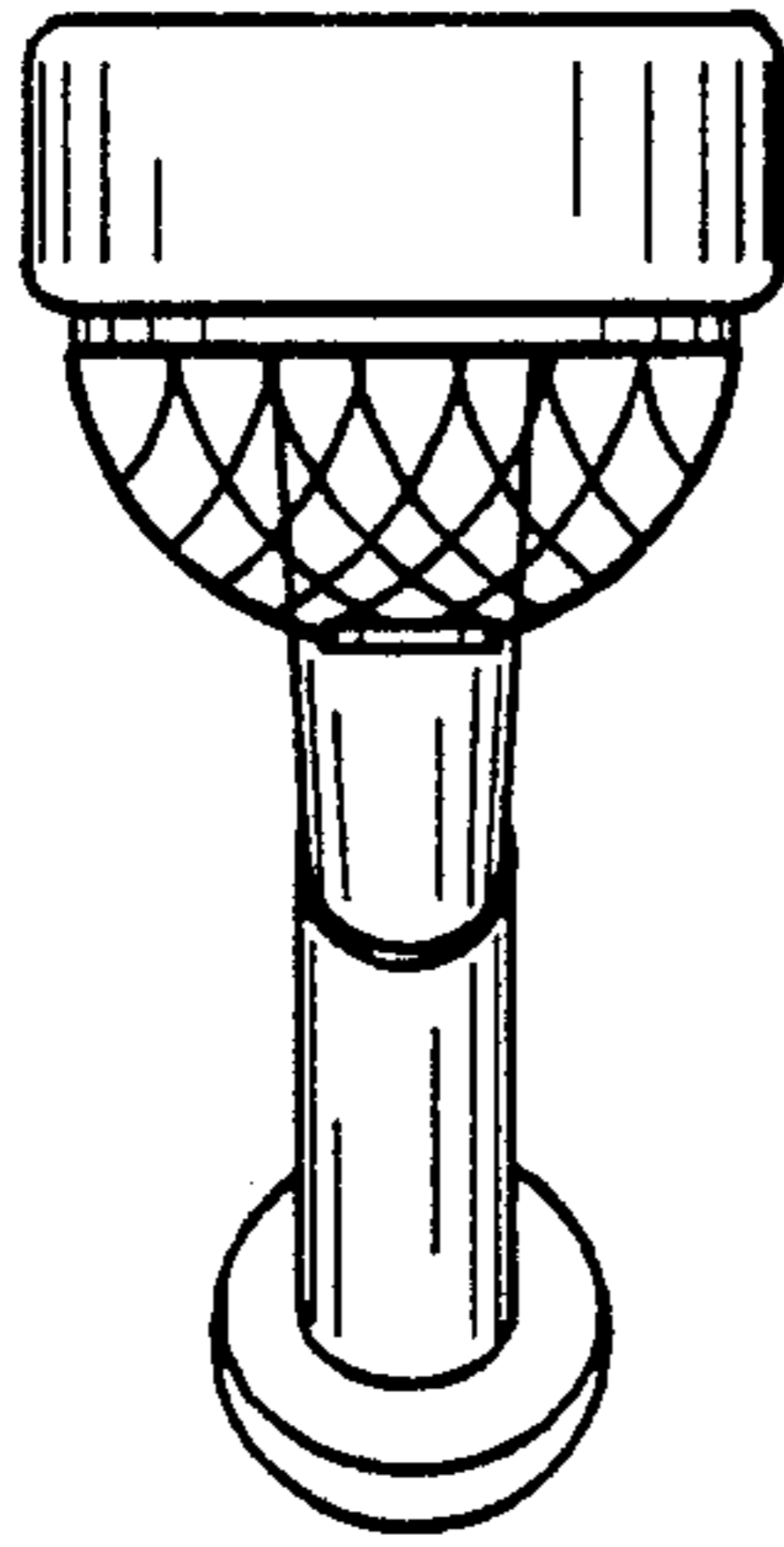

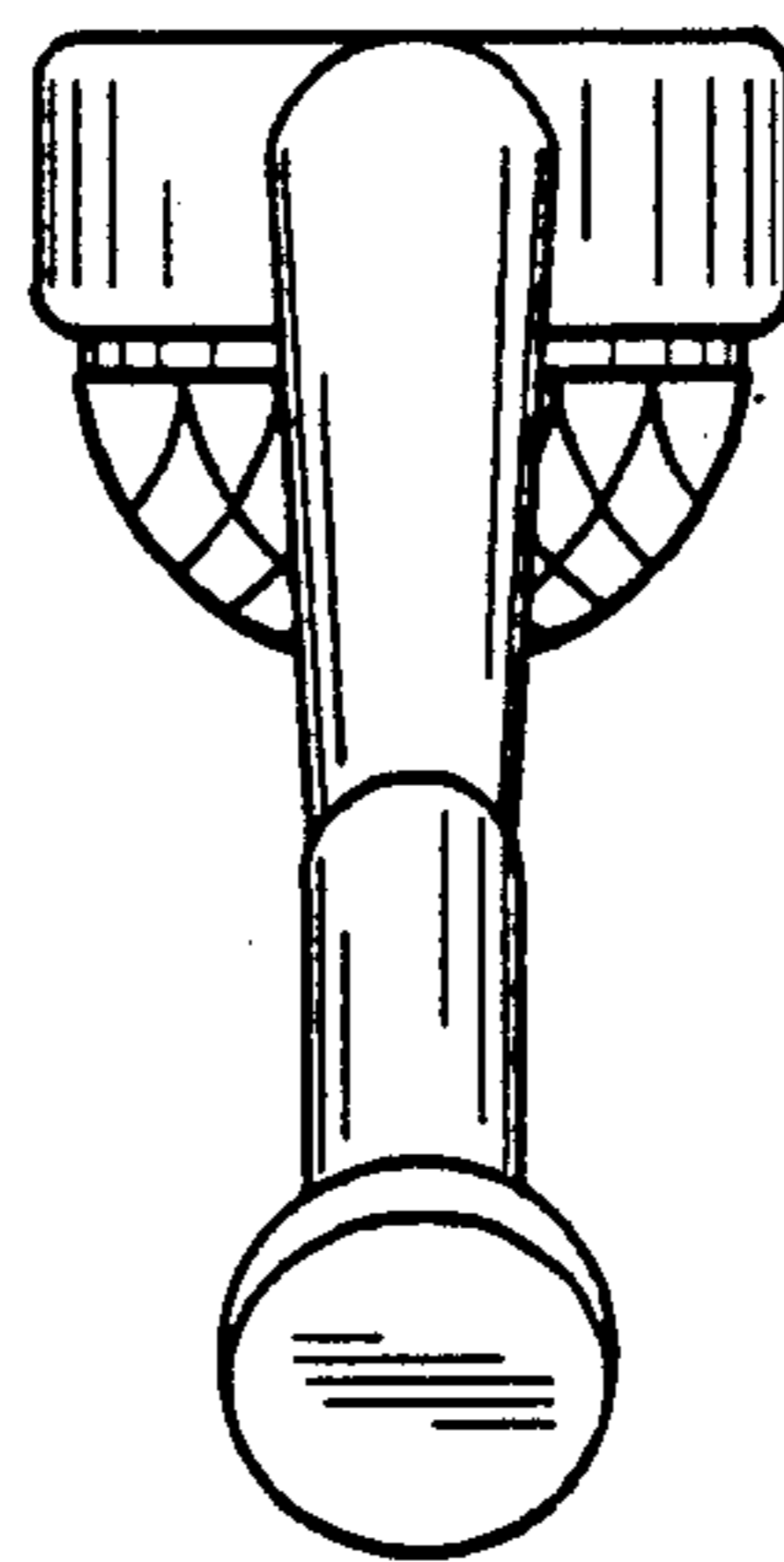
