FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof; and,

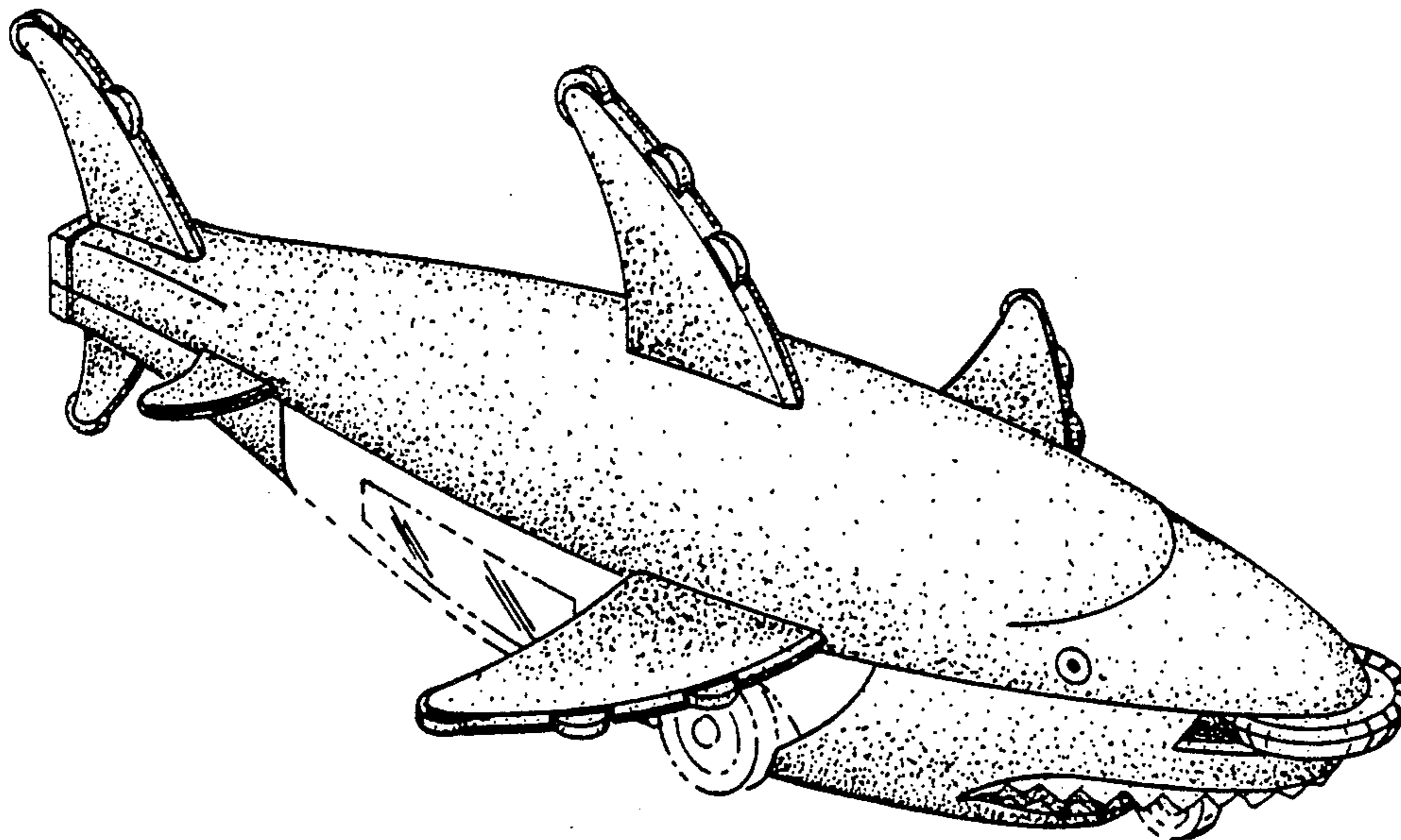
FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof.

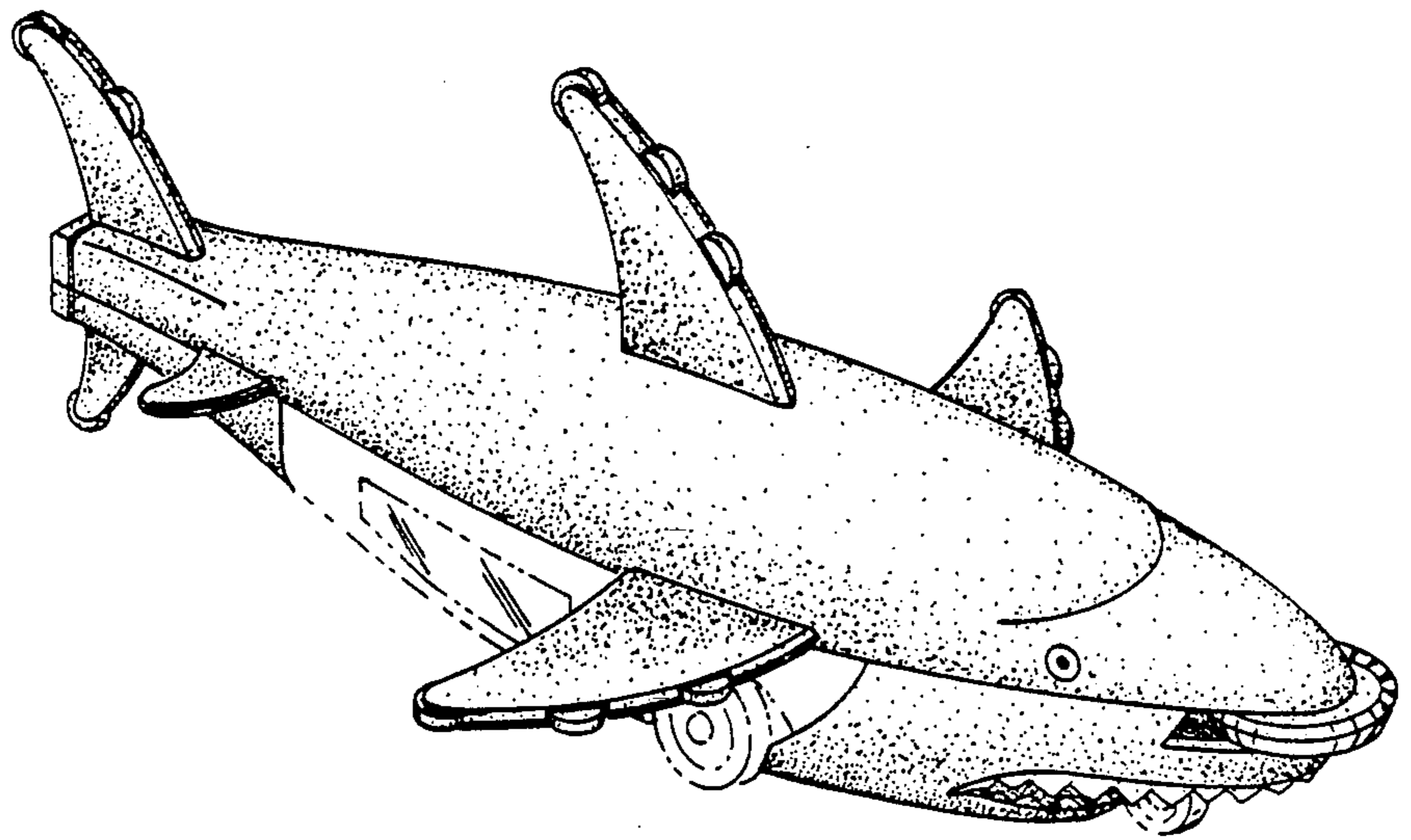

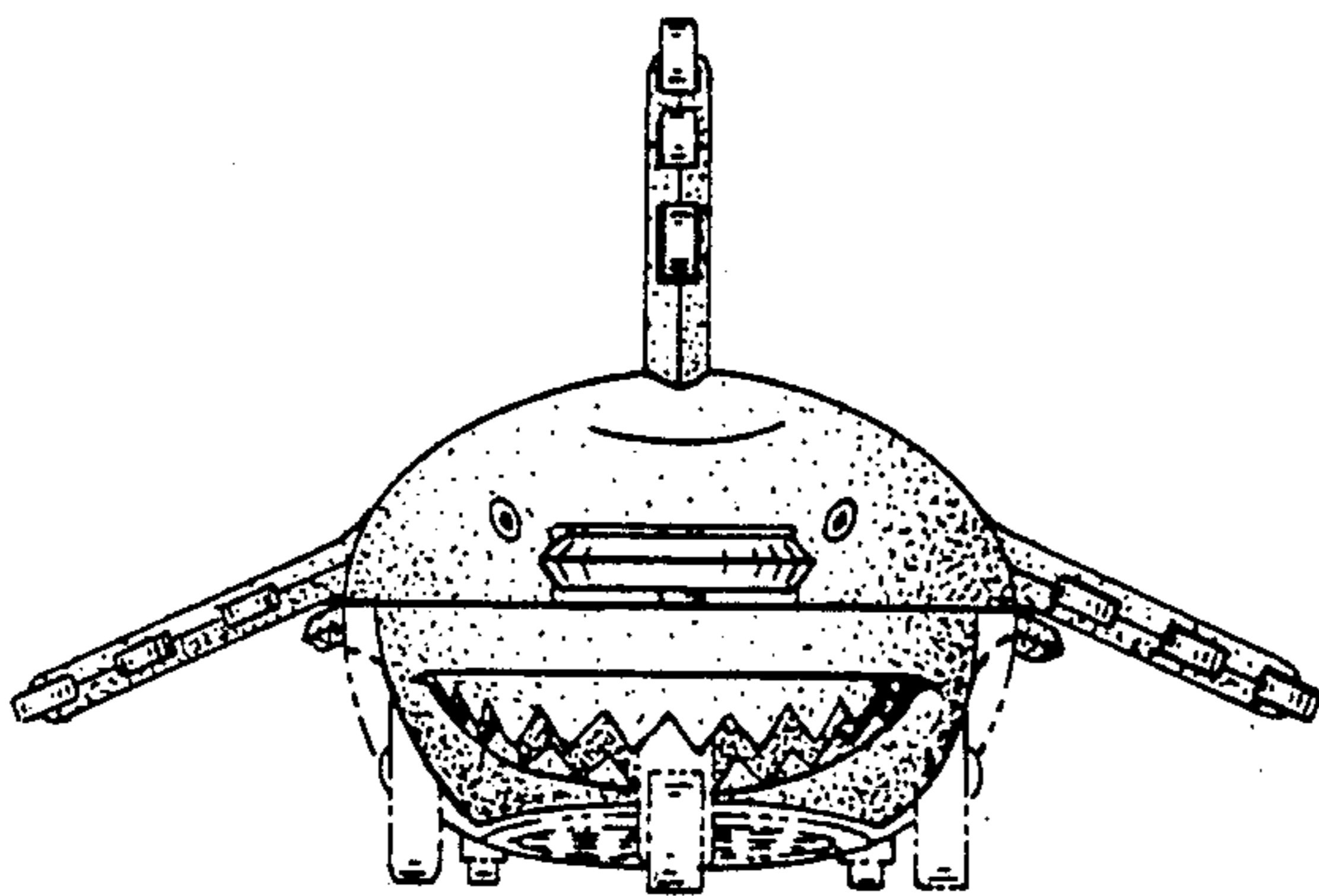

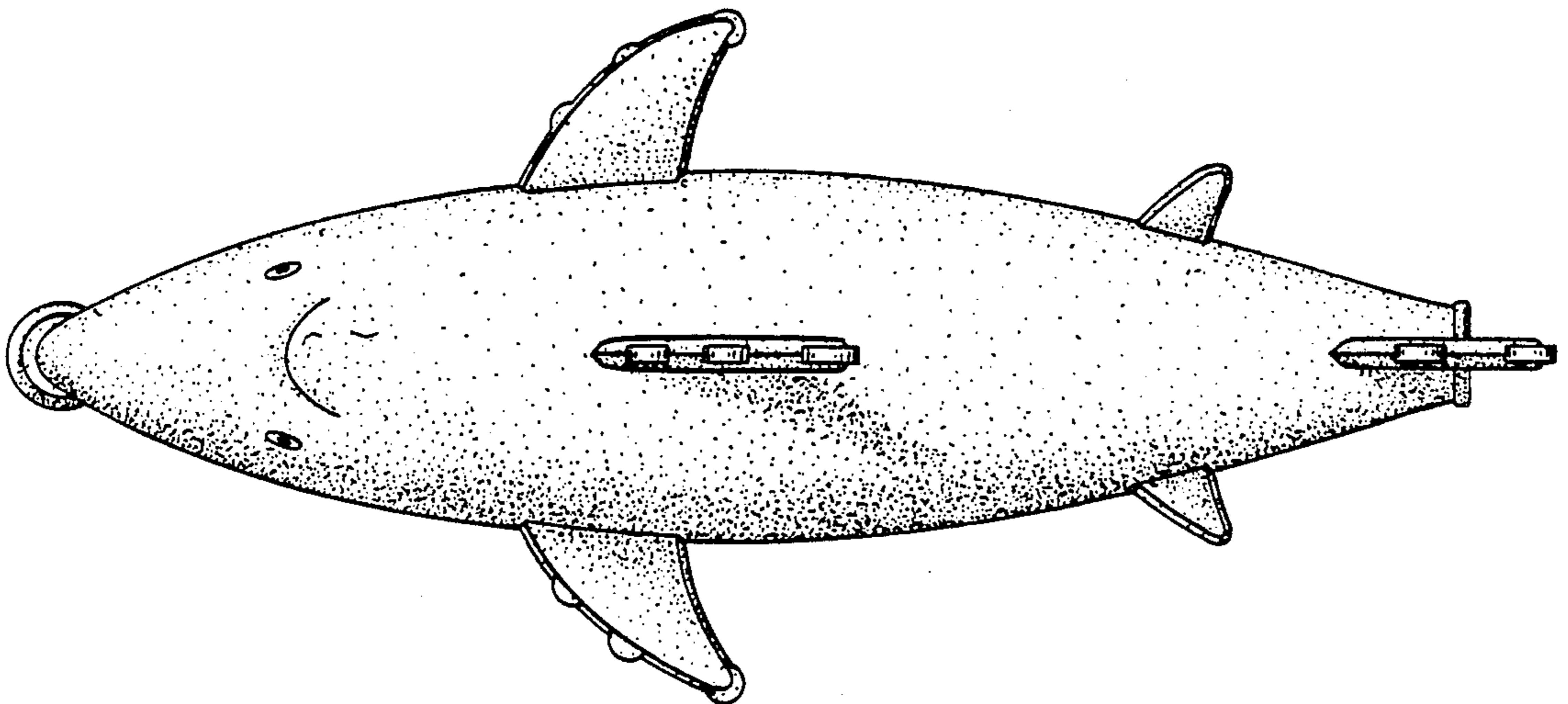

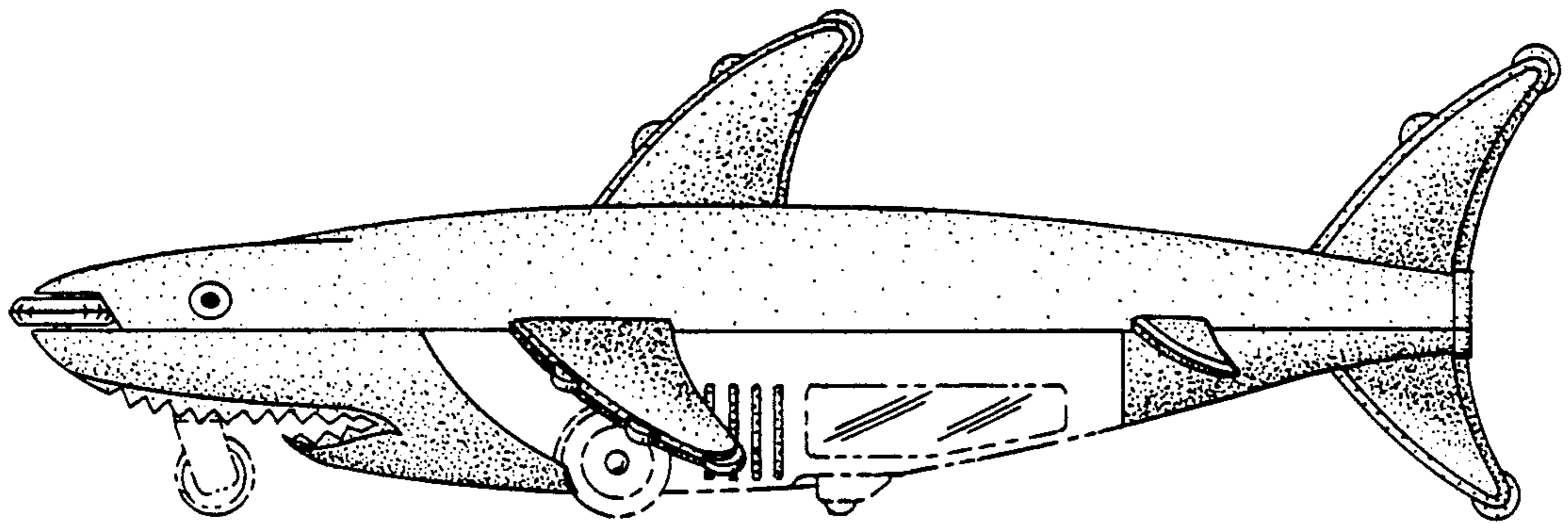

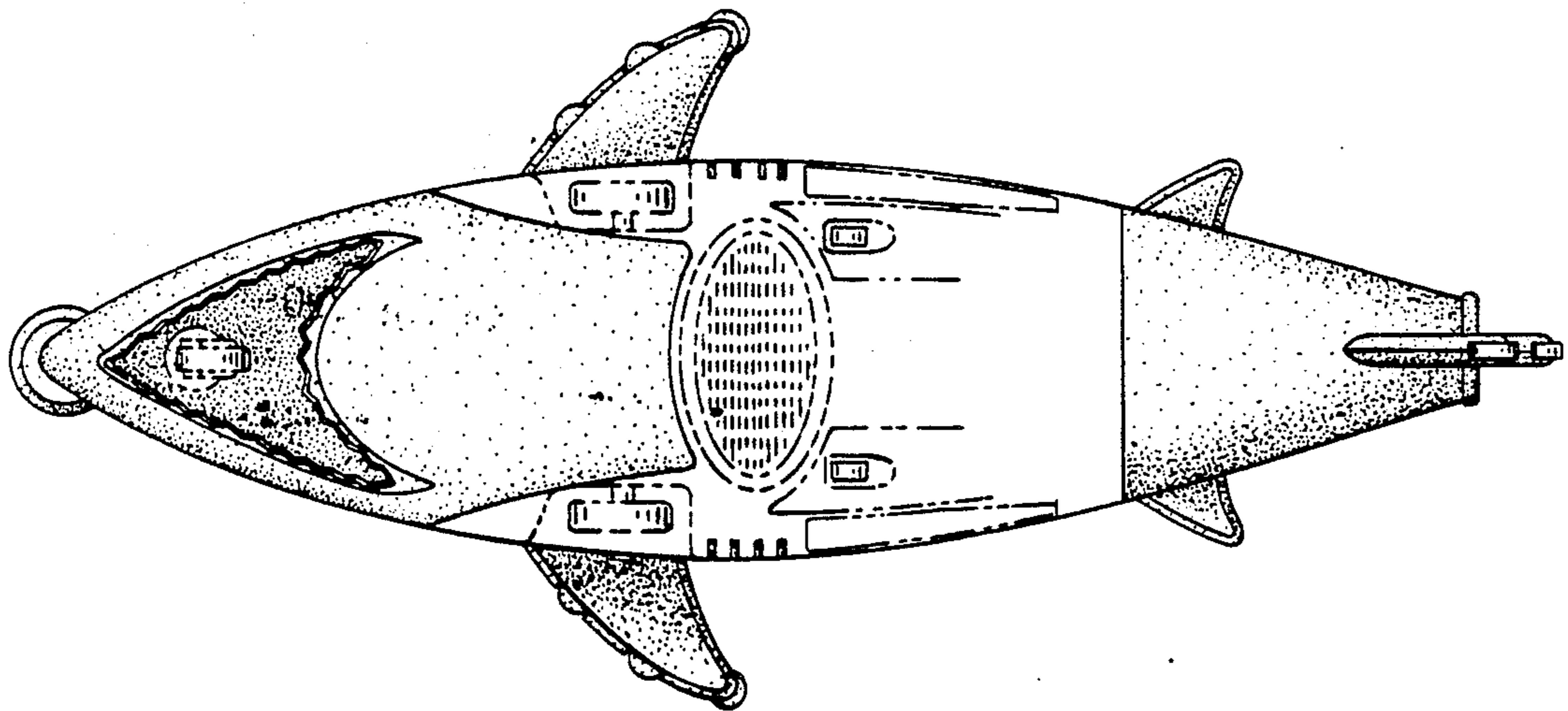

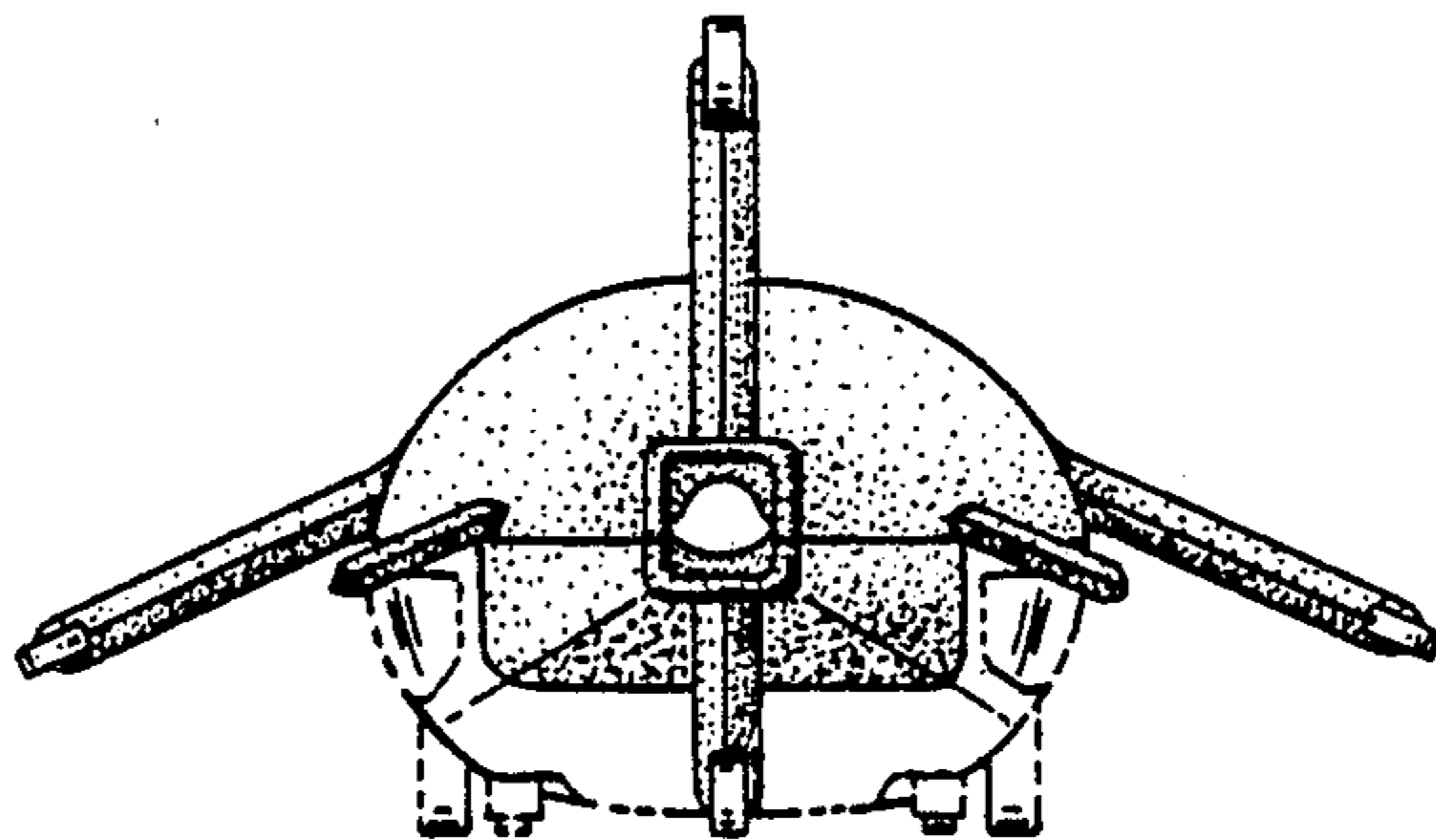
