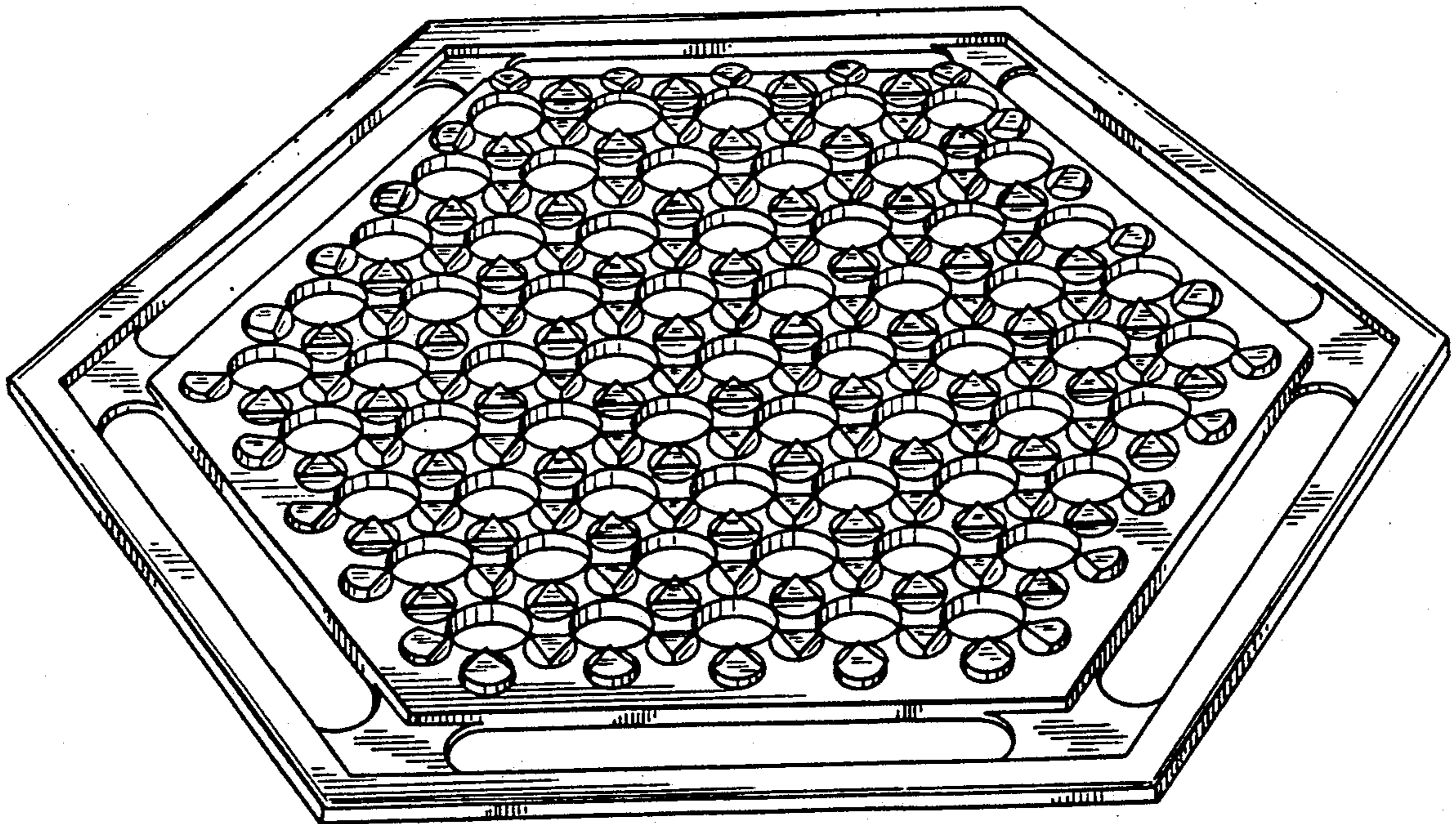

FIG. 3 is a top perspective view thereof.



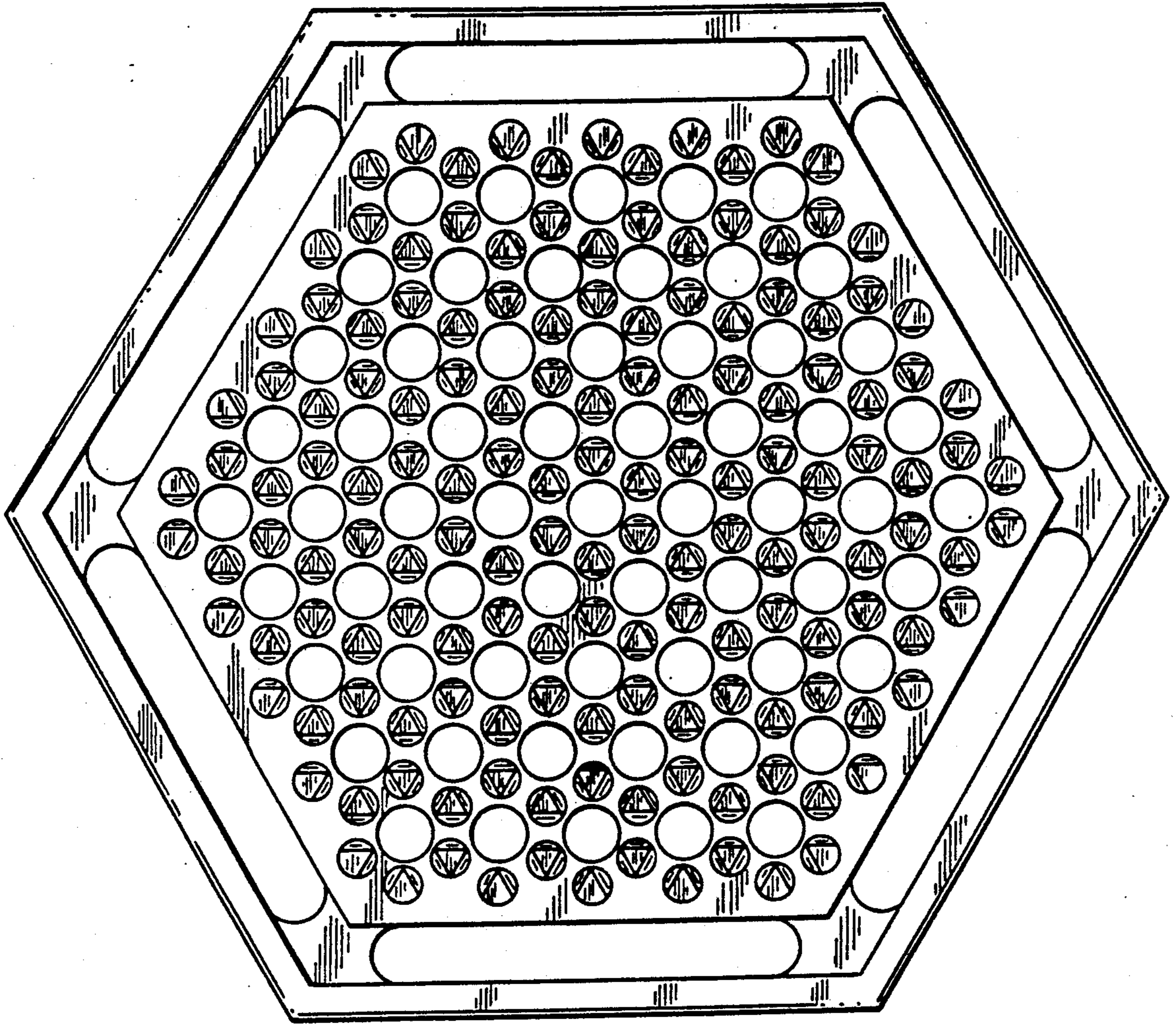

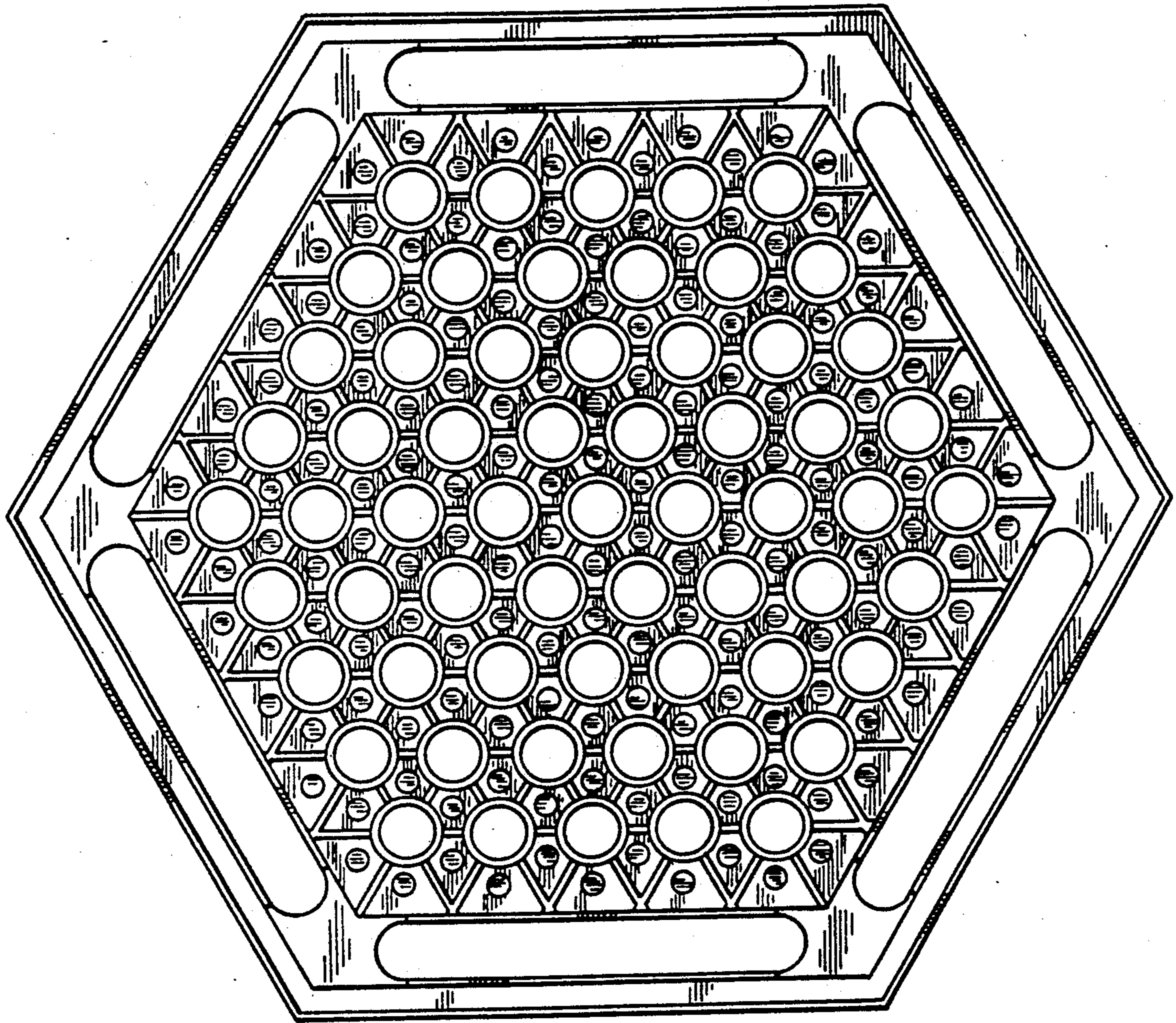

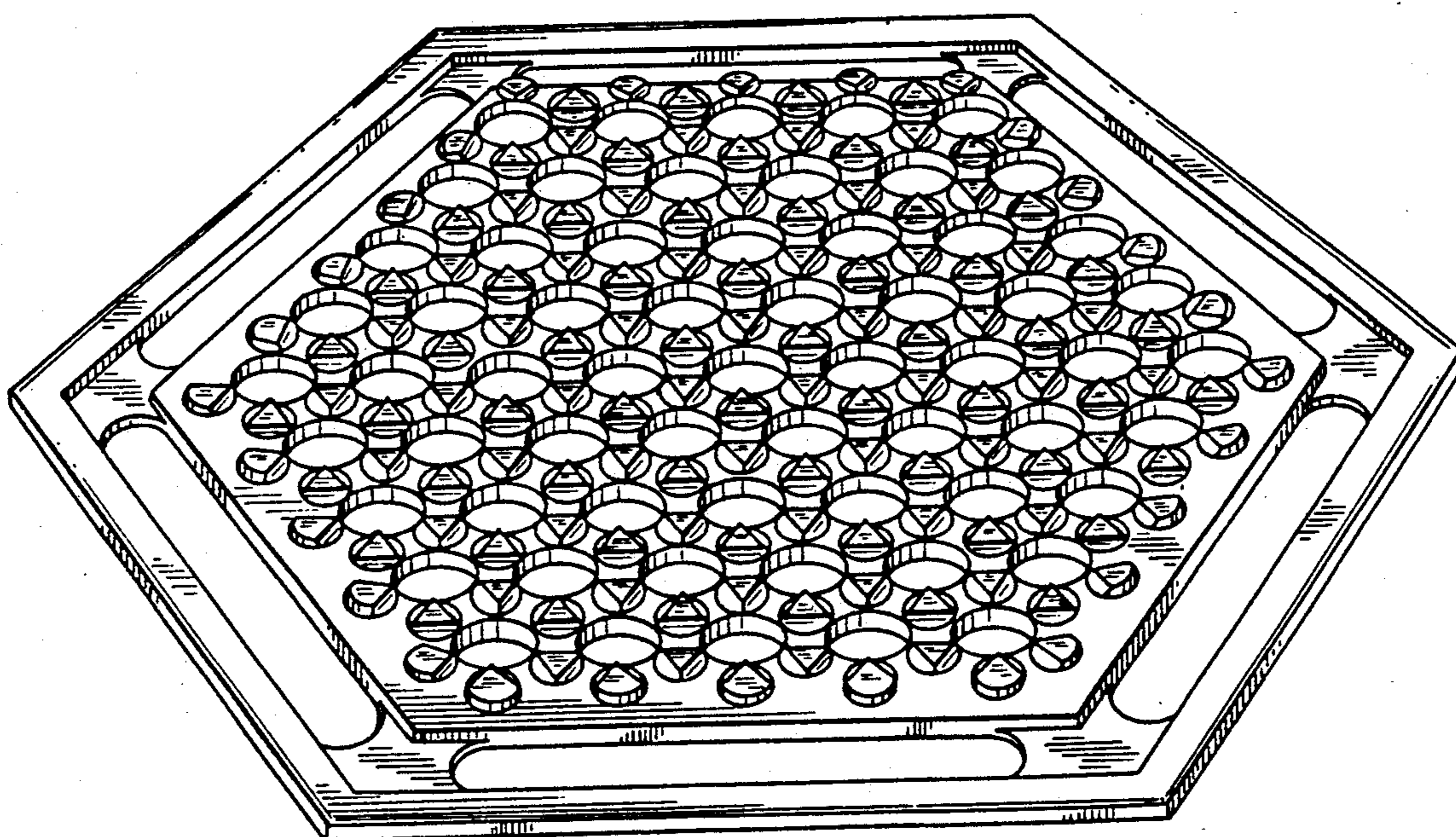
